THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

• This weekend marks the seventh and eighth meetings all time between Penn State and AIC and the first in six years. The all-time series sits in favor of the Nittany Lions at 4-2-0, however, a pair of overtime wins by AIC bookend the current series.

• AIC was Penn State's first-ever Division I opponent back on October 12, 2012, a 3-2 overtime victory for the Yellow Jackets at Greenberg Ice Pavilion. The following night in Wilkes-Barre, the Nittany Lions secured their first NCAA victory with an overtime win of their own, 4-3.

 While no current members of either team have competed against one another there is a unique connection between the two as Yellow Jacket senior forward Jordan Biro is the younger brother of former Nittany Lion captain Brandon Biro '20.

• Penn State is 47-15-2 all-time against Atlantic Hockey opponents averaging 4.36 goals per game in such contests.

• The Nittany Lions have won 20-straight non-conference games dating back to a 4-1 loss against Canisius over two years ago on October 8, 2021. That loss is the only setback against an Atlantic Hockey team in the last 23 contests.

• Penn State is 3-0-0 to begin the season for the second-straight year and the fourth time in the first 12 years of the program.

• Penn State is 7-3-1 all-time in home openers including a 7-2-1 mark at Pegula Ice Arena and have won twostraight and six of the last seven home openers.

• With an average age of 22 years 2 months, Penn State boasts the oldest team in the Big Ten. AIC is the sixth oldest team in its own conference, but the 14th oldest nationally with an average age of 22 years 9 months.

STREAKING START

• Junior Ryan Kirwan was named the B1G Third Star of the Week following a two-goal, three-point weekend in the North Country.

• Kirwan has scored a goal in each of the first three games of the season becoming just the third Nittany Lion in program history to start the season with goals in three or more games joining Andrew Sturtz '20 (2016-17) and Kevin Wall '23 who accomplished this feat twice, first in 2020-21 and against last season when he scored in four-straight games to begin the year, the current program standard.

 Kirwan's three goals are tied for second in the Big Ten and seventh in the nation while his five points place him tied for sixth in the conference and 17th nationally. His current three-game goal streak is also a new career-long.

 Junior classmate Danny Dzhaniyev is also riding a three-game point streak to open the season just one shy of his career-long. Dzhaniyev's four assists through three games pace the team and are tied for second in the Big Ten and ninth nationally.

ISN'T THAT SPECIAL

 The Nittany Lions will be the first to admit that their specialty units a season ago were not the strength of the team. With a full offseason and preseason of work, the new look special teams have opened the year strong.

• Penn State has scored a powerplay goal in each of its first three games posting a 3-for-13 clip (23.1 percent) to rank fourth in the Big Ten and 16th in the nation.

• Last season Penn State failed to have a three-game stretch when scoring at least one man-advantage goal in each game. This is the first such stretch in almost two years dating back to a three-game powerplay goal streak from 11/23/21 through 12/3/21.

• The Nittany Lion PK has also been solid allowing just a single powerplay tally by the opposition in nine chances (88.9 percent) to rank third in the Big Ten and tied for 18th nationally.

HE'S A SOUL-Y MAN

• Senior goaltender Liam Souliere is second in the Big Ten and 13th in the nation with a 1.67 goals-against average to open the season, however, he ranks fourth in the nation in save percentage among goaltenders who have played at least three games.

• Souliere's .924 save percentage is good for third in the Big Ten and 25th nationally.

• With his 4-1 victory at St. Lawrence last Saturday, Souliere became just the third Nittany Lion goaltender to reach 30 career wins as he now sits at 30-25-2 in 59 appearances.

GOOD BERGER

• Senior defenseman Christian Berger was voted the 10th captain in Penn State Hockey history earlier this month.

• Christian's brother, Chase Berger '19, also served as team captain for his senior season in 2018-19 and his oldest brother Jack, who Guy Gadowsky recruited to Princeton, served as team captain for two years with the Tigers following Gadowsky's departure to Penn State.

• Berger is Penn State's leading scorer returning in 2023-24 after finishing fifth on the team last year with 20 points on five goals and 15 assists, each career-high marks.

• Like his brother, Chase, Christian has yet to miss a game since stepping foot in Hockey Valley having played in 100 consecutive games. Chase played in 154-consecutive games an Iron Man streak that was surpassed last season by Paul DeNaples '23 who did not miss a game in his entire five-year Nittany Lion career playing in 172-straight.

