LEADING OFF

- Penn State opens the Big Ten Tournament Presented by IFS.ai on Tuesday against Illinois.
- The Nittany Lions dropped three games against the Illini in late March, leading into the fifth in all three games.
- Penn State swept a three-game series at Maryland, including a doubleheader sweep on Friday, to clinch its spot in the Big Ten Tournament.
- Mason Horwat earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week after seven shutout innings.
- In year one under Mike Gambino, Penn State has a winning record after the regular season for the first time since 2016 and maintained a .500 or better record the entire season for the first time since 2011.
- PSU tied for best in the Big Ten with an 11-3 record in weekend openers and went 6-2 in Big Ten series openers.
- J.T. Marr is second in the Big Ten in average (.419) and hits per game (1.73), good for sixth and seventh in the country, respectively.
- Marr's 85 hits are third in a season at PSU, while Adam Cecere's 46 walks are tied second. Cecere (15) and Grant Norris (14) rank fifth and sixth in homers.

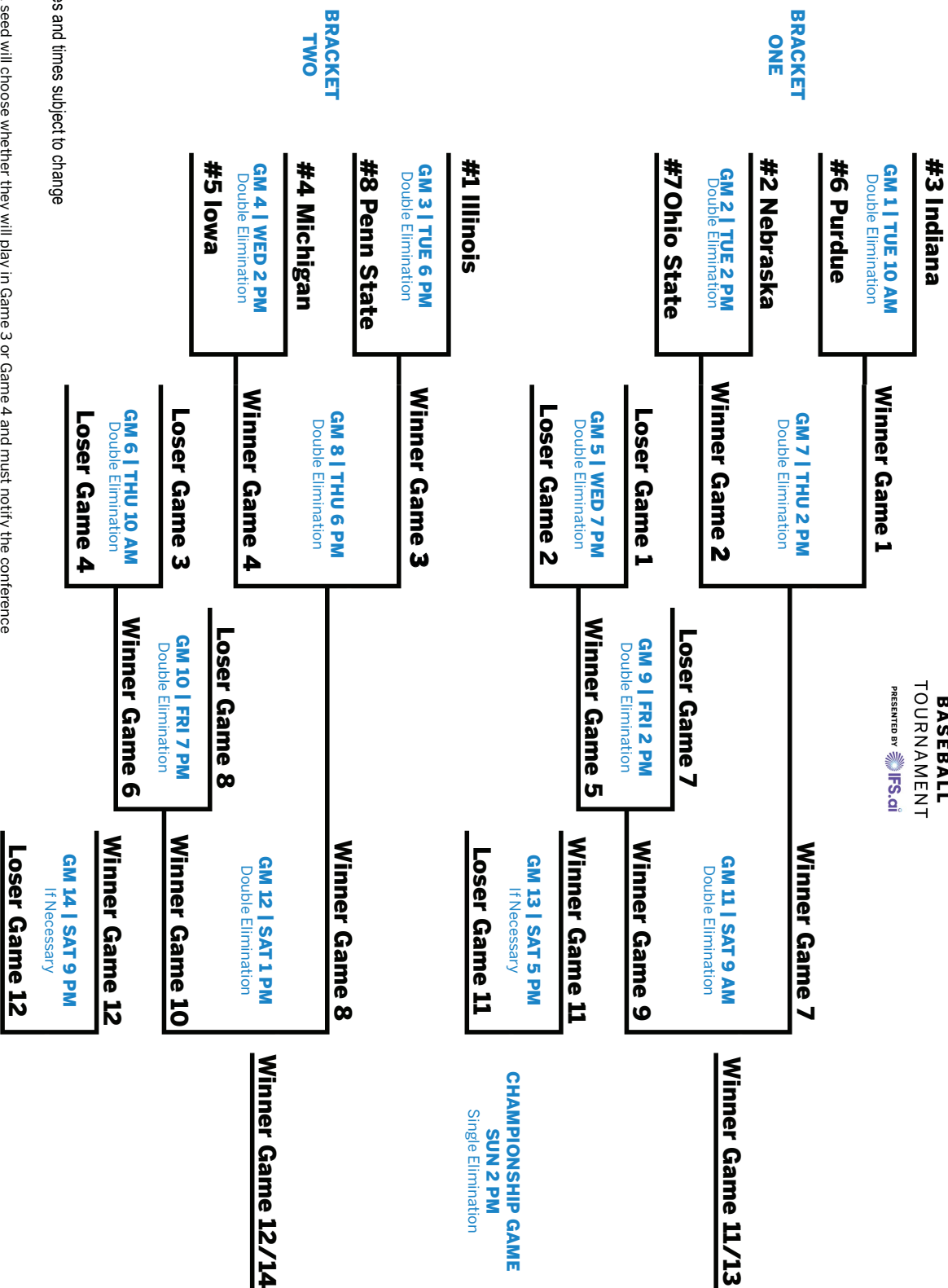

The Marr-Chine Keeps Hitting

- Grad student J.T. Marr's season average sits at .419 with a team-best 85 hits and 49 RBI.
- His 85 hits are third in a season at Penn State. He also reached the 200-career hit mark, currently sitting at 204.
- Marr ranks second in the Big Ten and sixth in the country with his .419 average.
- He ranks seventh in the nation, and second in the Big Ten, averaging 1.73 hits per game.
- Marr holds 15th in the country, and second in the conference, with 85 total hits.
- He owns 27 multi-hit games, including 14 against Big Ten opponents, and 15 multi-RBI games. Marr has two games with four hits and 13 games with three hits.
- Marr tied a PSU game record with three doubles against FDU.
- Among his 85 knocks, he has 16 doubles and six homers to go with 49 RBI and a 1.053 OPS, good for 11th in the Big Ten. He has five homers and 27 RBI in conference play.

Newcomers Leading Balanced Lineup

- The Nittany Lions rank Top 5 in the Big Ten in batting average (.307; 2nd), slugging percentage (.494; 2nd), sac flies (29; 2nd), on-base percentage (.404; 4th), home runs per game (1.37; 5th) and runs per game (7.7; 5th).
- Penn State has seven players with 48+ hits, five with a .400+ on-base percentage and eight with a .436+ slugging percentage.
