- Penn State completes the season series with Rutgers, hosting the Scarlet Knights at 1 p.m. Saturday in the Bryce Jordan Center. The Nittany Lions won a 60-47 New Years Day matchup in Piscataway.
- The Lions are coming off a triple-overtime loss at Indiana, 110-102, Wednesday. It was the first 30T game for Penn State since 1982 and marked the first 100-point game in Big Ten play. Rutgers has lost each of its last three games and all five Big Ten road contests.
- Saturday marks the Fourth Annual Team Ream Day. The Team Ream Foundation assists local financially-disadvantaged individuals who have been affected by cancer and serious medical conditions. [MORE: Page 3]
- Penn State leads the Big Ten in forced turnovers. PSU opponents average 15.4 turnovers on the season.
- Four players are averaging in double figures for Penn State, led by junior captain Shep Garner (12.5 ppg) and freshman Tony Carr (12.0). Three freshmen are among the top five scorers and are each of top-three rebounders.
- Carr is the team's leading scorer in Big Ten action with 12.9 ppg after tallying 23 points vs. Indiana Wednesday. He added 14 assists, the tying for the second-most in a game in program history.

MEDIA INFORMATION

CHAMBERS AVAILABILITY

Coach Chambers will hold weekly press conferences and teleconferences during the season (schedule at right). All additional interview requests should be directed to Alissa Clendenen in the Strategic Communications office.

PLAYER INTERVIEWS

All player interviews must be arranged through Alissa Clendenen at least two days in advance. Players will generally be available on a weekly basis throughout the season, in conjunction with head coach Patrick Chambers' weekly press conference. Interviews will not be granted on game day prior to tip-off. Player phone numbers will not be released. Following games, requested Penn State players will be brought to the postgame media interview room. The Penn State locker room is closed.

CREDENTIALS

Single game and season press credentials are issued to accredited members of the working media only. Requests for credentials should be directed to Alissa Clendenen at least one week in advance of each game. Press credentials can be picked up at Media Will Call, which is located at the Media/Team entrance, on the south side of the Bryce Jordan Center.

PHOTOGRAPHERS

A photo pass must be issued to gain access courtside in the Bryce Jordan Center. Please contact Alissa Clendenen one week in advance for photo passes. Courtside photographers must follow NCAA guidelines, which prohibit entry to the bench areas and the stands, and must remain seated at all times.

RADIO NETWORKS

The Penn State Sports Network originates from the first row of Booth C23 in the press area. Visiting radio stations are located on the first row of Booth C22 in the press area. Visiting radio is provided one phone line and one ISDN line.

PRESS ROW SEATING

To access the press seating area, turn left out of the media room, walk down the hallway and take the elevator to the Concourse level. Please allow several minutes when taking the elevator to the press room or the media room. When leaving the elevator, turn right. The press area is at Portal 23.

SETTING THE SCENE

- Saturday is highlighted by the Fourth Annual Team Ream Day. The mission of the Team Ream Foundation is to assist the everyday lives of financially-disadvantaged individuals in State College and surrounding areas who have been affected by cancer and serious medical conditions.
- It was founded in memory of Brandon Ream, a former Penn State punter and avid PSU basketball supporter who passed away in November 2013 at the age of 29 after a two-year battle with cancer. For more information, visit teamream.org.
- The Nittany Lions earned four Big Ten wins in the month of January for the first time since 2008-09.

SCOUTING RUTGERS

- The Scarlet Knights have gone 1-8 since facing the Nittany Lions on New Years Day in Piscataway and sit at 12-11 on the season, 1-9 in the Big Ten. The lone league win to date came against Nebraska, 65-64, on Jan. 21.
- Rutgers is fourth nationally in rebounds per game (42.3), 15th in blocks (5.6), 18th in rebound margin (+7.2) and 22nd in field goal percentage defense (39.6).
- Three players are averaging in double figures for Rutgers, led by Corey Sanders' 12.4 points per game on the season and 14.7 ppg in Big Ten play.

SERIES HISTORY

- Penn State and Rutgers have met 70 times previously with the Lions holding a 40-30 advantage in the series. Penn State is 25-8 at home and leads the series 3-1 since Rutgers joined the Big Ten in 2014-15.
- The Lions have captured each of the last three meetings.
- The Scarlet Knights and Nittany Lions were both members of the Atlantic 10 Conference from 1976-79 and from 1982-1991. Penn State was 11-12 vs. Rutgers as an A10 conference foe.

