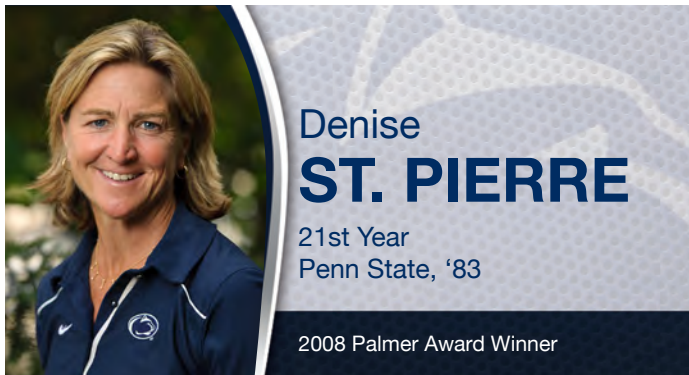

HEAD COACH DENISE ST. PIERRE



Experience is the best teacher...

Denise St. Pierre is entering her 21st season as the Penn State head women's golf coach. St. Pierre draws from her experience as a collegiate golfer as well as a PGA teaching professional to help her student-athletes reach their full potential.

In addition to coaching the Nittany Lions, St. Pierre has also coached in international competitions throughout her coaching career.

In August of 2004, St. Pierre helped coach the U.S. team at the World University Games in Thailand where they won the gold medal. Penn State's Katie Fitcher captured the individual title in that event.

In June of 1999, St. Pierre was selected by the NGCA to coach the U.S. team at the U.S./Japan Collegiate Golf Championships in Chiba, Japan, where the Americans captured their fourth consecutive title.

In its February 2002 issue, Golf for Women magazine named St. Pierre to its "Top 50 Women PGA/LPGA Instructors" list.

St. Pierre has served as President of the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). While president, she led the membership in volunteer work in New Orleans in relief of Hurricane Katrina. At the annual NGCA convention that had to be moved from New Orleans to Tahoe, Nevada, St. Pierre introduced an idea to the membership that called for as many golf programs as possible around the country to conduct fundraisers to raise money for the New Orleans Area Habitat for Humanity. Through the efforts of the Nittany Lion women's golf team as well as those by more than 30 other women's golf programs around the country, the NGCA raised \$60,000 to build a home for a displaced family in New Orleans. The efforts of the NGCA culminated last June when St. Pierre and several of her colleagues traveled to New Orleans and volunteered to help finish building the house that they sponsored through the Habitat for Humanity.

St. Pierre has served as the assistant coach of the United States women's golf team at the World University Games held in Torino, Italy for the second time after also serving as the coach in 2004. She led the team to a gold medal for the second straight time as well.

A native of Syracuse, N.Y., St. Pierre chose Penn State for its academic and athletic reputation. As a Nittany Lion herself, St. Pierre's team won several team titles as well as qualifying for the NCAA Championships.

After her graduation in 1983, St. Pierre completed an apprenticeship with the Professional Golfers Association (PGA) at the Innisbrook Resort in Tarpon Springs, Fla. In 1985, she returned to the University as an assistant coach for both the men's and women's golf teams under Mary Kennedy-Zierke. She earned 1991 Mid-Atlantic/East Region Coach-of-the-Year honors.

From 2000-2004, St. Pierre served as secretary for the National Golf Coaches Association, prior to becoming the president of the NGCA following her time as secretary. St. Pierre has been a guest lecturer for the PGA teaching and coaching summit as well as the National Golf Foundation.

A Class A member of the PGA, the Nittany Lion coach has taught in

New York and Florida and is currently the director of instruction at the Penn State golf courses. During the winter, St. Pierre teaches a golf conditioning class for the local community, as well as instructing health and human development classes at Penn State. She also serves as the director for the Penn State summer golf schools, and co-directs five junior camps. In addition to all that, St. Pierre is the author of Golf Fundamentals, an instructional book for recreational players.

St. Pierre offers more than just experience to her athletes; she brings with her knowledge of the sport and familiarity with the University. She had a very successful career at Penn State and looks forward to more growth and success for the Nittany Lion women. St. Pierre wants to provide life guidance as well as athletic guidance.

"It is about them being balanced and how we can encompass academics and personal growth in order for our players to reach their potential," St. Pierre says.