- Penn State, Illinois and Indiana are the only Big Ten teams with seven players owning at least 36 RBI and PSU is one of two Big Ten teams with seven players owning 48+ hits.
- The Nittany Lions' 67 home runs this year are its most since hitting 91 in 1998.
- PSU's 46 homers in Big Ten games are tied with Illinois for most among Big Ten teams.
- Graduate student J.T. Marr paces the squad with a .419 average and 85 hits. He owns 16 doubles, six homers, 49 RBI and 46 runs.
- Going 34-of-96 (.354) with 29 RBI at the plate in conference play, Bobby Marsh is hitting .311 with 56 hits, including nine doubles, one triple, six homers, 45 RBI and 34 runs.
- Matt Maloney's .364 average (28-of-77) in Big Ten play ranks 11th in the league.
- Holding a .337 average (32-of-95) in Big Ten play, Bryce Molinaro owns 10 homers and 11 doubles, among 62 hits, and 40 RBI to go with a .325 average. He had two homers at Indiana (4/12) and vs. Rutgers (5/11) and a go-ahead, three-run homer at MSU (4/21).
- Graduate student Adam Cecere is hitting .315 with 53 hits, including 12 doubles and 15 homers, 47 RBI and a team-best 47 runs. He has a team-high 46 walks and 10 hit-by-pitches. He owns nine homers and 26 RBI in Big Ten play.
- He leads the Big Ten with a 1.133 OPS and ranks second in slugging percentage (.655), while sitting fourth in on-base percentage (.478). He's third in the league in home runs in conference play (9). He's also third in the conference in total walks (46).
- Cecere is one of 17 current Division I players with 47+ homers and 163+ RBI in their career. Among active DI players, Cecere is 23rd in homers (47).
- Grant Norris has 55 hits, including 10 doubles, a triple, and 14 homers, 42 RBI and 39 runs.
- Norris collected his first career multi-homer game against Northwestern (4/6) and had another at Michigan State (4/20), while adding an inside-the-park homer vs. Minnesota.
- With Cecere (15), Norris (14) and Molinaro (10), Penn State has three players with 10+ homers for the first time since 1999 (Shawn Fagan, 13; Dan Beers, 13; Chris Netwall, 12; Eric Spadt, 10).
- Cecere is tied fifth in the Big Ten with 15 homers, while Norris is tied eighth with 14. Norris ranks second with 10 homers in conference games, while Cecere is third with nine homers.
- Joe Jaconski is fifth in the Big Ten in walks (39) and owns 54 hits, 42 runs and six homers.

