THE MATCHUP

WELCOME HOME

Penn State welcomes Hockey East opponent UConn to Pegula Ice Arena for a two game-series starting on Friday, Sept. 29 at 6 p.m. The series will be Penn State's first home games of the season.

HISTORY

Penn State is facing UConn for the sixth time in program history. The Huskies currently lead the series 3-0-2 with the last meeting occurring on Nov. 24, 2017 when the two tied 1-1. The Nittany Lions have faced Hockey East teams 51 times in the programs history and tally a record of 16-23-12.

SCOUTING THE HUSKIES

• UConn enters the 2023-24 season after being picked to finish fourth in the Hockey East preseason poll. Last season, the Huskies went 18-13-4 overall and 12-11-4 in league play. The Huskies ended the season finishing fifth in the league. The Huskies return 17 out of 25 players from a season ago which include goalie Tia Chan who tallied a .938 save percentage and GAA of 1.67 while tallying a record of 12-10-4. On offense, the Huskies return their top points getter Jada Habisch who scored 13 goals and added eight assists.

IMPORTANT NUMBERS

Penn State has 16 players who have returned for the 2023-24 season including reigning HCA Rookie of the Year Tessa Janecke and goalie Josie Bothun. Graduate student Julie Gough also returns to captain the Nittany Lions.

Penn State ranks 10th in the most recent USA Hockey/The Rink Live poll.

Penn State welcomed in five newcomers to the 2023-24 roster which featured three transfers from LIU, New Hampshire and Colgate.

Penn State head coach Jeff Kampersal is two wins away from securing his 100th win at Penn State.

KAMPERSAL APPROACHING 100 WINS

- Head coach Jeff Kampersal is on track to hit 100 wins at Penn State as he currently sits at 98 as the Nittany Lion head coach.
- Kampersal sits as the sixth most winningest coach among division one women's hockey coaches and already sits as the most winningest women's hockey coach in Penn State history with a record of 425-328-95.
- Kampersal captured his 400th career win last season at Boston College on October 14.

SCHEDULE HIGHLIGHTS

- The Nittany Lions, coming off a programrecord 27-win season, will play a challenging nonconference slate featuring three NCAA Tournament teams, including rematches with Yale at home and away at Colgate.
- Penn State will play 18 games against CHA foes Robert Morris, Mercyhurst, Syracuse, Lindenwood and RIT with 10 of those games finishing the regular season.
- The 2023 CHA postseason will open with a pair of best-of-three semifinals with the No. 1 seed hosting the No. 4 seed and the No. 2 seed hosting the No. 3 seed March 1-3.
- The CHA postseason will conclude on March 9 when the two semifinal winners meet at the home of the highest-seeded semifinal winner for one game to determine the CHA 2024 postseason champion. Date and time for the championship game that weekend are to be determined.
- 34 regular-season games, including 16 home games at Pegula Ice Arena.
- Six games against three 2023 NCAA Tournament teams (Colgate, Yale, and Northeastern).
- 10 games against ECAC opponents (Colgate, Cornell, Dartmouth, Union, and Yale).
- Rematch with ECAC tournament champion Colgate on Oct. 6-7 in Hamilton, N.Y.

- The Nittany Lions face Dartmouth for the first time in program history on Nov. 24-25.
- Penn State hosts Yale for the first time in program history on Dec. 8-9.
- First home series versus UConn on Sept. 29-30 at Pegula Ice Arena.
- 18 CHA conference games with home and away series against Syracuse, Lindenwood, Mercyhurst, RIT and Robert Morris.
- Penn State split it's opening series at #5/5
 Northeastern on Sept. 23-24 dropping the
 first game 0-1 and prevailing in the second
 game 2-1.

DOWN GOES NO. 5!

- The Nittany Lions defeated No. 5
 Northeastern 2-1 on Sept. 24, splitting the series with the Huskies.
- Penn State struck in the third period with the tying goal from Leah Stecker with help from Julie Gough and Tessa Janecke.
- Alyssa machado scored the game-winning goal off passes by Mya Vaslet and Maggie MacEachern.
- Prior to the series, Penn State was 9-44-6 against ranked opponents.
- The win marked just the second time in program history when Penn State defeated a top-five opponent on the road. The last time came at No. 5 Colgate on Sept. 28, 2018 when Penn State defeated the Raiders 4-2 in Hamilton, N.Y.

