PENN STATE HOCKEY

THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

- This week marks 31st and 32nd meetings in the all-time series with Penn State holding the 15-11-4 edge while the Spartans hold the slim 8-7-1 mark at Munn Ice Arena.
- Following a two-year stretch from 2015-2017 where Penn State didn't lose to the Spartans (7-0-1), MSU has evened the series a bit over the past three seasons with Penn State holding the slim 6-5-1 advantage. The two teams have split the season series the last two seasons following a three-year stretch where the Nittany Lions won the season series.
- Only six current Nittany Lions have goals against Michigan State in their careers with only three players having multiple career goals against the Spartans. Senior Sam Sternschein leads all current Nittany Lions with four goals and three assists for seven points in 11 games. Classmate Alex Limoges has added two goals and four assists for six points in 12 career games against MSU.
- In the first game back from holiday break Penn State is just 4-4-0 all-time but have won three-straight. The Nittany Lions are 5-7-2 in their first B1G series after break over the past seven seasons.

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

- For the first time in program history, Penn State secured the Big Ten regular-season championship in 2019-20 and No. 1 overall seed entering the conference tournament. Penn State's 12 victories and 41 points in conference play last season were both program highs.

FULLY CHARGED

- After going just 1-for-16 on the powerplay over the first five games of the season, including an 0-for-12 start, Penn State has regained its man-advantage swagger having scored at least one powerplay goal in three-straight contests going 6-for-11 in the process including a 4-for-6 mark against Michigan on December 3.
- Following the hot stretch the Nittany Lion powerplay currently stands at 25.9 percent (7-for-27) and has jumped from near the bottom nationally to 14th out of the 49 teams who have played games so far this season. Even with such a strong stretch with the man-advantage, Penn State still only ranks fourth out of the seven Big Ten teams.
- Senior Alex Limoges has tallied a man-advantage goal in three-straight contests moving into a tie with Nikita Pavlychev '20 for second on the Penn State all-time powerplay goal list just one shy of four different Nittany Lions who share the record at 13.
- Limoges' three powerplay goals this season lead the Big Ten and are tied for third nationally while his five powerplay points are tied for second in the conference and ninth in the nation.
- For all the recent powerplay success, the penalty kill continues to struggle ranking last in the Big Ten and tied for 43rd nationally at just 70.8 percent (17-for-24). The Nittany Lions have allowed at least one man-advantage goal in six of their eight games played this season, granted the first six games of the season were against the teams with the seventh (Minnesota) and tied for eighth (Michigan and Wisconsin) best PP units in the country.

FREE HOCKEY!

- In its last series before semester break against Arizona State, Penn State won back-to-back overtime contests for just the second time in program history and first since the 2017 Big Ten Tournament semifinal and final that each went to double-overtime.
- It was just the seventh time in program history that Penn State has played in back-to-back overtime games and just the third time both games of a series have gone into an extra session and first time in four years. It also marked the first time ever PSU has won two overtime games in the same series.
- The Nittany Lions' first-ever NCAA Division I series against AIC in 2012 saw both games decided in overtime with Penn State splitting the series with the Yellow Jackets while a 2016 non-conference series in South Bend also needed extra time in both games with the Nittany Lions tying the opening game before winning the series finale against the Irish on an Andrew Sturtz '20 goal.

- Penn State is now 17-9-22 all-time in overtime contests including a perfect 3-0-4 during the 2015-16 season. The Nittany Lions are also now 3-1-2 in three-on-three overtime games with three-straight victories. The Nittany Lions are just 4-8 in games that advance all the way to a shootout.

B1G AL

- Limoges leads all active Big Ten players in points with 112 for his career to rank third nationally. His 46 career goals are also the most among active players in the Big Ten and rank second nationally.
- After a slow start against Minnesota in the season opening series, Limoges has registered at least one point in five of the last six games including four multi-point efforts and is currently riding a three-game goal/point streak.

- During this hot streak, Limoges has slowly moved up the PSU record books and now ranks sixth on the all-time points and goals lists and fifth on the all-time assists list.