Maryland Series Recap

- The Nittany Lions swept a three-game series at Maryland last weekend.
- PSU won its first series against Maryland since the Terrapins joined the Big Ten and became the first Big Ten team to sweep at Maryland since Michigan in 2019.
- In the series, PSU hit .353 with 42 hits, 33 runs and seven homers.
- Kevin Michaels led PSU with seven hits, including a double and two homers, five RBI and five runs. Matt Maloney also had seven hits, with two doubles and a homer. Adam Cecere added a double and two homers with six RBI.
- Mason Horwat tossed seven shutout innings out of the bullpen, working four innings on Thursday to earn the save and three in Friday's first game to pick up the win.

Nittany Lions Climb Records Lists

- With 13 steals this year, senior Kyle Hannon has moved up to fourth all-time at Penn State with 47 career steals. He is currently three steals behind Doug Keener (50, 1984-87) for third place.
- Senior+ Tayven Kelley owns 13 career triples, tied second all-time at Penn State with Kevin Billotte (1995-98).
- Grad student Grant Norris' .548 career slugging percentage sits fifth all-time at Penn State, while sophomore Bobby Marsh's .495 slugging percentage is seventh all-time.
- Grad student Adam Cecere is tied fourth in a season at PSU with 15 homers, while Norris is tied sixth with 14.
- Fellow grad student J.T. Marr is now third in a season at Penn State with 85 hits, while Cecere is tied second at PSU with 46 walks.

First Year Under Mike Gambino

- In its first season under head coach Mike Gambino, Penn State finished the regular season with a winning record (26-23) for the first time since 2016 (28-27).
- Penn State maintained a .500 or better record for the entire season for the first time since the 2011 season (finished 32-22).
- The Blue and White posted its best record in Big Ten play (12-12) since going 12-12 in 2016.
- PSU ranks 111th in the RPI entering the Big Ten Tournament, it's highest ranking at this point of the season since finishing 103rd in 2012.
- The Nittany Lions went 11-3 in weekend opening games, tying Illinois and Nebraska for the best record among Big Ten teams.
- Penn State was 6-2 in Big Ten series openers, trailing only Illinois' 7-1 mark, and tying Nebraska and Purdue.
- Non-conference action included a series win at Stanford, a 2023 College World Series participant, and wins over current Top 100 RPI teams Georgetown (59) and Pitt (83) and two wins over Army, a 2023 NCAA Tournament team.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Illinois

- Head Coach Dan Hartleb is in his 19th season leading the Illinois program.
- Illinois is 565-415-1 under Hartleb, including an 11-12 mark this season.
- Last weekend, the Illini swept its three-game series at Purdue.
- The Illini rank fourth in the Big Ten in batting average (.304) and leads the Big Ten in both total homers (103) and home runs per game (2.06).
- Camden Janik leads Illinois with a .370 average, 74 hits, 15 doubles, seven homers and 47 RBI.
- Jacob Schroeder owns 14 homers and 41 RBI to go with a .315 average, while Ryan Moerman leads the Big Ten with 18 homers to go with 52 RBI and Drake Westcott has 16 homers and 49 RBI.
- Illinois holds seventh in the Big Ten with a 6.02 ERA and is allowing a .366 opponent average.
- Cooper Omans leads the Illini rotation with a 4.09 ERA in 13 appearances (11 starts) with 51 strikeouts in 55 innings.
- Jack Crowder is 6-1 with a 5.24 ERA in 14 starts with 70 strikeouts over 77.1 innings.
- Joe Glassey leads Illinois with 21 appearances and eight saves.