GOUGH TABBED CAPTAIN FOR THE 2023-24 SEASON

- Graduate-student Julie Gough was selected as the team's captain for the 2023-24 season. Entering her fifth season in Hockey Valley, Gough has been one of the most productive forwards on the team as a season ago she scored a career-high 14 goals including the game-winning goal in the CHA Tournament Championship game which sent Penn State to its first NCAA tournament. She was named to the All-Tournament team and Tournament MVP.
- In her career, Gough has racked 38 goals and 24 assists in 125 games played over four years. She sits fifth all-time in program history in goals scored and fourth in powerplay goals with 10. The Ontario native also ranks sixth in total plus/minus at a +38 rating.
- Off the ice, Gough is a four-time CHA All-Academic team honoree and is a key leader in addressing awareness of mental health of student-athletes as she led the Bench Out the Stigma event on campus this summer and traveled with student-athletes from across the Big Ten at the BIG Life Series: Selma to Montgomery initiative led by the Big Ten Equality Coalition which highlighted the civil rights movement in Alabama.

PRESEASON CHA AWARDS

- The Nittany Lions were picked to finish first for the second straight season in the 2024 College Hockey America Preseason Poll on Friday afternoon.
- Penn State earned 30 votes and five of six first-place votes. Mercyhurst tallied 25 and one first place vote with Robert Morris, Syracuse, Lindenwood and RIT rounding out the final four.
- Along with being voted first in the preseason coaches' poll as a team reigning CHA and National Rookie of the Year Tessa Janecke earned her second career preseason honor as she was named the Preseason Player of the Year which was voted unanimously by the other five head coaches.
- Freshman Karolina Hengelmüller earned her first career preseason honor as she was selected as the association's Preseason Co-Rookie of the Year.
- Headlining the coaches' Preseason All-CHA
 Team were Janecke and senior defenseman Lyndie Lobdell. Also receiving votes
 by the conference coaches were graduate forward Julie Gough, senior goaltender
 Josie Bothun, Hengelmüller, and graduate

defenseman Maggie MacEachern.

MACEACHERN NAMED CHA DE-FESNIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

- Graduate defenseman Maggie MacEachern was named the College Hockey America (CHA) Defensive Player of the Week on Monday afternoon. This is her first weekly award honor as a Nittany Lion.
- MacEachern tallied five blocked shots in the series against No. 5/5 Northeastern. The Brooklin, Ontario native also added one assist on the game-winning goal that came in game two in the series aiding in the Nittany Lions 2-1 victory.

A BUMP IN THE RANKINGS

- Penn State was ranked 10th in the most recent USA Hockey/The Rink Live poll on Tuesday afternoon.
- The bump comes following the Nittany Lions split series against fifth-ranked Northeastern in which Penn State took game two by a score of 2-1 off a pair of goals by Leah Stecker and Alyssa Machado in the third period to secure the victory.

HEAD COACH JEFF KAMPERSAL

One of the winningest and well-respected coaches in women's ice hockey history, Jeff Kampersal has taken the Penn State women's hockey program to new heights and now enters his seventh season at the helm of the Penn State program in 2023-24. The 2022-23 and 2020-21 CHA Coach of the Year and two-time AHCA National Coach of the Year finalist led a record-breaking Nittany Lion team to its first CHA tournament title and second CHA regular season title in 2022-23. The veteran coach brought the team to its first NCAA tournament in program history. He has amassed 61 wins over the last three seasons, the most over three years in program history.

His coaching excellence at both the collegiate level and the international level with USA Hockey has brought a steadying veteran leadership to the up-and-coming Nittany Lions.

With the Nittany Lions 3-2 victory over Boston College on October 14, 2022, Kampersal captured his 400th career win. He stands sixth all-time amongst division I women's hockey coaches in career wins with 424. He currently stands at 97 wins as head coach of the Nittany Lion program.

