LEADING OFF

- Penn State visits No. 10 Virginia for a midweek contest.
- The Nittany Lions are 11-15-2 all-time against Virginia and played a three-game series in Charlottesville in 2022.
- Penn State is coming off a series win at Davidson after sweeping Sunday's double-
- The Nittany Lions won 14-7 in game one as four players recorded multi-hit and multi-RBI performances.
- Penn State took game two, 6-4, after a strong start from freshman Mason Horwat, who went five innings and allowed one hit and two runs while not giving up a hit through the first five frames.
- After hitting .417 with five hits and seven RBI at Davidson, J.T. Marr leads the team with a .444 average and 20 hits. He paces the Big Ten in total hits and hits per game (2.0), good for ninth nationally in hits per game.
- Jaden Henline improved to 2-0 on the season with five solid innings to pick up the win in Sunday's first game vs. Davidson.

Newcomers Leading Balanced Lineup

- As a team, Penn State leads the Big Ten in on-base percentage (.431) and OPS (.885).
- The Nittany Lions rank second in the conference in walks (61), while holding third in batting average (.303) and sac flies (6).
- Penn State has five players with a .344 or better average, six with a .400+ on-base percentage and six with a .400+ slugging percentage.
- Graduate student J.T. Marr paces the squad with a .444 average and 20 hits. He own two
 doubles, a homer, 11 RBI and nine runs.
- Marr has a hit in all 10 games this season, including six multi-hit performances.
- The South Carolina native leads the Big Ten in hits per game (2.0), ranking ninth in the country, and total hits (20), sitting 23rd in the nation.
- Junior Matt Maloney is batting .364 with a team-high 13 RBI along with a double and a homer.
- Graduate student Adam Cecere is hitting .357 with 10 hits, including two doubles and a team-high three homers, eight RBI and 13 runs. He has a team-high 11 walks and six hit-by-piches.
- Cecere paces the team with a .750 slugging percentage and a .587 on-base percentage.
- He leads the Big Ten with a 1.337 OPS and on-base percentage (.587) while sitting third in slugging percentage (.750). He's also third in the conference in total walks (11) and walks per game (1.1).
- Cecere is one of 15 current Division I players with 35+ homers and 124+ RBI in their career.
- Among active DI players, Cecere is 17th in homers (34) and 50th in RBI (124).
- Bobby Marsh is hitting .345 with six RBI, while Joe Jaconski has a .344 average, five RBI, six runs and 10 walks.
- Jaconski is fifth in the Big Ten in walks (10) and walks per game (1.0).
- Tayven Kelley, Bryce Molinaro and Grant Norris each have two homers, while Molinaro has 11 RBI and Norris has nine.
- Kyle Hannon ranks sixth in the Big Ten with five steals.

Bats Warm Up In Game 2 At Davidson

- Penn State's bats broke through in Penn State's 14-7 win over Davidson in the first game on Sunday's doubleheader, and the second game in the overall series.
- Four Nittany Lions had multi-hit and multi-RBI games, led by J.T. Marr with two hits and four RBI. Marr's four RBI included a two-run homer. He also scored three times.
- Bryce Molinaro collected two hits, three RBI and three runs, while Bobby Marsh had two hits and three RBI. Grant Norris drove in two runs on two hits.
- Adam Cecere added a solo homer and three runs.

Strong Weekend At Stanford

- Penn State averaged 11 runs, 10.3 hits and 9.3 walks per game in the series at Stanford.
- The Nittany Lions displayed their power at the plate with four doubles, a triple and six homers among 31 hits.
- In Friday's 15-4 win, Penn State collected 13 hits and 17 walks. Five Nittany Lions reached base at least four times and eight Nittany Lion reached at least twice.
- The 17 walks are Penn State's most in a game since at least 2004 and are the fourth-most in Division I this season.
- Penn State plated 13 runs on 11 hits on Saturday.
- The Nittany Lions' wins marked the first time Stanford lost back-to-back home games by 10+ runs to the same opponent since at least 1959 and was the first time Stanford lost back-to-back games by 10+ runs since its 2012 Super Regional at Florida State.
- With Friday and Saturday's wins, Penn State won back-to-back games by a 10+ run margin for the first time since April 30-May 1, 2010 against Michigan State (18-7, 22-5). The Nittany Lions also won by a 10+ run margin in back-to-back road games for the first time since March 29-30, 2003 at Purdue (13-3, 14-4).
- Including a 12-4 win against Army on February 18, Penn State scored 12+ runs in threestraight games for the first time since April 4-7, 2000 (13 vs. Cornell, 12 vs. Cornell, 19 at Michigan State).
- The Nittany Lions scored 12+ runs in three-straight non-home games for the first time since March 23-25, 1986 (21 at Towson, 13 at Gettysburg, 12 at Gettysburg).

Hannon, Kelley, Norris Climb Records Lists

- Senior Kyle Hannon already has five steals in 2024.
- With five steals this year, Hannon has moved up to a tie for fifth all-time at Penn State with 39 career steals. He is currently tied with Kevin Billotte (1995-98).
- Hannon ranked second in the Big Ten in steals per game (0.55) and total steals (27) last season.
- The Harrisburg native is one of 14 Division I players, and the only Big Ten player, returning for the 2024 season who posted 7+ homers and 27+ steals last season.
- Senior+Tayven Kelley owns 11 career triples, tied fifth all-time at Penn State. He is one triple away from tying third place.
- Graduate student Grant Norris' .542 career slugging percentage sits sixth all-time at Penn State.

