OPENING TIP: Winners in four of its last five games, Northwestern will travel to Penn State for the first of two meetings this year against the Nittany Lions.

- The Wildcats are 2-1 to begin Big Ten play for the second consecutive season after defeating Michigan State 88-74 for the third straight meeting on Sunday (Jan. 7) night. Northwestern is looking to begin Big Ten play 3-1 in back-to-back and just the fourth time in the last 56 seasons: 2022-23 (3-1), 2020-21 (3-1) and 1967-68 (3-1). NU is looking to start conference play 3-1 or better in back-to-back seasons for the first time since 1966-77 and 1967-68.
- Head Coach **Chris Collins** recorded his 70th conference win at Northwestern over Michigan State on Sunday, moving him into a tie for second with **Bill Carmody** (70, 2000-13) for Big Ten wins by a head coach in school history. Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame member **Arthur "Dutch" Lonborg** holds the school record with 138 career Big Ten wins (1927-50).
- Northwestern is 11-3 over the first 14 games of the season for the second straight season, and has posted that mark or better for the fourth time in head coach **Chris Collins'** tenure (2022-23, 2016-17, 2015-16).
- NU and Penn State will meet for the 59th time with the Nittany Lions holding a 38-20 lead in the all-time series (More on Page 3). Last season, Northwestern and Penn State met in overtime twice in a nine-day span with the Nittany Lions winning both meetings. Head coach **Chris Collins** is 5-11 in his career against Penn State.
- Northwestern is 7-0 this season when holding opponents to 65 or fewer points and 27-2 over the last two seasons.
- NU's three NET Quad 1 wins (Purdue, Dayton, Michigan State) rank t-6th most in the country and t-2nd most in the Big Ten.
- Boo Buie** has 1,795 career points and is 10 points away from tying **Evan Eschmeyer** (1,805) for the fourth-most in program history. He is set to appear in his 130th career game at Northwestern, which would be tied for fourth-most in program history (Page 3).

- Ryan Langborg** is 26 points away from reaching 1,000 career points. The transfer scored 804 points in his career at Princeton.
- Northwestern ranks 4th in the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage (36.9%, 111-301) and in steals per game (7.6). Last year NU went 112-358 (31.3%) in its first 14 games.

LAST TIME OUT: Northwestern scored a season-high 46 first half points in an 88-74 victory over Michigan State inside Welsh-Ryan Arena on Sunday (Jan. 7) night. The Wildcats have won three straight against the Spartans for the first time since 1961-62 and have won four of the last five in the series. NU had just 5 turnovers and held a 21-2 advantage in points off turnovers.

- Boo Buie** recorded his first career double-double with 19 points and a career-high 10 assists. He is the first Wildcat to post a points/assists double-double since **Bryant McIntosh** had 11 points and a school-record 16 assists against Minnesota on Jan. 10, 2018. Buie also contributed three steals, recording the first 10+ point, 10+ assist, 3+ steal game by a Wildcat since at least 1996-97.
- Ty Berry** scored a season-high 22 points on 7-for-11 shooting from the field and a 4-for-7 mark from deep. NU is 18-5 over the last two seasons when he scores in double figures.
- Luke Hunger** earned his first career start and scored 10 points, tying a career-high which he set the previous game at Illinois.
- All five NU starters scored in double figures for the first time since Nov. 13, 2017, against Saint Peter's.

BALL SECURITY: Northwestern has been one of the best teams in the country at taking care of the ball this year, leading the Big Ten and ranking 5th in the country, averaging just 8.8 turnovers per game.

- NU's assist/turnover ratio of 1.90 leads the Big Ten and is 4th in the country behind BYU (2.13), Colorado St. (1.97), and Kentucky (1.96).
- Northwestern also forces an average of 13.9 turnovers per game, which ranks 5th in the Big Ten.
- NU's turnover margin of +5.1 is 2nd in the Big Ten and ranks 10th nationally. Last year the Wildcats held the Big Ten's best turnover margin at +4.3, which ranked 9th nationally.

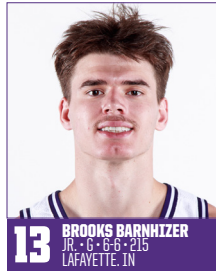

MORE NOTES...

