#### ADAM KASZUBOWSKI Interim Head Coach / Associate Head Coach

#### **4TH YEAR OVERALL**

Adam Kaszubowski is serving as Penn State's Interim Head Coach. Kaszubowski is in his fourth year at Penn State coaching the Penn State fencing teams and entered the season in his first season as Penn State's Associate Head Coach.

Born in Poland, he earned his master's degree in physical education with a specialization in fencing from the Academy of Physical Education in Gdansk.

Kaszubowski has been involved with fencing for more than 30 years, first as an athlete and then as a coach and referee. As a member of the Polish men's foil national team, he competed at many national and international competitions. He was a bronze individual and team gold medalist at the 1994 Polish Cadet Championships, as well as a silver team medalist at both the 1996 and 1997 Polish Junior Championships.

After his tenure with the Polish national team, Kaszubowski was Head Coach for the Egyptian men's and women's foil teams from 2013 to 2016. In addition to qualifying for the Rio 2016 Olympic games, his team also had successes at the African Championships: 1st place in Algiers 2016, Cairo 2015, Cairo 2014 and Cape Town 2013.



### **COACHING STAFF**



ALEXEI SINTCHINOV Assistant Coach

9TH YEAR

Coach Sintchinov is entering his ninth year as assistant coach. Sintchinov has an extensive fencing resume and has been a professional coach since 1976. He also has the recognition of being a Master of Sport in Fencing.

During his international coaching tenure, Sintchinov was the head coach of the Belarus, Egypt, and Tunisia National Teams. In 1991, Sintchinov was named Honored Coach of Belarus for his time with the team. He also served as the head coach of the 2000 Egypt Olympic Team.

Sintchinov was named the USFCA Men's Team National Assistant Coach of the Year in April of 2021.

Sintchinov was a sought after private and club coach from 2004-2011 before making the move into collegiate coaching, joining the Ohio State Staff in 2011. Sintchinov spent three years in Columbus as an assistant coach, helping guide the program to the 2012 NCAA Championships. Sintchinov studied at the Belarussian State Institute of Physical Culture and Sport, specializing in coaching and teaching.



**OLA SHELTON** Assistant Coach

**1ST YEAR** 

Olympian Alkesandra 'Ola' Shelton is in her first year as an assistant coach with the Penn State men's and weomn's fencing teams. Ola has competed in four Olympic games and has a number of international medals on her resume.

Shelton was part of saber fencing teams that won bronze, silver and gold at the European Championships in the early 2000s. She won an individual European Fencing Championship gold in 2004 and a silver again in 2011. Shelton competed for Poland in International Military competitions as well and is now competing for the United States internationally. Shelton was the first woman to ever represent Poland at the Olympic games in women's saber. She participated in the 2004, 2008, 2012 and 2016 Olympics. Shelton was a sparing partner for Team USA at the 2020 Olympic Games (held in 2021 in Tokyo).

For the past 10-plus years, Shelton has been a coach at the Oregon Fencing Alliance and has been a member of the US National Team in recent years. Prior to that she spent a year as a coach at the All-American Fencing Academy in North Carolina.

Shelton has also been a fitness trainer as well as a member of the Polish Military, earning the rank of Kapral. She is a 2007 graduate of the Academy of Physical Education in Warsaw, Poland, earning a Combined Studies BA and a Master of Physical Education. A few years later, she earned a postgraduate studies degree in International Relations and Diplomacy from the Collegium Civitas in Warsaw. Shelton is married to Bradley Shelton, and they have one son, Henry.
