TONIGHT'S GAME

• The Nittany Lions will play their final non-conference game of 2013-14 when they welcome Boston College to Pegula Ice Arena. The teams are meeting for the second time this season after facing off in the Three Rivers Classic championship game.

PACKING PEGULA

• Nittany Lions fans have packed Pegula Ice Arena during the facility's inaugural season, filling the 5,782-seat arena with an average of 5,998 fans per game. Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in eight of nine home games, with the Dec. 1 matchup against Union the lone exception.

• More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on five different occasions, including the season opener against Army (6,370) and the Nittany Lions' last home game against No. 1 Minnesota (6,154).

BEST TEAMS VISITING HOCKEY VALLEY

• Saturday's game will be Penn State's seventh home game of the season against a ranked team. Including their matchup against the Eagles, the Nittany Lions last three home contests will be against the No. 1 and No. 2 ranked teams in the country.

• Although Union was ranked at No. 15 when the two teams played at Pegula Ice Arena, the Dutchmen are currently ranked third in the USCHO.com poll. UMass Lowell has also improved in the poll and now sits at No. 8.

SKATING THE GAUNTLET

- Penn State is facing some of the best teams in the nation during its second NCAA season.
- Saturday's matchup against Boston College will mark the Nittany Lions' 10th game against a ranked opponent in a 13-game span.

LAST LEAD HELD AGAINST BC

- The last time the Nittany Lions held a lead was in the first period of their last matchup against Boston College in the Three Rivers Classic championship game Dec. 28.
- The Eagles have only trailed five times in four games during their 10-game unbeaten streak.

SCOUTING BOSTON COLLEGE

- The Eagles enter Happy Valley on a 10-game unbeaten streak (9-0-1), which is tied for longest in the nation with Minnesota.
- The Eagles have out scored their opponents by a 50-20 during that span.
- Boston College boasts three of the nation's top nine scorers -- Johnny Gaudreau (1st/2.00 points per game), Kevin Hayes (3rd, 1.79 ppg), Bill Arnold (t-9th, 1.38 ppg).
- The Eagles are eight points ahead of second-place Northeastern in Hockey East standings with just seven league games remaining.

FIRING AT WILL

- The 79 total shots fired against Michigan State last weekend were the most this year against any opponent during a two-game stretch.

JUHA AMONG NATION'S BEST

- Sophomore defenseman **Luke Juha** is tied for fifth among NCAA blueliners with four power-play goals.
- His four extra-man markers lead Big Ten defensemen while his eight power-play points place him second.
- The Mississauga, Ont., native's 12 points place him fourth among Big Ten defensemen.

POWER PLAY FIND SUCCESS

- The Nittany Lions scored a power-play goal for the first time in five games against Michigan State Jan. 18.
- Penn State, which scored 12 power-play goals in 2012-13, ranks third in the Big Ten in efficiency (14-of-72/.194).

LEADING THE WAY

- Redshirt sophomore **Eric Scheid** (9-5--14), sophomore **Luke Juha** (4-8--12) and freshman **David Goodwin** (4-6--10) lead the Nittany Lions with double-digit points.
- Scheid and Juha are among seven Nittany Lions who have appeared in all 19 games.

STAYING OUT OF THE BOX

• Penn State, which earlier in the season ranked second in the NCAA with more than 20 penalty minutes per game, stayed out of the box for the first time in its 45-game NCAA history vs. Michigan State Jan. 17.

CAREER YEARS

• Several Nittany Lions have posted or are close to posting career years.

• Defenseman **Luke Juha** (4-8--12) and forward **Tommy Olczyk** (4-3--7) have posted career highs in goals, assists and points.

• Defenseman **Patrick Koudys** (1-3--4) has collected personal bests in assists and points.

• **Eric Scheid's** nine goals are a career high, while his 14 points are one away from his personal best.

PLAYING THEM TIGHT

• The Nittany Lions have played in nine one-goal games (3-6-0) in 2013-14, tying for ninth in the country.

• Clarkson leads the nation with 15 one-goal games.

SCHEID SURGING

• Forward **Eric Scheid** is tied for third in the conference in power-play goals (4), sixth in goals (9) and ninth in power-play points (7).

SHORTHANDED LEADERS

• **David Glen, Curtis Loik** and **Tommy Olczyk** are tied for second in the conference with one shorthanded goal each.

• Penn State and Wisconsin are tied for the Big Ten lead with three shorthanded goals each.

FRESHMAN SUCCESS

• **David Goodwin** is tied for sixth among league rookies with 10 points, while **Ricky DeRosa's** eight points put him in a tie for 13th place.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

• Penn State underclassmen have accounted for more than 75 percent of the team's offense.

• The Nittany Lions' top three scorers are either freshmen or sophomores, with redshirt sophomore **Eric Scheid** leading the way with 14 points (9g, 5a).

• Penn State dropped both of its games to then-No. 17 Wisconsin in its first Big Ten series, falling 7-1 Friday, Dec. 6 before dropping a 4-3 game Dec. 7.

• In the finale, freshmen **Ricky DeRosa** (1g, 1a) and **Zach Saar** (1g, 1a) notched their first multi-point

games.

• The Nittany Lions, who took a 1-0 following **Eric Scheid's** marker, twice erased one-goal deficits before allowing the game-winning goal with 8:08 left in the third.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• In league action, each Big Ten team will play 20 league games, including 10 home contests.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a shootout win and one point for a shootout loss.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only BCS conference to sponsor men's hockey.

• The league tournament will take place at Saint Paul's Xcel Energy Center March 20-22 with the tournament champion earning the league's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament.

PEPPERING THE NET

• Penn State's 27 second-period shots against Robert Morris Dec. 27 were the most attempts in a period in program history.

• The team's 62 total shots ranked second, trailing the 63 attempts against AIC in the Nittany Lions' first NCAA game Oct. 12, 2012.

BACK OF THE NET

• With seven goals against Union Nov. 30-Dec. 1, Penn State scored its most goals in a series since netting eight markers against Alabama Huntsville Feb. 8-9, 2013.

• Freshman goaltender **Eamon McAdam** and rookie defenseman **Mike Williamson** played in their first career games against Air Force Friday, Oct. 18. McAdam turned aside 27 shots in his collegiate debut.

BACK ON THE SCORESHEET

• With a goal against Air Force Oct. 18, **Luke Juha** reached the back of the net for the first time since scoring in a 5-1 win vs. the Falcons Nov. 10, 2012.

• Sophomore forward **Jonathan Milley**, who missed 18 games due to injury in 2012-13, recorded a helper for his first point since registering a three-point outing vs. Holy Cross Dec. 7, 2012.

LIONS OPEN PEGULA WITH WIN

• The Nittany Lions opened Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win over Army in front of a standing-room only crowd of 6,370.

• Four different Nittany Lions scored, including **David Goodwin** and **Eric Scheid**, who scored in their Penn State debuts.

• Sophomore **Matthew Skoff** made 25 saves.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS

• Redshirt junior defenseman **Nate Jensen** etched his name in the Pegula Ice Arena record books as the first player to score in the facility.

• Jensen's slapshot through traffic 3:02 into the first period gave the Nittany Lions the early 1-0 lead.

FRESHMEN SHINE

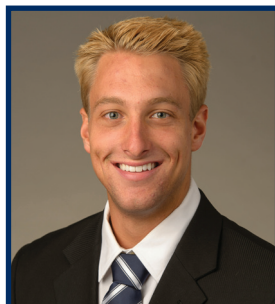
