NOTES AND HEADLINES

LADY LIONS KICK OFF 2023-24 CAMPAIGN AGAINST BUCKNELL

The Penn State women's basketball team begins its 2023-24 season at home against Bucknell on Tuesday, Nov. 7 at 6 p.m. in the Bryce Jordan Center. The Lady Lions, under the direction of head coach Carolyn Kieger, look to remain undefeated against the Bison as they kick off their season.

LAST TIME OUT

- » The Lady Lions concluded the 2022-23 campaign with an early run in the Big Ten Tournament. They earned a 72-67 win over Minnesota in the first round and lost a tight battle to the no. 5 seeded Michigan, 63-61.

LADY LIONS IN THE RANKS AHEAD OF GAME 1

- » Marisa ranks 58th nationally in points per game (17.5) and 59th in minutes per game (35.4). In the conference, she ranks third in minutes per game, seventh in points per game, ninth in total points, 11th in assists per game and total assists.
- » Kapinus finished eighth in the country in steals (97) and ninth in steals per game (3.1) and first in the Big Ten in the category. She also ranked seventh in the conference in blocks per game (1.0) and total blocks (31).
- » Ciezki finished 22nd in the nation in three-point percentage (.416) and second in the Big Ten.

2023-24 LADY LIONS' ACCOLADES

- » Marisa was named to the Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List for the second consecutive season. She also earned a spot on the All-Big Ten preseason team.
- » Owusu repeats on the Ann Meyers-Drysdale Award Watch List.

2023-24 PREVIEW

NO PLACE LIKE HAPPY VALLEY

- » Makenna Marisa uses her fifth season of eligibility to play one final season at Penn State. As one of the leaders of the Lady Lions, she has played in 114 games and started in 113 so far throughout her career.

2023 NEWCOMERS

- » Penn State welcomes six transfers into the program.
- » Ashley Owusu comes to Happy Valley after spending three years at Maryland and one year at Virginia Tech, but missed a portion of the season there to due injury. Owusu earned the Ann Meyers-Drysdale Award in 2021 and has found herself on the watch list every season since. During her time in College Park, she was also named an All-American according to Associate Press and College Basketball Writers Association. Also in 2021, she garnered first team All-Big Ten after earning second team following both her freshman and sophomore season. The Virginia native also led the Terrapins to two consecutive Big Ten titles in 2020 and 2021.
- » Tay Valladay transfers from Virginia for her fifth season. Valladay was originally recruited by Lady Lions Coach Kieger during her time at Marquette. The guard out of Illinois spent two seasons there before making the move to Virginia. She averaged 8.7 points, 3.7 assists, 3.3 rebounds and 1.4 steals as a Cavalier. Valladay concluded her 2022-23 season with five-straight 10+ point games.
- » Grace Hall transfers to Penn State after spending one season at LSU and one season at Wabash where she redshirted last season. Hall was a four-star prospect out of high school and was on the ESPNU HoopGurlz Top-100 list.
- » Kylie Lavelle knows the Pennsylvania scene, making the

move from Drexel where she spent her freshman season. She helped lead the Dragons to a CAA Regular Season Championship and was named the CAA Rookie of the Week four times and earned a spot on the All-Rookie Team. Lavelle averaged 13.3 ppg, 3.7 rpg and accumulated 13 double-digit

- » performances. The PA native accumulated 16 points in the first round of the WNIT game against Fordham.
- » Jayla Oden comes to the Lady Lions from a fellow Big Ten team, Illinois, where she spent two seasons. She played in 55 total games for the Fighting Illini and totaled 11 double-digit scoring performances.
- » Moriah Murray joined the Lady Lions after the fall semester last year but sat out due to NCAA transfer regulations.

ALL ROADS LEAD TO PENN STATE

- » The 2023-24 Lady Lions have players from all over the country. This squad has representation from two countries and seven states.

