STORYLINES

- The Nittany Lions host Georgia Tech at 7 p.m. Tuesday in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge. Both teams are coming off back-to-back wins with Penn State defeating George Washington, 74-68, on the road Saturday.
- This is the fourth meeting all-time between the Lions and Yellow Jackets, and the third in the Challenge.
- Penn State has won six of its last nine Big Ten/ACC Challenge games and holds a 7-8 record in 15 Challenge appearances. The Lions defeated Boston College, 67-58, on the road last season after Shep Garner knocked down eight 3-pointers and tallied 31 points. [More: Page 3]
- Freshmen led the way in the win over GW with Mike Watkins tallying a career-high 20 points and Lamar Stevens and Tony Carr adding 18 and 12, respectively. This followed up a veteran-led victory over Colgate last week with junior captains Payton Banks (20 pts), Terrence Samuel (16) and Shep Garner (10) among the double-digit scorers.
- Four players are averaging in double figures through six games, led by Garner and Carr (14.3). Three freshmen are among the top five scorers with a rookie leading the team in scoring in four of seven games.
- The Lions wrap up a program-record tying eight games in the month of November.

# CURRENT EVENTS

## FRESHMAN FOCUS

- All four of the freshmen on the Penn State roster hail from Philadelphia. True freshmen Nazeer Bostick, Tony Carr and Lamar Stevens all attended Roman Catholic and captured each of the last two PIAA AAAA state titles. Redshirt freshman Mike Watkins is a graduate of The Phelps School. In all, the Nittany Lions have six Philly-area players on the roster.
- Carr and Stevens are first and third on the team in scoring with 14.3 and 12.9 points per game, respectively. A rookie has led the team in scoring in four of seven games this season.
- With 14.3 ppg, Carr ranks 13th in the Big Ten in scoring and is one of four freshmen among the Top 15.
- The freshmen trio of Carr, Stevens and Watkins accounted for 72 percent (58 points) of Penn State's total scoring in the Lions' 82-74 win over Duquesne Nov. 13.
- To date, the rookies have scored nearly 52 percent (266/512) of the team's total points.

### GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE

- The Nittany Lions have once again earned a Graduation Success Rate (GSR) of 100 percent, according to statistical information released by the NCAA, this week.
- The program had a 100 percent success rate for the fourth-consecutive year and is the only Big Ten men's basketball team with a perfect score in the 2016 NCAA Graduation Rates report.
- For the 12th-consecutive year, every year the GSR data has been released, PSU basketball earned four-year Graduation Success Rates at least three points higher than the national average for its sport.
- The men's basketball graduation figure was 24 points higher than the Division I average in the 2016 NCAA report and 20 points above the Big Ten sport average.

### HOT FROM CHARITY STRIPE

- Penn State has hit 81.1 percent (103-127) of its free throws attempts this season, including a season-high 91.7 percent effort (11-12) against Cincinnati. The season percentage is ranked eighth in Division I and second in the Big Ten.
- Six players are shooting 80 percent or higher from the free-throw line. Among players with more than 10 attempts, Tony Carr leads the way with a 92.0 (23-25) showing. Carr missed his first FT of the season against Colgate last Wednesday.
- Lamar Stevens has made and attempted (32-35) the second-most free throws of any player in the Big Ten, behind Maryland's Melo Trimble.

### BLOCK. THAT. SHOT.

- Mike Watkins has 20 blocks through seven games to rank second in the Big Ten and 22nd in Division I with 2.9 blocks per game.
- Calvin Booth holds each of the top four places on the season blocks chart with his freshman campaign owning the No. 2 position (101/3.6 bpg, 1995-96).

### 40-STRAIGHT STARTS

- Shep Garner started in his 40th-consecutive game vs. Cincinnati last Sunday. He has started 72 of 73 career games to date, coming off the bench on senior night his freshman year in 2014 vs. Ohio State.

### HIGH-SCORING OFFENSE

- Head coach Patrick Chambers stated in the preseason one of the team's goals was to score at least 80 points per game and they did just that through the first three contests.
- The last time the Nittany Lions scored 80+ points in three-consecutive games was in the 2013-14 season (vs. Longwood, Monmouth and St. John's).

