

What You Need To Know

- Rider travels to Penn State Friday at 2 p.m. on B1G+.
- The Broncs have played to an overtime decision in each of their last two an 88-85 win at Delaware on Dec. 20 and a 77-73 loss at home to Penn on Dec. 23.
- Mervin James was named MAAC Player of the Week on Dec. 26 for averaging 22.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.0 blocks per game in the two overtime decisions. He scored 25 points at Delaware and added 20 against Penn.
- Allen Powell scored a season-high 21 points and hit six three-pointers in the Penn setback. He hit four of his five regulation triples in the final four minutes and added another in overtime.
- James leads the MAAC at 19.2 points per game and is third at 7.5 rpg.
- Allen Powell became the 42nd Rider player all-time to score 1,000 career points against Stonehill on Dec. 8. Already a 1,000-point scorer for his collegiate career with 1,604 points, including 620 in two seasons at North Alabama, James is next up on the Rider list with 984 points as a Bronc.
- Penn State is led by Kanye Cleary at 17.3 points per game, while Ace Baldwin Jr. has added 13.9 ppg. and a team-high 4.1 assists and 2.7 steals per game in his first year after following new PSU Head Coach Mike Rhoades to Happy Valley from VCU. Qudus Wahab also averages in double figures at 10.1 ppg. and a team-high 9.0 rebounds and 1.5 blocks per game.
- Some of Rider's most memorable high-major successes have come at Penn State's expense, including wins in each of the last two against PSU. Most recently, Frederick Scott's triple at the buzzer gave the Broncs a 71-70 win on Dec. 22, 2017. Before that, the Jason Thompson-led Broncs defeated Penn State in November 2007 at the Old Spice Classic. Penn State won the first three meetings in January and November 1981 and the 1998 NIT for a 3-2 lead in the series.
- 12th-year Head Coach Kevin Baggett's teams have posted a 180-175 record. Baggett won MAAC Coach of the Year in 2015 and 2018.
- Only John Carpenter (292) and Thomas Leyden (187) have more wins at Rider.

HOLD THE O; WE ARE THE BRONCS

Originally nicknamed the Rough Riders by the father of Rider Athletics, Clair Bee, Rider's nickname later changed to the Broncs. What is a Bronc? It's a Bronco. But you can keep the second o. Why do we call ourselves the Broncs, then? The quick answer is a newspaper writer at least 70 years ago likely wanted a shorter word to fit their headline and called us the Broncs. Enough people actually liked it, so it stuck. Bee was not one who enjoyed the change, later saying he "damn near went through the ceiling" when he first read of the change. Still to this day, broadcasters and public address announcers routinely call us the Broncos in error, setting off a firestorm of tweets to our social media and texts from administration to our SID. So, if you see Greg Ott walking toward you at the under-16 media timeout, you should already know - we're the Broncos, not the Broncos. Thanks in advance for giving his phone a rest.

SCOUTING THE PENN STATE NITTANY LIONS

Penn State is led by Kanye Cleary at 17.3 points per game, while Ace Baldwin Jr. has added 13.9 ppg. and a team-high 4.1 assists and 2.7 steals per game in his first year after following new PSU Head Coach Mike Rhoades to Happy Valley from VCU. Qudus Wahab also averages in double figures at 10.1 ppg. and a team-high 9.0 rebounds and 1.5 blocks per game. After winning their first four games of the year against mid-major competition, the Nittany Lions slipped in their next five to Texas A&M, Butler, VCU, Buckell and Maryland. Penn State has bounced back with wins in two of its last three against Ohio State and Le Moyne, while falling to Georgia Tech in overtime in the span.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. PENN STATE

Some of Rider's most memorable high-major successes have come at Penn State's expense, including wins in each of the last two against the Nittany Lions. Most recently, Frederick Scott's right-wing triple at the buzzer gave the Broncs a 71-70 win on Dec. 22, 2017. Before that, the Jason Thompson-led Broncs defeated Penn State in November 2007 at the Old Spice Classic. Penn State won the first three meetings in January and November 1981 and the 1998 NIT for a 3-2 lead in the series.

POWELL PRODUCES LATE

Allen Powell scored a season-high 21 points and hit six three-pointers in the Penn setback on Dec. 23. He hit four of his five regulation triples in the final four minutes and added another in overtime. It was the third time in his Rider career he made six or more three-point field goals in a single game.

