## HEAD COACH DENISE ST. PIERRE



Denise St. Pierre is entering her 25th season as the Penn State head women's golf coach. St. Pierre draws from her experience as a collegiate golfer, as well as a PGA teaching professional to help her student-athletes reach their full potential.

In addition to coaching the Nittany Lions, St. Pierre has also coached in international competitions throughout her coaching career.

In August 2004, St. Pierre helped coach the U.S. team at the World University Games in Thailand where they won the gold medal. Penn State's Katie Futcher captured the individual title in that event.

In June 1999, St. Pierre was selected by the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA) to coach the U.S. team at the U.S./Japan Collegiate Golf Championships in Chiba, Japan, where the Americans captured their fourth consecutive title.

In its February 2002 issue, *Golf for Women* magazine named St. Pierre to its "Top 50 Women PGA/LPGA Instructors" list.

St. Pierre has served as President of the NGCA. While president, she led the NGCA in volunteer work in New Orleans in relief of Hurricane Katrina. At the annual NGCA convention, that had to be moved from New Orleans to Tahoe, Nevada, St. Pierre introduced an idea to the membership that called for as many golf programs around the country as possible to conduct fundraisers to raise money for the New Orleans Area Habitat for Humanity. Through the efforts of the Nittany Lion women's golf team as well as those by more than 30 other women's golf programs around the country, the NGCA raised \$60,000 to build a home for a displaced family in New Orleans. The efforts of the NGCA culminated when St. Pierre and several of her colleagues traveled to New Orleans and volunteered to help finish building the house that they sponsored through the Habitat for Humanity.

In 2006, St. Pierre served, for the second time, as the assistant coach of the United States women's golf team at the World University Games held in Torino, Italy. St. Pierre also served as the coach in 2004. She led the team to a gold medal for the second straight time.

A native of Syracuse, N.Y., St. Pierre chose Penn State for its academic and athletic reputation. As a Nittany Lion herself, St. Pierre's team won several team titles as well as qualified for the NCAA Championships.

After her graduation in 1983, St. Pierre completed an apprenticeship with the Professional Golfers Association (PGA) at the Innisbrook Resort in Tarpon Springs, Fla. In 1985, she returned to Penn State as an assistant coach for both the men's and women's golf teams under Mary Kennedy-Zierke. She earned the 1991 Mid-Atlantic/East Region Coach of the Year honors.

From 2000-04, St. Pierre served as secretary for the NGCA, She later became the president. St. Pierre has been a guest lecturer for the PGA teaching and coaching summit, as well as the National Golf Foundation.

A Class A member of the PGA, the Nittany Lion coach has taught in New York and Florida and is currently the director of instruction at the Penn State Golf Courses. During the winter, St. Pierre teaches a golf conditioning class for the local community. She also serves as the director for the Penn State summer golf schools, and co-directs five junior camps. In addition to teaching, St. Pierre is the author of *Golf Fundamentals*, an instructional book for recreational players.

"It is about them being balanced and how we can encompass academics and personal growth in order for our players to reach their potential," St. Pierre says.

Players face challenges both on and off the course that affect how they play their game. As a coach, she believes she must be aware of those factors in order to help the player cope on the course.

"You have to first know what you want," she adds. "I believe every player has more potential than they realize. It is my job to help draw that potential out of them."

St. Pierre repeatedly stresses the importance of academic success to her players. After the 2013-14 season, the team received the Milt Morgan Jr. award, given to the team with highest average GPA at Penn State. In addition, three of St. Pierre's players were named WGCA All-American scholars.



In the 2013-14 season, St. Pierre also saw her players excel on the course as her top two players, Christina Vosters and Ellen Ceresko, both qualified for the NCAA East Regionals as individuals. In Tallahassee, Vosters and Ceresko finished T-36th and T-41st, respectively.

“In order to uphold the Penn State tradition of academic and athletic excellence, we provide each player with a safe environment to play the game at the highest level while balancing her time in the classroom,” says St. Pierre. Every coach has a different strategy on how to run a team. St. Pierre’s strategy is not just centered around golf but around education and dreams.

“I try to be supportive of student-athletes in both their athletic and academic endeavors while here at Penn State,” says the 1991 Mid-Atlantic/East Region Coach of the Year.

She understands that golf is not her student-athletes’ entire life. Each student-athlete is also at Penn State to receive an education and a life experience.

“My main job as a coach is to discuss what our team’s dreams and aspirations are while we’re here. My goals are to help them reach theirs. I am a vehicle to allow my players to get where they want to go.”

She wants her players to improve themselves in all aspects of life- as a competitor, an athlete and a person- during their time at Penn State.

This Class A teaching professional hopes that her players can develop “using my background as a player, I can display the right attitude and the right actions that I want them to follow.”

St. Pierre prepares her players for tournaments, both mentally and physically. The most important thing for her is to have as much information about a tournament, including climate, environment, grass, layout of the golf course and the competition.

Physically, she has her players practice the things that are most likely to occur at those sites.

“The more you know about the situation, the better you can prepare yourself both mentally and physically. The fewer the surprises, the more confident we can be,” says the Nittany Lion head coach.

Head coach Denise St. Pierre named Andrew Breon assistant coach prior to the spring 2012 season.

The Spring Mills, Pa. native and local Penns Valley Area High School graduate joined the staff after holding numerous positions at Penn State, including PGA apprentice at the Penn State University Golf Courses.

Breon served as an assistant golf professional in 2011 under the university's director of golf, Joe Hughes. Breon's position included group instruction, club repair, staff supervision, merchandising and employee scheduling.