MAC ATTACK

- Sophomore classmates Connor MacEachern and Connor McMenemy each scored the overtime game winning goals against Arizona State in Penn State's final games before the holiday break.
- The goals were mirror images of each other during the 3-on-3 overtime frame as both right-handed shot forwards skated into the offensive zone, down the left wing and ripped absolute lasers short side over the blocker of Sun Devil net-minder Evan DeBrouwer and then celebrated near the Nittany Lion bench.
- For MacEachern he is currently riding a career-best three-game point-streak with each game being a multi-point effort, the first three of his career. The sophomore is now tied for third on the team with six points this season while leading Penn State with five assists.
- McMenemy has now scored two goals while adding two assists for four points this season and has registered four game-winning goals in his last 23 games played including a pair of overtime winners.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE



- The Spartans were inconsistent in their first eight games of the season starting 2-0-1 then losing three-straight before closing the first half by taking four-of-six points at Notre Dame with a shootout loss and an overtime victory.
- Michigan State lost four of its top six scorers from last season including leading scorer Patrick Khodorenko, however, they do return Mitchell Lewandowski who ranks second among active players in the Big Ten in career points (93) and goals (45) only behind Alex Limoges in both categories.
- The Spartans are led by Bemidji State graduate transfer Charlie Combs with six points so far this season on a team high three goals and three assists. Sophomore Josh Nodler leads the team with six assists while Lewandowski has added a pair of goals and three assists for five points.
- Drew DeRidder has been the lone goaltender to see action for the Spartans so far this season following the graduation of John Lethemon. DeRidder ranks second in the Big Ten and ninth nationally with a .940 save percentage this season and is also second in the Big Ten among goalies with multiple starts with a 1.96 goals-against average.
- MSU has struggled with the man-advantage so far this season converting just two of 25 chances (8 percent) and have gone 0-for-10 in its last four games.
- The Spartan penalty kill has fared much better ranking second in the Big Ten and 12th nationally at 84.8 percent (28-for-33).
- Michigan State is just 1-2-1 at home this season after going 7-8-1 at Munn Ice Arena last season.





SOUL-Y MAN

• Freshman Liam Souliere secured his first collegiate victory in the 5-4 overtime victory against Arizona State to close out the first semester of play.

• After allowing four first period goals, the freshman shut down the Sun Devils over the final 47:23 making 29-straight stops en route to a career-best 36 saves.

• Souliere also picked up his first career apple with the only assist on McMenamin's overtime game-winner. He is now the fourth Nittany Lion net-minder to register a point.

COMEBACK KIDS

• The Nittany Lions got in a hole early against Arizona State in its last game before the holiday break as the Sun Devils scored three goals on three shots in a 69 second span early in the first period.

• The Nittany Lions never hung their heads coming all the way back to tie the contest just 4:21 into the second period and Penn State eventually won the game in overtime 5-4.

• The three-goal comeback victory ties the largest comeback in program history and it was the first time Penn State has comeback from a three-goal deficit since January 23, 2015 against Northern Michigan.

NINE TIMES!

• Penn State had scored just 10 goals in its first five games of the season entering before erupting for nine goals in a 9-5 victory over No. 7 Michigan on December 3.

• The nine goals tie the third most in a single-game in program history and tie the most-ever scored against a conference opponent. Penn State defeated No. 5 Notre Dame 9-1 nearly two years to the day on December 8, 2018.

• The Nittany Lions have now scored seven or more goals 24 times, including 16 times in the past three-plus seasons, and are a perfect 24-0-0 when doing so.

• Penn State has now hit its magic number of five goals twice in its last three games after going 11-0-0 last year when doing so. The Nittany Lions are now 79-1-2 all-time when scoring five or more goals with the lone loss coming during the 2018-19 season at Wisconsin.

SATURDAY NIGHT'S ALRIGHT FOR... NOTHING

• With a Sunday-Monday series lined up this week Penn State continues to avoid Saturday, having played at least one game on every other day of the week so far this season. The Nittany Lions will play their first Saturday game next week in Columbus.

• Historically Saturday has been the most successful day for Penn State. Over the past four seasons the Nittany Lions are 38-21-6 in games played on Saturday including a 10-4-1 record last season (6-1-1 in the second half).

