LEADING OFF

- Penn State visits Maryland for the final weekend of the regular season.
- The Nittany Lions trail 23-19 in the all-time series against Maryland and took one of three games against the Terrapins in 2023.
- Last weekend, Penn State took two of three games against Rutgers, winning both on walk-offs in the ninth.
- On Friday, Bryce Molinaro launched two homers and Grant Norris drove in the winning run with a single in the ninth.
- On Sunday, PSU rallied for four runs in the ninth, starting with homers by Bobby Marsh and Norris and ending with a single by Joe Jaconski.
- The Nittany Lions have 60 homers this season, its most since hitting 67 in 1999.
- Grant Norris is tied second in the Big Ten with 14 homers, while Adam Cecere is tied eighth with 13.
- In Big Ten games, Norris leads the league with 10 homers, while Cecere and Bryce Molinaro are tied third with 7.
- J.T. Marr is second in the Big Ten in average (.416) and hits per game (1.72).

The Marr-Chine Keeps Hitting

- Grad student J.T. Marr’s season average sits at .418 with a team-best 79 hits and 46 RBI.
- His 79 hits are fourth in a season at Penn State. He is also approaching 200 career hits, currently sitting at 198.
- Marr ranks second in the Big Ten and eighth in the country with his .418 average.
- He ranks sixth in the nation, and second in the Big Ten, averaging 1.72 hits per game.
- Marr holds 23rd in the country, and second in the conference, with 79 total hits.
- He owns 25 multi-hit games, including 12 against Big Ten opponents, and 14 multi-RBI games. Marr has two games with four hits and 12 games with three hits.
- Marr tied a PSU game record with three doubles against FDU.
- Among his 79 knocks, he has 16 doubles and six homers to go with 46 RBI and a 1.065 OPS, good for eighth in the Big Ten. He has five homers and 24 RBI in conference play.

Newcomers Leading Balanced Lineup

- The Nittany Lions rank Top 5 in the Big Ten in batting average (.303; 2nd), sac flies (26; 3rd), home runs per game (1.30; 4th), slugging percentage (.486; 4th), runs per game (7.5; 5th) and on-base percentage (.401; 5th).
- Penn State has six players with 49+ hits, five with a .400+ on-base percentage and seven with a .414+ slugging percentage.
- Penn State, Illinois and Indiana are the only Big Ten teams with seven players owning at least 33 RBI and PSU is one of two Big Ten teams with six players owning 49+ hits.
- The Nittany Lions’ 60 home runs this year are its most since hitting 67 in 1999.
- PSU’s 39 homers in Big Ten games are tied for most among Big Ten teams.
- Graduate student J.T. Marr paces the squad with a .418 average and 79 hits. He owns 16 doubles, six homers, 46 RBI and 43 runs.
- With a 33-of-85 start (.388) and 26 RBI at the plate in conference play, Bobby Marsh is hitting .325 with 55 hits, including nine doubles, one triple, six homers, 42 RBI and 32 runs. He ranks seventh in the league with his .397 average and sits sixth with 33 hits in Big Ten play.
- Holding a .358 average (29-of-81) in Big Ten play, Bryce Molinaro owns nine homers and 10 doubles, among 59 hits, and 37 RBI to go with a .333 average. He had two homers at Indiana (4/12) and vs. Rutgers (5/11) and a go-ahead, three-run homer at MSU (4/21).
- Graduate student Adam Cecere is hitting .310 with 49 hits, including 11 doubles and 13 homers, 41 RBI and a team-best 43 runs. He has a team-high 40 walks and 10 hit-by-pitches. He owns seven homers and 20 RBI in Big Ten play.
- He ranks sixth in Big Ten with a 1.094 OPS and fifth in slugging percentage (.627), while tying seventh with Marr in on-base percentage (.467). He’s third with Molinaro in home runs in conference play (7). He’s also fourth in the conference in total walks (40).
- Cecere is one of 21 current Division I players with 45+ homers and 157+ RBI in their career. Among active DI players, Cecere is 24th in homers (45).
- Grant Norris has 52 hits, including nine doubles, a triple, and 14 homers, 42 RBI and 34 runs.
- Norris collected his first career multi-homer game against Northwestern (4/6) and had another at Michigan State (4/20), while adding an inside-the-park homer vs. Minnesota.
- With Cecere (13) and Norris (14), Penn State has multiple players with 13+ homers for the first time since 1999 (Shawn Fagan, 13; Dan Beers, 13).
- Norris is tied third in the Big Ten with 14 homers, while Cecere is eighth with 13. Norris leads with 10 homers in conference games, while Cecere is third with seven homers.
- Joe Jaconski is fifth in the Big Ten in walks (37) and owns 51 hits, 40 runs and six homers.