MERV CONTINUES TO SWERVE

Mervin James was named MAAC Player of the Week on Dec. 26 for averaging 22.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.0 blocks per game in the two overtime decisions. He scored 25 points at Delaware and added 20 against Penn. His six blocks on the week moved him into the Top 25 at Rider with 51 career rejections to end the week.

OVERTIME ON REPEAT

Rider played consecutive overtime games on Dec. 20 and Dec. 23, pulling out an 88-85 win at Delaware and falling at home to Penn, 77-73. The Broncs played from ahead in 28:32 of game time against the Blue Hens, while trailing for less than six minutes. On the flip side, the Broncs erased a 16-point deficit and led for just 1:43 against the Quakers.





BREAKTHROUGH VICTORY OVER BLUE HENS

The Broncs scored an 88-85 overtime victory at Delaware, which entered the night at #95 in the NET Rankings, on Dec. 20. Mervin James scored a team-high 25 points, his 11th-straight game in double figures to begin the year, and matched his season high with four blocked shots. Allen Powell added 17 points, including the coast-to-coast lay-up that put Rider on top for good with 42 seconds remaining in the extra session. Tariq Ingraham also contributed a season-high 16 points. The Broncs blocked 10 shots, their first double-digit rejection performance since Feb. 14, 2016 against Niagara. Rider also won its second overtime game in its last three, dating back to last season, after falling in each of the prior five chances.

GOING NATIONAL

A year after ranking 37th nationally among the Division I leaders in rebounding margin, Rider has outrebounded the opposition by an average of 5.6 boards per game (72nd) this year. Included in the mark is the 12th-most offensive rebounds per game (14.67 orpg.) in the nation and the 18th-most rebounds per game (42.25 rpg.). Rider has done it without a single rebounder in the top 130 in the country individually. Mervin James is Rider's top rebounder at 7.5 rpg. (132nd-NCAA), while Tariq Ingraham (6.5 rpg.) and T.J. Weeks Jr. (6.3 rpg.) give the Broncs three of the top nine rebounders in the MAAC.

AP ONE THOUSAND

Allen Powell became the 42nd Bronc all-time to score 1,000 career points on Dec. 8 vs. Stonehill. He achieved the feat in his 120th career game at Rider.

ONE THOUSAND WATCH

In addition to Powell, Mervin James has already eclipsed 1,000 for his collegiate career, but sits 16 points away from 1,000 in a Rider uniform. T.J. Weeks Jr. (939 points) is also likely to reach 1,000 for his college career after amassing 843 points in 85 games at UMass.

MERVIN WITH A PURPOSE

Mervin James posted his second double-double of the year and the 16th of his collegiate career with 20 points and 10 rebounds in the MAAC opener Dec. 1 at Siena. He made 6-of-14 from the floor and 8-of-10 from the free-throw line. He followed up with his eighth through 12th-straight games in double figures. He compiled his third-straight with 20 points or more when he scored 27 points on Dec. 3 vs. Fairfield, before going for 15 points against Stonehill on Dec. 8. After adding 18 on 7-of-12 shooting at Monmouth on Dec. 16, he led the Broncs with 25 points on 10-of-16 shooting at Delaware. He then scored 20 points and grabbed 12 rebounds to add to his double-double total against Penn on Dec. 23.

SNAPPING OUT OF IT

Rider snapped a seven-game losing streak with a 73-56 win over Stonehill on Dec. 8. The losing streak was the Broncs' longest since an eight-game skid spanning the last seven games of the 2005-06 season and the 2006-07 opener.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE DUO

T.J. Weeks Jr. (16 points, 11 rebounds) and Tariq Ingraham (13 points, 10 rebounds) each posted double-doubles in the Broncs' win over Stonehill on Dec. 8. Weeks Jr. accomplished the feat for the fifth time in his career and the second time this season, while Ingraham's double-double was the first of his career.

MR. JAMES' CAREER NIGHT

Mervin James scored a career-high 28 points on 10-of-15 from the floor and 8-of-10 from the free-throw line to go along with eight rebounds before fouling out in 29 minutes, Nov. 28 at Maryland. His previous career high of 25 came for North Alabama on Dec. 6, 2020, against Carver College of the National Christian College Athletic Association.

DOUBLE-DOUBLE NUMBER 15 FOR MERV

Mervin James posted the 15th double-double of his collegiate career Nov. 17 at Duquesne with 15 points and 10 rebounds. It was his first of the season. He narrowly missed a second-straight double-double with 19 points and nine rebounds next time out at Stony Brook on Nov. 20.