CURRENT ROSTER VS. RUTGERS

PISCATAWAY, N.J. (Jan. 1, 2017) - Payton Banks had 20 points and Tony Carr had 15 points to lead Penn State past Rutgers 60-47 in a New Year's Day matinee.

Penn State (9-6, 1-1) struggled out for the gate. The Nittany Lions went 0 of 10 from the field before Carr made a 3-pointer with 12:51 left in the first half. From that 7-5 deficit, the Lions reached halftime with a 27-23 lead.

Penn State would lead by as many as 18 leading 47-29 11:57 to play. While Penn State would go on a seven minute stretch without a field goal midway through the half, the closest Rutgers was able to get was 49-38 with 5:26 to play. Mike Williams had 16 points for Rutgers (11-3, 0-1).

OTHER MEMORABLE MATCHUPS

Dec. 1, 2004 (PSU, 83-80): Then-freshman Geary Claxton scored 10 of his 17 points in the second half, including two decisive late-game foul shots, to give Penn State its third-consecutive win of the 2003-04 season. This was Penn State's last visit to the RAC.

Feb. 27, 1991 (RU, 92-70): Rutgers handed Penn State its largest loss of the season in the regular-season finale in Piscataway before the Nittany Lions went on a four-game winning streak through the Atlantic 10 tournament and the second round of the NCAA tournament.

March 21, 1990 (PSU, 58-55): In the National Invitational Tournament quarterfinal in Piscataway, Penn State rallied from a second-half deficit to defeat Rutgers for its first trip to the NIT semifinals.

LOOKING AHEAD

Penn State hosts No. 17/17 Maryland at 6 p.m. Tuesday before returning to the road for back-to-back games. The Nittany Lions close out the season with four of their final six games away from home.

Penn State has played the fifth-toughest league schedule of any conference team. The Nittany Lions' overall schedule is the 17th in the country, according to ESPN.

STARTER SHUFFLE

- Head coach **Patrick Chambers** has used five different starting lineup combinations this season with eight different players seeing at least one start.
- Freshmen **Tony Carr** and **Lamar Stevens** are the only players to start in all 23 games to date.

BIG START

- At 3-3, Penn State had its best Big Ten start under Patrick Chambers and overall since 2010-11.
- The Nittany Lions earned four Big Ten wins in the month of January for the first since 2008-09.
- The Nittany Lions used a 14-point comeback for its third league win vs. Minnesota (1/14). It was the third-biggest comeback under **Patrick Chambers** and largest since coming back from a 17-point deficit against Drexel (12/19/15). [MORE: Page 7]

TRIPLE THE OT

- Penn State's loss at Indiana was the first triple-overtime game for the Nittany Lions since 1982 and the only one in Big Ten play. It also set records for points scored in league play (102) and well as points allowed (110). [More: Page 7]
- Penn State's game at Indiana was just the fifth game in Division I this season to reach triple overtime and the first game between two Power 5 teams to reach three overtime periods.

DROPPING DIMES

- Freshman **Tony Carr** leads the team in assists (4.0 apg) with a season-high 14 in the loss at Indiana (2/1).
- The 14 assists are tied for the second-most in a game in program history and the most since 1973, standing as a freshman single-game record.
- Carr needs 22 assists to break the rookie record for season assists. He currently has 93 on the year with Ben Luber holding the record with 114 in the 2003-04 season.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

- Mike Watkins** and **Tony Carr** are the lone members of the squad with a double-double and have five and two on the season, respectively.
- They each produced one in the triple-overtime game vs. Indiana, marking the first time two players had a double-double in the same game since since Geary Claxton (11p, 11r) and Jamelle Cornley (22p, 11r) did so at Northwestern on Jan. 2, 2008.
- Watkins' five double-doubles are sixth in the league and were secured against Georgia Tech, Pitt, St. John's, Minnesota and Indiana. [MORE: Page 24].
- Carr produced his first vs. Morgan State (12/21) with 11 points, 10 rebounds and nearly earned a triple-double with eight assists. His second featured 23 points and 14 assists, marking the first PSU double-double with assists since Tim Frazier against Duquesne in the 2013-14 season.

KEEP THEM UNDER 70

- Penn State is 9-0 when keeping its opponents below 70 points. The opposition averages 62.1 points in the 12 games won by the Nittany Lions with a +12.5 PSU scoring margin.

