### KICKIN' IT

- No. 4 Penn State women's soccer heads west for its first extended road trip of the 2023 campaign, as the Nittany Lions get set for a nationally-ranked matchup against the No. 22 Michigan Wolverines Thursday night from the U-M Soccer Stadium. Kickoff is slated for 7 p.m. (ET), with streaming available to a worldwide audience via B1G+.
- The Blue & White return to action following another undefeated work in Big Ten Conference competition with a pair of one-goal victories over the Rutgers Scarlet Knights and Nebraska Cornhuskers. PSU secured its first win in Piscataway since 2008 with a 2-1 result, followed by a rain-soaked 1-0 win over the Cornhuskers at Jeffrey Field.
- Individually, senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke hauled in TopDrawerSoccer Honorable Mention National Team of the Week accolades, her first national recognition in her career.
- Penn State currently stands as the No. 1 team in the nation in terms of the NCAA RPI, with the Blue & White edging No. 2 North Carolina by a slim 0.00426 margin.
- The Blue & White stand as one of just four women's soccer programs nationally that has yet to trail in a match, joining B1G foe Indiana, as well as Dartmouth and Texas Tech. Among teams that have yet to trail this season, PSU has allowed the fewest total goals, surrendering just three opponent scores in the 2023 campaign.

### WATCHING THE WOLVERINES

- Sixth-year skipper Jennifer Klein leads Michigan into Thursday night's contest boasting a 6-2-2 overall record coupled with a 2-1 start to Big Ten Conference competition. The Wolverines stand as the 22nd-ranked team in the nation, dropping three spots after suffering a 2-1 road loss against the Illinois Fighting Illini. Michigan opened Big Ten competition with consecutive victories over Minnesota and then-No. 18 Northwestern before their defeat in Champaign.
- Senior forward Sammi Woods has been dominant for the Wolverines in her fourth season in Ann Arbor, connecting on five goals with 11 total points scored in 2023. Between the posts, senior shot stopper Stephanie Sparkowski leads the way with 53 total saves and a 0.883 save percentage.

### STORY OF THE SERIES

- Heading into the 41st all-time meeting between the two programs, Penn State maintains a dominant 26-7-7 overall lead against Michigan since the teams first met back in 1994. In the last 10 matchups, Penn State has hauled in seven victories while dropping just three contests to Michigan.
- The Nittany Lions seek their first victory over Michigan on the road in Ann Arbor since downing the Wolverines in a 2-1 result on Oct. 7, 2018.
- Penn State came away with a convincing 3-0 victory over the Wolverines in last year's regular season meeting in University Park. Ally Schlegel led the way with a pair of goals while Ellie Wheeler contributed a pair of assists in the dominant result.

#### UNBEATEN.

- The 30th varsity team in Penn State women's soccer history etched its name in the Nittany Lion record book following its final non-conference win over Princeton, becoming just the second squad in program annals to go undefeated through the non-league portion of its regular season schedule. PSU last accomplished that feat in 2005, a team that went on to publish a 23-0-2 record, book a perfect 10-0-0 ledger in Big Ten play while reaching the Women's College Cup for the third time in school history.
- PSU secured its ninth-straight win after the victory over Nebraska, continuing the Blue & White's longest overall win streak since the Nittany Lions hauled in 11 straight back in the 2019 campaign. Penn State's unblemished start to B1G action marks the Nittany Lions' first 3-0 opening in a conference campaign since 2017 and the 14th instance of a 2-0 league start all-time.

#### LAST TIME OUT: NEBRASKA

- No. 4 Penn State coupled a dominant defensive outing with a late set piece score from senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke, culminating in a 1-0 victory Sunday afternoon over the Nebraska Cornhuskers.
- The Cornhuskers and Nittany Lions played a relatively even match across the board, with both teams having to fight through intense defensive pressure to generate offensive opportunities. Nebraska finished the afternoon's contest with a slim lead on the shot chart, outpacing the Blue & White by a narrow 16-13 edge overall and a 5-3 margin in terms of shots on goal. The Huskers also took home a narrow edge in the corner kick battle, leading the category by a 5-4 tally. Sunday's result saw the Nittany Lions pick up a win while losing the corner kick contest for the first time in 2023.