NEW CAREER HIGH FOR COREY

Corey McKeithan scored a career-high 18 points on Nov. 13 at Nebraska, eclipsing his previous career high of 13 points on Nov. 20, 2021 at Buffalo. McKeithan hit on 6-of-14 attempts, including 2-of-6 from long range to go along with 4-of-5 from the free-throw line. He also grabbed five rebounds.

SCRAPPY DOUBLE-DOUBLE FOR TJ AT MARQUETTE

T.J. Weeks Jr. posted his first double-double as a Bronc and the fourth of his collegiate career with 14 points and 12 rebounds at nationally-ranked No. 5 Marquette on Nov. 10. Weeks Jr. grabbed five of his career-high-tying 12 rebounds on the offensive glass. His last double-double came for UMass on March 2, 2022, against Fordham.

OPENING VICTORY OVER IMMACULATA

All 14 active Broncs scored, led by 18 points from Mervin James, as Rider defeated Division III Immaculata, 113-67, in their season opener Monday. TJ Weeks Jr. (13), Allen Powell (12), Corey McKeithan (11), DJ Dudley (10) and JT Langston Jr. (10) all scored in double figures.

GREAT EXPECTATIONS

Rider was named the MAAC Preseason Favorite for the second time in program history after being picked first in 2018-19. The Broncs received 117 points and eight first-place votes, ahead of Iona with 108 points and two first-place nods. In addition, Mervin James was named Preseason MAAC Player of the Year. The lone returning All-MAAC player after earning Second Team honors and seeing all of the other 14 honorees graduate or transfer, James joins Ryan Thompson (2009-10) and current Rider Assistant Coach Jason Thompson (2007-08) in being named Preseason MAAC Player of the Year. James averaged 12.9 points (2nd-Team, 14th-MAAC) and 6.8 rebounds (1st-Team, 5th-MAAC) last season. He shot 48.2 percent from the floor (1st-Team, 8th-MAAC) and 82.5 percent from the free-throw line (1st-Team, 5th-MAAC).

POWELL PICKED AMONG LEAGUE'S BEST

Allen Powell joined Mervin James on the Preseason All-MAAC First Team. Powell earned his second-straight Preseason honor after being named to the Third Team in October 2022. He averaged 10.4 points, 2.1 assists (21st-MAAC), 1.5 three-point field goals made (23rd-MAAC) and 0.9 steals (22nd-MAAC) in 33.7 minutes per game (4th-MAAC) last year. He scored a season-high 24 points on 9-of-15 shooting, including 3-of-7 from long range, in a win over Siena on Feb. 24. Powell scored in double figures 16 times and opened the 2023-24 season 68 points away from becoming Rider's 42nd 1,000-point scorer.





RETURNING CAST

In addition to James and Powell, the Broncs return three additional letterwinners, including starting center Tariq Ingraham. After battling through injury and illness in parts of three years at Wake Forest, Ingraham played in all 30 games for the Broncs last season, including 16 starts, averaging 6.4 points and 3.5 rebounds per game. He shot 58.5 percent (72-123) from the floor and 72.7 percent (48-66) from the free-throw line. Ingraham scored in double figures nine times. Corey McKeithan also saw action in all 30 games, including two starts, and will get a chance to be the Broncs' lead guard this season. He averaged 3.4 points, 1.3 rebounds and 1.2 assists in 14.7 minutes per game a year ago. Finally, Anthony McCall saw action in 17 games a year ago and will look to expand his role.

AN EXPERIENCED GROUP

Head Coach Kevin Baggett brought in three players with collegiate experience for his incoming recruiting class in UMass transfer T.J. Weeks Jr., his brother Tyriek, a transfer from Miami Dade College, and JT Langston Jr. from East Los Angeles College. T.J. Weeks Jr. started his collegiate career with a splash, scoring 23 points on 8-of-12 shooting in his collegiate debut and going for 21 points, including 6-of-6 shooting from long range against the Broncs in his fifth game with the Minutemen. Weeks Jr. and his brother, Tyriek, came to Rider to join forces with a familiar face to the family in Rider Assistant Coach Geoff Arnold, who coached their father, Tyrone, in their time at UMass. Tyriek averaged 14.3 points and 7.4 rebounds as a freshman at Miami Dade, while Langston was South Coast Conference Player of the Year for East Los Angeles College, the featured team on Netflix's Last Chance U.