Prior to that, the Lock Haven University graduate worked at Penn State's Ashenfelter Multi-Sport Complex, coordinating practices and assisting with equipment duties. In 2009, he was an assistant to the Penn State Sport Camps.

On the links, Breon has been involved in many Penn State golf tournaments. He volunteered at Penn State's Coaches vs. Cancer Celebrity Golf Tournament in 2007 and 2008, assisting in the preparation of the course for the tournament. In 2008, he put together the marketing plan and assisted in the preparation and execution of the Big Ten Women's Golf Championships.

In 2008 and 2009, Breon organized the Intercollegiate Golf Tournament at Penn State and the Football Letterman's golf outing, arranging groups, preparing the course and supervising play. Breon also helped with the 2008 Penn State Men's Rutherford Invitational in Farmington, Pa.

A 2008 graduate of Lock Haven University, Breon earned his degree in sports administration with a coaching emphasis and verification.

Like Coach St. Pierre, Breon emphasizes the importance of academic success. Since Breon joined the women's golf staff in 2012, the Nittany Lions have had an astonishing academic record. Overall, Breon has nurtured four Academic All-Americans and nine Academic All-Big Ten student-athletes in his time at Penn State.

Shot a 75 (plus-3) in the third round of the Nittany Lion Invitational to achieve a three-round score of 240 (plus-24). Lion Career

Fall 2017: Competed in all five tournaments during the fall season with a 73.07 stroke average during 14 rounds and a low-round score of 69 (-3). Took home individual first place at the William & Mary Invitational with a three-round score of 218 (plus-2). Shot even to par in the first round, one-under 71 in the second round and two-over 75 in the third round of the Nittany Lion Invitational for an eight place finish. Finished even to par in three rounds at the Blue Hen Invitational, bringing home a second place finish.

2016-17: Competed in all 10 matches during her sophomore season finishing with a 76.14 stroke average during 29 rounds with a low-round score of 68. Had a third place finish in the Nittany Lion Invitational with a career low score of 68 (-4) in the first round and an overall score of 218 (plus-2). Earned her second top three finish when she tied for second in the River Landing Classic with a three- round score of 218 (plus-2). Completed the Big Ten Championship with a three-round score 231 (plus-15) which left her tied for 40th. Ended the season at the Lady Buckeye where she made par, 72, in the first round and finished tied for fifth overall.

2015-16: Competed in all 10 tournaments throughout the season, leading the team in average round score with a 74.31. Rogowicz finished 2nd at (+1) in the Nittany Lion Invitational, the best finish by anyone on the team in 2015-16. Named Big Ten golfer of the week on September 9th. Shot her career low round score of 69 (-3) in the second round of the East and West Match. Had two top 10 finishes and shot eight rounds under par.

Junior/Amateur Career

Three AJGA top ten finishes her senior year, with two of those finishes being second at the AJGA Philadelphia Junior (Girls) and third place at the AJGA Junior at Talbot (Girls). Rogowicz won the 2011 AJGA Junior at Basking Ridge with a 10-over and managed another victory at the 2014 AJGA Junior hosted by Morgan Hoffman with a six-over.

**Fall 2017:** Competed in all five tournaments during the fall season with a 74.00 stroke average during 14 rounds and a low-round score of 69 (-3). Finished tied for eighth in the William & Mary Invitational with a three-round score of 224 (plus-8). Tied for second with a three-round score of two-under 215 in the Nittany Lion Invitational. Shot her season-low round (69) in the third round of the Blue Hen Invitational. She finished the tournament in fourth place with a three-round score of 220 (plus-4).

**2016-17:** Competed in all 10 matches during her sophomore season with a 75.93 stroke average during 28 rounds and a low-round score of 71. Finished tied for 10th in the Nittany Lion Invitational where she achieved a three-round score of 225 (plus-9). Shot under par, 71 (-1), in the second round of the Cougar Classic. Tied for 11th during the River Landing Classic where she finished with a three-round score of 222 (plus-6). Lion Career

Fall 2017: Competed in all five tournaments during the fall seasons with a 74.64 stroke average during 14 rounds and a low-round score of 68 (-4). Tied for eighth at the William & Mary Invitational with a three-round score 224 (plus-8). Shot a second 224 (plus-8) in the Nittany Lion Invitational ending in the top 20 with the 20th place slot. Finished even to par (216) to tie for fourth at the Bettie Lou Evans Invitational. Shot her season-low round of 68 (-4) in the second round of the same tournament.

2016-17: Competed in all 10 matches during her sophomore season finishing with a team best 74.72 stroke average during 20 rounds with a low-round score of 70. Placed fifth in the Nittany Lion Invitational with a three-round score of 220 (plus-4). Shot her lowest score of the season, 70 (-2), during the first round in the Cougar Classic. Finished tied for 13th during the Hurricane Invitational with a three-round score of 219 (plus-3). Achieved a three-round score of 220 (plus-4) during the River Landing Classic where she tied for sixth. Finished out the Big Ten Championship tied for 25th with a three-round score of 228 (plus-4).

2015-16: Competed in all 10 tournaments throughout the 2015-16 season, second on the team in average round score with a 74.86. Finished in the top 10 three times, with her most notable finish coming in the Big Ten Championship when she placed tied for 9th with a score of 213 (-3). Finished 3 tournaments under par, only player to do so. Tied for team-high 8 round scores under par. Waller shot a 68 (-4) her career low round score, and lowest round on the team for the season in the 3rd round of the Landfall Tradition.

Junior/Amateur Career

Waller won numerous AJGA events as a junior player including the 2011 Lessings AJGA Classic and the 2012 Junior All-Star at Penn State. Finished second in the New Era Junior Championship (Girls) and third in the PGA Junior Series at Port St. Lucie (Girls).
