Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Dr. Pat Kraft named Lisa Bervinchak Love the head coach of Penn State's storied field hockey program on February 20, 2023. Bervinchak Love, the long-time associate head coach for the recently retired Char Morett-Curtiss, became the sixth head coach in school history.

Bervinchak Love will begin her first season as the head coach in what will be her 30th year on the Penn State staff. She began her Penn State coaching career in 1994, joining Morett-Curtiss' staff as an assistant coach, was eventually promoted to associate head coach, and has remained a fixture in the Penn State community since.

"We are excited to have Lisa take over the reins of the Penn State field hockey program," said Kraft. "Lisa has been a huge part of the program's success for the last 29 years, working alongside the legendary Char Morett-Curtiss. Lisa's fingerprints are all over this program and she is more than ready to take on the challenge of being a head coach. Her love for Penn State, this program and these student-athletes is evident when you talk to her and her passion shines through in every aspect of her coaching."

"I am truly blessed and honored to be the next head coach for Penn State Field Hockey," said Bervinchak Love. "I want to thank Pat Kraft for giving me this opportunity and Char for all her support, mentoring and the friendship she has given me over the years. Char has been the heart and soul of this program for a long time, and I am truly grateful to have been by her side for 29 of those years. I will do my best to honor Char's legacy and the traditions of Penn State Field Hockey. We will continue to play with heart and strive to be the best both on and off the field. We Are!"

During Bervinchak Love's time on the Penn State staff, the Nittany Lion program cemented itself as a national powerhouse. Since her arrival as an assistant coach, Penn State has achieved national success:

- * 23 NCAA appearances
- * 3 trips to the national semifinals
- * 2 trip to the NCAA title game
- * Seven Big Ten Regular-Season Championships
- * Six Big Ten Tournament Championships

Penn State's student-athletes have achieved heralded success during Bervinchak Love's tenure as an assistant:

- * 30 NFHCA first-team All-Americans
- * 31 second team All-Americans
- * 25 third team All-Americans
- * 70 first-team All-Big Ten selections
- * 6 Big Ten Players of the Year
- * 9 Big Ten Offensive Players of the Year
- * 9 Big Ten Defensive Players of the Year
- * Over 300 Academic All-Big Ten selections
- * Nearly 300 NFHCA National All-Academic honorees

"When I returned to Penn State in 1987 Lisa was a talented right wing," said former head coach Char Morett-Curtiss upon her retirement in February of 2023. "She could weave through a defense with skill and speed and make it look easy. More importantly she displayed a love for the game, a fierce competitive spirit, a motivational work ethic and was highly respected by her teammates. She became a humble captain her senior year and a first-team All-American."

"A few years later, searching for an assistant in 1993, I reached out to Lisa," Morett-Curtiss continued. "She always embodied the traditions, values, and pride of Penn State Field Hockey as a player and alum and I knew that she would be an outstanding coach. Twenty-nine years, as a leader by my side, she has exceeded those expectations and has become a coach who has led Penn State to years of consistent success in the classroom and on the field. She values every aspect of a player's collegiate life, coaches with a keen knowledge of the game, and an understanding to prepare weekly for game day decisions and success. Lisa is a proud representative of Penn State University, who is highly respected in the coaching community and amongst her coaching peers on campus. Our years together were successful, fun and special. With Lisa at the helm, Penn State Field Hockey is primed for success."

As a player, Bervinchak Love played there years at Penn State after transferring from Villanova at the conclusion of her freshman year. A three-year letterwinner (1986-88), Bervinchak Love earned a lengthy list of honors during her playing career:

- * First-team NFHCA All-American
- * First-team All-Atlantic 10
- * Atlantic-10 All-Tournament Team
- * Atlantic-10 Player of the Week
- * 28 career goals in three seasons at Penn State
- * Team captain as a senior

Following her graduation from Penn State in 1989, Bervinchak Love continued to play field hockey at the national level. In 1991, she helped guide her team to a Silver Medal at the Olympic Sports Festival in Los Angeles. Bervinchak Love graduated from Penn State with a degree in health policy and administration. She began her professional career as an elementary school teacher in Penn Manor School District and assisted head coaches in field hockey and basketball. She continued teaching in a number of elementary schools before coming to Penn State as an assistant coach.

She is married to Steve Love, a Penn State alum and senior graphic designer in Penn State Athletics. They have two daughters, Taylor and Kelsey (a junior on this year's Nittany Lion team).

Penn State's Laura Gebhart was promoted to the position of associate head coach with the Nittany Lion field hockey program in March of 2023. Gebhart moved up to fill the slot formerly held by new head coach Lisa Bervinchak Love.

Gebhart, a former Nittany Lion All-American as a player, will begin her third season on the Penn State staff in the fall of 2023. She played for former Penn State head coach Char Morett-Curtiss and returned to Happy Valley to coach with her former mentor. With Bervinchak Love taking over after Morett-Curtiss retired in February, Gebhart has been elevated to the position once held by Bervinchak Love.

A 2015 Penn State graduate, Gebhart joined the Nittany Lion coaching staff prior to the 2021 season. She came to Penn State after serving as head coach at Bryant University and a volunteer assistant at the University of Vermont.

