• The Nittany Lions will play their first Big Ten road series in more than a month when they travel to East Lansing, Mich., for a two-game series against Michigan State.

LAST YEAR IN EAST LANSING

• During its inaugural NCAA Division I season, Penn State traveled to Michigan State Jan. 25-26, 2013 for its first road series against a future Big Ten team. The Lions dropped the first game, 5-3, before defeating the Spartans by a 3-2 margin on BTN in the finale.

• Forwards **Casey Bailey** (1g, 3a) and **Max Gardiner** (4a) paced the team with four points each during the series. Then-freshman netminder **Matthew Skoff** played both games for the Nittany Lions and corralled 31 shots in the Penn State victory.

WELL-KNOWN NETMINDERS

• Penn State goaltender **Matthew Skoff** and Michigan State netminders Jake Hildebrand and Will Yanakeff all played for the USHL's Sioux City Musketeers during parts the 2009-10 season.

• Skoff and Hildebrand, both Pittsburgh-area natives, also played for Sioux City during the 2010-11 season and competed for the Pittsburgh Hornets youth hockey organization.

GLEN FINDING GROOVE

• Sophomore forward **David Glen**, who ranked second on the team with 25 points in 2012-13, has recorded points in back-to-back games for the first time this season.
• The Fort Saskatchewan, Alta., native, who produced a two-point weekend (1g, 1a) against Minnesota, has collected three points (1g, 2a) in the last four games.

YOUTH MOVEMENT

- Penn State underclassmen have accounted for nearly 75 percent of the team's offense.

- The Nittany Lions' top four scorers are either freshmen or sophomores, with redshirt sophomore **Eric Scheid** leading the way with 13 points (8g, 5a).

SHORTHANDED LEADERS

- Penn State and Wisconsin are tied for the conference lead with three shorthanded goals.

JOINING THE FUN

- At least 20 players on the 26-man roster have notched at least one point during the 2013-14 season.

SACRIFICING THE BODY

- Junior defenseman **Patrick Koudys** leads the Big Ten with 38 blocked shots. The Smithville, Ont., native averages 2.24 blocks per game.

JUHA AMONG NATION'S BEST

- Sophomore **Luke Juha** is tied for fifth among NCAA blueliners with four power-play goals. The Nittany Lions are 2-2-0 when he scores a goal.

- In the Big Ten, Juha is tied for second among defensemen in power-play points (7) and is tied for third among all skaters in PPGs (4).

THE DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES

- The Nittany Lions, who scored 12 power-play goals and ranked 59th in the country in 2012-13, have converted on 13-of-62 chances (.200), good for a tie of 24th place.

FRESHMEN MAKING IMPACT

- **David Goodwin** (4-6--10) and **Ricky DeRosa** (3-5--8) are tied for 11th and 15th, respectively, among Big Ten rookies in points.

CAREER YEARS

- Forwards **Tommy Olczyk** and **Eric Scheid** are boasting career years as Penn State reached the season's halfway point.

- Olczyk, who recorded four points in 26 games last season, already has seven points (4g, 3a). The Long Grove, Ill., notched his career-high fourth goal against Robert Morris Dec. 27.

LIONS PLAY FIRST B1G SERIES

- Penn State dropped both of its games to then-No. 17 Wisconsin in its first Big Ten series, falling 7-1 Friday, Dec. 6 before dropping a 4-3 game Dec. 7.

- In the finale, freshmen **Ricky DeRosa** (1g, 1a) and **Zach Saar** (1g, 1a) notched their first multi-point games.

- The Nittany Lions, who took a 1-0 following **Eric Scheid's** marker, twice erased one-goal deficits before allowing the game-winning goal with 8:08 left in the third.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

- In league action, each Big Ten team will play 20 league games, including 10 home contests.

- Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation or overtime victory, two points for a shootout win and one point for a shootout loss.

- Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

- The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only BCS conference to sponsor men's hockey.

- The league tournament will take place at Saint Paul's Xcel Energy Center March 20-22 with the tournament champion earning the league's automatic big to the NCAA tournament.

PEPPERING THE NET

- Penn State's 27 second-period shots against Robert Morris Dec. 27 were the most attempts in a period in program history.

- The team's 62 total shots ranked

second, trailing the 63 attempts against AIC in the Nittany Lions' first NCAA game Oct. 12, 2012.

BACK OF THE NET

- With seven goals against Union Nov. 30-Dec. 1, Penn State scored its most goals in a series since netting eight markers against Alabama Huntsville Feb. 8-9, 2013.

RICHARD LIGHTS THE LAMP

- Freshman **Dylan Richard** netted his first career goal in Penn State's 3-3 tie against RIT Oct. 25.

LIONS EARN FIRST DRAW

- Penn State skated to its first tie in the NCAA era with a 3-3 draw against RIT Oct. 25.

DeROSA MAKES IMPACT

- Freshman forward **Ricky DeRosa** tallied a goal in his first career game when he scored with 2:46 left in the third period in PSU's 3-1 loss to Air Force Oct. 19.

McADAM, WILLIAMSON DEBUT

- Freshman goaltender **Eamon McAdam** and rookie defenseman **Mike Williamson** played in their first career games against Air Force Friday, Oct. 18. McAdam turned aside 27 shots in his collegiate debut.

BACK ON THE SCORESHEET

- With a goal against Air Force Oct. 18, **Luke Juha** reached the back of the net for the first time since scoring in a 5-1 win vs. the Falcons Nov. 10, 2012.

- Sophomore forward **Jonathan Milley**, who missed 18 games due to injury in 2012-13, recorded a helper for his first point since registering a three-point outing vs. Holy Cross Dec. 7, 2012.

LIONS OPEN PEGULA WITH WIN

- The Nittany Lions opened Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win over Army in front of a standing-room only crowd of 6,370.

- Four different Nittany Lions scored, including **David Goodwin** and **Eric Scheid**, who scored in their Penn State debuts.

- Sophomore **Matthew Skoff** made 25 saves.