Rutgers Series Recap

- Penn State won two of three games in its series against Rutgers, winning both on walk-offs in the ninth.
- PSU tallied 31 hits and 19 runs in the series, led by J.T. Marr’s six hits. Matt Maloney added five hits.
- Bryce Molinaro had four hits, two homers, two RBI and five runs, while Grant Norris and Bobby Marsh added homers.
- On Friday, Molinaro homered twice and PSU walked it off on a single by Grant Norris.
- Saturday was highlighted by Jaden Henline’s seven shutout innings.
- On Sunday, PSU rallied for four runs in the ninth, started by back-to-back homers from Marsh and Norris and ended on a single by Joe Jaconski.

Nittany Lions Climb Records Lists

- With 13 steals this year, senior Kyle Hannon has moved up to fourth all-time at Penn State with 47 career steals. He is currently three steals behind Doug Keener (50, 1984-87) for third place.
- Hannon ranks ninth in the Big Ten in total steals (13).
- Senior+ Tayven Kelley owns 13 career triples, tied second all-time at Penn State with Kevin Billotte (1995-98).
- Grad student Grant Norris' .560 career slugging percentage sits fifth all-time at Penn State, while sophomore Bobby Marsh's .510 slugging percentage is seventh all-time.
- Grad student Grant Norris ranks fifth in a season at Penn State with 14 homers, while grad student Adam Cecere is tied sixth with 13.
- Fellow grad student J.T. Marr is now fourth in a season at Penn State with 79 hits.

Dollar Dog Night Returns

- Penn State's Dollar Dog Nights became popular in 2023 and have returned with strong numbers in 2024.
- April 16th's contest against Kent State was the Nittany Lions' fourth Dollar Dog Night of the 2024 campaign.
- Penn State set a new attendance record (5,025), topping 5,000 fans for the first time in program history. PSU fans consumed a Dollar Dog record 8,591 hot dogs, breaking the previous record of 6,151 against FDU.
- On Tuesday, PSU drew more fans that night than current Top 25 teams Alabama (3,672), Clemson (4,567), Duke (469), North Carolina (3,268), Oklahoma State (4,803), Oregon (2,070), Tennessee (4,617), Virginia Tech (1,035) and West Virginia (4,614) and MLB's Oakland A's (3,296).
- The Nittany Lions welcomed 4,902 fans against FDU on April 9 and 3,505 fans against Pitt on March 26.
- Across nine Dollar Dog Nights in 2023 and 2024, Penn State fans have consumed 35,177 hot dogs, averaging 3,908.6 per Dollar Dog Night.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Maryland

- Head Coach Matt Swope is in his first season as head coach at Maryland after serving 11 seasons on the Maryland staff.
- Swope played at Maryland from 1999-02 and then worked his way up from director of operations (2013-17) to assistant coach (2017-22) to associate head coach (2022-23) before being elevated to head coach.
- Maryland is 34-19 overall and 10-11 in Big Ten play. Last weekend, the Terrapins won two of three games at Boston College.
- The Terrapins rank 11th in the Big Ten with a .273 average and 10th in the conference averaging 6.8 runs per game.
- Eddie Hacopian leads Maryland with a .376 average and 77 hits to go with seven homers, 46 RBI and 50 runs.
- Chris Hacopian is batting .325 with 69 hits, including 14 homers, and 41 RBI, while Sam Hojnar is hitting .279 with 14 homers and a team-best 54 RBI.
- Maryland's pitching staff ranks fourth in the Big Ten with a 5.55 ERA.
- Kenny Lippman paces the staff with 59 strikeouts in 61.2 innings while holding a 4-3 record and 4.52 ERA.
- Logan Berrier is 7-1 with a 2.85 ERA in 19 appearances.

Against The Terrapins

- Penn State trails 23-19 in the all-time series vs. Maryland.
- Last season, Penn State won one of three games against the Terrapins.
- In the win over Maryland on May 19, 2023, PSU won 5-3. Jay Harry hit a go-ahead two-run single in the fifth and C.J. Pittaro delivered an RBI single in the eighth. Tommy Molsky worked six innings, allowing three runs, before Ryan Partridge closed it out with three shutout innings.