Henline, Horwat Collect Wins On The Mound At Davidson

- Senior Jaden Henline improved to 2-0 on the season with a solid performance on the mound to help Penn State to a victory in game one of Sunday's doubleheader. He tossed five innings, allowing three runs on six hits. He struck out one.
- Henline earned a win against Stanford in his first start of the season.
- Freshman Mason Horwat followed with an impressive performance in his first career start in the second game on Sunday's twin bill.
- He fired five innings, giving up one hit and two runs to earn his first career win.
- Horwat did not allow a hit before the start of the sixth inning, faced the minimum through five and retired 11-straight batters between the second and fifth innings.
- Chic DeGaetano (1.2) and Mason Butash (1.0) provided strong relief performances to close out a tight 6-4 win in Sunday's second game.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Virginia

- Head Coach Brian O'Connor is in his 21st season at Virginia.
- The Cavaliers are 849-354-2 under O'Connor and have reached at least an NCAA Regional in 17 seasons, including a College World Series appearance in 2023.
- Virginia is 10-1 this season and ranked No. 10 in the D1Baseball Poll.
- UVA won two of three games in its series against UMass last weekend.
- Virginia has a .347 team average and is scoring 9.8 runs per game.

BY THE NUMBERS

- Bobby Whalen leads the team with a .519 average to go with 11 RBI, while Henry Godbout is hitting .515 with a homer and 10 RBI.
- Henry Ford and Harrison Didawick are tied for the team lead with three homers, while Ford paces the squad with 14 RBI.
- Virgnia's pitching staff has a 4.19 ERA and is allowing a .264 opponent batting average.
- Cullen McKay has started both of Virginia's midweek games so far this season and is 1-0 with an 0.79 ERA in 11.1 innings. He has 12 strikeouts.
- In his last start against VMI, McKay worked six innings, allowing one run on three hits and striking out six.

Against The Cavaliers

- Penn State is 11-15-2 all-time against Virginia.
- The teams last met in 2022 with the Cavaliers winning all three games. Kyle Hannon went 7-of-8 at the plate in that series.
- Penn State is 5-12 in games at Virginia with wins in 1928, 1933, 1999, 2001 and 2004.



PAGE 22 I PENN STATE VS. VIRGINIA HEAD COACH MIKE GAMBINO



Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino takes over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the D1Baseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting

Gambino's pitching staff ranked 26th in the country in strikeoutto-walk ratio (2.54) and 26th in walks allowed per nine innings (3.58). Boston College held fifth in the country, and led the ACC, with a .982 fielding percentage.

The 2022 MLB Draft saw four of Gambino's student-athletes be chosen, led by second baseman Luke Gold, who was selected in the fifth round by the Detroit Tigers. Pitchers Mason Pelio (Reds - 12th round), Joe Mancini (Astros - 15th round) and Max Gieg (Angels -18th round) were also chosen in the draft.

In 2021, an impressive three players were selected in the first six rounds of the MLB Draft headlined by outfielder Sal Frelick, who was the 15th overall pick by the Milwaukee Brewers. Shortstop Cody Morissette was picked in the second round by the Miami Marlins and pitcher Emmet Sheehan was selected in the sixth round by the Los Angeles Dodgers

Gambino led BC to a 31-27 record in 2019 and the Eagles reached the ACC semifinals as the 12th seed with wins over Clemson and topseeded Louisville. A program-record five Eagles earned All-ACC, led by All-ACC first team pitcher Dan Metzdorf, who was a fifth-round pick for the Chicago White Sox and led the ACC with a 2.30 ERA. Jake Alu (Nationals - 24th round) and Matt Gill (Reds - 27th round) were also chosen during the 2019 MLB Draft.

In 2018, outfielder Chris Galland earned All-ACC third team accolades and Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-America honors. The 2018 MLB Draft had four of Gambino's players selected with Jake Palomaki (Rays - 18th round), Jacob Stevens

(Diamondbacks - 21st round), Brian Rapp (Twins - 26th round) and

Dan Metzdorf (Yankees - 38th round).

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship Tournament for the first time since 2010. BC won 10 of its last 15

ACC games with sweeps over Notre Dame and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005 and third-highest total in program history. They also tallied 13 ACC wins, the most since 2010, while their six conference series victories set a school record. Gambino led the Eagles to a sweep in the Oxford Regional as the third seed to advance to the program's first NCAA Super Regional, BC finished the season in the Top 25 of all four major polls for the first time in program history (15th -D1Baseball, 16th - Baseball America, NCBWA and 21st - USA Today/ Coaches Poll).

For his efforts, Gambino was named the 2016 American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year, a finalist for D1Baseball Coach of the Year and earned a spot on the

website's top-10 coaching performances of the season.

Gambino proteges were selected in the first round of the MLB Draft in back-to-back years for the first time in program history in 2015 and 2016. Chris Shaw was selected 31st overall by the San Francisco Giants in 2015 and Justin Dunn was taken 19th overall by the New York Mets in 2016. Overall, five players were drafted in 2016: Dunn, Michael King (12th round), Jesse Adams (14th round), Nick Sciortino (19th round) and Joe Cronin (34th round).

Gambino was an assistant coach for four seasons at Virginia Tech prior to his move to Boston College. He served as the Hokies' recruiting coordinator and worked with the hitters and infielders. In his four years, he saw 15 players get drafted in the MLB Draft,

including nine in 2010.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big

East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny

and Callahan.