Against The Illini

- Penn State is 31-44 all-time against Illinois.
- The teams last played in late March, with the Nittany Lions dropping three games.
- Penn State's last win in the series came on May 23, 2021, a 13-4 victory.
- PSU is 3-4 all-time against Illinois in the Big Ten Tournament.

Head Coach

Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino takes over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect Game.

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the D1Baseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting pitcher.

Gambino's pitching staff ranked 26th in the country in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.54) and 26th in walks allowed per nine innings (3.58). Boston College held fifth in the country, and led the ACC, with a .982 fielding percentage.

The 2022 MLB Draft saw four of Gambino's student-athletes be chosen, led by second baseman Luke Gold, who was selected in the fifth round by the Detroit Tigers. Pitchers Mason Pelio (Reds - 12th round), Joe Mancini (Astros - 15th round) and Max Gieg (Angels - 18th round) were also chosen in the draft.

In 2021, an impressive three players were selected in the first six rounds of the MLB Draft headlined by outfielder Sal Frelick, who was the 15th overall pick by the Milwaukee Brewers. Shortstop Cody Morissette was picked in the second round by the Miami Marlins and pitcher Emmet Sheehan was selected in the sixth round by the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Gambino led BC to a 31-27 record in 2019 and the Eagles reached the ACC semifinals as the 12th seed with wins over Clemson and top-seeded Louisville. A program-record five Eagles earned All-ACC, led by All-ACC first team pitcher Dan Metzdorf, who was a fifth-round pick for the Chicago White Sox and led the ACC with a 2.30 ERA. Jake Alu (Nationals - 24th round) and Matt Gill (Reds - 27th round) were also chosen during the 2019 MLB Draft.

In 2018, outfielder Chris Galland earned All-ACC third team accolades and Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-America honors. The 2018 MLB Draft had four of Gambino's players selected with Jake Palomaki (Rays - 18th round), Jacob Stevens (Diamondbacks - 21st round), Brian Rapp (Twins - 26th round) and Dan Metzdorf (Yankees - 38th round).

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship Tournament for the first time since 2010. BC won 10 of its last 15 ACC games with sweeps over Notre Dame and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005 and third-highest total in program history. They also tallied 13 ACC wins, the most since 2010, while their six conference series victories set a school record. Gambino led the Eagles to a sweep in the Oxford Regional as the third seed to advance to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. BC finished the season in the Top 25 of all four major polls for the first time in program history (15th - D1Baseball, 16th - Baseball America, NCBWA and 21st - USA Today/Coaches Poll).

For his efforts, Gambino was named the 2016 American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year, a finalist for D1Baseball Coach of the Year and earned a spot on the website's top-10 coaching performances of the season.

Gambino proteges were selected in the first round of the MLB Draft in back-to-back years for the first time in program history in 2015 and 2016. Chris Shaw was selected 31st overall by the San Francisco Giants in 2015 and Justin Dunn was taken 19th overall by the New York Mets in 2016. Overall, five players were drafted in 2016: Dunn, Michael King (12th round), Jesse Adams (14th round), Nick Sciortino (19th round) and Joe Cronin (34th round).

Gambino was an assistant coach for four seasons at Virginia Tech prior to his move to Boston College. He served as the Hokies' recruiting coordinator and worked with the hitters and infielders. In his four years, he saw 15 players get drafted in the MLB Draft, including nine in 2010.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny and Callahan.