Gebhart was a four-time All-American at Penn State, including first team honors in 2014. She earned first team All-Big Ten laurels four times (2011-14) and was a CoSIDA First Team Academic All-American as well. Gebhart left Penn State with 91 career points off 23 goals and 45 assists. She helped lead Penn State to four straight NCAA tournaments, including three trips to the NCAA quarterfinals. Penn State won 64 games during her career, two Big Ten Regular Season crowns and two Big Ten Tournament titles during her four years as a player.

Former Penn State All-American Ayla Halus-Johnson has been named assistant coach of the Nittany Lion field hockey team, joining first-year head coach Lisa Bervinchak Love's coaching staff. Halus-Johnson was a standout goalkeeper at Penn State from 2009-2012. She returns to Happy Valley after spending the last two seasons as an assistant coach at William and Mary.

Halus-Johnson served as an assistant at William and Mary from 2021 through the spring of 2023. Prior to her tenure at W&M, she was an assistant coach at Colgate for four years, briefly serving as interim head coach during her time with the Raiders. She served as the goalkeepers coach at Big Ten foe Indiana for two seasons in 2015 and 2016 after beginning her coaching career as a volunteer assistant at nearby Lock Haven University. Halus-Johnson joins the Penn State staff with over a decade of collegiate coaching experience.

"I am excited to welcome Ayla back to Penn State as part of our coaching staff," said Bervinchak Love. "As a player she was one of Penn State's best goalkeepers, earning All-America honors and leading us to two Big Ten Tournament Championships. As a coach, she brings a wealth of experience and knowledge to our defense and goalies. Ayla has a great work ethic and a passion for coaching. She will have a positive impact on our athletes both on and off the field."

Halus-Johnson was a two-time second team All-American goalie during her days as a Nittany Lion, earning the honor in both 2010 and 2011. Halus-Johnson was a first team All-Big Ten and first team NFHCA All-Region pick twice as well. She was the national leader in save percentage in 2010, posting a stellar .826 mark that year and helped lead Penn state to back-to-back conference tournament titles in 2011 and 2012 under former mentor Char Morett-Curtiss.

An outstanding student-athlete during per playing days, Halus-Johnson was a four-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree and a three-time NFHCA National All-Academic selection. After graduating from Penn State in 2012 with a biology degree, she earned her master's in education from Penn State in 2015. Halus-Johnson was a member of the U.S. National Indoor Team in 2014-15. She and her husband Chris were married in 2021 and recently welcomed their first child.

Bervinchak Love was elevated to head coach earlier this year when Morett-Curtiss announced her retirement. Gebhart, Bervinchak Love's coaching colleague under Morett-Curtiss, was promoted to associate head coach as well.

Former Penn State standout and State College native Amanda Dinunzio has been named an assistant coach for the Penn State field hockey team. Dinunzio rounds out new head coach Lisa Bervinchak Love's staff as the third assistant coach. She played at Penn State from 2011-14.

Dinunzio served as a volunteer assistant for Penn State during the 2018 and 2019 seasons after retiring from international play. She competed for Penn State from the 2011-12 academic year through the 2014-15 campaign and was part of two Big Ten regular season championship squads and two Big Ten Tournament champions.

She was a four-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree (2012-2015), a Big Ten Distinguished Scholar (2012-2015) and a four-time member of the NFHCA National All-Academic Team (2011-2014). Dinunzio lettered all four years at Penn State and played in nearly 60 games, starting over 20.

Dinunzio comes back to Happy Valley after spending the last few years in Las Vegas where she served as a performance coach at Elevate Sport Performance and Healthcare and as a Raiders Ambassador for the National Football League's Las Vegas Raiders. Prior to her move to Las Vegas, she served as the volunteer assistant at Penn State as well as working as the Field Hockey Director at Nittany Valley Sports Centre.

A State College native who played at State College High School, Dinunzio joined the U.S. National Team in 2016 and retired from international play in 2018 with 11 international caps. She also played for HC Rotterdam Dames First Team in The Netherlands. Dinunzio graduated from Penn State in 2015 with a bachelor's degree in Spanish and a 3.84 grade point average. She is currently working towards her athletic development specialist certificate at the University of Florida.

"I am thrilled to welcome Amanda back to Penn State and our coaching staff," said Bervinchak Love. "She will bring a lot of experience and knowledge of the game to our team and will have a positive impact right from the start. Her energy and passion for the game and Penn State are contagious and the team is going to love her."

Miriam Powell begins her third season as the director of operations for the Penn State field hockey team. Powell, former director of community outreach for the Penn State women's basketball team, came to Penn State from the Jana Marie Foundation.

Powell graduated from Gustavus Adolphus College in 1995 and graduated from the University of Minnesota's Post-Baccalaureate Teacher Licensure Program in Social Studies Education in 1997.

She began her professional career as a teacher at Holy Trinity High School in Winsted, Minn. in 1997. She spent a year at Vision Quest Alternative Education Program in South Mountain, Pa. and then moved on to The Milton Hershey School. Powell spent nearly a decade as a teacher in the Mechanicsburg School district as well.

Powell was the director of community outreach for the Penn State women's basketball team from 2016 to 2019 and spent the past year as the community engagement manager at the Jana Marie Foundation.

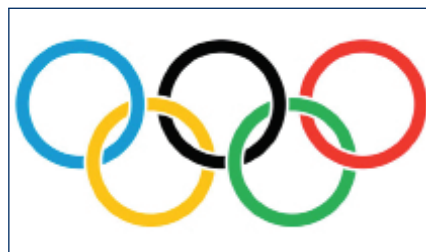