- Against Duquesne (11/13), Stevens (24 points) and Carr (20) became the first rookie duo since 1989 to produce 20 or more points apiece in a game since 1989. Freddie Barnes (24) and Monroe Brown (32) last pulled off the feat against Murray State in the opening round of the NIT March 15, 1989.
- The freshmen are also making impressive showings on the boards. Watkins (6.9 rpg), Carr (4.6) and Stevens (4.6) are the team's top-three rebounders. Watkins nabbed 11 boards vs. Cincinnati for the team's first double-digit rebound effort of the season.
- Stevens and Carr combined for nine of the team's 20 assists vs. Duquesne Nov. 13. It was the first time since 2013 that Penn State tallied 20 or more assists as a team. After tallying seven assists Tuesday vs. Grand Canyon, Carr has 4.3 per game and is among the Top 10 in the Big Ten.
- Through the first seven games, rookies make up three of the top five scorers for the Nittany Lions. Carr (14.3) is tied for first, followed by Stevens (12.9) in third and Watkins in fifth (9.6).

- The Nittany Lions scored 48 points in the first half against Grand Canyon Nov. 15. This is the most first-half points since scoring 49 in the first half vs. Penn on Nov. 25, 2008.

### DROPPING DIMES

- The Nittany Lions tallied 20 assists in back-to-back games vs. Duquesne (11/13) and Grand Canyon (11/15).
- Nearly 56 percent of the team's field goals are assisted so far this season (100/179), compared to 44 percent a year ago.
- The last time Penn State secured 20 assists in back-to-back contests was in three-consecutive games in the 2006-07 season (vs. Maine, VMI and Northwestern).
- Freshman Tony Carr leads the team in assists (4.0 apg) after tallying a team-high five at George Washington. He is ninth in the Big Ten.

### EARLY-SEASON TOURNEYS

After the losses to Duke and Cincinnati, Penn State is 77-91 in early-season tournaments. The Lions have participated in at least one each season since 1981 and have captured 10 tourney championships, 12 second-place and 27 third-place finishes.

Last season, Penn State finished the Las Vegas Classic with a 3-1 record and a third-place finish. The Lions defeated Canisius and Louisiana-Monroe in the on-campus contests, before splitting with Colorado (L, 71-70) and Kent State (W, 75-69).

# SEASON NOTES

## SEASON OPENERS

With the loss to Albany Nov. 11, Penn State dropped its first season opener since 2004. It had won its last 11 season openers dating to 2005, including the previous five under Patrick Chambers. The Lions are 89-31 overall in season openers and 79-11 in home season openers.

## CHAMBERS TAKES ON YEAR SIX

The 2016-17 season marks the sixth year at the helm of the Nittany Lions for head coach Patrick Chambers. The Philly native is coming off one of his best coaching performances in University Park after leading the team to seven Big Ten wins, the most of his career, and 16 overall victories for the third year in a row. The Nittany Lions had not previously reached reached 16 wins in three-consecutive seasons since joining the Big Ten Conference.

## #UNLOCKED

The Nittany Lions offered an unprecedented look into their program through a web series called #UNLOCKED, available through the team's social media accounts, as well as GoPSUsports.com / GoPSUnow (search men's basketball). In conjunction with WPSU, the videos feature never before seen access into the Nittany Lion players, coaches, staff and program.

## SCORING THREATS

Penn State returns three of its top four scorers from a year ago: Shep Garner (14.8 ppg), Payton Banks (9.4 ppg) and Josh Reaves (6.4 ppg).

## STARTER EXPERIENCE

Five of Penn State's returning letterwinners made at least one appearance in the starting lineup last season, including three who started more than 60 percent of the team's games: Shep Garner (32 starts), Payton Banks (31) and Josh Reaves (20).

## TOUGH SLATE

Patrick Chambers and his staff have assembled one of the toughest non-conference slates in program history. The Nittany Lions will face Duke (11/19), Cincinnati or Rhode Island (11/20), George Washington (11/26), Georgia Tech (11/29), Pittsburgh (12/10) and St. John's (12/18).

