#### TONIGHT'S GAME

- The Nittany Lions and Wolverines will face off for the first time when the puck drops at Pegula Ice Arena Friday night. Following the weekend opener, the teams will conclude their series Saturday at 5 p.m. The game will broadcast live on ESPNU.

#### GETTING COMFORTABLE AT PEGULA

- Friday night's game will be the first of four straight for the Nittany Lions at Pegula Ice Arena. After its series with Michigan, Penn State will host Michigan State Feb. 14-15 before hitting the road for its final two road trips (Michigan - Feb. 21-22, Minnesota - Feb. 28, March 1) of the regular season.
- The Nittany Lions will be home for consecutive weekends for the first time since their season-high five-game homestand Nov. 8-Dec. 1.

#### SCOUTING MICHIGAN

- The Wolverines, who went 0-4-1 from Dec. 11-Jan. 11, will enter Hockey Valley unbeaten in their last four games (3-0-1). Michigan finished 1-0-1 against Wisconsin last weekend at Yost Ice Arena.
- Freshman JT Compher (9g, 12a), who played against Penn State last season as a member of the U.S. National Under-18 Team, leads Big Ten rookies and ranks sixth in the nation among newcomers with 0.95 points per game.
- Classmate Zach Nagelvoort ranks fourth in the country with a .936 save percentage and sixth in goals-against average (1.91).
- Michigan ranks seventh in the country in scoring defense (2.23)

## GLEN'S MATCH MEANS SECOND CHANCE FOR SOMEONE ELSE

• On Jan. 28, sophomore forward **David Glen** concluded a five-day bone marrow donation procedure after learning he was a match through Be The Match, a National Marrow Donation Program.

• The assistant captain participated in the Be The Match-facilitated Match4Kim Drive, which was held in support of Penn State men's lacrosse player's Drew Roper's mother, on campus November 2012. Glen does not know the identity of who will receive the donation.

• According to Be The Match, the five-day peripheral blood stem cell (PBSC) donation is a non-surgical procedure and is one of two methods of collecting blood-forming cells for bone marrow transplants. A 7-10 day timetable is typical for recovery for most PBSC donors and mild bone pain can result due to the excessive stem cell crowding within the bone marrow.

• Glen missed the Nittany Lions' games against Boston College (Jan. 25) and Ohio State (Jan. 31, Feb. 1) for the procedure and recovery.

## PACKING PEGULA

• Nittany Lions fans have packed Pegula Ice Arena during the facility's inaugural season, filling the 5,782-seat arena with an average of 6,020

fans per game. Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in nine of 10 home games, with the Dec. 1 matchup against Union the lone exception.

• More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on six occasions, including the season opener against Army (6,370) and the Nittany Lions' last home game against No. 2 Boston College (6,214).

## BEST TEAMS IN HOCKEY VALLEY

• Penn State will play its eighth and ninth home games against a ranked opponent after this weekend series against Michigan.

• Included in the opposition are three top-10 foes (No. 1 Minnesota, No. 2 Boston College, No. 10 Michigan).

## SKATING THE GAUNTLET

• Penn State is facing some of the best teams in the nation during its second NCAA season.

• This weekend will mark the 11th and 12th games against a ranked opponent in a 16- and 17-game span, respectively.

## ALL-TIME VS. MICHIGAN

• Although Penn State and Michigan have never met, four members of the Nittany Lions have experience against the Wolverines.

• Redshirt juniors **Taylor Holstrom** (1g) and **Nate Jensen** helped Mercyhurst to a 4-4 tie against

- Head coach **Guy Gadowsky** faced Michigan 12 times (4-8-0) when he served as head coach of the then-CCHA's Alaska Nanooks.

### FIRING AT WILL

- Penn State has out shot its opponent in five of the last six games.

- The Nittany Lions' 27 second-period shots against Robert Morris Dec. 27 were the most attempts in a period in program history. The team's 62 total shots ranked second, trailing the 63 attempts against AIC in the Nittany Lions' first NCAA game Oct. 12, 2012.

- The 79 total shots fired against Michigan State Jan. 17-18 were the most this year against any opponent during a two-game stretch.

- PSU out shot No. 1 Minnesota by a 38-25 margin Monday, Jan. 13 as the Gophers failed to out shoot a team for just the fourth time in 2013-14.

- Penn State out shot their second straight ranked opponent Jan. 25 vs. No. 2 Boston College (35-30).

### JUHA AMONG NATION'S BEST

- Sophomore defenseman **Luke Juha** is tied for seventh among NCAA blueliners with four power-play goals.

- His four extra-man markers lead Big Ten defensemen while his eight power-play points place him second.

- The Mississauga, Ont., native's 13 total points place him fourth among Big Ten defensemen.

### SHORTHANDED SUCCESS

- The Nittany Lions have scored four shorthanded goals - the most by a Big Ten team - in 2013-14.

### LEADING THE WAY

- Redshirt sophomore **Eric Scheid** (10-5--15), sophomore **Luke Juha** (4-9--13) and freshman **David Goodwin** (5-6--11) lead the Nittany Lions with double-digit points.

- Scheid and Juha are among six Nittany Lions who have appeared in all 22 games.

- Junior defenseman **Patrick Koudys** ranks fourth in the Big Ten with 45 blocked shots.

- Penn State, which earlier in the season ranked second in the NCAA with more than 20 penalty minutes per game, stayed out of the box for the first time in its then-45-game NCAA history vs. Michigan State Jan. 17.

- With a goal and an assist against Minnesota Monday, Jan. 13, sophomore forward **Curtis Loik** notched his first career multi-point game.

### McADAM SHINES VS. GOPHERS

- Penn State dropped both of its games to then-No. 17 Wisconsin in its first Big Ten series, falling 7-1 Friday, Dec. 6 before dropping a 4-3 game Dec. 7.

- In the finale, freshmen **Ricky DeRosa** (1g, 1a) and **Zach Saar** (1g, 1a) notched their first multi-point games.

- The Nittany Lions, who took a 1-0 following **Eric Scheid's** marker, twice erased one-goal deficits before allowing the game-winning goal with 8:08 left in the third.

### THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- In league action, each Big Ten team will play 20 league games, including 10 home contests.

- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a shootout win and one point for a shootout loss.

- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only BCS conference to sponsor men's hockey.

- The league tournament will take place at Saint Paul's Xcel Energy Center March 20-22 with the tournament champion earning the

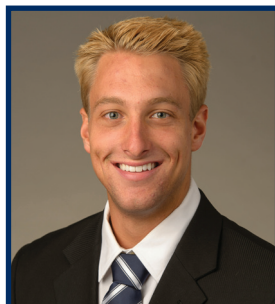