GIMME THAT: NU's 7.6 steals per game rank 4th in the Big Ten. **Brooks Barnhizer** (1.9, 4th) and **Ty Berry** (1.6, 8th) rank among the Big Ten's leaders. Last season, Northwestern ranked second in the Big Ten forcing 7.9 steals per game, and set the single-season program record by recording 267 total thefts.

BOO BACK: Graduate guard **Boo Buie** returns for his fifth season in Evanston in 2023-24, and heading into this season was named Preseason All-Big Ten, Preseason All-American and garnered NABC Division I Player of the Year and Bob Cousy Award Watch List recognition.

- Buie was named Big Ten Player of the Week for the third time in his career on Dec. 4, averaging 27.0 points, 8.0 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game in wins over NIU and Purdue.
- Buie is 5th in the school's career scoring record book with 1,795 career points. **Michael "Juice" Thompson** and Buie are the only two players in program history with career marks of at least 1,500 points, 500 assists and 200 made 3-pointers.
- He is averaging 18.1 points per game this year (6th in BIG) and 4.9 assists per game (5th in BIG). He is the only Northwestern player to post those numbers over the season's first 14 games since at least 2010-11. He is one of just two high-major players to post 18+ points and 4.9+ assists per game this season.

LAST TIME AGAINST PENN STATE: Northwestern fell in the Big Ten Tournament Quarterfinals at United Center to Penn State, 67-65.

- **Boo Buie** led the team with 16 points, while **Brooks Barnhizer** had a double-double off the bench with 15 points and 11 rebounds.
- NU forced 15 Penn State turnovers compared to just four for the Wildcats.

SERIES NOTES VS. PENN STATE: Northwestern has dropped the last five meetings and nine of the last 11 overall.

- NU last defeated the Nittany Lions on March 7, 2020, inside Welsh-Ryan Arena in an 80-69 victory.
- Penn State is 16-6 inside the Bryce Jordan Center and claimed a Senior Night victory over Northwestern in the last meeting in State College on Feb. 25, 2022.
- The first ever meeting between Northwestern and Penn State took place in Evanston on Dec. 31, 1928, with the Wildcats recording a 41-17 victory over the Nittany Lions. They would not meet again until Penn State joined the Big Ten starting with the 1992-93 season.

ROAD OPENING WIN: With a road victory over DePaul on Dec. 16, Northwestern won its road opener in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons. Last year, the Wildcats went on the road and defeated Georgetown in their road opener, 75-63. In 2011 the Wildcats won at Georgia Tech 76-60 and in 2012 at Baylor, 74-70.

LET BROOKS COOK: After an expanded role late last season, junior guard **Brooks Barnhizer** has gotten off to a hot start in 2023-24.

- Barnhizer is averaging 13.2 points per game, a team-best 7.4 rebounds per game (11th in the BIG) and 1.8 steals per game, which leads the team and ranks 4th in the BIG in his first season starting for the Wildcats. His 7.4 rebounds per game lead the league among guards.
- Barnhizer is the only high-major player in the country posting 13.0+ points, 7.0+ rebounds and 1.8+ steals per game. Since 1992-93, only three Big Ten players have posted those numbers for an entire season: Glenn Robinson (Purdue, 1992-93) and Ryan Bowen (Iowa, 1997-98).
- He is the only guard in the country averaging 13.0+ points and 7.5+ rebounds for game this season.
- He recorded a double-double in back-to-back games against Binghamton and Dayton becoming the first Northwestern player to do so since **Vic Law** in 2018-19.
- Barnhizer is averaging 35:34 minutes played per game, which ranks second in the Big Ten.

BORG BUCKETS: Princeton transfer guard **Ryan Langborg** has provided an offensive spark to the Wildcats this season, after leading the Tigers to an NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 appearance last year.

- Langborg is averaging 2.2 made 3-pointers per game this season, which ranks 8th in the Big Ten. He became the first Wildcat to make 29 or more 3-pointers over the season's first 12 games since **Scottie Lindsey** made 34 in 2017-18.
- Over a five-game stretch from 11/27 through 12/16, Langborg made 19 total 3-pointers, shooting 65.0% (19-of-29). He is the first Northwestern player to hit 19+ threes and shoot 60%+ from deep in a five game stretch since at least 2010-11. During the stretch, he averaged 17.8 points per game, and over the last 13 games, dating back to last year's NCAA Tournament, he posted 14.8 points per game.

TB3: Senior guard **Ty Berry** is posting some of the best numbers of his career in 2023-24.

