UNBEATEN.

The 30th varsity team in Penn State women's soccer history etched its name in the Nittany Lion record book following its final non-conference win over Princeton, becoming just the second squad in program annals to go undefeated through the non-league portion of its regular season schedule. PSU last accomplished that feat in 2005, a team that went on to publish a 23-0-2 record, book a perfect 10-0-0 ledger in Big Ten play while reaching the Women's College Cup for the third time in school history. PSU secured its ninth-straight win after the victory over Nebraska, continuing the Blue & White's longest overall win streak since the Nittany Lions hauled in 11 straight back in the 2019 campaign. Penn State's unblemished start to B1G action marks the Nittany Lions' first 3-0 opening in a conference campaign since 2017 and the 14th instance of a 2-0 league start all-time.

LAST TIME OUT: NEBRASKA

No. 4 Penn State coupled a dominant defensive outing with a late set piece score from senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke, culminating in a 1-0 victory Sunday afternoon over the Nebraska Cornhuskers. The Cornhuskers and Nittany Lions played a relatively even match across the board, with both teams having to fight through intense defensive pressure to generate offensive opportunities. Nebraska finished the afternoon's contest with a slim lead on the shot chart, outpacing the Blue & White by a narrow 16-13 edge overall and a 5-3 margin in terms of shots on goal. The Huskers also took home a narrow edge in the corner kick battle, leading the category by a 5-4 tally. Sunday's result saw the Nittany Lions pick up a win while losing the corner kick contest for the first time in 2023.

BALLIN' WITH BALANCE

- Penn State women's soccer boasts one of the most balanced attacks in the nation, with 16 different student-athletes logging at least one point through the first 10 matches of the season. In total, 26 members of the Nittany Lions' 30-woman roster have appeared in at least one match, with 14 earning starts.
- On the offensive end, 13 different Nittany Lions have amassed a total of 26 goals on the season, the second-highest goals per match mark in the Big Ten Conference (2.60). PSU's balanced offensive front has allowed eight student-athletes to score at least twice, with sophomore midfielder Olivia Borgen leading the team with four. Nine different Penn State performers have found their way onto the assist leaderboard at PSU
- this year, with Eva Alonso and Kate Wiesner leading the way with six and four, respectively.

GETTING DEFENSIVE

- The Nittany Lions boast one of the most effective defensive units in the nation through the first 10 matches of the season, tied for the league lead in the Big Ten and fourth nationally in terms of goals-against average with a 0.300 mark.
- PSU's shutout percentage is tied for first in the Big Ten and ranks seventh in Division I, boasting a 0.700 mark overall. The Nittany Lions have shutout seven opponents and have surrendered just one goal on Jeffrey Field, outscoring challengers by a 22-1 margin at home. Between the posts, Penn State goalkeepers have published a dominant season
- through the first 10 matches of the year, stopping 90.6% of opponent shots on target. PSU's save percentage is tied for first in the Big Ten and ranks fifth nationally.

EVA'S EMERGENCE

- Senior defender Eva Alonso's return to Penn State's starting XI in the 2023 season has coincided with the team's resurgence to the top of the national conversation. The Madrid, Spain, native has started in all 10 Nittany Lion contests this year and has already surpassed her total minutes played from the 2022 campaign.
- Alonso notched the 15th instance of a Nittany Lion passing for three assists all-time in Penn State's rout of Maryland and became the first to accomplish that feat since Kate Wiesner did so in the second round of last year's NCAA Tournament.
- The senior owns six total assists, tied for the third-most in the conference and 16th nationally, while notching 0.60 assists per match, also tied for the third-best mark in the B1G.
- Alonso became the program's fourth individual to land TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week honors in 2023. Alonso's accolade on Sept. 19 marked her second career TDS recognition, joining a prior appearance on May 4 during the COVID-altered spring 2021 season.

AWARD-WINNING WORK

Senior defender Eva Alonso became Penn State's most recent TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week honoree on Tuesday, Sept. 19, following her three-assist performance against the Maryland Terrapins to open Big Ten Conference play. Redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean picked up her first career national or conference weekly honors from TDS on Aug. 29, booking a pair of match-winning goals in the same week against West Virginia and then-No. 16 TCU.

Junior defender Mieke Schiemann landed Penn State's second National Team of the Week distinction on Sept. 12 after booking a brace against Princeton in Penn State's eventual 3-0 decision that concluded the non-conference calendar.

 Senior defender Ellie Wheeler and senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke have both hauled in TopDrawerSoccer Honorable Mention National Team of the Week accolades this season, earning those honors on Aug. 22 and Sept. 26, respectively.