• Over the past four seasons, Penn State has won the Big Ten Tournament on a Saturday, won it's first-ever NCAA Tournament game on a Saturday and last season came-from-behind to defeat Minnesota, 3-2 on a Saturday in a game that became a defacto Big Ten regular-season championship game.

BREAK THE WALL DOWN

- Sophomore Kevin Wall had just seven points on a pair of goals and five assists in 26 games last season but he has already bettered his 2019-20 goal output and equalled his point output in the first eight games of 2020-21 registering three goals and four assists for seven points.

- Wall is second on the team with his three goals and seven assists and has registered at least one point in six of eight games so far this season.



NEXT UP



- Penn State remains on the road as they face the Ohio State Buckeyes on Friday and Saturday as they open the second-half of the season much like the first with four-straight road games in a one-week span.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Penn State is 83-43-14 all-time at Pegula Ice Arena including an 11-5-3 record last season and a program-best 15 home victories during the 2018-19 season.

ETCHED INTO THE RECORD BOOKS

- Penn State will look a little different when they hit the ice this season after graduating the largest senior class in program history and arguably one of the most decorated throughout the nation as well as having two juniors leave early after signing entry-level NHL contracts.

- The 2020 senior class accounted for 85 victories over their four years, just one shy of the most-ever by a single class, a distinction held by the class of 2019 with 86 wins.

- The group consisted of four of the top-10 scorers in program history led by Penn State's all-time leading scorer, Nate Sucese with 140 points and followed by Brandon Biro (116), Denis Smirnov (115) and Liam Folkes (103) in fourth, fifth and seventh, respectively. The group also featured Peyton Jones, the most decorated goalie in program history who holds nearly every single goaltending record Penn State.

- The 2020 senior class played in a total 1,142 games scoring 634 points on 258 goals and 376 assists and had four 100-point scorers.

- The Nittany Lions are also without the services of Evan Barratt and Cole Hults after the pair inked entry-level NHL contracts with the Chicago Blackhawks and the Los Angeles Kings back in April.

- Barratt ranked ninth on the all-time points list and tenth on the goals list at Penn State with 95 and 39, respectively, while Hults held nearly every single record for defensemen at Penn State and led the entire Big Ten with a plus-23 rating last season.

THE GREAT GADOWSKY

• Head Coach Guy Gadowsky was named a finalist for Big Ten Coach of the Year last season after leading the Nittany Lions to their first-ever B1G regular-season title. The Bench Boss secured the seventh 20-win season of his collegiate coaching career and his fourth with the Nittany Lions with a 3-2 victory over Minnesota to close out the regular season.

• The 2014-15 Big Ten Coach of the Year registered his 300th career victory earlier this year and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 321 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 45th with his 321 wins and is currently 13th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

• Senior Alex Limoges was selected by his peers as the eighth captain in program history for the 2020-21 season. Junior classmates Paul DeNaples and Aarne Talvitie will serve as alternates.

LIMOGES PENN STATE'S LONE PRESEASON ALL-B1G HONOREE

• Senior Alex Limoges was Penn State's lone representative on the preseason All-Big Ten teams earning his second-straight first team nod. Limoges was an honorable mention at the conclusion of the 2019-20 season.

• Limoges leads all active Big Ten players in points with 103 for his career to rank fifth nationally. His 41 career goals are the second-most among active players in the Big Ten entering the season also good for fifth nationally.

• Limoges became the eighth Nittany Lion in program history to reach the 100-point mark for his career last season and is currently tied for seventh on the Penn State all-time points list just 37 shy of Nate Sucece '20. The senior's 41 goals are the eighth most all-time at Penn State.

PACKING THE PEG

• Penn State has played to a sellout crowd in 126-of-135 home games, which included a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season games that was snapped earlier this season.

• More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 86 occasions including 10 games in 2019-20 while five of the final six home crowds last season rank in the top-10 all-time in the building including a record crowd of 6,475 in the last home game against Notre Dame on February 1, 2020.

• Last season, Penn State ranked fifth in average attendance (5,990) and first in the nation in building capacity percentage (103.6 percent).

• Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its eighth season entering 2020-21. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.

• The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. New for the 2020-21 season is that regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 5 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

• Arizona State will play each Big Ten team four times all on the road giving each team 28 regular season contests. ASU is not eligible for conference awards or the Big Ten Tournament.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 21st collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his ninth at Penn State in the 2020-21 campaign

AT PENN STATE

This past year, Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the 2019-20 Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.



Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October and currently ranks tied for 78th all-time throughout all divisions with 318 victories. Among Division I coaches all-time, Gadowsky ranks 45th with his 318 wins and is currently 13th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucece landed on the Second-Team West while also being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucece took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten

wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice

for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with



the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning re-

cord in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn State faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, and capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to double-digit wins (13-14-0) during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13, with several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells

Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA in 2011-12, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

Before arriving in Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Gadowsky took a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and guided it to both the ECAC Hockey Tournament and Ivy League crowns in 2007-08. The team earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1998, and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalemba (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

AT ALASKA

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he took a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign and garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. A three-time WCHA All-Academic team member, he collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, the Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

PERSONAL LIFE

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.

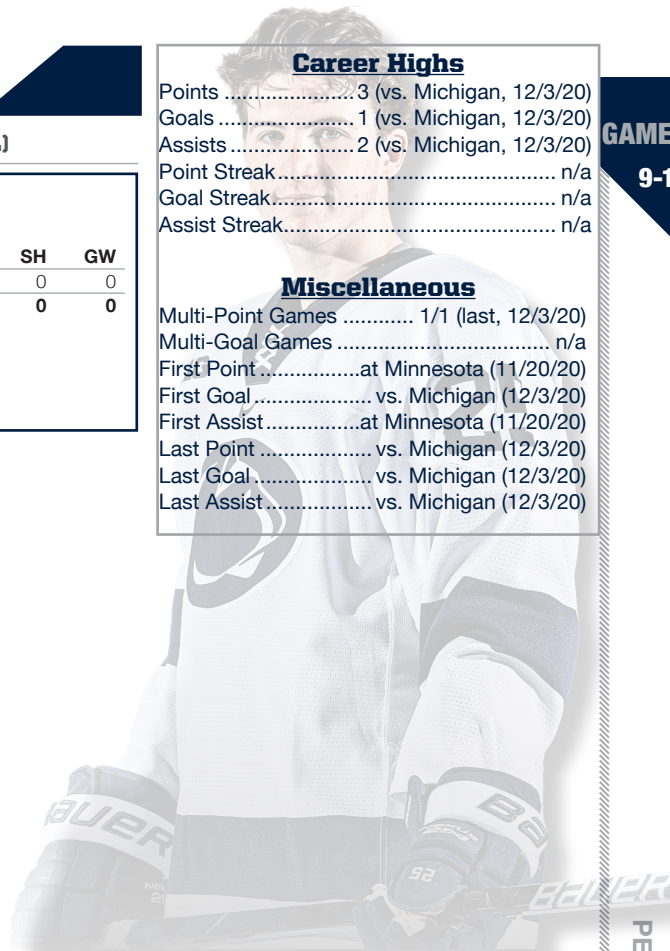

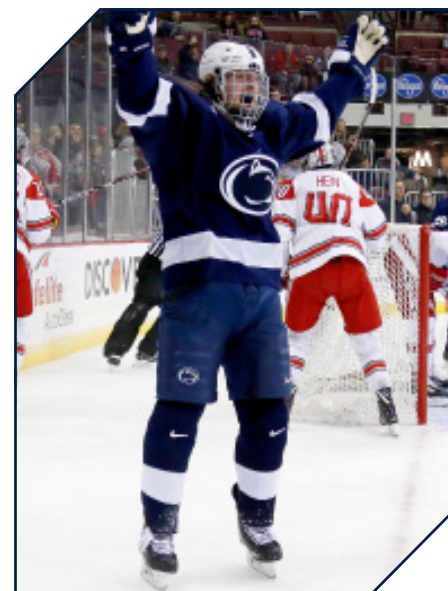