SCOUTING AIC



• AIC is coming off an 18-14-7 season losing to Holy Cross in a best-of-three Atlantic Hockey Quarterfinal series to snap a streak of four-consecutive Atlantic Hockey Championships.

• The Yellow Jackets return most of its offensive firepower from a season ago with 10 of their top-12 scorers back on the roster in 2023-24, with the only exceptions being Blake Bennett who Paced AIC with 22 goals and 35 points last season and Nicholas Cardelli who ranked fourth on the team with 22 points, but was one four Jackets with double-digit goals finishing tied for second on the team with 11.

• AIC does return both Jordan Biro and Dustin Manz who added 11 and 10 goals, respectively, while producing 31 and 24 points.

• Alexandros Aslanidis returns between the pipes for the Yellow Jackets after making 13 starts a season ago posting an 8-3-1 record with a .923 save percentage and a 2.14 goals-against average, however, freshman Nils Wallstrom has started all three games for AIC so far this season posting an .831 save percentage and a 4.65 goals-against average.

• AIC is averaging just 1.67 goals per game in its first three games with five different goal scorers. On the defensive side the Yellow Jackets are allowing 5.33 goals per game including an 8-0 shutout in its last game against Quinnipiac.

• AIC has yet to convert with the man-advantage opening the year on an O-for-15 skid while allowing four powerplay goals of its own on 10 chances.

· Senior goaltender Liam Souliere had a breakthrough season as a junior in 2022-23 setting program records with a 2.43 goals-against average and three shutouts while ranking second all-time with 19 wins and third with a .917 save percentage. Souliere also set a single-game record with 55 saves in a 2-1 OT victory over Ohio State in the B1G Quarterfinals

 Entering the 2023-24 campaign Souliere ranks first alltime with a 2.72 career goals-against average while his .908 save percentage and 27 victories are good for second and third, respectively.

 Souliere has also logged over 3000 minutes played becoming just the third Nittany Lion goaltender in program history to hit that mark while his three shutouts are one shy of the program record.

OFFENSIVE OPPORTUNITY

 A year after returning each of its top-12 scorers, Penn State enters the 2023-24 season without the services of six of its top-12 scorers including each of its top-4 from last season leaving opportunity for new faces to step up offensively.

. The Nittany Lions lost 45 percent of its scoring from last season's NCAA Tournament team including 54 percent of their goal scoring (70 goals).

DIMINUTIVE DANNY

• Standing just 5 foot 4 inches tall, junior Danny Dzhaniyev has the distinction as shortest player in college hockey for the second consecutive season. Dzhaniyev, who wears No. 13, is a full 16 inches shorter than the last player to don No. 13 for the Blue & White, Nikita Pavlychev, who at 6 foot 8 inches tall spent many years as the tallest player in college hockey.

THE B1G GADOWSKY

• Now in his 12th season in Hockey Valley, head coach Guy Gadowsky is 197-168-25 behind the Penn State bench.

· Gadowsky secured career win No. 350 last season against St. Thomas and currently ranks 35th among Division I coaches all-time and 11th among active NCAA Division I coaches with 370 wins, one clear of Bemidii State bench boss Tom Serratore.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

 Senior Christian Berger was named the 10th captain in Penn State Hockey history following in his brother Chase Berger's '19 footsteps. Chase donned the 'C' during his senior year in 2018-19. Senior classmates Christian Sarlo and Xander Lamppa will serve as alternate captains this season.

2022-23 RECAP

• Penn State was an overtime goal away from its first-ever Frozen Four appearance finishing the season 22-16-1. the 22 victories last year marked the fifth time in the 11year history of the program and the first since 2019-20 that the Nittany Lions hit the 20-win mark.

• The Nittany Lions set an NCAA Tournament record in Allentown with an 8-0 shutout over Michigan Tech in the opening round, the largest shutout in tournament history.

• Kevin Wall paced the team with career-highs in each offensive category leading the team with 31 points and 17 goals earning Big Ten Honorable Mention accolades.

• Senior goaltender Liam Souliere had a breakthrough season as a junior in 2022-23 setting program records with a 2.43 goals-against average and three shutouts while rankingsecond all-time with 19 wins and third with a .917 save percentage. Souliere also set a single-game record with 55 saves in a 2-1 OT victory over Ohio State in the B1G Quarterfinals.