## PHILLY TOUGH

Six players hail from the Philadelphia area on this year's Penn State roster, including four from Roman Catholic High School. Freshmen Nazeer Bostick, Tony Carr and Lamar Stevens joined Shep Garner as PSU players from Roman. Mike Watkins (The Phelps School) and Julian Moore (Germantown Academy) round out the group.

## ROMAN CATHOLIC x 4

The four players from Roman Catholic High School in Philadelphia - Shep Garner, Nazeer Bostick, Tony Carr and Lamar Stevens - are believed the only group of four players from the same high school on an active Division I men's basketball roster.

## PALESTRA AS HOME COURT

Penn State is taking Big Ten basketball to the City of Brotherly Love, hosting Michigan State in a league matchup Saturday, Jan. 7, 2017 in Philadelphia's historic Palestra. It will count as a home game for the Nittany Lions, who boast six players from the Philly area on this year's roster, in addition to Chambers, a Delaware County native. The game sold out to the public in September.

## OFFSEASON TRAINING

Penn State enlisted the SEAL Team Physical Training program for assistance in offseason workouts. The team was put through two days of physical and mental challenges designed to enhance physical and mental toughness. Check out the two-part video series on the workouts, as well as numerous other videos from the offseason on the team's Facebook page (/pennstatebasketball/videos).

## NEW FACES

In addition to the members of the freshman recruiting class, the Nittany Lions welcomed rookie walk-on Grant Hazle from Houston, Texas this fall. Satchel Pierce, a 7-footer from Virginia Tech, transferred to Happy Valley in the offseason and will sit out the upcoming campaign. Terrence Samuel, a backup guard on UConn's 2014 National Championship team, is coming off his year of sitting out and will be primed for action in 2016-17, joining redshirted freshman Mike Watkins, who was not eligible to compete last season.

## NO SENIORS HERE

There is not a single senior on the Nittany Lions' 2016-17 roster. Juniors Shep Garner and Payton Banks are the veterans of the squad, along with UConn transfer Terrence Samuel. Virginia Tech transfer Satchel Pierce also is a junior and will have two years of eligibility remaining beginning next year. Eleven of 15 players on the roster have freshman or sophomore year eligibility, including Pierce.

## FREQUENT TRAVELERS

Head coach Patrick Chambers has not shied away from taking his squads away from home in the non-conference. The Lions have five road or neutral games before league play this year, following up six such contests a year ago.

Penn State's trips this season include stops in metro area hotbeds: New York (St. John's/MSG), Newark (Pitt/Prudential Center), Washington (GW/Smith Center), in addition to the Palestra stop to face Michigan State.

## LIONS IN THE PROS

Tim Frazier signed a two-year, \$4.1-million contract with the NBA's New Orleans Pelicans in July following a stint with them late last season. He is Penn State's first NBA player since Calvin Booth finished a 10-year NBA career in 2009.

All four members of 2016 senior class are currently playing professionally overseas. Jordan Dickerson (Serbia), Devin Foster (Georgia), Donovan Jack (England) and Brandon Taylor (Greece) are all on teams to start the season. They join Nittany Lion legend D.J. Newbill (Belgium) and Sasa Borovnjak (Serbia) as PSU alums in Europe. All of Penn State's seven players currently playing pro earned their undergraduate degrees.

## POSEY ENTERED NAISMITH HOF

Cumberland "Cum" Posey, Jr., recognized as the first African-American student-athlete in Penn State history, was inducted to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame Friday in Springfield, Massachusetts this summer. Posey enrolled at Penn State in 1909 and played forward on the freshman basketball team (1909-10) and the varsity basketball team (1910-11), while also playing on the freshman baseball team (1910). Although he did not play in enough games to earn a varsity letter as a Nittany Lion, Posey's impact and influence at Penn State goes well beyond the bound of official records.