- This season he is averaging career-highs in points (11.8) and field goal percentage (48.0) and 3-point field goal percentage (43.4).
- Berry is second in the Big Ten in 3-point field goal percentage (min. 50 attempts) behind Ohio State's Jamison Battle (45.2).
- Berry ranks 4th in the Big Ten averaging 2.4 made 3-pointers per game.
- Over his last four games, Berry is averaging 17.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game, while shooting 58.5% (24-for-41) from the field and 53.8% from behind the arc (14-for-26).
- He tied his career-long streak of five consecutive games in double figures from last season. Over this year's stretch of five straight double figure scoring games, he averaged 15.6 points and 2.4 steals per game, while making multiple threes in each game.
- Against Detroit Mercy (Dec. 10) Berry posted 16 points on 6-of-8 shooting and a 3-of-4 mark from behind the arc.
- He notched his first double-double of the season and the third of his career with 12 bounds and 10 rebounds against Arizona State (Dec. 20).
- Berry reached 100 career assists and steals on Dec. 13.

MARTINELLI MINUTES: Sophomore guard **Nick Martinelli**, from nearby Glenview, Ill. (9 miles from Welsh-Ryan Arena), has been a huge lift of the bench for the 'Cats this year.

- He posted career-highs of 22 points, 6 rebounds and 3 assists off the bench on Dec. 10 against Detroit Mercy.

MORE NOTES...

Martinelli scored the most points by a Northwestern bench player since **Boo Buie** had 26 points against Michigan State on December 18, 2019.

- Martinelli's 22 points off the bench in a non-conference game were the most by a Northwestern player since Scottie Lindsey posted 26 against New Orleans in 2015.
- Martinelli made his first eight shots from the field before finishing the game 10-of-12 from the field. It is the highest shooting percentage by a NU player while making 10+ field goals since **John Shurna** shot 10-of-11 from the field on Dec. 13, 2010, against Long Island.
- Martinelli was named the Fisher-McGrath Award Winner, given to the MVP of the Northwestern/DePaul game, for scoring a game-high 16 points and grabbing 5 rebounds off the bench.

SPEED LIMIT, 65

- Northwestern is 7-0 when holding opponents to 65 or fewer points this season, after going 20-2 last year when doing so.
- During the Chris Collins era, Northwestern is 125-35 (.781) when holding its opponent to 65 or fewer points.

RANKED CATS: Northwestern earned a No. 25 ranking in Week 6 of the Associated Press Poll (Dec. 11). Below are some facts about when the Wildcats are ranked.

- The Wildcats have been ranked in back-to-back seasons after earning a No. 21 ranking in Week 15 last year.
- With a 56-46 win over DePaul on Dec. 16, Northwestern snapped a six-game losing skid while ranked.
- Northwestern won its first road game as a ranked team at DePaul since Jan. 4, 1969, when the No. 19 ranked Wildcats defeated Michigan State 85-71 inside Jenison Field House. NU won its first road game as a ranked team against a non-conference opponent against DePaul for the first time since the No. 6 'Cats defeated Louisville 73-68 on Dec. 19, 1958.
- Northwestern is 13-19 all-time as a ranked team.
- The Wildcats won eight games as a ranked team during the 1958-59 season, a single-season program record.
- Northwestern hasn't won a Big Ten game as a ranked team since defeating Michigan State 85-71 on Jan. 4, 1969, when the 'Cats were ranked No. 19.
- NU's highest all-time ranking is No. 6, which happened two times during the 1958-59 season.
- Under head coach Chris Collins, Northwestern has been ranked six times, the second-most times NU has been ranked under a head coach

SCORING 'CATS: Northwestern is averaging 73.5 points per game this season. If the mark holds for the season, it would be Northwestern's third-highest scoring output in the last 50 seasons. The 2020-21 team averaged 73.0 points and the 1989-90 team averaged 78.2 points per game.

RETURNING PRODUCTION: Northwestern returns 61.7% of its points from last season, which ranks fourth in the conference. The Wildcats rank in the top half of the Big Ten in percentage of minutes returning (57.2%, fifth), percentage of rebounds (57.0%, sixth) and percentage of assists (63.4%, fifth).

O CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN(S): Northwestern's Boo Buie, Brooks Barnhizer and Ty Berry were named team captains for the 2023-24 season ... Buie is serving as a captain for the second consecutive season, while Barnhizer and Berry take on the leadership role for the first time.