Penn State has hauled in a trio of Big Ten weekly accolades through this point in the 2023 campaign, all three Nittany Lion captains earning laurels from the league office. In the B1G's first release on Aug. 22, Dyke, as well as graduate goalkeeper Katherine Asman brought home Defensive Player of the Week and Co-Goalkeeper of the Week, respectively. Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner landed B1G Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors most recently on Sept. 19.

MIEKE MAGIC

- Junior defender Mieke Schiemann is in the midst of a breakout 2023 season, with the Berlin, Germany, native currently tied for second on the roster in total goals scored with three. Schiemann booked all three goals in a three-match span with just five shots on goal.
- The stalwart center back has been crucial in Penn State's continued defensive success this season, contributing heavily on the back line to the team's seven shutouts this season. In PSU's wins over Princeton and Nebraska, Schiemann played a pivotal role in holding Tiger star Pietra Tordin and national scoring leader Eleanor Dale of Nebraska scoreless in both matchups.

Schiemann's defensive ability is bolstered by an elite offensive skillset, especially in regard to set piece opportunities. Two of her three goals in 2023 have come on set piece chances, with both of those goals coming in Penn State's eventual 3-0 win over Princeton. Schiemann landed TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week honors following the result.

WEEZY BREEZY

Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner continues her fifth year in Happy Valley and her fourth season of on-field competition in 2023. The Monrovia, California, native was dominant in her first full season as a routine starter a year ago, finishing with two goals, 11 assists and 15 total points in 2022. Wiesner ranked at the top of the Big Ten Conference in both total assists (11) and assists per match (0.48) last year.

Wiesner is well on her way to replicating her dominant 2022 season, with the Nittany Lions' starting left back ranked second on the 2023 roster with four assists through the first 10 matches of the year. Wiesner set a season high against West Chester with a pair of dishes in the match, in addition to assists against Princeton and Nebraska. Wiesner ranks ninth in the Big Ten Conference in assists per match with a 0.40 mark, while her four total assists place her in 10th in the Big Ten in the category.

ASTOUNDING ASMAN

Graduate captain and goalkeeper Katherine Asman is off to a dominant start in the 2023 campaign, boasting 10 starts with a Big Ten-leading 0.226 goals-against average. The team captain stands as the only Big Ten keeper to allow fewer than three goals between the posts after the first 10 matches of the season. Her exemplary start to the year landed her as a B1G Co-Goalkeeper of the Week in the conference's Aug. 22 release. In Penn State's non-conference finale against Princeton, Asman assumed sole possession of fifth place in Nittany Lion history with 22 career shutouts, moved into fourth alltime at PSU in terms of goalie minutes played with 6,144, and tied with Nittany Lion legend Amanda Dennis for fourth all-time in career goalkeeper wins after notching her 45th.

CORI'S CORNER

Senior+ midfielder and captain Cori Dyke is in the midst of her fifth and final season in Happy Valley coming off her most successful campaign with the NIttany Lions a year ago. The Littleton, Colorado, native appeared and earned the start in all 23 PSU matches, connecting on four goals with an assist to score nine total points in 2022. Dyke was named a Big Ten Player to Watch in 2023 in the conference office's preseason release. She had also been previously named to the Big Ten Women's Soccer All-Tournament Team in 2022 in addition to securing BIG All-Freshman Team and Top-DrawerSoccer Freshman Best XI First Team recognition during her 2019 season. In recognition of her efforts against UNC and WCU, Dyke was honored as the BIG Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 22, followed by TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week Honorable mention accolades last week after notching the match-winner against Nebraska.

UNITED, WE RANKED

- Penn State debuted at the No. 10 position in the inaugural United Soccer Coaches poll of the 2023 season and has maintained a top-10 ranking in every subsequent release. The Nittany Lions currently stand as the fourth-ranked team in the nation for the second week in a row, securing their highest ranking since the 2020-21 spring campaign. Prior to the organization's Sept. 19 release, PSU owned the No. 6 spot for three consecutive weeks.
 - The Blue & White stand as the highest-ranked team in the B1G this week, leading a group of four programs that were either ranked or receiving votes. An unbeaten newcomer to the United poll, Indiana surged from unranked to the No. 16 spot, while Michigan fell three spots to No. 22. Michigan State returned to the spotlight this week, landing a placement in the receiving votes category. Penn State non-conference opponents North Carolina (1), Princeton (13) and UCF (T19) round out the six Nittany Lion challengers in and around the Top-25.

