Promotions: Friday is \$1 Dog Night at Medlar Field, with the first 500 fans receiving a FREE appetizer voucher to the Texas Roadhouse at the gates. Following the conclusion of the game, there will be fireworks to celebrate the commencement of Blue-White Weekend. Lion Stats: Coming off of a 7-6, extra-inning victory over Bucknell on Tuesday evening, Penn State looks to carry that momentum into its weekend Big Ten series. Sophomore J.C. Coban continues to lead the Lions at the plate, currently holding a .301 batting average with a teambest 34 hits. Following his two-RBI, two-double showing against the Bison, senior Luis Montesinos leads his squad with 18 RBIs and has now posted five multiple-RBI games. Freshman James Coates, who leads the team with 17 runs, tallied his eighth multiple-hit game on Tuesday, going 2-for-5 with one run scored. Coban, Montesinos, Coates and redshirt senior Elliot Searer, who drove in the game-winning run in the walk-off victory over Bucknell, have combined for 124 hits, 57 RBIs and 57 runs this season.

**Scouting the Hawkeyes:** Iowa currently holds a 13-18 overall record with a 2-7 mark in the Big Ten, most recently dropping a weekend series to Kansas State, 2-1. The Hawkeyes are led by sophomore **Kris Goodman**, holding a team-best .344 batting average, as well as 42 hits and 24 runs scored. Sophomores **Jake Yacinich** and **Taylor Kaufman** have each tallied 17 RBIs, while Goodman sits close behind with 13. Four Hawkeyes are currently batting over .300, including Goodman, Yacinich (.314), freshman **Nick Roscetti** (.311) and junior **Trevor Kenyon** (.306). The foursome has combined for 107 hits, 52 runs and 44 RBIs.

**Iowa Rotation:** Senior **Matt Dermody** will face off with Jann on Friday, boasting a 6-1 record and currently holding a 3.77 ERA. Dermody has struck out a team-best 39 while allowing 69 hits and 24 earned runs in 57.1 innings. Making the start on Saturday, senior **Andrew Hanse** sits with a 4.76 ERA after 12 appearances and three starts this season. The right-handed pitcher has seen 28.1 innings of action with 33 hits and 15 earned runs allowed. Closing out the series on Sunday, lefty **Sasha Kuebel** has fired 43.2 innings with a 6.60 ERA. The sophomore has allowed 58 hits and 32 earned runs while striking out 28. Senior **Ricky Sandquist** and Kaufman lead Iowa's bullpen, holding respective ERAs of 1.50 and 2.86 after 10 appearances a piece. Sandquist has fired 30.0 innings with just five earned runs and 30 hits allowed, while Kaufman has allowed 32 hits and 11 earned runs in 34.2 innings.

**All-Time Series:** Penn State leads the all-time series against Iowa, holding a 36-27 record since their first meeting in 1994. The Lions are 4-6 in the last 10 contests but hold an 18-13 overall record in Happy Valley. Last season, Penn State took the Big Ten series 2-1, winning 5-2 and 2-0

and falling 4-2 at Iowa. The 2-0 victory over the Hawkeyes on April 21, 2012 was the first Penn State no-hitter since 1995, with Hill throwing a perfect game.