BEATING NO. 1: Northwestern became the seventh program in the country to defeat an AP No. 1 ranked team in back-to-back seasons since 2010-11 with a 92-88 overtime win over then-No. 1 Purdue on Dec. 1. Only Rutgers was unranked in both wins.

- Northwestern is the 25th program to record two wins against an AP No. 1 team since 2010-11 and the sixth Big Ten team to do so, joining Rutgers, Indiana, Michigan State, Ohio State and Wisconsin.
- The Wildcats are the third program to ever defeat the same AP No. 1 team at home in consecutive season. Butler defeated Villanova in 2016-17 and 2017-18 and Maryland defeated Duke in 2001-02 and 2002-03. NU would be the first to do so while unranked.
- **Boo Buie** led the way for NU with 31 points, the second-highest mark of his career, and 9 assists. He did not turn the ball over and tallied 7 points in OT. He became the first major conference player to post those numbers in a single game since Oklahoma State's JameSon Curry vs. Texas A&M-CC on Nov. 29, 2006 (35/9/0).
- **Ty Berry** tallied a season-high 21 points, with 7 points coming in OT. **Ryan Langborg** had a season-high 20 points, as the trio combined for 72 of the team's 92 points.
- NU was 0-19 against the AP No. 1 until the last two years against Purdue. It was the Wildcats first overtime win over an AP top 5 team since Dec. 27, 1959, a 118-109 OT win over a Jerry West led and No. 5 ranked West Virginia team.
- It was head coach **Chris Collins** 15th win over a ranked opponent, tied for the program lead with Bill Carmody.
- NU has won 5 of its last 6 games against ranked opponents.

RECAPPING LAST YEAR: Northwestern won its second most games in a single-season in program history and finished tied for second place in the Big Ten Conference standings for the first time since 1958-59 by finishing 22-12 with a 12-8 conference mark.

- Northwestern reached the NCAA Tournament for the second time in program history, earning a No. 7 seed, its highest in program history.
- The Wildcats advanced to the second round defeating Boise State 75-67, before falling to No. 7 UCLA, 68-63.
- The 'Cats 12 Big Ten wins were the most in school history, ahead of the 1930-31 (11-1) team, the school's only outright Big Ten championship squad.
- Head coach **Chris Collins** was named Big Ten Coach of the Year, becoming the first Northwestern coach to win the

award since 2004. Following the conclusion of the season he signed a contract extension through 2028.

- Guard **Boo Buie** was named an All-Big Ten First Team selection, Northwestern's first since **John Shurna** in 2012.
- NU posted an over .500 road record (7-4) for the first time in a season since 1958-59 (7-2). The team's six BIG road wins last year tied the program benchmark for most in a single-season in school history (1930-31, 6-0).

LEARNING FROM THE BEST: Northwestern's coaching staff scored 6,212 career collegiate points, the most among coaching staffs in the Big Ten.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN: Northwestern returns three starters from last year's team (**Ty Berry**, **Boo Buie**, **Matthew Nicholson**), and **Brooks Barnhizer**, who played starters minutes coming off the bench. Four of the top six scorers from last season are back.

- The Wildcats added three transfers through the portal for 2023-24: Graduate guard **Ryan Langborg** from Princeton, graduate forward **Blake Preston** from Liberty and sophomore guard **Justin Mullins** from Denver.
- NU added three first-years in guards **Jordan Clayton** and **Parker Strauss** and forward **Blake Barkley**.

HEAD COACH CHRIS COLLINS: Sullivan-Ubben Head Men's Basketball Coach Chris Collins is in his 11th season as the program's head coach, the third-longest coaching tenure in program history.

- Collins is the fourth-longest tenured coach in the Big Ten, trailing Michigan State's Tom Izzo (29), Purdue's Matt Painter (19) and Iowa's Fran McCaffery (14).
- Collins has guided Northwestern to 20 wins or more in a season three times. Northwestern had two 20 win seasons in its first 111 seasons of basketball. Collins has guided the team to three 20 or more win seasons in the last eight campaigns.
- His 70 Big Ten wins rank tied for second in school history with Bill Carmody (70, 2000-13). Arthur Longborg (138, 1927-50) is the school career leader.

