### TONIGHT'S GAME

- The Nittany Lions will return home with a rematch against Buffalo State Saturday night.
- The Bengals defeated Penn State, 3-0, Oct. 19.

### HOME SWEET HOME

- Penn State returns home for the first time since its first game of the season (10/12/12 vs. AIC).

### STREAKING LIONS

- Penn State is currently on a three-game win streak.
- During that stretch, the Nittany Lions have outscored their opponents by a 14-5 margin.
- Opposing teams are 0-for-14 on the power play during that stretch.

### HOT HANDS

- Fifteen players have recorded at least one point in the past three games.
- Freshmen **Casey Bailey** (2g, 3a) and **David Glen** (1g, 4a) have led the team with five points each in their last three games.
- Junior **Michael McDonagh** has collected four assists, registering one against RIT before picking up three

helpers against Sacred Heart.

### PLAYING WITH THE LEAD

- The Nittany Lions have trailed for only 32 seconds during their three-game win streak. Penn State trailed Sacred Heart, 1-0, before **Michael Longo** scored the first-period equalizer.

### LIONS IN THE NATION

- As of Nov. 1, freshman **David Glen** ranks seventh among rookies in points per game (1.17).
- Classmate **Casey Bailey** is tied for ninth (1.00) among freshmen.
- Sophomore goalie **PJ Musico** is one of 10 backstops who have won all their starts (4-0-0).
- Penn State is tied for 12th in the NCAA in scoring offense (3.33).

### ROAD TRIPPING

- Penn State concluded its three-game road trip with an unblemished 3-0-0 record.
- The next time the Nittany Lions will play three straight games away from Greenberg Ice Pavilion is Jan. 19-26 (1/19 vs. Vermont, 1/25-26 at Michigan State).

### LAST TIME VS. BUFFALO STATE

- Penn State fell to Buffalo State, 3-0, Oct. 19.
- The Nittany Lions outshot Buffalo State by a 35-26 margin.
- Both teams combined for 29 infractions, totaling 83 penalty minutes.
- The Bengals were 3-for-11 on the power play, while Penn State finished 0-for-9.
- Penn State's last loss of the season came against Buffalo State.

### SCOUTING THE BENGALS

- Buffalo State is currently 1-1-1 overall on the season. Following their win against Penn State, the Bengals lost to Brockport, 4-2, and tied Geneseo, 4-4.
- Sophomore forward Nick Melligan leads the team with five points (3g, 2a).
- Junior netminder Kevin Carr has been the only Buffalo State netminder to see action in 2012-13. He has compiled a 2.27 GAA and .924 save percentage.

### PENN STATE VS. NCAA DIII

- Penn State is playing its second of three games against NCAA Division III opponents (0-1-0).
- The Nittany Lions will also play Fredonia State Tuesday, Dec. 11. The game was originally scheduled for Oct. 30 but was postponed due to Hurricane Sandy.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Six different players scored as Penn

State topped Sacred Heart, 6-3, Oct. 27.

- Penn State fell behind, 1-0, before scoring three goals in a 5:06 span to take a 3-1 lead.
- Senior forward **Michael Longo** and junior defenseman **Nate Jensen** scored their first goals of the season.

### SPREADING THE WEALTH

- Twelve players have recorded at least two points, while 16 Nittany Lions have reached the scoresheet this season.

### FRESHMAN IMPACT

- All nine of Penn State's skating freshmen have recorded at least one point during the 2012-13 season.
- Seven players registered at least one point during the Nittany Lions' first two games.

- Sophomore goaltender **PJ Musico** stopped all 34 Army shots for the shut-out and improved to 3-0-0 on the season.
- Penn State defeated Army, 5-0, for its first win against the Black Knights in a series that dates back to the 1940s.
- Five different Nittany Lions scored (**Casey Bailey, Kenny Brooks, David Glen, Jonathan Milley, Peter Sweetland**) in the game while Bailey and Glen registered a goal and two assists each.
- Brooks and Sweetland both scored their first collegiate goals.

## BLAST FROM THE PAST

- Penn State and Army twice played during the Nittany Lions' varsity years in the 1940s.
- Penn State fell to the Black Knights, 18-3, Feb. 26, 1944 and by a 12-13 margin Feb. 14, 1947. Both games were played at West Point.
- Army is one of three Penn State opponents from the 1940s (Cornell, Colgate) that still sponsors varsity hockey.

## SERVICE ACADEMIES

- Friday night's matchup was the first of three season meetings between Penn State and a service academy.
- The Nittany Lions will also host Air Force Nov. 9-10 at Greenberg Ice Pavilion.

## A TRIP ALONG THE ATLANTIC

- During the course of the season, Penn State will play eight Atlantic Hockey opponents, the most from any conference.
- The Nittany Lions are currently 4-1-0 against AHA foes.
- Penn State's AHA schedule consists of AIC (10/12-13), RIT (10/20), Army (10/26), Sacred Heart (10/27), Air Force (11/9-10), Holy Cross (12/7-8), Robert Morris (12/15, 28), UConn (1/4-5).

