## UCF VS. PENN STATE - THE MATCHUP

### THE SERIES

• Penn State captured victories on its home field in 2002 and 2004, however UCF produced a 34-31 win at PSU last season.

• The Knights never trailed in 2013, with quarterback Blake Bortles going 20-for-27 with 288 yards and three touchdowns.

PSU's counterpart, Christian Hackenberg, went 21-for-28 with 262 yards and a touchdown.

• The 2004 meeting between the Knights and Nittany Lions was during George O'Leary's first year at UCF.

### SCOUTING THE PENN STATE NITTANY LIONS

• Closing out 2013 with a win at Wisconsin, Penn State went 7-5 overall and 4-4 in the Big Ten.

• Just a true freshman quarterback, Christian Hackenberg had a 58.9 completion percentage with 20 touchdowns and 10 interceptions a year ago. Top target Allen Robinson who had 40 percent of the team's receptions moved on to the NFL.

• Seniors Zach Zwinak and Bill Belton combined for 1,792 rushing yards and 17 touchdowns in 2013.

• The Nittany Lions lost DT DaQuan Jones (11.5 TFL), but return DE C.J. Olaniyan (11 TFL) and CB Jordan Lucas (13 break-ups, 3 INT, 16 passes defended).

## TEAM NOTES

### BAILE ÁTH CLIATH - WE'VE ARRIVED

- UCF's 2014 opener may be the most anticipated in school history, not only because the Knights are coming off an incredible 12-1 season, but they will be battling Penn State in the Croke Park Classic in Dublin Saturday, Aug. 30.
- This will be the 36th season of UCF football. The Knights are entering their 19th year at the FBS level.
- UCF is 23-12 overall in season-openers, and has won its last eight.
- The Knights are 6-3 all-time in the month of August.
- This will be the second NCAA game held at Croke Park (1996 - Notre Dame def. Navy).

### FAN EVENTS IN BAILE ÁTH CLIATH

- From week-long excursions to weekend trips, UCF fans will have a lot to do in Ireland. In Dublin, free events will include a UCF Pep Rally Friday at 4 p.m. at Meeting House Square, and a tailgate party Saturday at 10 a.m. at The Old Storehouse.

### WHEN IT BEGAN

- The Croke Park Classic was announced on July 14, 2013, with both athletic directors and UCF head coach George O'Leary in attendance at Croke Park before the GAA Leinster Football Finals.
- Members of the GAA would be at Beaver Stadium for last year's UCF-PSU meeting, as well as in Orlando for UCF's win over South Florida.

### WHAT THEY'RE PLAYING FOR

- The Croke Park Classic victor will receive the Dan Rooney Trophy, named after the chairman of the Pittsburgh Steelers and U.S. Ambassador to Ireland from 2009-12.
- The trophy is a replica football made of bog yew and Pittsburgh steel, with the yew coming from what remains of forests that grew 4,200 years ago and lie deep in the Irish midlands. The steel is left from the construction of the Steelers' Heinz Field.

- With nine in a row, UCF has the third-longest active winning streak in the FBS:

- In the preseason, he was selected as a candidate for this year's Doak Walker Award, which is handed out to the nation's premier running back.

#### Interview Policy

All UCF interviews must be coordinated through the UCF Athletics Communications Office. Please do not attempt to contact players, coaches or other team personnel directly by any means of communication, including personal phone numbers, email and social networking accounts.

#### In Orlando

Student-athlete interviews are permitted Aug. 24 and at Monday's press conference.

#### In Orlando - Head Coach George O'Leary

Head coach George O'Leary will be available for interviews during Monday's press conference at Bright House Networks Stadium. The press conference begins at approximately 1 p.m. and also includes a pair of players.

#### In Dublin

UCF will practice Wednesday and Thursday at the Carton House Hotel. Interviews will take place before each session. Coach O'Leary also will be available Friday at the Croke Park walk-thru.

#### Filming at Practice

In Dublin, TV station video and photo access will be available during individual drills at the beginning of practice up to period five (approximately 20-25 minutes). No filming is permitted during team work. Tripods are not permitted on the practice field at all times and media must stand at least five yards off the sideline. Media members must stay on the perimeter of the practice fields. At all times, videography at practice is at the discretion of the coaching staff and the UCF Office of Athletics Communications.

#### Postgame Interviews

Coach O'Leary and selected student-athletes will meet the media in the main press conference room on the press box side of Croke Park. UCF's locker room is closed to the media.

#### Credential Requests at UCF

All requests for media credentials and scouting passes for home and away games in the States should be directed to the UCF Athletics Communications Office at least one week in advance.

-Head Coach George O'Leary has witnessed 14 of his players at UCF be selected in the NFL Draft.

-Blake Bortles became the highest pick in UCF history when he was taken third overall (first quarterback) in the 2014 draft by Jacksonville.

-Former Knights have made 15 trips to the Super Bowl, resulting in 10 Super Bowl rings.