TRANSFER ADDITIONS: Northwestern added three transfers to its roster for the 2023-24 season:

- Grad transfer guard Ryan Langborg comes to Northwestern from Princeton, where he was pivotal in leading the Tigers to a Sweet 16 appearance last season. Over 81 games in his career, the San Diego, Calif. native is averaging 9.9 points, 2.9 rebounds and 1.4 assists per game, and last season posted averages of 12.7 points, 3.1 rebounds and 1.6 assists per game.
- Grad transfer forward Blake Preston joins the roster after playing 109 career games at Liberty, and averaged 6.7 points and a team-high 5.1 rebounds per game last season on Liberty teams that went a combined 102-30 during his career in Lynchburg.
- Sophomore guard Justin Mullins is a local product from Oak Park, Ill. (12 miles from Welsh-Ryan Arena), that comes by way of Denver, where he led the Pioneers and ranked third in the Summit League averaging 1.5 steals per game last season.

CHRIS COLLINS

SULLIVAN-UBBEN HEAD MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



Sullivan-Ubben Head Coach Chris Collins is in his 11th season at Northwestern and ranks third in school history in wins. He was named the University's 24th head men's basketball coach on March 27, 2013, and this offseason signed a contract extension through 2028.

Collins guided the Wildcats to heights never before reached during his tenure, including the first two NCAA Tournament appearances in program history. Through 10 seasons at NU, Collins is 155-162 and guided the program to its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 2016-17, and guided the program to its second appearance in 2022.

Most recently in 2022-23, Collins led the Wildcats to the school's second NCAA Tournament berth, a 22-12 overall record, and a second-place finish in the Big Ten Conference standings with a 12-8 league ledger. For the first time since 1958-59, Northwestern finished second in the league standings, while also setting a school record for conference wins in a single-season. For the first time in his career, Collins was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year, the second time in Northwestern history a coach has earned the award. Additionally, he received national recognition as the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year and a Naismith Coach of the Year Semifinalist.

The regular season was highlighted by a school-record four wins over AP ranked opponents and the program's first victory against the nation's No. 1 team, on Feb. 12 against No. 1 Purdue, 64-58, inside Welsh-Ryan Arena. Playing away from home, the team went 7-4 in true road contests, winning the school's most road games in a season since 1958-59. The 'Cats captured their first win over a ranked Indiana team since 1988 by downing the No. 15 Hoosiers, 84-83, at Assembly Hall on Jan. 8. Northwestern won back-to-back road games over ranked opponents for the first time in school history as it defeated No. 20 Michigan State 70-63 in East Lansing.

Northwestern earned a No. 7 seed in the NCAA Tournament, the highest in school history, and defeated Boise State 75-67 in the First Round in Sacramento, Calif., before falling to No. 2 UCLA, 68-63. The 'Cats improved to 2-0 all-time in NCAA Tournament First Round games.

Under his coaching, Northwestern's senior guards of Chase Audige and Boo Buie combined to form one of the best backcourts in the country and in school history. Audige was named co-Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, a first at NU since 1994, and an All-Big Ten Second Team selection. Buie posted one of the best seasons by a point guard in program history and became the first Wildcat named All-Big Ten First Team since John Shurna in 2012. Buie was also a finalist for the Bob Cousy Award, which is awarded to the nation's best point guard. The duo became the first Northwestern teammates to earn first and second team All-Big Ten honors

since 1963-64.

In 2021-22, the team went 15-16. He guided the program to seven Big Ten wins, the program's most in a year since the 2016-17 season. Forward Pete Nance earned All-Big Ten Honorable Mention recognition, averaging 14.6 points and 6.5 rebounds per game. The Wildcats tallied a 64-62 road win at No. 10 Michigan State on Jan. 15, Collins' third triumph over an AP-Top 10 opponent as head coach. Northwestern defeated Nebraska 71-69 in the Big Ten Tournament, earning the team's first postseason win since 2016-17.

In 2020-21, the 'Cats opened Big Ten play 3-0 for the first time since the 1967-68 season and earned a No. 19 ranking from the AP. NU recorded a 79-65 win over No. 4 Michigan State on Dec. 20, it's first win over a top-five opponent since beating the Spartans in 1979. Later that week, the Wildcats knocked off No. 23 Ohio State, 71-70.