MARISA MILESTONES

- » Marisa became the only Lady Lion to achieve 1,750 points, 500 rebounds, 400 assists and 175 three-pointers in her career.
- » The PA native achieved 26 double-digit performances including two in the Big Ten Tournament.
- » Marisa ranks 10th all-time in career points at Penn State, just five points shy of moving into the ninth spot. She also ranks third all-time in career 30-point performances (7) and fifth in career three-pointers (187).

REPRESENTING ROOTS

- » Leilani Kapinus and Chanaya Pinto played for their home country's teams this summer. Kapinus earned a spot on the USA Basketball 3X3 U23 Nations League Roster. She helped the team to a second-place finish at the Montreal Stop from Sept. 2-3. Pinto competed in the 2023 FIBA Women's AfroBasket Tournament for her home country Mozambique. She played in six games and accumulated 40 points, 13 rebounds and 12 assists.

ACE IN ACTION

- » Redshirt-junior Alli Campbell returns to the floor after suffering her second ACL injury early last season.
- » After transferring from Notre Dame back home to central PA, the Altoona native only had a chance to play in ten games last season.

2022-23 IN REVIEW

- » Penn State finished the season last year 14-17, 4-14 Big Ten.
- » The Lady Lions lost four games in overtime.
- » Makenna Marisa led the offense in total scoring with 541 points and free throw percentage, .763.
- » Leilani Kapinus led the Lady Lions defense, averaging 6.7 rpg to total 208 on the season. She also led the team in steals, 97 and blocks, 31. The redshirt-junior totaled 348 points during her redshirt-sophomore campaign.
- » Freshman at the time Shay Ciezki had a standout rookie season totaling 353 points. The New York native was lethal beyond the arc leading the Lady Lions offense in three-point percentage (.416) and total three-point baskets made with 64.
- » Penn State completed the biggest comeback in program history against Syracuse on Nov. 21, 2022, rallying back from a 45-24 third quarter deficit to a 82-69 final score.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Bucknell

- Bucknell finished the 2022-23 campaign with a record of 13-17, 9-9 Patriot League.
- The Bison finished sixth in the Patriot League standings.
- Sophomore Cecelia Collins ranked sixth in the league last year in scoring average with 14.1 points per game and scored a total of 311 points.
- Senior Emma Shaffer ranked fifth in the Patriot League at the conclusion of last season in rebounds per game with 6.1 per game to total 279. With Shaffer's graduation, Emma Theodorsson ranked behind her in rebounds with 103.

Against The Bison

- This is the 14th meeting between Penn State and Bucknell, with the Lady Lions winning all 13 games so far.
- Picking up after a 10-year hiatus, the programs were regular opponents during the first 15 years of the 21st Century.
- Being local foes, the series dates back to the early days of each program, with the first game taking place at the White Building on February 21, 1967 - a 38-26 Lady Lions victory.
- The contest is the ninth to be held on the Penn State campus.

- Earned selection to the All-Big Ten team for a second straight season, after earning First Team honors as a junior. She became the 12th Lady Lion to repeat as a first team selection.
- Led the Lady Lions in scoring (17.5 ppg) and assists (4.2 per game) in addition to 60 made three-point baskets, 4.1 rebounds and 1.6 steals per game.
- Finished the 2022-23 season ranked 58th nationally in points per game, 59th in minutes per game (35.5), 77th in total points scored (541), 95th in assists per game (4.2) and 96th in total assists (129), and 99th in field goals (189). In the B1G, Marisa finished second in minutes played, seventh in scoring, 11th in assists, 13th in three-point field goals made.

- An important rotation player and starter in all four seasons with the Lady Lions, the Downingtown, Pa. native has produced 583 points, 312 rebounds, 111 three-pointers and 61 blocks in her career.

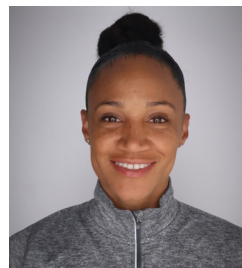