FRESHMAN FIVE

Baggett also brought in five freshmen in Nic Anthony, D.J. Dudley, Ruben Rodriguez, Moustapha Sanoh and Ife West-Ingram. Anthony led Raleigh Christian Academy to the 2022 National Association of Christian Athletes Division 2 National Championship, averaging 25.8 points, 8.8 assists, 7.4 rebounds and 3.4 steals per game as a junior to become the first RCA student-athlete to earn NACA All-America honors. Dudley capped a storied high school career by averaging 25.6 points, 8.7 rebounds and 7.3 assists per game, shooting 52.1 percent from the floor, 40.4 percent from long range and 82.4 percent from the free-throw line for LA Premier Prep. Rodriguez scored 2,008 career points at Reading Senior High School, becoming his school's all-time leader and eclipsing the marks of fellow former Red Knights Stu Jackson (1,563) and Lonnie Walker IV (1,828). He led his team to the Class 6A State Championship twice. Sanoh led Executive Education ACS to four-straight District Championships and State Playoff appearances, routinely flirting with triple-doubles in his senior season. West-Ingram was an All-Friends School League First Team selection, averaging 14.5 points and 8.0 rebounds per game.

DON'T DOUBT US DOWN DOUBLE DIGITS

Rider made a habit of coming back double-digit deficits last season. Coming back from second-half deficits of 18 points at Iona and 11 points against Niagara, Rider won for the 33rd and 34th times in Head Coach Kevin Baggett's 11 years leading the Broncs when trailing by 10 points or more. The number grew to 35 after a comeback from down 14 at Marist on Jan. 27 and further grew to 36 following a comeback from down 10 at Fairfield on Jan. 29. The largest deficit from which the Broncs have come back to win was a 21-point hole at Marist on Feb. 10, 2018. The Broncs' eight-game winning streak started with five-straight halftime deficits.

Two-time MAAC Coach of the Year Kevin Baggett returns for his 12th season as the Rider University head basketball coach in 2023-24. The 2023-24 season is the 18th for Baggett as a member of the Rider staff, serving two as an assistant coach and four as an associate head coach. In the last 17 years, Rider has compiled 288 wins, the third-most in the MAAC behind only Iona (322) and Siena (290). Baggett has coached on the Division I level for 27 years and has been on the Rider staff since the 2006-07 season.

'Baggs' is a two-time MAAC Coach of the Year (2015 and 2018) and has been a finalist for three different National Coach of the Year Awards - the Ben Jobe Award, the Joe B. Hall Award and the Hugh Durham Award.

As Head Coach at Rider, Baggett has led his players to 22 All-MAAC honors and two MAAC Sixth Player of the Year awards. The total increases to 32 including six seasons as an assistant coach, with mentorship of 2008 NBA Lottery Pick Jason Thompson, the 2008 MAAC Player of the Year and two-time MAAC Defensive Player of the Year, to his credit. In addition, he's coached six MAAC All-Rookie Team honorees.

In his first season at Rider, Baggett took a team with just two returning starters and six total letterwinners that was picked to finish seventh in the 10-team Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference in 2013 and finished in second place. With an emphasis on defense, Baggett's Broncs led the MAAC in three-point field goal percentage defense in 2012-13 and was second in overall field goal percentage defense, third in blocks and fourth in points allowed.

He guided the 2012-13 Broncs to a 19-win season, the most by a Rider rookie head coach since Bob Greenwood led Rider to a 20-win season in 1962-63. The only other Rider basketball coach to compile 19 wins in his rookie campaign was the legendary Clair Bee. Included in the 19 wins was Rider's first-ever Division I national postseason tournament victory, a road win at Hartford in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (CIT). The last time Rider had won a game in a national postseason tournament came in 1957, when the Roughriders won a pair of games in the NCAA College Division Championships (now NCAA Division II).

In 2013-14, Coach Baggett took a young team and produced two All-MAAC performers along with a MAAC All-Rookie team selection. His 2013-14 squad was ranked eighth in the nation in three-point field goal percentage and was 51st in Division I in three-point field goals made.

In 2014-15, Baggett took a squad that was picked seventh in the MAAC and guided the team to a 21-win season and a second place finish in the conference, earning MAAC Coach of the Year honors as Rider was selected to play in the College Basketball Invitational tournament. Baggett was a finalist for the Ben Jobe National Coaching Award for the second time in three years and he was named the UPS All-District 1 Coach of the Year.