## PSU SPOILS RIT HOMECOMING

- Penn State defeated RIT, 3-2, in front of a sellout crowd of 10,556 at Rochester's Blue Cross Arena Oct. 20.
- The game was played at Blue Cross Arena, home of the American Hockey League's Rochester Americans, and was part of the University's homecoming celebration.
- Freshman forward **Curtis Loik** scored his first collegiate goal to give Penn State a 1-0 lead, while classmate **Casey Bailey** and sophomore **Max**

**Gardiner**, who scored his first Nittany Lion goal, (1g, 1a) also scored.

- **PJ Musico** made a career-high 40 saves in net, including nine in the final 4:13 as Penn State killed a RIT power play.

## NEUTRAL SITE SUCCESS

- Through four games, Penn State has twice played at neutral site venues, winning both contest in AHL arenas.
- The Nittany Lions won their first NCAA Division I game against AIC Oct. 13 at Mohegan Sun Arena in Wilkes-Barre, Pa. Mohegan Sun Arena is home to the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton Penguins.
- Against RIT, Penn State topped the Tigers, 3-2, at Blue Cross Arena, home of the Rochester Americans.

## PSU FALLS TO BUFFALO STATE

- The Nittany Lions fell to Buffalo State, 3-0, Friday night at Buffalo State Sports Arena.
- Freshman **Matthew Skoff** made 23 saves for the Nittany Lions.
- Penn State was 0-for-9 on the power play, while the Bengals were 3-for-11 with the man advantage.
- The teams combined for 29 infractions and 83 penalty minutes.

## HISTORY IS MADE

- Penn State won its first game at the NCAA Division I level with a 4-3 overtime victory against AIC Saturday, Oct. 13.
- A crowd of 5,389 fans came out to Mohegan Sun Arena at Casey Plaza in Wilkes-Barre, Pa., to see the Nittany Lions.
- Penn State took a 1-0 lead in the first period and a 3-1 third-period advantage before the Yellow Jackets tied the game in the third.
- **David Glen**, who tallied twice, scored the game-winner just 38 seconds into OT, while freshmen **Mark Yanis** and **Jonathan Milley** also scored. Milley's goal was Penn State's first power-play goal.
- Sophomore **PJ Musico** stopped 32 shots for the win.

## PSU SPLITS OPENING WEEKEND

- The Nittany Lions split their opening weekend, falling to AIC Friday, Oct. 12 before their historic victory the next day.
- Penn State competed in its first NCAA Division I game Friday, Oct. 12

- Junior defenseman **Nate Jensen** and freshman blueliners **Joseph Lordo** and **Mark Yanis** collected one assist each on the historic night.

- Freshman goalie **Matthew Skoff** made 26 saves in his collegiate debut.

### HISTORIC NIGHT IN HAPPY VALLEY

- When the puck dropped at Greenberg Ice Pavilion Friday night, it officially opened Penn State's first NCAA Division I season.

- It also marked the first varsity men's hockey game since March 3, 1947. On that day, the Nittany Lions fell to Georgetown, 11-4.

- Penn State fielded a varsity hockey team for five seasons in the 1940s (1940-44, 1946-47) before the sport was dropped due to limited facilities.

### NCAA DIVISION I HOCKEY

- With the addition of Penn State to the NCAA Division I ranks, there are now 59 schools that sponsor NCAA Division I men's hockey.

- The last school to establish NCAA hockey was Robert Morris in 2004-05.

### OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

- Sophomore forward **Tommy Olczyk** was named Penn State's first NCAA Division I captain.

- Junior defenseman **Nate Jensen** and senior forward **George Saad** will serve

as assistant captains.

- All captains were chosen through a team vote.

### NCAA VETERANS

- Five players -- **Max Gardiner** (Minnesota), **Taylor Holstrom** (Mercyhurst), **Nate Jensen** (Mercyhurst), **Bryce Johnson** (St. Cloud State), **Justin Kirchhevel** (Alaska Anchorage) -- on Penn State's 27-man roster have previous NCAA Division I experience.

- All five student-athletes played for their respective teams during the 2010-11 season.

- Holstrom was named Atlantic Hockey Rookie of the Year that season.

### NEUTRAL SITE GAMES

- Penn State will play at four neutral site venues during the 2012-13 season.

- The Nittany Lions will also play at two NHL arena's -- CONSOL Energy Center in Pittsburgh (Three Rivers Classic Jan. 28-29) and Philadelphia's Wells Fargo Center (vs. Vermont Jan. 19).

### THREE RIVERS CLASSIC

- Penn State will play in the first Three Rivers Classic at Pittsburgh's CONSOL Energy Center Dec. 28-29.

- The Nittany Lions will play Robert Morris Dec. 28 at 4:30 p.m. while Ohio State and Miami faceoff at 7:30 p.m.

- The consolation (4:30 p.m.) and championship game (7:30 p.m.) will take place Dec. 29.

- **George Saad's** brother, Brandon, appeared in two games with the Chicago Blackhawks in 2011-12.
- **Tommy Olczyk's** dad, Eddie, was a 16-year NHL veteran who helped the Rangers win the Stanley Cup in 1994.
- **Nate Jensen's** father, David, appeared in 18 games over three seasons with the Minnesota North Stars.

## FATHER/SON ROOMMATES

- **Tommy Olczyk's** father, Eddie, and **Nate Jensen's** father, David, lived together while playing for Team USA in the 1984 Olympics.
- Tommy and Nate are roommates at Penn State.

## NHL HOPEFUL

- Sophomore forward **Max Gardiner** was chosen by the St. Louis Blues in the third round (74th overall) of the 2010 NHL Entry Draft.
- Gardiner will be the first NHL draft choice to skate for Penn State.