UNDER 40 PERCENT

- The Nittany Lions are 7-0 this season when holding opponents under 40 percent shooting from the field.
- Penn State holds a 53-17 record under head coach Patrick Chambers when limiting opponents to a sub-40 percent FG%.
- Penn State limited Rutgers (1/1) to 28.6 percent shooting, the lowest field-goal percentage by a Big Ten opponent since March 6, 2014 when Northwestern shot 23.3 percent in Evanston.

MAN OF STEAL

- Josh Reaves** has the third-most steals in the Big Ten (42), despite only playing in 18 games. He leads the league with 2.3 per game, which also stands as 13th in the NCAA.
- Reaves is the only Big Ten player averaging more than 2.0 spg.
- He had a career-high five steals at St. John's in MSG (12/18) and again against vs. Minnesota (1/14).

MONEY IN THE BANKS

- Payton Banks** is in the Top 4 in the Big Ten in total 3-pointers (62), 3-point percentage (39.5) and 3-pointers per game (2.7).
- Over 70 percent of Banks' field goals this season (62-88) are from behind the arc.
- He has had four or more 3-pointers in seven games this season

TOPS IN TURNOVERS

- Penn State leads the Big Ten in forced turnovers. PSU opponents average 15.5 turnovers on the season and 15.1 since the start of Big Ten play.
- Penn State forces 1.4 more turnovers per game than the next squad's defense, Nebraska (14.1).
- The Nittany Lions are third in the Big Ten in turnover margin (+1.8)

MICHAEL SWAT-KINS

- Mike Watkins** has the second-most blocks (60) of any player in the Big Ten and the 12th-most of any Division I player (first among freshmen).
- He is second in the league and 16th (first among freshmen) in the NCAA with 2.6 blocks per game.
- Watkins is ranked eighth all-time in single-season blocks at the Penn State with 60. He is one of just three PSU players to tally 54 or more blocks in a season, joining Calvin Booth and John Amaechi.
- Penn State has now had at least one player with 50 or more blocks in each of the last four seasons, a feat not achieved by the program since Calvin Booth in 1996-99.

- Watkins had eight blocks vs. Wright State (12/3), which is tied for the sixth-most all-time by a Penn State player and are the most since 1999.
- He is one of just 13 Division I players to tally eight-plus blocks in a game this season, and the only player besides Calvin Booth to tally at least eight blocks in a game in Penn State history.

1,000-POINT CLUB

- With a made jumper at the 12:19 mark in the first half against Michigan State (1/7), **Shep Garner became the 33rd Penn State player all-time to eclipse 1,000 career points.**
- He now has 1,075 career points with a scoring average of 12.0 points per game over the last three seasons. He is ranked 25th all-time in Penn State career scoring. [Scoring chart: Page 6]

BOARD GAMES

- Penn State is 7-1 on the season when outrebounding its opponent.
- Penn State has a +3.6 rebound margin in 12 games won, compared to a -8.3 spread in games lost.
- **Mike Watkins** leads Penn State with 8.1 rebounds per game on the season and 7.7 in Big Ten play, seventh among all league players in conference games (second among freshmen). Watkins averages 9.2 rpg in games won.

SHARE THE LOVE

- Seven players have led the team in scoring at least once this season.
- After posting a career-high 22 points vs. Northwestern, **Josh Reaves** became the sixth player to tally 20 or more points this season.

- He shot 67 percent (6-9) from the field with three dunks, marking sixth game this season with three or more slam dunks. Watkins is among the league leaders in field-goal percentage, converting on nearly 58 percent of shots over the last five games.
- Watkins previously earned FOW honors after producing 15 points, 13 rebounds, four assists and three blocks in the Nittany Lions' win over St. John's (12/18) in Madison Square Garden.

DUNKS ON DUNKS ON DUNKS

- Penn State has 88 dunks through 23 games this season, passing last year's mark (58) after 17 games. The Lions are averaging 3.8 dunks per game with opponents throwing down just 1.6.
- Last season, Penn State did not have more than four dunks in a single game, averaging 1.8 per outing.
- The Lions have had five or more dunks in eight games, with a season-high eight against Morgan State and again at Indiana, and five or more in five league games.
- The Lions have had at least one dunk in all but one game.
- Comparatively, only one opponents have had more than four dunks vs. Penn State this season. Indiana posted five in the triple-overtime decision in Bloomington (2/1)
- Mike Watkins leads the way with 41 total dunks and an average of 1.8 per game. He has had a season-high four in two games, in wins over St. John's (12/18) and Illinois (1/28).
- Relatedly, the Nittany Lions average 8.7 fast-break points per game after producing just 4.0 points off the break last season. Opponents are scoring 6.5 points per game in transition this season.