The Broncs had another very successful campaign in 2016-17, winning 18 games and advancing to the MAAC Championship Quarterfinals. Rider was offered the chance to play in multiple national postseason tournaments, but declined. Seniors Jimmie Taylor and Kahlil Thomas were each named to the All-MAAC Third Team. Rider finished first in the league in rebounds per game (40.3), with three Broncs - Thomas, Norville Carey and Taylor - finishing in the top 20 individually.

2017-18 was a banner year for Baggett and the Broncs. Picked to finish seventh in the MAAC after losing four starters to graduation, the Broncs won 22 games, a share of the MAAC Regular Sea-

son Championship and advanced to the NIT for the second time in program history. Baggett Rider vs. Opponents Under Baggett was named MAAC Coach of the Year for the second time in six years, took NABC All-District 1 Coach and was also a finalist for the Hugh Durham and Ben Jobe Awards. Baggett guided four players to All-MAAC honors, including First Teamer Dimencio Vaughn, Second Teamer Stevie Jordan and Third Team honorees Jordan Allen and Frederick Scott. Scott was named MAAC 6th Player of the Year, while Allen earned All-Rookie Team honors. Vaughn was also selected to the NABC All-District Second Team and earned Second Team All-Met. As a team, Rider led the MAAC in field-goal percentage (.465), offensive rebounds per game (13.2), rebound margin (+2.6), steals per game (7.5), rebounds per game (39.2), turnover margin (+2.2) and turnovers forced per game (15.4). Jordan led the league in assists (5.9) for the second-straight year and was 26th in the nation. Allen's 2.88 three-point field goals made per game ranked 50th in the country, while Vaughn's 1.83 steals per game were 55th. Baggett earned his 100th career win on Jan. 26, 2018, against Saint Peter's.

Stevie Jordan and Frederick Scott repeated as All-MAAC Second and Third Team selections, respectively, in 2018-19, as the Broncs finished tied for second in the MAAC Regular Season Standings. Jordan recorded his 1,000th career point, becoming the 37th player in Rider history to reach the plateau.

In 2019-20, Tyere Marshall joined the ranks of All-MAAC selections, earning Third Team recognition. Dimencio Vaughn returned to All-MAAC First Team form, while Scott earned his third-straight Third Team honor. Vaughn, Scott and Marshall became the 38th, 39th, and 40th Broncs to score their 1,000th points in the cranberry and white. The Broncs compiled an 18-12 overall record and a 12-8 mark in league play. Baggett's Broncs earned the No. 3 seed in the MAAC Championships and were riding a three-game winning streak when the tournament was halted due to COVID-19.

Rider once again won a MAAC Tournament game in 2020-21 under Baggett, taking an opening-round contest against sixth-seeded Canisius. Dwight Murray, Jr. earned All-MAAC Second Team and NABC All-District 1 Second Team honors.

While 2021-22 had its up's and down's, the year ended on a high note, as Baggett led the Broncs to a pair of MAAC Tournament wins, including an upset of top-seeded Iona in the quarterfinals. Dimencio Vaughn earned All-MAAC Second Team honors and Dwight Murray, Jr. was named to the MAAC All-Championship Team after hitting the game-winning shot against Iona with six seconds remaining in regulation.

Baggett led the Broncs to a second-place finish in the MAAC regular season standings in 2022-23, including a win at eventual champion Iona, snapping the Gaels' 21-game home winning streak. Rider ranked among the best rebounding teams in the nation with a +4.6 rebounding margin, good for 37th in Division I. Murray earned his second All-MAAC honor, being named to the First Team, while Mervin James was selected to the Second Team.

Baggett was named the Rider men's basketball head coach at a standing room only press conference on May 24, 2012.

"This was a popular decision," Rider Director of Athletics Don Harnum said at that time. "It was also a convenient decision, but let me make it very clear, this was not a hire of convenience. This was a hire because I firmly believe and am very confident that Kevin is the right person to lead this program in the future."

Baggett hails from Burlington, NJ and was a 2006 inductee into the South Jersey Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Saint Joseph's 1985-86 basketball team that compiled a 26-6 record and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament. He received his bachelor's degree in marketing from Saint Joseph's in June, 1989.

Baggett came to Rider from the University of Maryland Baltimore County, where he served as assistant coach from 2004-06. At UMBC Baggett recruited an America East All-Rookie Team member who went on to earn First Team All-Conference honors three times, as well as a pair of transfers from the Colonial Athletic Association who went on to earn All-America East honors.

Baggett has also served as an assistant coach at James Madison, Howard, Western Kentucky and Coastal Carolina.
