KICKIN' IT

- No. 6 Penn State women's soccer prepares for the final match of its 2023 non-conference schedule, as the Nittany Lions host the Princeton Tigers in a 7:30 p.m. fixture on Jeffrey Field. Streaming is available to a worldwide audience of authenticated subscribers via B1G+.
- Penn State returns to action after securing a dominant 4-1 result over the Monmouth Hawks last Sunday, Sept. 3. Payton Linnehan led the way with a pair of assists on goals scored in the run of play, while four different Nittany Lions published a goal in the contest. Riley Gleason got credit for the match-winner in the fifth minute of play.
- PSU's dominance inside the friendly confines of Jeffrey Field continues, with the Blue & White boasting a 4-0-1 ledger at home after the result against Monmouth. The Nittany Lions have conceded just one goal in the 2023 season at home, coming in the final ten minutes against Monmouth. Penn State is unbeaten at home through its first five matches for the second year in a row.
- Penn State's defense remains one of the strongest units across all of Division I soccer, with the Blue & White surrendering just two total goals in six matches, with Penn State managing to outscore its opponent by a 16-2 margin in 2023. PSU boasts the second-most effective defense in the Big Ten Conference, allowing 0.33 goals per match.

PREPPING FOR PRINCETON

- Eighth-year head coach Sean Driscoll leads Princeton into Thursday night's contest boasting an undefeated record through four matches for the second time in three years. The Tigers rank sixth in the nation in shots per match with 22, and stand 14th nationally in points
 per match with 10. Sophomore striker Pietra Tordin has dominated for the Tigers through
 the early going, mustering seven goals with 16 total points so far in 2023.
- Princeton opened the season with a dominant 3-0 home victory over the Monmouth Hawks,
 Penn State's most recent opponent, and followed that effort with a 5-0 win over La Salle. The signature result of the season for the Tigers came in a scoreless draw with Rutgers on Aug. 31.

STORY OF THE SERIES

- A pair of storied programs in women's college socer history, the Nittany Lions and Tigers prepare to take the pitch for just the second time in school history. Penn State seized a victory over Princeton in the opening round of the 2002 NCAA Tournament on the road in College Park, Maryland.
- The Nittany Lions toppled the Tigers in a 2-0 match to open postseason competition and followed that performance with a 2-1 win over host-Maryland to advance to the tournament's third round. Penn State went on to appear in the Women's College Cup that season, ultimately falling to Portland in the National Semifinal by a 2-0 score.

UNBEATEN.

- The 2023 edition of Nittany Lion women's soccer joined elite company in Penn State history after earning its sixth unbeaten decision of the year, climbing to 5-O-1 overall after tallying a win over the Monmouth Hawks last week. PSU's 30th varsity squad becomes just the fourth Penn State team to open a season unbeaten through its first six contests all-time, joining the 1996, 1998 and 2005 teams.
- In Penn State program history, only the 2005 squad managed to complete the entirety of its non-conference slate without a loss, a feat the 2023 Nittany Lions will look to accomplish against Princeton. Penn State's 2005 roster went on to become the second Women's College Cup participant in program history and remains the only team in PSU annals to go a full season without a loss, publishing a 23-0-2 record.

MIEKE MAGIC

- Junior defender Mieke Schiemann accepted a pinpoint pass from senior+ forward Payton Linnehan and housed the match-winning goal in the 88th minute, propelling Penn State to a 1-0 win over the UCF Knights on Thursday, Aug. 31.
- With UCF forced to play shorthanded due to a red card issued to fifth-year midfielder Sanja Homann, Penn State was able to rack up dominant statistical advantages across the board. The Nittany Lions totaled 26 shots on the night, a season-high against Division I opposition, while registering a dozen shots on goal. The Knights tallied just four total shots with three on-target attempts by comparison. PSU also dominated the corner kick battle, 9-2, outpacing its opponent in the category for just the second time this year.