PHILLY PRODUCTION IN PALESTRA

- In the win over Michigan State (1/7), Penn State's six Philadelphia natives showed out in front of the home crowd, providing 76 percent of the teams scoring. Three of the Philadelphians (Stevens, Carr and Moore) finished in double figures scoring.

HIGH(ER)-SCORING OFFENSE

- The Nittany Lions are averaging 68.5 points per game in Big Ten play, a mark that ranks sixth all-time among league scoring averages (at the end of the season) and the highest since 2000-01.
- Penn State averaged 75.2 ppg in non-conference play, compared to 67.3 prior to league play last season.
- Penn State posted 90-plus points in consecutive games (at St. John's, vs. Morgan State) for the first time since opening the 1995-96 season.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

- According to *KenPom*, Penn State is ranked No. 333 out of 351 Division I programs in terms of experience, with players averaging just 1.03 years.

- **Mike Watkins** and **Tony Carr** are the lone members of the squad with a double-double and have five and two on the season, respectively.
- **Tony Carr**, **Lamar Stevens** and **Mike Watkins** are second, fourth and fifth on the team in scoring. A rookie has led the team in scoring in 12 games this season.
- **Tony Carr** is leading the team in assists with 93/4.0 apg. He had 14 in the triple overtime loss at Indiana, the second-most in a game in PSU history and the most since 1973.
- **Mike Watkins** is one of just three players to producer 54 or more blocks in a season, joining John Amaechi and Calvin Booth. Watkins' 60 blocks are ranked seventh all-time.
- With eight blocks vs. Wright State (12/3), **Mike Watkins** had the most in a PSU game since 1999 and the tied for the sixth-most all-time. He is second in the Big Ten and is the top blocking freshman in DI (13th overall) with 2.6 per game.
- The freshmen are also making impressive showings on the boards. **Mike Watkins** (8.1 rpg), **Lamar Stevens** (5.6) and **Tony Carr** (4.8) are the team's top-three rebounders. Watkins' 15 rebounds against Minnesota (1/14) and Pitt (12/10) are the first multiple showings with 15+ boards by a PSU player since 2004-05.
- The freshmen trio of **Tony Carr**, **Lamar Stevens** and **Mike Watkins** accounted for 72 percent (58 points) of Penn State's total scoring in the Lions' 82-74 win over Duquesne Nov. 13.
- Against Duquesne (11/13), **Lamar Stevens** (24 points) and **Tony Carr** (20) became the first rookie duo since 1989 to produce 20 or more points apiece in a game. They did it again against Indiana (2/1).

SEASON NOTES

GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE

- The Nittany Lions have once again earned a Graduation Success Rate (GSR) of 100 percent, according to statistical information released by the NCAA in mid-November.
- The program had a 100 percent success rate for the fourth-consecutive year and is the only Big Ten men's basketball team with a perfect score in the 2016 NCAA Graduation Rates report.
- For the 12th-consecutive year, every year the GSR data has been released, PSU basketball earned four-year Graduation Success Rates at least three points higher than the national average for its sport. The men's basketball graduation figure was 24 points higher than the Division I average in the 2016 NCAA report and 20 points above the Big Ten sport average.

BACK IN BLACK (AND PINK)

- Penn State wore its black and pink throwback uniforms against Georgia Tech in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge Nov. 29. The uniforms honor the original school colors from 1887.
- The Lions are 4-0 in the unis since debuting them in 2014.
- The color pairing lasted just 2.5 years. Problems arose when the pink faded to white after several weeks of exposure to the sun.
- The students then opted for blue, rather than black, and white. The official announcement of the new choice was made on March 18, 1890.

SEASON OPENERS

With the loss to Albany Nov. 11, Penn State dropped its first season opener since 2004. It had won its last 11 season openers dating to 2005, including the previous five under Patrick Chambers. The Lions are 89-31 overall in season openers and 79-11 in home season openers.

EARLY-SEASON TOURNEYS

After the losses to Duke and Cincinnati, Penn State is 77-91 in early-season tournaments. The Lions have participated in at least one each season since 1981 and have captured 10 tourney championships, 12 second-place and 27 third-place finishes.