WHAT 2 WATCH 4

In addition to Penn State's trio of Big Ten Players to Watch, the Nittany Lions also saw multiple student-athletes land recognition on a variety of preseason watch lists. Senior forward Rebecca Cooke led the way, garnering an appearance on the MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List in addition to garnering recognition as a United Soccer Coaches Forward to Watch. Cooke was also named the No. 19 preseason player in Division I by TopDrawerSoccer, who released their list of top-100 preseason players on Aug. 16. Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner also hauled in recognition from TopDrawerSoccer in the preseason, landing the national No. 86 ranking on the preseason top-100 players list.

2022 IN REVIEW

- Penn State finished the 2022 campaign with a 15-5-3 overall record paired with a 5-3-2 mark against Big Ten opposition. The Blue & White published four wins against nationally-ranked teams last year, highlighted by a 2-0 win at home over then-No. 4 Rutgers on Jeffrey Field. Penn State hauled in the program's ninth B1G Tournament Title and advanced to the third round of the NCAA Women's Soccer Tournament for the sixth consecutive season. Then-senior+ forward Ally Schlegel brought home First Team All-America honors from
- United Soccer Coaches, while three athletes overall were recognized as All-Region choices. In January, the Nittany Lions saw a pair of student-athletes chosen in the 2023 NWSL Draft, with Penelope Hocking taken seventh followed by Schlegel at the No. 23 spot. Both Nittany Lion alumnae were drafted by the Chicago Red Stars.

POWER OF THE PORTAL

Penn State welcomed a trio of transfer athletes out of the portal prior to the start of the 2023 campaign, with all three individuals immediately eligible to play for the Blue & White this season. PSU signed the nation's returning scoring leader in forward Rebecca Cooke from Quinnipiac, All-B1G Second Team midfielder Rowan Lapi out of Northwestern and defender Michela Agresti, a two-time team captain from Boston College. PSU's trio of transfers amassed a combined 160 starts in their collegiate careers prior to arriving at PSU, adding a variety of depth and experience to the Nittany Lion field position groups. The newest crop of Nittany Lions played a combined 13,862 minutes before arriving in Happy Valley.

Fourteen Penn State women's soccer alumnae represent the program at the professional level in the National Women's Soccer League, the highest level of professional women's soccer in the world. PSU has alumnae on nine different franchises, including a program-best three former Nittany Lions with the Chicago Red Stars. The Penn State program's dominance within the Big Ten Conference also extends to its development of professional caliber student-athletes, as the Nittany Lions lead all Big Ten programs with 17 alumnae selected in NWSL Drafts since the inception of the practice in 2013. Seventeen draftees stands as the sixth-highest NWSL draft tally in all of collegiate soccer.

The Penn State women's soccer program saw five program alumnae participate in the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup in Australia and New Zealand. Those five individuals represented five different national teams, signifying the diverse array of talent that the Penn State program attracts. Canada's Olivia Smith, Costa Rica's Raquel Rodriguez, Germany's Laura Freigang, Ireland's Marissa Sheva and American Alyssa Naeher rounded out the five Nittany Lions to appear on senior women's national teams at the event.

Five selections to the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup stands as a tie for the fourth most among all collegiate programs, and the most in the Big Ten Conference. The Nittany Lions have a long track record of preparing student-athletes for success on the international level, with Head Coach Erica Dambach having previously served as an assistant coach for the four-time World Cup Champion and reigning Olympic Bronze Medalist United States Women's National Team. Multiple program alumnae have made history at the event, including Alyssa Naeher's groundbreaking score in a Round of 16 PK shootout in 2023 that marked the first instance of a goalkeeper converting on a penalty kick attempt in ANY FIFA World Cup, men's or women's.

JEFFREY FIELD THE HOME OF THE NITTANY LIONS



Jeffrey Field, the home of Nittany Lion soccer, was dedicated on Sept. 29, 1972. Located in the heart of the Penn State athletic facilities complex with a picturesque view of Mount Nittany, the stadium was named in honor of the late Bill Jeffrey, legendary head coach of the soccer program from 1926-52. Jeffrey Field has been the host site for numerous NCAA and conference contests in men's and women's soccer. Games are frequently televised from Jeffrey Field, allowing a nationwide audience to view Penn State in action. Widely regarded as one of the finest grass surfaces in the country, Jeffrey Field was honored as the 2006 Collegiate Soccer Field of the Year by the SportsTurf Managers Association.

Dambach enters her 17th season at the helm in University Park heading into the 2023 campaign, Penn State's 30th varsity season.

