#### **CYR HAULS IN PAIR OF HONORS**

- After sparking the Nittany Lions' 12-10 come-from-behind victory against then-No. 7/5 Johns Hopkins Friday, April 18, sophomore midfielder **Madison Cyr** earned ALC Offensive and WomensLax. com Player of the Week honors.
- The sophomore led Penn State with four second-half goals, including three in a 26-second span, during the team's pivotal conference victory. The midfielder, who netted at least four goals in a game for the fourth time this season, added a game-high five draw controls along with two ground balls.

#### **CLIMBING THE CHARTS**

• Senior attacker **Mackenzie Cyr** registered three assists in the win over Johns Hopkins to bring her career total to 102, making her just the third Nittany Lion to eclipse 100 career assists. Julie Tice (115) and Marsha Florio (109) are the only other Nittany Lions with more assists.

#### **ALL-TIME VS. PRINCETON**

- The Nittany Lions and Tigers will meet for the 35th time on Saturday. Princeton enters the game having won the last five meetings, with Penn State's last win coming in 2007.
- Junior attacker Maggie McCormick leads all Nittany Lions with nine career points (5g, 4a) against the Tigers. Senior attacker Mackenzie Cyr (3g, 2a) and junior midfielder Kelly Lechner (5g) both have five career points, while junior midfielder Tatum Coffey has three career goals.

#### **SCOUTING THE TIGERS**

- The Tigers arrive in Happy Valley fresh off an Ivy League regular-season championship after a 10-8 victory against Dartmouth. Princeton is led by junior attacker Erin McMunn, who has 40 points (29g, 11a) through 13 games this season. Eight Tigers have at least 21 points this season, and all eight have scored 17 goals or more.
- In net for Princeton this season has been junior Annie Woehling. In more than 630 minutes of work, she has made 70 saves, while allowing 84. In 12 games, she has a goals-against average of 7.96 and a 9-1 record.

#### LAST TIME VS. PRINCETON

- In the 2013 regular-season finale, the Nittany Lions fell to the Tigers, 14-9. Princeton scored the games first four goals and took a 6-2 lead into halftime. Penn State scored four consecutive goals midway through the second half to bring the score to 10-8, but the Tigers responded with four goals of their own to widen the gap and secure the victory.
- Seven current Nittany Lions registered a point in the setback. Kelly Lechner scored three goals, while Maggie McCormick had a goal and a pair of helpers. Tatum Coffey netted two goals of her own, and Haley Ford, Madison Cyr, and Ally Heavens all had one goal.
- Final Stats (PSU-PU): Shots (29-21), Saves (4-13), Ground Balls (15-14), Draw Controls (13-12), Turnovers (12-18), Caused Turnovers (13-11).

#### **FAMILIAR TERRITORY**

- Head coach **Missy Doherty** served as an assistant coach at Princeton for three seasons (2001-03) before becoming Towson's head coach. She helped lead the Tigers to two national championships (2002, 2003) and three lvy League crowns.
- Assistant coach **Amy Altig** spent three seasons as a Tigers' assistant prior to coming to Happy Valley. During her three-year stint, the Tigers compiled a 33-19 record and qualified for the NCAA Tournament twice.

#### **NITTANY LIONS STREAKING**

- Midfielder **Madison Cyr** extended her points streak to 12 games after netting four goals against Johns Hopkins. The sophomore has a team-high 43 points (37g, 6a) and leads the Nittany Lions in goals (37) and shots (68) and ranks second in caused turnovers (19).
- Junior attacker **Jess Loizeaux** scored one goal against Johns Hopkins to extend her point-scoring streak to 13 games. Currently, Loizeaux is fifth on the team with 31 points.

#### ANOTHER HAT TRICK FOR CYR

• Madison Cyr netted four goals, including three in a 26-second span, marking the seventh time the sophomore has registered at least a hat trick this season. Cyr has scored four goals three times this season and five goals once this season.

#### ON THE HORIZON

- Following their match against Princeton, the Nittany Lions will prepare to travel to Evanston, Ill., to begin action in the American Lacrosse Conference tournament.
- Depending on the outcome between Ohio State and Johns Hopkins this weekend, the Nittany Lions will either play Johns Hopkins or Vanderbilt in the opening round Thursday, May 1.

#### **BALANCED ATTACK**

- The Nittany Lions' boast the nation's 17th-ranked offense with an average of 13.27 goals per game.
- Eight Nittany Lions have recorded at least 13 goals, with **Madison Cyr** netting a team-high 37 markers.

#### LIONS AMONG ALC LEADERS

- The Nittany Lions rank second in the conference in scoring offense and caused turnovers per game (9.27) and third in points (286) and draw controls per game (13.00).
- Defender Lauren Purvis has collected a conference-leading 1.67 caused turnovers per game, while Jenna Mosketti ranks third in draw controls (4.13) and Mackenzie Cyr and Maggie McCormick are tied for fourth in assists (21).

#### **DOHERTY SUCCESSFUL AT HOME**

• Penn State boasts a 26-8 home record under fourth-year head coach **Missy Doherty**. The Nittany Lions defeated Johns Hopkins, 12-10, in their last home matchup.

#### **COFFEY SETS CAREER HIGH**

• In a 13-8 victory over Cornell, junior midfielder **Tatum Coffey** gathered two assists to push her season total to a career-best 12.

#### **NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP**

- Against Cornell, sophomore midfielder Madison Cyr registered a career-high five goals and tied a career high with four caused turnovers.
- In an 18-11 victory against Loyola March 8, Cyr set career highs in points (6) and draw controls (5), while matching her career high in assists (2).

#### **DOHERTY ENTERS YEAR FOUR**

- Head coach **Missy Doherty** entered her fourth season in Happy Valley in 2014. During her three seasons, Doherty has led Penn State to two NCAA tournaments (2012, 2013) and a share of one ALC regular-season championship (2013).
- At PSU, Doherty has coached six IWLCA All-Americans, 14 All-ALC members and one CoSIDA Academic All-American.

#### **RETURNING FIRE POWER**

 Penn State returned its top four scorers, including a pair of IWLCA Second Team All-Americans (Maggie McCormick, Kelly Lechner), and nearly 90 percent of the team's scoring from 2013.

#### **BIG TEN ON THE HORIZON**

• The 2014 season will mark the final year of the ALC as the Big Ten, with the additions of new conference members Maryland and Rutgers, will begin play in 2015.