LONE STAR STATE OF MIND

- Redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean headed in her second match-winning goal of the week in the 77th minute, guiding PSU to a hard-fought 1-0 win over the No. 16 TCU Horned Frogs on Aug. 27.
- Penn State and TCU battled in a highly competitive environment Sunday afternoon, with the Nittany Lions logging a 12-8 advantage on the shot chart, while the Horned Frogs placed more shots on target, edging the Nittany Lions by a 5-4 margin. For the second straight match, Penn State tied its opponent in the corner kick battle, with both squads notching four corners apiece.
- Graduate goalkeeper Katherine Asman maintained her streak of dominance between the pipes, recording a five-save shutout in 90 minutes of work. Asman improved to 3-O-1 individually and notched her second complete-match clean sheet of the season.

COUNTRY ROADS, TAKE US HOME

- With the match nearing its end, redshirt junior midfielder Olivia Damico found MacBean, who buried a miraculous match-winning goal to guarantee Penn State's 2-1 win on the road over West Virginia, who was receiving votes in the United Soccer Coaches Poll at the time of the match.
- West Virginia took slim leads in the box score, winning the shot battle by a 10-8 margin while placing six shots on goal to PSU's four. The Nittany Lions and Mountaineers split the corner kick contest right down the middle, with each squad picking up a pair of corners in the match.
- A quartet of PSU athletes booked points on the evening, headlined by sophomore midfielder Olivia Borgen's first career goal in addition to MacBean's go-ahead score. Damico and senior+ midfielder Natalie Wilson were both credited with assists on the night, marking the second-straight scoring match for both PSU standouts.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- The Nittany Lions boast one of the most effective defensive units in the nation through the first six matches of the season, tied for the third spot in the Big Ten and 25th nationally in terms of goals-against average with a 0.333 mark.
- PSU's shutout percentage is tied for second in the Big Ten and ranks 21st in Division I, boasting a 0.667 mark overall. The Nittany Lions have shutout four opponents and have surrendered just one goal on Jeffrey Field, outscoring opponents by a 14-1 margin at home.
- Between the posts, Penn State goalkeepers have published a dominant season through the first six matches of the year, stopping 89.5% of opponent shots on target. PSU's save percentage is third in the Big Ten Conference and ranks 25th nationally.

AWARD-WINNING WORK

- Redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean became Penn State's first TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the week honoree in 2023, earning those accolades on Aug. 29.
 She recorded the most dominant single week of her collegiate career, scoring the match-winning goal that defeated West Virginia on the road on Thursday, Aug. 24 in addition to the match-winner over TCU on Sunday, Aug. 27.
- Penn State additionally saw a trio of student-athletes land weekly accolades on Aug. 22, as senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke and graduate goalkeeper Katherine Asman garnered Big Ten Player of the Week honors, while senior defender Ellie Wheeler was named to the TopDrawerSoccer Honorable Mention National Team of the Week.
- Dyke, Asman and Wheeler were instrumental in the Nittany Lions opening the program's 30th season undefeated through the first week of competition, just the 16th time PSU has accomplished that feat in school history. Both Dyke and Wheeler made their first career appearances on either a national or conference weekly award list, while Asman secured the fifth B1G Goalkeeper of the Week award in her career.

WEEZY BREEZY

- Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner continues her fifth year in Happy Valley and her fourth season of on-field competition in 2023. The Monrovia, California, native was dominant in her first full season as a routine starter a year ago, finishing with two goals, 11 assists and 15 total points in 2022. Wiesner put together a remarkable performance against West Virginia in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, logging a career-high three assists in PSU's eventual 4-0 rout.
- Wiesner ranked at the top of the Big Ten Conference in both total assists (11) and assists per match (0.48) last year. She finished ranked ninth in the nation in total assists and 22nd nationally in assists per match. She garnered Big Ten Player to Watch accolades following a preseason announcement from the league office on Aug. 15 and is already tied for second on PSU's assist leaderboard in 2023, dishing out a pair in the Nittany Lion win over West Chester.

PAYTON'S PLACES

- Senior+ forward Payton Linnehan continues her fifth year with the Blue & White and stands as the program's lead returning goal scorer from 2022. Linnehan participated in 19 matches a season ago, making 14 starts while amassing six goals scored and eight assists. The Douglas, Massachusetts, native set a career high for points scored in a single season with 20 and matched her single-season career high in assists with her eight dishes last year.
- Linnehan was chosen as one of three Penn State student-athletes as a Big Ten Player to
 Watch for the 2023 season, the league office announced on Aug. 15. The fifth-year Nittany
 Lion lived up to the billing in PSU's 8-0 rout of West Chester, booking a brace in just 31 minutes of live action. Last week, Linnehan booked the match-winning assist in the 88th minute on Schiemann's score against UCF and tallied two assists in the win over Monmouth.

