## NOTES AND HEADLINES

### PENN STATE HOSTS ST. JOHN'S ON LABOR DAY

The Penn State men's soccer team continues its four-game homestand when they welcome St. John's on Monday, Sept. 4 at 5 p.m. The two teams square off at Jeffrey Field for the first time in nearly 10 years and for just the eighth time in history.

### LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State earned a 1-1 draw against the number one team in the country, Syracuse on Friday, Sept. 1.
- » The Nittany Lions scored a goal in the 88th minute of the game and the Orange responded seconds later with the equalizer.
- » The Syracuse goalkeeper was given a red card with 30 minutes to go in the second half and forced the team to play down a man for the remainder of the match.
- » Freshman Caden Grabfelder scored the lone Penn State goal marking his second in the past two games.
- » A pass out wide from Freddie Bell to Alex Stevenson began the surge. Stevenson juked the Syracuse defender and sent the ball in the air to Grabfelder who headed it past the Orange keeper.
- » The Nittany Lions became the first team to score a goal on Syracuse this season.
- » Friday night's attendance marked the largest crowd at Jeffrey Field since 2014.

### NITTANY LIONS IN THE RANKS

- » Danielson and Grabfelder are tied for first in the Big Ten ranks in goals with two in two games.
- » Shakes sits first in the Big Ten in saves with 13 and third in save percentage with a .867.
- » Penn State is fourth in the conference, one week into the season.

### 2023 PREVIEW

#### STRONG SCHEDULE

- » Penn State has no shortage of tough opponents throughout the fall, playing the top-two teams at the end of the 2022 season, Syracuse and Indiana. Five of the Nittany Lions opponents finished last season in the top-25 and in the 2023 preseason poll.

#### NO PLACE LIKE HAPPY VALLEY

- » Four Nittany Lions return home to use their fifth year of eligibility at Penn State.
- » Starting goalkeeper Kris Shakes makes his return for a final season with eyes from the Big Ten on him as he was named a Preseason Player to Watch.
- » 2023 MLS SuperDraft pick Liam Butts made the decision to return for a fifth season in Happy Valley while pursuing a second undergraduate degree. Butts is a major component of the Nittany Lions offense and brings strength and speed to the attack.
- » Alex Stevenson, a key to the Nittany Lions in both the defense and midfield, joins the blue & white one last time while he completes a second undergraduate degree.
- » Owen Elliott will graduate this fall while playing a fifth season at Penn State. The keeper brings experience and leadership to the program as a veteran player.

### 2022 NEWCOMERS

- » Penn State welcomed ten incoming freshmen throughout the off season. Among the ten newcomers is no. 6 ranked Mohamed Cisset. He joins the rest of head coach Jeff Cook's recruiting class as the no. 10 ranked recruiting class in the country this year.
- » In addition to the new athletes, Cook added two new faces to his staff. Assistant Coach Sean Lawlor joins the Nittany Lions coaching staff after his four-year stint at the 2022 National Champions Syracuse. Oscar Umar, a Villanova graduate, came to Penn State this spring after spending two seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Washington University in St. Louis.

### 2023 CAPTAINS

- » Seniors Peter Mangione and Femi Awodesu were named the 2022 captains.

### ALL ROADS LEAD TO PENN STATE

- » The 2023 Penn State men's soccer roster is the most diverse group of athletes the program has seen in its existence.
- » Seven countries across the world are represented in addition to America including: Argentina, Mali, Mexico, Kenya, England, Scotland and Sweden.

### 2022 IN REVIEW

- » The Nittany Lions finished the 2022 campaign ranked fifth in the Big Ten with an overall record of 6-4-4 and a conference record of 3-2-3.
- » Penn State earned ranked wins against no. 18 West Virginia and no. 15 Akron on Senior Day.
- » Six Nittany Lions received Big Ten postseason honors. Mangione and Kuhn earned first team All-Big Ten, Awodesu and Butts earned second team and Liscum and Henderson landed on the All-Freshman team.
- » Mangione (second team), Kuhn (third team) and Awodesu (third team) garnered All-North Region as well.
- » Mangione led the team in goals with eight and points with 18 for the second time in his career as a Nittany Lion.

### 2023 MLS SuperDraft

- » Three Penn State men's soccer alumni were selected in the 2023 MLS SuperDraft.
- » Jalen Watson was drafted 32nd overall to Toronto FC, his home team and inked his contract in March.
- » Liam Butts was selected 33rd by the San Jose Earthquakes.
- » Andrew Privett was drafted 69th overall to Charlotte FC and signed his contract in March.
- » Privett saw major success playing for Charlotte's MLS Next Pro team and was called up to its first team in early summer. By July, he made his first start at the professional level and scored his first goal on August 3rd in a shootout win against Houston. Privett and the team advanced to the playoffs.

- » The Red Storm concluded the 2022 campaign with a 4-8-5 record, losing in the quarterfinals of the Big East Tournament to Marquette.
- » The team currently sits at fourth in their conference with their two wins.
- » Nicolas Fleuriau Chateau ranks second in the Big East in points with six and Max McNulty sits third in the conference in points with five, from two goals and two assists in his opening games.
- » Fleuriau Chateau leads the team in goals with three.
- » Nutley was named to the Big East Weekly Honor Roll after tallying two goals in the Red Storm's 2-1 victory over Lehigh.