The numbers that document PSU's success are staggering. The Nittany Lions have accumulated 20 Big Ten championships, with 11 coming under Dambach's watch, in addition to five Big Ten Tournament crowns in the Dambach era.

A two-time National Coach of the Year and five-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Dambach has led her teams to 16 NCAA Tournaments, 11 Big Ten titles, five Big Ten Tournament titles and the 2015 NCAA National Championship.

In 21 years as a head coach and 17 seasons leading the Nittany Lions, Dambach has accumulated 307 career wins with a .710 winning percentage, one of the most dominant marks in all of college athletics.

SWB's mission is to use soccer as a vehicle for positive change in the lives of under-served youth around the world and has project sites in the U.S. as well as in Africa and Central America. Cook's primary in-volvement has been with its project for girls in Granada, Nicaragua.

As an early assistant project director for SWB, she helped establish what is now a thriving year-round program there. Cook has accompanied Penn State student-athletes there on multiple occasions and she took the team to Nicaragua for spring break 2018 to run camps and clinics for girls as well as coaches' clinics.

Ann Cook enters her 17th season with the Nittany Lions in 2023. This will also be the 17th season that Cook will be coaching alongside former team-mate and friend Erica Dambach. The two combined for numerous wins on the field together at William & Mary and have shown their provess on the sidelines, as they led the Nittany Llons to the program's first NCAA title in 2015, two College Cup appearances, 11 Big Ten titles and 15 NCAA Tourna-ment appearances.

As an associate head coach, Cook is the director of player development and is in charge of the Nittany Lion attack. Since she has been with the Blue & White, Penn State has had one of the most prolific attacks in the country. Since 2011, Penn State has scored over 500 goals, placing third in the nation over that period. Under the guidance of Cook, five Nittany Lions have scored 100 or more points over the span of their careers. Maya Hayes finished her Nittany Lion career with 163 points (71g, 21a), which ranks third-best in school history.

Promoted to associate head coach in July 2021, Tim Wassell has contribut-ed greatly to Penn State's success as the program's recruiting coordinator while simultaneously directing the team's goalkeepers and defensive unit. He enters his 14th season with the Nittany Lions in 2023, the program's 30th year at the varsity level overall.

Wassell has attracted multiple nationally ranked recruiting classes to Happy Valley year after year with five top-5 classes since 2014 as ranked by Top Drawer Soccer, including the No. 1 recruiting class in 2019 and 2022. His reputation as one of the top recruiters in the sport, combined with the ex-ceptional Penn State women's soccer experience, builds the aspirations of the program on those past successes. The Blue & White are fresh off signing yet another top-10 class under Wassell's direction, with the incoming 2023 corps ranked as the nation's No. 9 unit per Top Drawer.

14th Season

Under Wassel's guidance, multiple goalkeepers have experienced high level of success on the collegiate, professional and international levels. Amanda Dennis became the most recent Nittany Lion goalkeeper to enter the NWSL and signed with the Houston Dash following her senior season in 2019. helping the organization capture the 2020 NWSL Challenge Cup title in her rookie campaign. For Rose Chandler, she was a member of the U.S. U-20 WNT that won the 2015 CONCACAF U-20 World Cup Qualifying Tournament and was on the U.S. U-20 WNT at the 2016 FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup.

As an elite collegiate goalkeeper at Penn State Altoona, Wassell was a two-time NSCAA Mid-Atlantic Region selection in 2004 and 2005 and a two-time All-AMCC first-team pick as well. In both 2004 and 2005, Wassell led the AMCC in save percentage, shutouts and goals-against average (GAA), completing his two-year tenure between the pipes with a school-record 0.71 GAA. For his efforts as a player and coach, Wassell was inducted in the Penr State Altoona Athletics inaugural Hall of Fame class in October 2021.

Assistant Coach Indiana Wesleyan '22 **First Season**

Before arriving in Happy Valley, Baker served as the Director of Player Anal-ysis for the Xavier Musketeers women's soccer program over the course of the 2022 fall campaign. He assisted with video analytics, travel coordination opponent scouting and social outreach. Xavier published an unbeaten 2022 season in Big East Conference play with a 6–0-4 record, ultimately placing second in the league behind the Georgetown Hoyas. XU reached the 2022 NCAA Tournament with Baker on staff, winning its opening round test before falling to the Pittsburgh Panthers in the second round.

During his time with the Wildcats, Baker was responsible for developing and training the team's goalkeepers, including 2021 NAIA Honorable Mention All-American Hope Stacker. Baker also has experience as both a staff coach and soccer trainer with KingsHammer SC and X Factor Futbol, aiding young athletes in technical soccer development.