ASTOUNDING ASMAN

- Graduate captain and goalkeeper Katherine Asman continues her final season in the Blue & White in 2023. Asman earned two Big Ten Goalkeeper of the Week honors, appeared on the Big Ten All-Tournament Team and garnered recognition as the Big Ten Tournament's Defensive MVP in 2022.
- Asman owns 70 appearances for PSU and has started in 69 of those matches. She
 currently ranks as the fifth-most experienced goalkeeper in Penn State history with
 6,053:30 minutes played and is tied for fifth in the Nittany Lion record book with 21
 career shutouts, notching her 21st against UCF.
- The Roswell, Georgia, native is off to a dominant start in the 2023 campaign, boasting six starts with a 0.20 goals-against average, one of just two Big Ten keepers to allow one goal or less between the posts after the first six matches of the season. Her exemplary start to the year landed her as a B1G Co-Goalkeeper of the Week in the conference's Aug. 22 release. Additionally, Asman stands as the best keeper in the league in terms of goals-against average.

CORI'S CORNER

- Senior+ midfielder and captain Cori Dyke is in the midst of her fifth and final season in Happy Valley coming off her most successful campaign with the NIttany Lions a year ago. The Littleton, Colorado, native appeared and earned the start in all 23 PSU matches, connecting on four goals with an assist to score nine total points in 2022.
- Dyke was named a Big Ten Player to Watch in 2023 in the conference office's preseason release. She had also been previously named to the Big Ten Women's Soccer All-Tournament Team in 2022 in addition to securing B1G All-Freshman Team and Top-DrawerSoccer Freshman Best XI First Team recognition during her 2019 season.
- In recognition of her efforts against UNC and WCU, Dyke was honored as the B1G Defensive Player of the Week in the B1G's most first announcement of the 2023 campaign on Aug. 22. She hauled in the first conference weekly honor of her accomplished collegiate career.

UNITED, WE RANKED

- Penn State debuted at the No. 10 position in the inaugural United Soccer Coaches poll of the 2023 season and climbed two spots to No. 8 nationally in the organization's release on Aug. 22. The Nittany Lions once again earned a two-place bump in the rankings on Aug. 29, matching its highest ranking from a season ago by earning the No. 6 selection and currently rank in that slot.
- The Blue & White stand as the highest-ranked team in the Big Ten Conference this week, leading a group of four programs that were either ranked or receiving votes. Returning NCAA Third Round participant Northwestern garnered the No. 20 position in the rankings, while Nebraska appeared at No. 24 and Iowa received votes. Penn State non-conference opponents North Carolina (3) and TCU (25) round out the five overall Nittany Lion challengers in and around the United Top-25.

WHAT 2 WATCH 4

In addition to Penn State's trio of Big Ten Players to Watch, the Nittany Lions also saw multiple student-athletes land recognition on a variety of preseason watch lists. Senior forward Rebecca Cooke led the way, garnering an appearance on the MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List in addition to garnering recognition as a United Soccer Coaches Forward to Watch. Cooke was also named the No. 19 preseason player in Division I by TopDrawerSoccer, who released their list of top-100 preseason players on Aug. 16. Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner also hauled in recognition from TopDrawerSoccer in the preseason, landing the national No. 86 ranking on the preseason top-100 players list.

2022 IN REVIEW

- Penn State finished the 2022 campaign with a 15-5-3 overall record paired with a 5-3-2 mark against Big Ten opposition. The Blue & White published four wins against nationally-ranked teams last year, highlighted by a 2-0 win at home over then-No. 4 Rutgers on Jeffrey Field. Penn State hauled in the program's ninth B1G Tournament Title and advanced to the third round of the NCAA Women's Soccer Tournament for the sixth consecutive season.
- Then-senior+ forward Ally Schlegel brought home First Team All-America honors from United Soccer Coaches, while three athletes overall were recognized as All-Region choices.
- In January, the Nittany Lions saw a pair of student-athletes chosen in the 2023 NWSL Draft, with Penelope Hocking taken seventh followed by Schlegel at the No. 23 spot. Both Nittany Lion alumnae were drafted by the Chicago Red Stars.