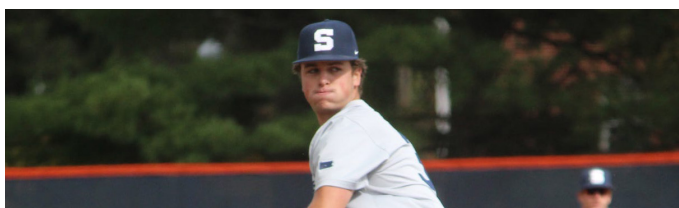

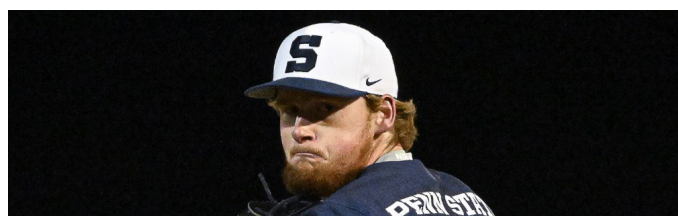

Head Coach

Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino takes over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect Game.

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the D1Baseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting pitcher.

Gambino's pitching staff ranked 26th in the country in strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.54) and 26th in walks allowed per nine innings (3.58). Boston College held fifth in the country, and led the ACC, with a .982 fielding percentage.

The 2022 MLB Draft saw four of Gambino's student-athletes be chosen, led by second baseman Luke Gold, who was selected in the fifth round by the Detroit Tigers. Pitchers Mason Pelio (Reds - 12th round), Joe Mancini (Astros - 15th round) and Max Gieg (Angels - 18th round) were also chosen in the draft.

In 2021, an impressive three players were selected in the first six rounds of the MLB Draft headlined by outfielder Sal Frelick, who was the 15th overall pick by the Milwaukee Brewers. Shortstop Cody Morissette was picked in the second round by the Miami Marlins and pitcher Emmet Sheehan was selected in the sixth round by the Los Angeles Dodgers.

Gambino led BC to a 31-27 record in 2019 and the Eagles reached the ACC semifinals as the 12th seed with wins over Clemson and top-seeded Louisville. A program-record five Eagles earned All-ACC, led by All-ACC first team pitcher Dan Metzdorf, who was a fifth-round pick for the Chicago White Sox and led the ACC with a 2.30 ERA. Jake Alu (Nationals - 24th round) and Matt Gill (Reds - 27th round) were also chosen during the 2019 MLB Draft.

In 2018, outfielder Chris Galland earned All-ACC third team accolades and Collegiate Baseball News Freshman All-America honors. The 2018 MLB Draft had four of Gambino's players selected with Jake Palomaki (Rays - 18th round), Jacob Stevens (Diamondbacks - 21st round), Brian Rapp (Twins - 26th round) and Dan Metzdorf (Yankees - 38th round).

In 2017, the Eagles returned to the ACC Championship Tournament for the first time since 2010. BC won 10 of its last 15 ACC games with sweeps over Notre Dame and NC State.

Gambino guided the 2016 Eagles to 35 wins, the most since 2005 and third-highest total in program history. They also tallied 13 ACC wins, the most since 2010, while their six conference series victories set a school record. Gambino led the Eagles to a sweep in the Oxford Regional as the third seed to advance to the program's first NCAA Super Regional. BC finished the season in the Top 25 of all four major polls for the first time in program history (15th - D1Baseball, 16th - Baseball America, NCBWA and 21st - USA Today/Coaches Poll).

For his efforts, Gambino was named the 2016 American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) Northeast Region Coach of the Year, a finalist for D1Baseball Coach of the Year and earned a spot on the website's top-10 coaching performances of the season.

Gambino proteges were selected in the first round of the MLB Draft in back-to-back years for the first time in program history in 2015 and 2016. Chris Shaw was selected 31st overall by the San Francisco Giants in 2015 and Justin Dunn was taken 19th overall by the New York Mets in 2016. Overall, five players were drafted in 2016: Dunn, Michael King (12th round), Jesse Adams (14th round), Nick Sciortino (19th round) and Joe Cronin (34th round).

Gambino was an assistant coach for four seasons at Virginia Tech prior to his move to Boston College. He served as the Hokies' recruiting coordinator and worked with the hitters and infielders. In his four years, he saw 15 players get drafted in the MLB Draft, including nine in 2010.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny and Callahan.