During the 2022-23 season, Kampersal was named the 2022-23 CHA Coach of Year for the second time in his career as the team won a program-high 27 games as well as had a team that comprised a total of 26 CHA weekly award winners, 12 CHA monthly award winners, and five All-CHA team selections. He's produced a team that went on an 18-game unbeaten streak and been nationally ranked amongst the top 10 in the nation. Kampersal became a finalist for National Coach of the Year for the second time in his career.

Under Kampersal's leadership, Kiara Zanon was a top-10 Patty Kazmier Award finalist for the second time in her career in 2023. She broke Natalie Heising's record in single season goals. The Fairport, N.Y., native also led the nation with five shorthanded goals.

On January 13 against RIT, the forward equaled and surpassed the 100-career point mark as she scored back-to-back shorthanded goals on the same penalty kill. She hit the mark faster than any Nittany Lion in program history.

Zanon also broke her own single season program record in points from a season ago. She was a three-time CHA Forward of the Week recipient and captured two CHA Forward of the Month honors. The Fairport, N.Y. native also was named the 2023 CHA Player of the Year and CHA Scoring Champion.

Kampersal also aided freshman Tessa Janecke as she was an integral part of Penn State's championship season as she skated in 38 games and tallied 22 goals alongside 25 assists for 47 points. The Orangeville, Ill. native scored her first hat-trick as a Nittany Lion on February 25 against Lindenwood in the CHA semifinals as it was the second time in program history a hat-trick was scored in the postseason. She also broke all the program records for freshman including single season points, assists and goals. She was named the USCHO. com Rookie of the Year and was named the All-USCHO Rookie team for the first time in her career.

She is the third Nittany Lion in program history to be named to the All-Rookie team. Janecke was named

Year and was a Patty Kazmaier Award nominee. Additional accolades from the 2022-23 season include one CHA Forward of the Month honor, one HCA National Rookie of the Month award, three CHA Rookie of the Month awards, and six CHA Rookie of the Week nods. She also captured a gold medal with Team USA at the 2023 IIHF Women's World Championships and tallied three goals and three assists during the tournament.

Penn State's 2020-21 team secured its first No. 1 seed in the College Hockey America tournament, its first topten national ranking in botht the USCHO.com and USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine polls, and broke several team records both offensively and defensively. Seven of his players on the 2020-21 squad received All-CHA honors, also a program record. Under Kampersal's direction, two Nittany Lion freshmen broke through as a pair of the nation's top performers.

Kiara Zanon became the first Patty Kazmaier finalist in team history and was named the WHCA National Rookie of the Year while teammate Josie Bothun was chosen as the team's first national goalie of the year finalist while also being named the USCHO.com National Rookie of the Year. These two players in addition to several other key contributors elevated their individual play and bought in to an unselfish team culture that led to the Nittany Lions' title season.

Kampersal's team has showcased defensive excellence since his arrival, highlighted in the 2019-20 season by seven total shutout victories, a single-season program high. Penn State's increased competitiveness has resulted in marquee program victories of late, including a win over fifth-ranked Colgate, 4-2, in 2018-19, the highest-ranked win in program history.

Kampersal's arrival impacted Penn state immediately on the ice in his first season in 2017-18, when Penn State allowed a CHA-best 1.92 goals per game, an improvement of more than a goal per game from the previous season.

In addition to his on-ice guidance, Kampersal has built and sustained a program culture of excellence both in the classroom and in the community. Since Kampersal's arrival in Hockey Valley, Penn State women's hockey recorded back-to-back perfect academic progress rates according to the latest NCAA APR reports, which measures eligibility, retention and graduation of the program's student-athletes. The Nittany Lions have also had 66 All-CHA Academic team honorees and 61 Academic All-Big Ten winners during his tenure.

The 2018-19 team captain Kelsey Crow was the recipient of Penn State's prestigious Eric A. Walker Award, an award given to a graduating Penn State senior who has best represented the university through extracurricular activities and community service.

Kampersal was named Penn State head coach on June 1, 2017. The head coach of the Princeton Tigers for 21 seasons, Kampersal garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors three times and Ivy League Coach of the Year accolades twice.

He guided the Tigers to two Ivy League Championships (2005-06 & 2015-16) and two NCAA Tournament appearances (2005-06 & 2015-16).