## 121ST SEASON PENN STATE BASKETBALL

The Nittany Lions embark on the 121st season of basketball at Penn State and their 26th as a member of the Big Ten in 2016-17. The Lions began play in 1897 with a pair of contests vs. Bucknell. Penn State has made 13 postseason appearances in the last 28 years (4 NCAA, 8 NIT, 1 CBI) and a total of 20 (9 NCAA, 10 NIT, 1 CBI) overall.

Over the last five seasons, **PATRICK CHAMBERS** has reinvigorated Penn State basketball. Since being named the 12th head coach in program history June 6, 2011, the Philly native quickly energized his players and staff, as well as the Penn State fan base with his passion, enthusiasm and his team's all-out style of play.

The 2015-16 freshman class - the first Top 30 recruiting class in PSU history - clearly illustrates the progress Chambers and his staff have made during their time in Happy Valley. The future continues to be bright as Penn State will welcome a four-member consensus Top 15 class (at the time of signing) to begin their Nittany Lion careers in 2016-17.

Chambers has sent players into the professional ranks in each of the last two years with Tim Frazier (2010-14) spending time with the New Orleans Pelicans, Portland Trail Blazers and Philadelphia 76ers, and with D.J. Newbill (2013-15) playing professionally in Europe in Turkey. The 2014-15 senior class produced a Euroleague player (Newbill), a Kansas City Chiefs practice player (Ross Travis), a Ford engineer (Alan Wisniewski) and a Penn State graduate student in accounting with eight-consecutive semesters of a 4.0 GPA (Kevin Montminy), proving all venues of success are available.

Penn State has had 16 or more wins in a season six times since 2000-01, including each of the last three seasons under the direction of Chambers. The Nittany Lions had not previously reached 16 wins in three-consecutive seasons since joining the Big Ten Conference. These wins include five over Top 25-ranked teams in his tenure with two coming last season alone vs. Indiana and Iowa.

In both victory and defeat, however, the Philly native's teams are heralded for their work ethic, perseverance and relentless attitude.

During his time with the Nittany Lions, Chambers has guided five players to a combined seven All-Big Ten honors, including Tim Frazier's first-team nod in 2011 and most recently with Brandon Taylor's third-team selection in 2016. Frazier ended his career as the all-time leader in assists at Penn State — a record Chambers also holds to this date at his alma mater Philadelphia. When D.J. Newbill's PSU career ended, he was the fourth-ranked scorer in Nittany Lion history, after just three seasons, and Ross Travis has the third-most rebounds of any player to ever don the Blue and White.

To Penn State students, Chambers is known around campus for his infectious energy. He ordered up a pair of golf carts and began making spur-of-the-moment trips around the University Park campus distributing t-shirts. In his first few years, he visited amusement parks, pep rallies, student groups, and classes and threw out first pitches. Chambers even went as far as to go behind the counter to serve free Big Macs to students at State College's downtown McDonald's and donned a Penn State football jersey and helmet to fire up the famed "Nittanyville" student campout.

UNIVERSITY PARK, Pa. - Lamar Stevens scored 19 points, Payton Banks added 15 and Shep Garner chipped in 14 points to lead Penn State to an 85-76 victory over Grand Canyon in the Hall of Fame Tip-Off Tournament on Tuesday night.

Penn State used a 28-18 run to build a 48-41 halftime lead. That evaporated within the first 5 minutes of the second half. In that span, the Nittany Lions went 0-for-9 from the field as Grand Canyon jumped back in front.

The Nittany Lions (2-1) put together an impressive 13-7 run in which Banks and Stevens combined for all 13 points. Stevens tipped in a rebound with 6:06 left to put Penn State up 75-63 for its biggest lead of the game.

Joshua Braun made 5 of 10 3-pointers and led Grand Canyon (0-2) with 25 points. Oscar Frayer, Darion Clark, Keonta Vernon and Shaq Carr also finished in double figures for the Antelopes with 13, 12, 11 and 10 points, respectively.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Penn State started Tony Carr, Shep Garner, Payton Banks, Lamar Stevens and Mike Watkins for the second-consecutive game Tuesday night. The lineup is 2-0 on the season.
Penn State scored 85 points total, a season-high for the 2016-17 season.
This is the third-consecutive game that the Nittany Lions scored 80+ points. The last time the Nittany Lions scored 80+ points in three-consecutive games was in the 2013-14 season (vs. Longwood, Monmouth and St. John's).