#### BALLIN' WITH BALANCE

- Penn State women's soccer boasts one of the most balanced attacks in the nation, with 16 different student-athletes logging at least one point through the first 10 matches of the season. In total, 26 members of the Nittany Lions' 30-woman roster have appeared in at least one match, with 14 earning starts.
- On the offensive end, 13 different Nittany Lions have amassed a total of 26 goals on the season, the second-highest goals per match mark in the Big Ten Conference (2.60). PSU's balanced offensive front has allowed eight student-athletes to score at least twice, with sophomore midfielder Olivia Borgen leading the team with four.
- Nine different Penn State performers have found their way onto the assist leaderboard at PSU this year, with Eva Alonso and Kate Wiesner leading the way with six and four, respectively.

#### GETTING DEFENSIVE

- The Nittany Lions boast one of the most effective defensive units in the nation through the first 10 matches of the season, tied for the league lead in the Big Ten and fourth nationally in terms of goals-against average with a 0.300 mark.
- PSU's shutout percentage is tied for first in the Big Ten and ranks seventh in Division I, boasting a 0.700 mark overall. The Nittany Lions have shutout seven opponents and have surrendered just one goal on Jeffrey Field, outscoring challengers by a 22-1 margin at home.
- Between the posts, Penn State goalkeepers have published a dominant season through the first 10 matches of the year, stopping 90.6% of opponent shots on target. PSU's save percentage is tied for first in the Big Ten and ranks fifth nationally.

#### EVA'S EMERGENCE

- Senior defender Eva Alonso's return to Penn State's starting XI in the 2023 season has coincided with the team's resurgence to the top of the national conversation. The Madrid, Spain, native has started in all 10 Nittany Lion contests this year and has already surpassed her total minutes played from the 2022 campaign.
- Alonso notched the 15th instance of a Nittany Lion passing for three assists all-time in Penn State's rout of Maryland and became the first to accomplish that feat since Kate Wiesner did so in the second round of last year's NCAA Tournament.
- The senior owns six total assists, tied for the third-most in the conference and 16th nationally, while notching 0.60 assists per match, also tied for the third-best mark in the B1G.
- Alonso became the program's fourth individual to land TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week honors in 2023. Alonso's accolade on Sept. 19 marked her second career TDS recognition, joining a prior appearance on May 4 during the COVID-altered spring 2021 season.

# AWARD-WINNING WORK

- Senior defender Eva Alonso became Penn State's most recent TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week honoree on Tuesday, Sept. 19, following her three-assist performance against the Maryland Terrapins to open Big Ten Conference play.
- Redshirt junior forward Kaitlyn MacBean picked up her first career national or conference weekly honors from TDS on Aug. 29, booking a pair of match-winning goals in the same week against West Virginia and then-No. 16 TCU.
- Junior defender Mieke Schiemann landed Penn State's second National Team of the Week distinction on Sept. 12 after booking a brace against Princeton in Penn State's eventual 3-0 decision that concluded the non-conference calendar.
- Senior defender Ellie Wheeler and senior+ midfielder Cori Dyke have both hauled in TopDrawerSoccer Honorable Mention National Team of the Week accolades this season, earning those honors on Aug. 22 and Sept. 26, respectively.
- Penn State has hauled in a trio of Big Ten weekly accolades through this point in the 2023 campaign, all three Nittany Lion captains earning laurels from the league office. In the B1G's first release on Aug. 22, Dyke, as well as graduate goalkeeper Katherine Asman brought home Defensive Player of the Week and Co-Goalkeeper of the Week, respectively. Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner landed B1G Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors most recently on Sept. 19.