During his sixth campaign at the helm of the program, Collins saw program greats Vic Law and Dererk Pardon complete their college careers. Both were named All-Big Ten honorable mention and both finished with over 1,000-career points. Law finished his career in the top-10 at Northwestern for 3-pointers made (10th; 193), rebounds (9th; 710), and double-doubles (7th; 8). As a senior, Pardon averaged a career-high 13.9 points per game, a single-season high 244 rebounds and was the only Wildcat to start and play in all 31 games throughout 2018-19. Collins mentored Pardon to become Northwestern's all-time leader in career field goal percentage (60.2%). He ranks second all-time at NU in blocks (149), fifth in rebounds (785) and fourth in double-doubles (18).

In 2017-18, Collins saw his first Northwestern recruiting class wrap up their collegiate careers. Bryant McIntosh left NU with more than 1,600 points and 700 career assists, becoming one of only three players in Big Ten history to reach both milestones. His 700 career assists are a program record, while ranking seventh in league history. Scottie Lindsey finished his time in Evanston ranking eighth in school history in career three-point field goals and in the top 20 in scoring.

In 2016-17, he guided the Wildcats to a school-record 24 wins while earning the program's first NCAA tournament berth and victory in school history NU captured the nation's attention with its outstanding start to the season. An 18-4 start, including a six-game winning streak in Big Ten Conference play – the program's first since 1933 – saw the team crack the top 25 of the AP poll on Jan. 30, the team's first national ranking in seven years. NU went on to record 10 wins in league play, its most since the 1932-33 campaign.

NU was rewarded with an NCAA tournament berth on Selection Sunday and the Wildcats earned a 68-66 victory over Vanderbilt in an opening-round contest in Salt Lake City. Northwestern pushed second-ranked and eventual national runner-up Gonzaga to the limits in the second round before eventually suffering a narrow loss.

Collins' contributions to the program were rewarded by being named one of four national finalists for the Naismith Men's Coach of the Year award.

Collins came to Evanston after serving on the coaching staff at Duke since July 22, 2000. He was promoted to Associate Head Coach in the summer of 2008. During Collins' 13 seasons on the Blue Devils' staff, Duke posted an overall record of 385-77 while recording eight ACC tournament championships, four ACC regular season titles, eight in-season tournament titles and national championships in 2001 and 2010.

Collins worked primarily with backcourt players during his time at Duke and tutored All-Americans Jason Williams, Mike Dunleavy, Chris Duhon, J.J. Redick, Gerald Henderson, DeMarcus Nelson, Jon Scheyer, Nolan Smith and Austin Rivers, in addition to NBA draft picks Daniel Ewing, Kyrie Irving and Kyle Singler.

Collins also served as a court coach and scout for Mike Krzyzewski, assisting the USA Basketball Senior National Team staff with on-court duties as well as game preparation from 2006-12, including during the program's gold-medal performances at the 2008 Beijing Olympics, 2010 FIBA World Championships and 2012 London Olympics. Before returning to his alma mater, Collins served as an assistant coach at Seton Hall for two years with Tommy Amaker. In 1999-2000, Collins was part of a staff that guided the Pirates to a 22-10 record and the Sweet 16 of the NCAA tournament. Prior to Seton Hall, Collins spent the 1997-98 season as an assistant with the WNBA's Detroit Shock.

As a player, Collins played professional basketball in Finland during the 1996-97 season, leading the league in scoring.

While at Duke, Collins was a team captain as a senior and four-year letterman from 1993-96. He ranks 11th among Duke's all-time leaders in three-point field goals (209) and 10th in three-point field goal attempts (539). Collins averaged 9.1 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.4 assists as a collegian. He earned second-team All-ACC honors as a senior.

Collins was a member of a Duke senior class that had 83 total victories, three NCAA tournament bids, one Final Four appearance, two ACC regular season championships, an ACC tournament title, and two in-season tournament championships (the 1992 Maui Classic and the 1995 Carrs Great Alaska Shootout).

As a senior in 1996, Collins had his most productive season, leading the Blue Devils in three-point field goals (79), three-point percentage (.441), free throws made (83) and attempted (115), assists (132) and steals (37). Collins also ranked second on the team by averaging 16.3 points per game. He was among the ACC leaders in scoring (10th), assists (fourth), field goal percentage (.467, seventh) and free throw percentage (.722, 10th).

Collins is the son of former NBA All-Star, Doug Collins, who is currently a senior advisor for the Chicago Bulls. A native of nearby Northbrook, Illinois, Collins is a 1996 graduate of Duke with a bachelor's degree in sociology.

Collins and his wife, Kim, have two children: Ryan, who is a student manager for the Wildcats and Kate.