POWER OF THE PORTAL

Penn State welcomed a trio of transfer athletes out of the portal prior to the start of the 2023 campaign, with all three individuals immediately eligible to play for the Blue & White this season. PSU signed the nation's returning scoring leader in forward Rebecca Cooke from Quinnipiac, All-B1G Second Team midfielder Rowan Lapi out of Northwestern and defender Michela Agresti, a two-time team captain from Boston College. PSU's trio of transfers amassed a combined 160 starts in their collegiate careers prior to arriving at PSU, adding a variety of depth and experience to the Nittany Lion field position groups. The newest crop of Nittany Lions played a combined 13,862 minutes before arriving in Happy Valley.

RECRUITING ROUNDUP

- The 2023 Nittany Lion recruiting class ranked as the No. 9 squad in the nation according to TopDrawerSoccer, the organization announced on Monday, August 14. PSU welcomed a quintet of incoming freshmen student-athletes and bolstered its class with three Division I transfer performers.
 - Penn State features a trio of incoming freshmen who were ranked inside the national top-150 by TopDrawerSoccer, highlighted by the No. 10 recruit in the country in Worcester, Massachusetts, native forward Nicollette Kiorpes. PSU also welcomed the nation's No. 20 prospect in Bolingbrook, Illinois, native defender Keegan Schmeiser as well as No. 148-ranked defender Kaelyn Wolfe out of West Chester, Pennsylvania. The Nittany Lion recruiting class also featured Chesterfield, Ohio, native forward Frankee Flesher in addition to Downingtown, Pennsylvania, native defender Ava Rightmire.

THE B1G LEAGUES

- For the 21st year in a row, the Penn State women's soccer program was selected as the
 preseason favorite to win the Big Ten Conference regular season championship following a preseason poll of the league's coaches, the B1G announced on Tuesday, August 15.
- Northwestern took the No. 2 spot behind the Nittany Lions, with Rutgers and Michigan State rounding out the top four slots. Wisconsin, Nebraska, Ohio State and Michigan were selected as preseason favorites to complete the eight-team Big Ten Tournament field. Additionally, each school saw three players selected as Big Ten Players to Watch in 2023, with Cori Dyke, Payton Linnehan and Kate Wiesner earning the nods from PSU.
- Penn State has been selected as the preseason favorite by the Big Ten Conference's women's soccer coaches in every season since 2003. Since that inaugural selection in the early 2000s, the Nittany Lions have hauled in 15 Big Ten Regular Season Championships in addition to six Big Ten Tournament titles.

30 FOR 30

- The Penn State women's soccer program celebrates its 30th varsity season in the 2023 campaign. PSU began as a club team in the 1970s and blossomed, ultimately reaching varsity status for the first time in 1994, publishing a winning record in the squad's inaugural campaign. The following season in 1995, Penn State began its 28-year NCAA Tournament streak that survives to the present day while simultaneously managing a 29-year streak of overall winning seasons.
- Penn State has won 20 Big Ten Regular Season Championships, nine Big Ten Tournament Titles, participated in five NCAA Women's College Cups and took home the 2015 National Championship. The Blue & White have combined for 500 all-time victories, and look to build on that rich tradition in 2023.

UP NEXT

No. 6 Penn State women's soccer takes an eight-day hiatus from play before it opens Big Ten Conference play on Friday, Sept. 16 with a 6 p.m. fixture against the Maryland Terrapins. The match will conclude Penn State's five-match homestand that started against TCU on Aug. 27 and will also serve as the program's senior day celebration. PSU has alumnae on nine different franchises, including a program-best three former Nittany Lions with the Chicago Red Stars. The Penn State women's soccer program saw five program alumnae participate in the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup in Australia and New Zealand. Those five individuals represented five different national teams, signifying the diverse array of talent that the Penn State program attracts. Canada's Olivia Smith, Costa Rica's Raquel Rodriguez, Germany's Laura Freigang, Ireland's Marissa Sheva and American Alyssa Naeher rounded out the five Nittany Lions to appear on senior women's national teams at the event.