## MIEKE MAGIC

- Junior defender Mieke Schiemann is in the midst of a breakout 2023 season, with the Berlin, Germany, native currently tied for second on the roster in total goals scored with three. Schiemann booked all three goals in a three-match span with just five shots on goal.
- The stalwart center back has been crucial in Penn State's continued defensive success this season, contributing heavily on the back line to the team's seven shutouts this season. In PSU's wins over Princeton and Nebraska, Schiemann played a pivotal role in holding Tiger star Pietra Tordin and national scoring leader Eleanor Dale of Nebraska scoreless in both matchups.
- Schiemann's defensive ability is bolstered by an elite offensive skillset, especially in regard to set piece opportunities. Two of her three goals in 2023 have come on set piece chances, with both of those goals coming in Penn State's eventual 3-0 win over Princeton. Schiemann landed TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week honors following the result.

## WEEZY BREEZY

- Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner continues her fifth year in Happy Valley and her fourth season of on-field competition in 2023. The Monrovia, California, native was dominant in her first full season as a routine starter a year ago, finishing with two goals, 11 assists and 15 total points in 2022. Wiesner ranked at the top of the Big Ten Conference in both total assists (11) and assists per match (0.48) last year.
- Wiesner is well on her way to replicating her dominant 2022 season, with the Nittany Lions' starting left back ranked second on the 2023 roster with four assists through the first 10 matches of the year. Wiesner set a season high against West Chester with a pair of dishes in the match, in addition to assists against Princeton and Nebraska.
- Wiesner ranks ninth in the Big Ten Conference in assists per match with a 0.40 mark, while her four total assists place her in 10th in the Big Ten in the category.

## ASTOUNDING ASMAN

- Graduate captain and goalkeeper Katherine Asman is off to a dominant start in the 2023 campaign, boasting 10 starts with a Big Ten-leading 0.226 goals-against average. The team captain stands as the only Big Ten keeper to allow fewer than three goals between the posts after the first 10 matches of the season. Her exemplary start to the year landed her as a B1G Co-Goalkeeper of the Week in the conference's Aug. 22 release.
- In Penn State's non-conference finale against Princeton, Asman assumed sole possession of fifth place in Nittany Lion history with 22 career shutouts, moved into fourth all-time at PSU in terms of goalie minutes played with 6,144, and tied with Nittany Lion legend Amanda Dennis for fourth all-time in career goalkeeper wins after notching her 45th.

## CORI'S CORNER

- Senior+ midfielder and captain Cori Dyke is in the midst of her fifth and final season in Happy Valley coming off her most successful campaign with the Nittany Lions a year ago. The Littleton, Colorado, native appeared and earned the start in all 23 PSU matches, connecting on four goals with an assist to score nine total points in 2022.
- Dyke was named a Big Ten Player to Watch in 2023 in the conference office's pre-season release. She had also been previously named to the Big Ten Women's Soccer All-Tournament Team in 2022 in addition to securing B1G All-Freshman Team and Top-Drawer Soccer Freshman Best XI First Team recognition during her 2019 season.
- In recognition of her efforts against UNC and WCU, Dyke was honored as the B1G Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 22, followed by TopDrawer Soccer National Team of the Week Honorable mention accolades last week after notching the match-winner against Nebraska.

## UNITED, WE RANKED

- Penn State debuted at the No. 10 position in the inaugural United Soccer Coaches poll of the 2023 season and has maintained a top-10 ranking in every subsequent release. The Nittany Lions currently stand as the fourth-ranked team in the nation for the second week in a row, securing their highest ranking since the 2020-21 spring campaign. Prior to the organization's Sept. 19 release, PSU owned the No. 6 spot for three consecutive weeks.
- The Blue & White stand as the highest-ranked team in the B1G this week, leading a group of four programs that were either ranked or receiving votes. An unbeaten newcomer to the United poll, Indiana surged from unranked to the No. 16 spot, while Michigan fell three spots to No. 22. Michigan State returned to the spotlight this week, landing a placement in the receiving votes category. Penn State non-conference opponents North Carolina (1), Princeton (13) and UCF (T19) round out the six Nittany Lion challengers in and around the Top-25.

## WHAT 2 WATCH 4

- In addition to Penn State's trio of Big Ten Players to Watch, the Nittany Lions also saw multiple student-athletes land recognition on a variety of preseason watch lists. Senior forward Rebecca Cooke led the way, garnering an appearance on the MAC Hermann Trophy Watch List in addition to garnering recognition as a United Soccer Coaches Forward to Watch. Cooke was also named the No. 19 preseason player in Division I by TopDrawer Soccer, who released their list of top-100 preseason players on Aug. 16.
- Senior+ defender Kate Wiesner also hauled in recognition from TopDrawer Soccer in the preseason, landing the national No. 86 ranking on the preseason top-100 players list.