IN THE ACC/B1G CHALLENGE

After defeating Georgia Tech, 67-60, Nov. 29, Penn State has won each of its last three and seven of its last 10 Big Ten/ACC Challenge games and holds an 8-8 record in 15 challenge appearances. Big Ten men's basketball teams lost the Commissioner's Cup for the first time since 2008, falling to the ACC 8-5 in this year's challenge.

CHAMBERS TAKES ON YEAR SIX

The 2016-17 season marks the sixth year at the helm of the Nittany Lions for head coach Patrick Chambers. The Philly native is coming off one of his best coaching performances in University Park after leading the team to seven Big Ten wins, the most of his career, and 16 overall victories for the third year in a row. The Nittany Lions had not previously reached 16 wins in three-consecutive seasons since joining the Big Ten Conference.

#UNLOCKED

The Nittany Lions offered an unprecedented look into their program through a web series called #UNLOCKED, available through the team's social media accounts, as well as GoPSUsports.com / GoPSUnow (search men's basketball). In conjunction with WPSU, the videos feature never before seen access into the Nittany Lion players, coaches, staff and program.

SCORING THREATS

Penn State returns three of its top four scorers from a year ago: Shep Garner (14.8 ppg), Payton Banks (9.4 ppg) and Josh Reaves (6.4 ppg).

STARTER EXPERIENCE

Five of Penn State's returning letterwinners made at least one appearance in the starting lineup last season, including three who started more than 60 percent of the team's games: Shep Garner (32 starts), Payton Banks (31) and Josh Reaves (20).

TOUGH SLATE

Patrick Chambers and his staff have assembled one of the toughest non-conference slates in program history. The Nittany Lions will face Duke (11/19), Cincinnati or Rhode Island (11/20), George Washington (11/26), Georgia Tech (11/29), Pittsburgh (12/10) and St. John's (12/18).

PHILLY TOUGH

Six players hail from the Philadelphia area on this year's Penn State roster, including four from Roman Catholic High School. Freshmen Nazeer Bostick, Tony Carr and Lamar Stevens joined Shep Garner as PSU players from Roman. Mike Watkins (The Phelps School) and Julian Moore (Germantown Academy) round out the group.

ROMAN CATHOLIC x 4

The four players from Roman Catholic High School in Philadelphia - Shep Garner, Nazeer Bostick, Tony Carr and Lamar Stevens - are believed the only group of four players from the same high school on an active Division I men's basketball roster.

PALESTRA AS HOME COURT

Penn State is taking Big Ten basketball to the City of Brotherly Love, hosting Michigan State in a league matchup Saturday, Jan. 7, 2017 in Philadelphia's historic Palestra. It will count as a home game for the Nittany Lions, who boast six players from the Philly area on this year's roster, in addition to Chambers, a Delaware County native. The game sold out to the public in September.

OFFSEASON TRAINING

Penn State enlisted the SEAL Team Physical Training program for assistance in offseason workouts. The team was put through two days of physical and mental challenges designed to enhance physical and mental toughness. Check out the two-part video series on the workouts, as well as numerous other videos from the offseason on the team's Facebook page (/pennstatebasketball/videos).

NEW FACES

In addition to the members of the freshman recruiting class, the Nittany Lions welcomed rookie walk-on Grant Hazle from Houston, Texas this fall. Satchel Pierce, a 7-footer from Virginia Tech, transferred to Happy Valley in the offseason and will sit out the upcoming campaign. Terrence Samuel, a backup guard on UConn's 2014 National Championship team, is coming off his year of sitting out and will be primed for action in 2016-17, joining red-shirted freshman Mike Watkins, who was not eligible to compete last season.

NO SENIORS HERE

There is not a single senior on the Nittany Lions' 2016-17 roster. Juniors Shep Garner and Payton Banks are the veterans of the squad, along with UConn transfer Terrence Samuel. Virginia Tech transfer Satchel Pierce also is a junior and will have two years of eligibility remaining beginning next year. Ten of 14 players on the roster have freshman or sophomore year eligibility, including Pierce.

FREQUENT TRAVELERS

Head coach Patrick Chambers has not shied away from taking his squads away from home in the non-conference. The Lions have five road or neutral games before league play this year, following up six such contests a year ago.

Penn State's trips this season include stops in metro area hotbeds: New York (St. John's/MSG), Newark (Pitt/Prudential Center), Washington (GW/Smith Center), in addition to the Palestra stop to face Michigan State.