Five selections to the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup stands as a tie for the fourth most among all collegiate programs, and the most in the Big Ten Conference. The Nittany Lions have a long track record of preparing student-athletes for success on the international level, with Head Coach Erica Dambach having previously served as an assistant coach for the four-time World Cup Champion and reigning Olympic Bronze Medalist United States Women's National Team. Multiple program alumnae have made history at the event, including Alyssa Naeher's groundbreaking score in a Round of 16 PK shootout in 2023 that marked the first instance of a goalkeeper converting on a penalty kick attempt in ANY FIFA World Cup, men's or women's.

JEFFREY FIELD THE HOME OF THE NITTANY LIONS



Jeffrey Field, the home of Nittany Lion soccer, was dedicated on Sept. 29, 1972. Located in the heart of the Penn State athletic facilities complex with a picturesque view of Mount Nittany, the stadium was named in honor of the late Bill Jeffrey, legendary head coach of the soccer program from 1926-52. Jeffrey Field has been the host site for numerous NCAA and conference contests in men's and women's soccer. Games are frequently televised from Jeffrey Field, allowing a nationwide audience to view Penn State in action. Widely regarded as one of the finest grass surfaces in the country, Jeffrey Field was honored as the 2006 Collegiate Soccer Field of the Year by the SportsTurf Managers Association.

The leadership of Penn State women's soccer Head Coach Erica Dambach continues to produce incredible success season after season. While trophies, academic awards and international achievements line the walls as evidence of a championship program, her impact on Nittany Lion student-athletes stands as the truest testament to her teams' culture of excellence. Dambach enters her 17th season at the helm in University Park heading into the 2023 campaign, Penn State's 30th varsity season.

The numbers that document PSU's success are staggering. The Nittany Lions have accumulated 20 Big Ten championships, with 11 coming under Dambach's watch, in addition to five Big Ten Tournament crowns in the Dambach era.

A two-time National Coach of the Year and five-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Dambach has led her teams to 16 NCAA Tournaments, 11 Big Ten titles, five Big Ten Tournament titles and the 2015 NCAA National Championship.

In 21 years as a head coach and 17 seasons leading the Nittany Lions, Dambach has accumulated 303 career wins with a .707 winning percentage, one of the most dominant marks in all of college athletics.

PENN STATE WOMEN'S SOCCER ASSISTANT COACHES

ANN ROOK

Associate Head Coach William & Mary '97 17th Season



COACH BIO

Ann Cook enters her 17th season with the Nittany Lions in 2023. This will also be the 17th season that Cook will be coaching alongside former teammate and friend Erica Dambach. The two combined for numerous wins on the field together at William & Mary and have shown their prowess on the sidelines, as they led the Nittany Lions to the program's first NCAA title in 2015, two College Cup appearances, 11 Big Ten titles and 15 NCAA Tournament appearances.

As an associate head coach, Cook is the director of player development and is in charge of the Nittany Lion attack. Since she has been with the Blue & White, Penn State has had one of the most prolific attacks in the country. Since 2011, Penn State has scored over 500 goals, placing third in the nation over that period. Under the guidance of Cook, five Nittany Lions have scored 100 or more points over the span of their careers. Maya Hayes finished her Nittany Lion career with 163 points (71g, 21a), which ranks third-best in school history.

As Director of Player Development, Cook has mentored 17 players to NWSL draft selection, making Penn State one of the top producers of pro talent.

Throughout her time at Penn State, Cook has been involved in the organization Soccer Without Borders (SWB) and currently serves as a member of its advisory board. SWB's mission is to use soccer as a vehicle for positive change in the lives of under-served youth around the world and has project sites in the U.S. as well as in Africa and Central America. Cook's primary involvement has been with its project for girls in Granada, Nicaragua.

As an early assistant project director for SWB, she helped establish what is now a thriving year-round program there. Cook has accompanied Penn State student-athletes there on multiple occasions and she took the team to Nicaragua for spring break 2018 to run camps and clinics for girls as well as coaches' clinics.

WASSELL

Associate Head Coach Penn State Altoona '06 14th Season



COACH BIO

Promoted to associate head coach in July 2021, Tim Wassell has contributed greatly to Penn State's success as the program's recruiting coordinator while simultaneously directing the team's goalkeepers and defensive unit. He enters his 14th season with the Nittany Lions in 2023, the program's 30th year at the varsity level overall.