## 2022 IN REVIEW

- Penn State finished the 2022 campaign with a 15-5-3 overall record paired with a 5-3-2 mark against Big Ten opposition. The Blue & White published four wins against nationally-ranked teams last year, highlighted by a 2-0 win at home over then-No. 4 Rutgers on Jeffrey Field. Penn State hauled in the program's ninth B1G Tournament Title and advanced to the third round of the NCAA Women's Soccer Tournament for the sixth consecutive season.
- Then-senior+ forward Ally Schlegel brought home First Team All-America honors from United Soccer Coaches, while three athletes overall were recognized as All-Region choices.
- In January, the Nittany Lions saw a pair of student-athletes chosen in the 2023 NWSL Draft, with Penelope Hocking taken seventh followed by Schlegel at the No. 23 spot. Both Nittany Lion alumnae were drafted by the Chicago Red Stars.

## POWER OF THE PORTAL

- Penn State welcomed a trio of transfer athletes out of the portal prior to the start of the 2023 campaign, with all three individuals immediately eligible to play for the Blue & White this season. PSU signed the nation's returning scoring leader in forward Rebecca Cooke from Quinnipiac, All-B1G Second Team midfielder Rowan Lapi out of Northwestern and defender Michela Agresti, a two-time team captain from Boston College.
- PSU's trio of transfers amassed a combined 160 starts in their collegiate careers prior to arriving at PSU, adding a variety of depth and experience to the Nittany Lion field position groups. The newest crop of Nittany Lions played a combined 13,862 minutes before arriving in Happy Valley.

## RECRUITING ROUNDUP

- The 2023 Nittany Lion recruiting class ranked as the No. 9 squad in the nation according to TopDrawerSoccer, the organization announced on Monday, August 14. PSU welcomed a quintet of incoming freshmen student-athletes and bolstered its class with three Division I transfer performers.
- Penn State features a trio of incoming freshmen who were ranked inside the national top-150 by TopDrawerSoccer, highlighted by the No. 10 recruit in the country in Worcester, Massachusetts, native forward Nicollette Kiorpes. PSU also welcomed the nation's No. 20 prospect in Bolingbrook, Illinois, native defender Keegan Schmeiser as well as No. 148-ranked defender Kaelyn Wolfe out of West Chester, Pennsylvania. The Nittany Lion recruiting class also featured Chesterfield, Ohio, native forward Frankee Fleisher in addition to Downingtown, Pennsylvania, native defender Ava Rightmire.

## THE BIG LEAGUES

- For the 21st year in a row, the Penn State women's soccer program was selected as the preseason favorite to win the Big Ten Conference regular season championship following a preseason poll of the league's coaches, the B1G announced on Tuesday, August 15.
- Northwestern took the No. 2 spot behind the Nittany Lions, with Rutgers and Michigan State rounding out the top four slots. Wisconsin, Nebraska, Ohio State and Michigan were selected as preseason favorites to complete the eight-team Big Ten Tournament field. Additionally, each school saw three players selected as Big Ten Players to Watch in 2023, with Cori Dyke, Payton Linnehan and Kate Wiesner earning the nods from PSU.
- Penn State has been selected as the preseason favorite by the Big Ten Conference's women's soccer coaches in every season since 2003. Since that inaugural selection in the early 2000s, the Nittany Lions have hauled in 15 Big Ten Regular Season Championships in addition to six Big Ten Tournament titles.

## 30 FOR 30

- The Penn State women's soccer program celebrates its 30th varsity season in the 2023 campaign. PSU began as a club team in the 1970s and blossomed, ultimately reaching varsity status for the first time in 1994, publishing a winning record in the squad's inaugural campaign. The following season in 1995, Penn State began its 28-year NCAA Tournament streak that survives to the present day while simultaneously managing a 29-year streak of overall winning seasons.
- Penn State has won 20 Big Ten Regular Season Championships, nine Big Ten Tournament Titles, participated in five NCAA Women's College Cups and took home the 2015 National Championship. The Blue & White have combined for 500 all-time victories, and look to build on that rich tradition in 2023.