LIONS IN THE PROS

Tim Frazier signed a two-year, \$4.1-million contract with the NBA's New Orleans Pelicans in July following a stint with them late last season. He is Penn State's first NBA player since Calvin Booth finished a 10-year NBA career in 2009.

All four members of 2016 senior class are currently playing professionally overseas. Jordan Dickerson (Serbia), Devin Foster (Georgia), Donovan Jack (England) and Brandon Taylor (Greece) are all on teams to start the season. They join Nittany Lion legend D.J. Newbill (Belgium) and Sasa Borovnjak (Serbia) as PSU alums in Europe. All of Penn State's seven players currently playing pro earned their undergraduate degrees.

POSEY ENTERED NAISMITH HOF

Cumberland "Cum" Posey, Jr., recognized as the first African-American student-athlete in Penn State history, was inducted to the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame Friday in Springfield, Massachusetts this summer. Posey enrolled at Penn State in 1909 and played forward on the freshman basketball team (1909-10) and the varsity basketball team (1910-11), while also playing on the freshman baseball team (1910). Although he did not play in enough games to earn a varsity letter as a Nittany Lion, Posey's impact and influence at Penn State goes well beyond the bound of official records.

121ST SEASON PENN STATE BASKETBALL

The Nittany Lions embark on the 121st season of basketball at Penn State and their 26th as a member of the Big Ten in 2016-17. The Lions began play in 1897 with a pair of contests vs. Bucknell. Penn State has made 13 postseason appearances in the last 28 years (4 NCAA, 8 NIT, 1 CBI) and a total of 20 (9 NCAA, 10 NIT, 1 CBI) overall.

Over the last five-plus seasons, **PATRICK CHAMBERS** has reinvigorated Penn State basketball. Since being named the 12th head coach in program history June 6, 2011, the Philly native quickly energized his players and staff, as well as the Penn State fan base with his passion, enthusiasm and his team's all-out style of play.

The 2015-16 freshman class - the first Top 30 recruiting class in PSU history - clearly illustrates the progress Chambers and his staff have made during their time in Happy Valley. The future continues to be bright as Penn State will welcome a four-member consensus Top 15 class (at the time of signing) to begin their Nittany Lion careers in 2016-17.

Chambers has sent players into the professional ranks in each of the last two years with Tim Frazier (2010-14) spending time with the New Orleans Pelicans, Portland Trail Blazers and Philadelphia 76ers, and with D.J. Newbill (2013-15) playing professionally in Europe in Turkey. The 2014-15 senior class produced a Euroleague player (Newbill), a Kansas City Chiefs practice player (Ross Travis), a Ford engineer (Alan Wisniewski) and a Penn State graduate student in accounting with eight-consecutive semesters of a 4.0 GPA (Kevin Montminy), proving all venues of success are available.

Penn State has had 16 or more wins in a season six times since 2000-01, including each of the last three seasons under the direction of Chambers. The Nittany Lions had not previously reached 16 wins in three-consecutive seasons since joining the Big Ten Conference. These wins include five over Top 25-ranked teams in his tenure with two coming last season alone vs. Indiana and Iowa.

In both victory and defeat, however, the Philly native's teams are heralded for their work ethic, perseverance and relentless attitude.

During his time with the Nittany Lions, Chambers has guided five players to a combined seven All-Big Ten honors, including Tim Frazier's first-team nod in 2011 and most recently with Brandon Taylor's third-team selection in 2016. Frazier ended his career as the all-time leader in assists at Penn State — a record Chambers also holds to this date at his alma mater Philadelphia. When D.J. Newbill's PSU career ended, he was the fourth-ranked scorer in Nittany Lion history, after just three seasons, and Ross Travis has the third-most rebounds of any player to ever don the Blue and White.

To Penn State students, Chambers is known around campus for his infectious energy. He ordered up a pair of golf carts and began making spur-of-the-moment trips around the University Park campus distributing t-shirts. In his first few years, he visited amusement parks, pep rallies, student groups, and classes and threw out first pitches. Chambers even went as far as to go behind the counter to serve free Big Macs to students at State College's downtown McDonald's and donned a Penn State football jersey and helmet to fire up the famed "Nittanyville" student campout.

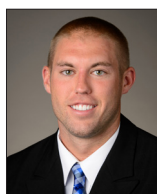