UNCASVILLE, Conn. - Freshman Frank Jackson led five players in double figures with 17 points and top-ranked Duke defeated Penn State 78-68 Saturday in the Hall of Fame Tip-Off tournament.

Amile Jefferson added 16 points and 16 rebounds for the Blue Devils (3-1), who lost forward Chase Jeter to injury early in the game. The 6-foot-10 sophomore rolled his left ankle in the first half and didn't return.

Tony Carr had 20 points and Shep Garner added 15 to lead Penn State (2-2).

Grayson Allen finished with 12 points. He needs just three more to become the 65th Duke player with 1,000 points for his career.

Matt Jones and Luke Kennard added 15 points each for Duke.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Penn State is now 2-2 on the season after falling to No. 1/1 Duke, 78-68.
The Nittany Lions started the lineup or Tony Carr, Shep Garner, Payton Banks, Lamar Stevens and Mike Watkins for the third time in 2016 against the Blue Devils. PSU is now 2-1 with said lineup starting.
Penn State took the lead at the 17:01 mark of the first half, as a jumper from Payton Banks made the score 6-5. PSU held the lead for 1:38 before a layup from Duke's Amile Jefferson gave the Blue Devils the lead. Penn State would not take the lead again.
After trailing by as much as 17 at 47:30 with 17:25 left on the clock, Penn State made continued to chip away at the defense with a 36-17 run over 16 minutes to tighten the gap to just eight points (68-74) with 0:36 remaining.
Freshman guard Tony Carr led all scorers in the game with 20 points. The scoring output matched Carr's season best, set against Duquesne (11/13).

UNCASVILLE, Conn. - Kyle Washington had 16 points and 17 rebounds and No. 24 Cincinnati beat Penn State 71-50 on Sunday in the consolation game of the Hall of Fame Tip-Off. Jacob Evans added 14 points for the Bearcats (3-1). They bounced back from a loss to No. 21 Rhode Island on Saturday by dominating the Nittany Lions.

Shep Garner had 20 points to lead Penn State (2-3), after scoring 15 in the team's 10-point loss Saturday to top-ranked Duke.

This one wasn't as competitive. The Bearcats put the game away early, using an 18-1 run to build a 32-10 advantage. Washington had 10 of his points and seven rebounds in the first half and Bearcats shot 59 percent from the field, getting inside almost at will. They went into halftime leading 34-19.

POSTGAME NOTES

- Penn State is now 2-3 on the season after the setback against No. 24/25 Cincinnati, 71-50.
The Nittany Lions started the lineup or Tony Carr, Shep Garner, Payton Banks, Lamar Stevens and Mike Watkins for the fourth time in 2016 against the Bearcats. PSU is now 2-2 while starting the lineup.
Garner led Penn State's scoring efforts, netting 20 points in the game on 7-of-16 shooting from the field. Freshman guard Tony Carr joined Garner in double figure scoring with 10 points on 3-of-9 shooting and a perfect 4-of-4 from the free throw line.
Freshman Mike Watkins set a new single-game high for rebounding, posting 11 boards in the game against Cincinnati.
Penn State posted its best showing from the free throw line this season, going 11-of-12 (91.7%) from the charity stripe.
After a scoring drought spanning just over six minutes, Penn State closed out the final 2:36 of the first half on a 9-2 run, highlighted by a three-pointer from junior Garner. Garner led Penn State's scoring efforts through the first half with eight points in the first 20 minutes.
Penn State now sits at 1-7 all-time against teams ranked No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

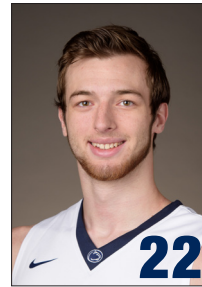

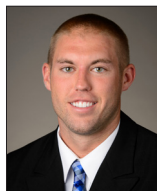