## UP NEXT

- No. 4 Penn State women's soccer continues its weekend sojourn through the Great Lakes State of Michigan, as the Nittany Lions gear up for a rematch of the 2022 Big Ten Tournament Final against the Michigan State Spartans. Kickoff on Sunday, Oct. 1 from DeMartin Stadium is slated for noon, with the match tabbed for a national television broadcast via the Big Ten Network.

The Penn State women's soccer program saw five program alumnae participate in the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup in Australia and New Zealand. Those five individuals represented five different national teams, signifying the diverse array of talent that the Penn State program attracts. Canada's Olivia Smith, Costa Rica's Raquel Rodriguez, Germany's Laura Freigang, Ireland's Marissa Sheva and American Alyssa Naeher rounded out the five Nittany Lions to appear on senior women's national teams at the event.

Five selections to the 2023 FIFA Women's World Cup stands as a tie for the fourth most among all collegiate programs, and the most in the Big Ten Conference. The Nittany Lions have a long track record of preparing student-athletes for success on the international level, with Head Coach Erica Dambach having previously served as an assistant coach for the four-time World Cup Champion and reigning Olympic Bronze Medalist United States Women's National Team. Multiple program alumnae have made history at the event, including Alyssa Naeher's groundbreaking score in a Round of 16 PK shootout in 2023 that marked the first instance of a goalkeeper converting on a penalty kick attempt in ANY FIFA World Cup, men's or women's.

# JEFFREY FIELD

THE HOME OF THE NITTANY LIONS



Jeffrey Field, the home of Nittany Lion soccer, was dedicated on Sept. 29, 1972. Located in the heart of the Penn State athletic facilities complex with a picturesque view of Mount Nittany, the stadium was named in honor of the late Bill Jeffrey, legendary head coach of the soccer program from 1926-52. Jeffrey Field has been the host site for numerous NCAA and conference contests in men's and women's soccer. Games are frequently televised from Jeffrey Field, allowing a nationwide audience to view Penn State in action. Widely regarded as one of the finest grass surfaces in the country, Jeffrey Field was honored as the 2006 Collegiate Soccer Field of the Year by the SportsTurf Managers Association.

The leadership of Penn State women's soccer Head Coach Erica Dambach continues to produce incredible success season after season. While trophies, academic awards and international achievements line the walls as evidence of a championship program, her impact on Nittany Lion student-athletes stands as the truest testament to her teams' culture of excellence. Dambach enters her 17th season at the helm in University Park heading into the 2023 campaign, Penn State's 30th varsity season.

The numbers that document PSU's success are staggering. The Nittany Lions have accumulated 20 Big Ten championships, with 11 coming under Dambach's watch, in addition to five Big Ten Tournament crowns in the Dambach era.

A two-time National Coach of the Year and five-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Dambach has led her teams to 16 NCAA Tournaments, 11 Big Ten titles, five Big Ten Tournament titles and the 2015 NCAA National Championship.

In 21 years as a head coach and 17 seasons leading the Nittany Lions, Dambach has accumulated 307 career wins with a .710 winning percentage, one of the most dominant marks in all of college athletics.

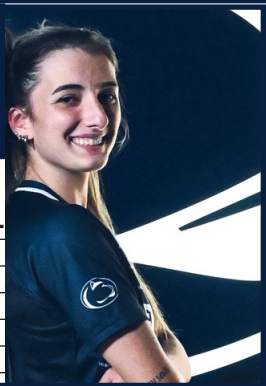

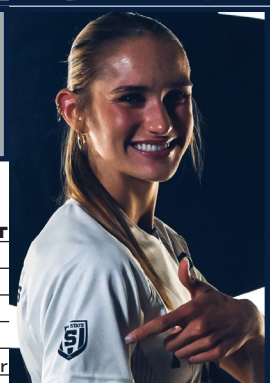