• Senior Christian Berger is Penn State's leading scorer returning in 2023-24 after finishing fifth on the team last year with 20 points on five goals and 15 assists, each career-high marks. Berger was named to the 2023 Allentown Regional All-Tournament Team.

PACKING THE PEG

• Penn State once again played in front of the highest capacity crowds in the nation in 2022-23 with a 106.4 percent capacity. Pegula Ice Arena was sold out for 17 of the 20 regular season home games last year and has been filled for 170 of its 189 games hosted all-time, excluding the 2020-21 season when fans were prohibited from attending games due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

• Penn State had a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season sell-outs from March 14, 2014 through November 22, 2019.

• More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 117 occasions including 15 games in 2022-23. Seven games in 2022-23 cracked the top-10 all-time for attendance including the current topthree.

• The attendance record for Pegula lce Arena occured against Notre Dame on January 21, 2023 where a crowd of 6,566 fans attended breaking the record set the previous night when 6,558 fans entered the building.

• Penn State celebrated its 1,000,000th fan at Pegula Ice Arena on January 20, 2023 against Notre Dame.

• Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula lce Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its 11th season entering 2023-24. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.

• The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. Continuing in 2022-23, regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 24th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his 12th at Penn State in 2023-24.

AT PENN STATE

This past season, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to their third NCAA Tournament appearance over the past six that have been played (The 2020 postseason was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic with Penn State sitting No. 7 in the Pair-Wise). Penn State advanced to the Allentown Regional Final following an 8-0 victory over Michigan Tech, the largest shutout in NCAA Tournament history. The Nittany Lions finished the year 22-16-1 registering the second-most wins in a single-season in program history and it was also the fifth

20+-win season over the past eight years for Penn State under Gadowsky.

Led by goaltender Liam Souliere, Penn State improved drastically on the defensive side of the puck lowering its goals-against average by nearly a half goal per game from the 2021-22 campaign. Souliere had one of the best seasons in program history between the pipes as his 2.43 goalsagainst average set a new Penn State single-season record while his 19 wins are the second-most all time and his .917 save percentage is the third best mark.

Penn State climbed to as high as No. 5 during the 2022-23 season and became the first team in NCAA history to defeat separate No. 1 ranked teams in back-toback weeks when they defeated No. 1 Michigan and No. 1 Minnesota on consecutive weekends in November. The Nittany Lions finished the year with a No. 8 final ranking in both national polls to tie their highest finish all-time.

In 2021-22, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions back to the Big Ten semifinals for the seventh-straight season and the eighth time overall in the nine-year history of the conference. Both marks tie for the most all-time.

Penn State became the first road team in league history to win a best-of-three quarterfinal series defeating No. 12 Ohio State in back-to-back games after starting in a one-game hole following an opening game loss.

Throughout the 2021-22 season, Penn State had marquee wins against No. 6 North Dakota in the first-ever meeting between the two schools. The Nittany Lions defeated the Fighting Hawks, 6-4, in front of a sold-out crowd at Bridgestone Arena in Nashville, Tennessee during the 2021 US Hockey Hall of Fame Game. The Nittany Lions also defeated No. 7 Minnesota on the road for just the sixth time in program history. Gadowsky also saw former captain Brandon Biro '20 make his NHL debut as he suited up for the Buffalo Sabres back in February becoming the third former Nittany Lion to lace 'em up in the show.

In a season unlike any other in 2020-21, Gadowsky led Penn State back to the Big Ten semifinals for the sixth consecutive season and the seventh time overall as he became the winningest coach in the history of the tournament after securing his 11th victory in B1G tournament play.

The Bench Boss registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State.

Penn State captain Alex Limoges went on to sign an AHL contract with the San Diego Gulls and in just 23 games scored 11 goals while adding 10 assists for 21 points.

Following the season Aarne Talvitie inked his entry-level, NHL contract with the New Jersey Devils while earlier in the season former Nittany Lion Peyton Jones also put pen to paper on an NHL contract giving Penn State six NHL signees in the past two seasons and 10 overall.

Near the conclusion of the 2020-21 NHL season former Penn State forward Brett Murray (2017-18) made his NHL debut with the Buffalo Sabres becoming the second Nittany Lions to skate in an NHL contest.

Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship during the 2019-20 season with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.

Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-



win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October against Sacred Heart.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucese landed on the Second-Team West while also being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucese took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their

second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin

in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning record in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a twoyear contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn State faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, and capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.