Wassell has attracted multiple nationally ranked recruiting classes to Happy Valley year after year with five top-5 classes since 2014 as ranked by Top Drawer Soccer, including the No. 1 recruiting class in 2019 and 2022. His reputation as one of the top recruiters in the sport, combined with the exceptional Penn State women's soccer experience, builds the aspirations of the program on those past successes. The Blue & White are fresh off signing yet another top-10 class under Wassell's direction, with the incoming 2023 corps ranked as the nation's No. 9 unit per Top Drawer.

Under Wassel's guidance, multiple goalkeepers have experienced high level of success on the collegiate, professional and international levels. Amanda Dennis became the most recent Nittany Lion goalkeeper to enter the NWSL and signed with the Houston Dash following her senior season in 2019, helping the organization capture the 2020 NWSL Challenge Cup title in her rookie campaign. For Rose Chandler, she was a member of the U.S. U-20 WNT that won the 2015 CONCACAF U-20 World Cup Qualifying Tournament and was on the U.S. U-20 WNT at the 2016 FIFA U-20 World Cup.

As an elite collegiate goalkeeper at Penn State Altoona, Wassell was a two-time NSCAA Mid-Atlantic Region selection in 2004 and 2005 and a two-time All-AMCC first-team pick as well. In both 2004 and 2005, Wassell led the AMCC in save percentage, shutouts and goals-against average (GAA), completing his two-year tenure between the pipes with a school-record 0.71 GAA. For his efforts as a player and coach, Wassell was inducted in the Penr State Altoona Athletics inaugural Hall of Fame class in October 2021.

DANIEL BAKER

Assistant Coach Indiana Wesleyan '22 First Season



Penn State women's soccer Head Coach Erica Dambach announced the promotion of volunteer assistant Daniel Baker to become the program's third full-time assistant coach for the upcoming 2023 season on Tuesday, July 25, 2023.

Baker was elevated to the program's third full-time assistant position joining Associate Head Coaches Ann Cook and Tim Wassell on Dambach's acclaimed staff. Baker joined the Nittany Lions as a volunteer assistant in February of 2023, alding in internal video recording and review during PSU's spring activities. He was instrumental in the preparation and execution of Penn State's spring practices while aiding in the program's ID and summer camps in University Park.

Before arriving in Happy Valley, Baker served as the Director of Player Analysis for the Xavier Musketeers women's soccer program over the course of the 2022 fall campaign. He assisted with video analytics, travel coordination opponent scouting and social outreach. Xavier published an unbeaten 2022 season in Big East Conference play with a 6–0-4 record, ultimately placing second in the league behind the Georgetown Hoyas. XU reached the 2022 NCAA Tournament with Baker on staff, winning its opening round test before falling to the Pittsburgh Panthers in the second round.

While a student at his alma mater, Indiana Weslevan, Baker assisted as a While a student at his alma mater, indiana Wesleyan, Baker assisted as a student coach for the university's women's soccer program. During his time with the Wildcats, Baker was responsible for developing and training the team's goalkeepers, including 2021 NAIA Honorable Mention All-American Hope Stacker. Baker also has experience as both a staff coach and soccer trainer with KingsHammer SC and X Factor Futbol, aiding young athletes in technical soccer development.

Kara Cook enters her 12th season with the Penn State women's soccer pro-gram in 2023, the program's 30th year at the varsity level. The 2023 cam-paign marks her ninth season in her current role as director of operations and performance leadership with the Blue & White. Cook served as the pro-gram's director of operations during her first three seasons at Penn State.

Cook has been in a coaching or mentoring role in collegiate athletics for over 20 years, and her primary role with the women's soccer team includes di-recting the team culture, leadership and player development programming.

Building a high-performance culture that can sustain success over time in a highly competitive environment takes a 360-degree approach. Establishing a culture that fosters growth and excellence begins with authenticity, vision, connection, ownership, and intentionality. Cook has built a unique approach to prioritizing team culture and periodizing effective leadership and player development programming throughout the year.

Since coming to Penn State 12 years ago, she has helped create an elite high-performance culture that has led to the highest team GPA at Penn State in program history, six Big Ten Regular Season Championships, four Big Ten Tournament Championships, nine NCAA Sweet 16s, five Elite 8s, two NCAA Women's College Cup berths and the 2015 NCAA National Champi-