Players face challenges both on and off the course that affect how they play their game. As a coach, she believes she must be aware of those factors in order to help the player cope on the course.

"You have to know first what you want," she adds. "I believe every player has more potential than they realize. It is my job to help draw that potential out of them."

St. Pierre wants her players to graduate from the program not only better golfers but also better people.

"In order to uphold the Penn State tradition of academic and athletic excellence," says St. Pierre, "we provide each player with a safe environment to play the game at the highest level while balancing her time in the classroom."





Every coach has a different strategy on how to run a team. Denise St. Pierre's is not just centered around golf but around education and dreams.

"I try to be supportive of student-athletes in both their athletic and academic endeavors while here at Penn State," says the 1991 Mid-Atlantic/East Region Coach-of-the-Year.

She understands that golf is not her student-athletes' entire life. Each student-athlete is also at Penn State to receive an education and a life experience.

"My main job as a coach is to discuss what our [team's] dreams and aspirations are while we're here...my goals are to help them reach theirs...I am a vehicle to allow my players to get where they want to go."

She wants her players to improve themselves in all aspects of life- as a competitor, an athlete and a person- during their time at Penn State.

This Class A teaching professional hopes that her players can develop "using my background as a player...I can display the right attitude and the right actions that I want them to follow."

St. Pierre prepares her players for tournaments, both mentally and physically. The most important thing for her is to have as much information about a tournament, including climate, environment, grass, layout of the golf course and the competition.

Physically, she has her players practice the things that are most likely to occur at those sites.

"The more you know about the situation, the better you can prepare yourself both mentally and physically. The fewer the surprises, the more confident we can be," says the Nittany Lion head coach.

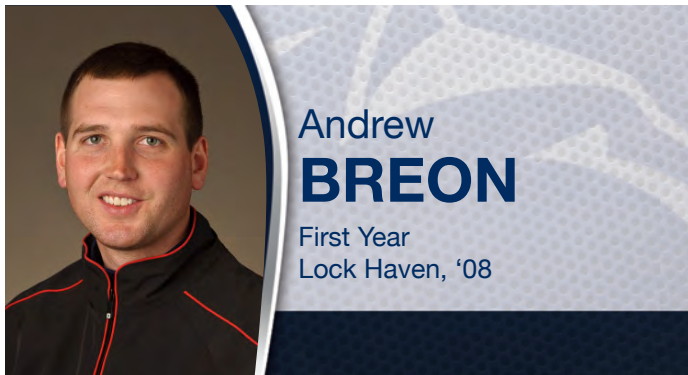

Breon begins second season as Nittany Lion assistant...

Head coach Denise St. Pierre named Andrew Breon assistant coach prior to the spring 2012 season.

The Spring Mills, Pa., native and local Penns Valley Area High School graduate joined the staff after holding numerous positions at Penn State, including PGA apprentice at the Penn State University Golf Courses.

Breon served as an assistant golf professional 2011 under the University's director of golf, Joe Hughes. Breon's position included group instruction, club repair, staff supervision, merchandising and employee scheduling.

Prior to that, the Lock Haven University graduate worked at Penn State's Ashenfelter Multi-Sport Complex, coordinating practices and assisting with equipment duties. In 2009, he was an assistant to the Penn State Sport Camps.

On the links, Breon has been involved in many Penn State golf tournaments. He volunteered at Penn State's Coaches vs. Cancer Celebrity Golf Tournament in 2007 and 2008, assisting in the preparation of the course and for the tournament. In 2008, he put together the marketing plan and assisted in the preparation and execution of the Big Ten women's golf tournament.

In 2008 and 2009, Breon organized the Intercollegiate Golf Tournament at Penn State and the Football Letterman's golf outing, arranging groups, preparing the course and supervising play. Breon also helped with the 2008 Penn State Men's Rutherford Invitational in Farmington, Pa.

A 2008 graduate, Breon earned his degree in sports administration with a coaching emphasis and verification.

2011-12: Lavin competed in 15 rounds during her junior season and had an 80.5 average for the season ... had a season-best round of 74 in the Pinehurst Challenge ... scored a 78 in the Western Tri-Match for third place ... tied for 48th in the Nittany Lion Invitational after carding a 159 in two rounds ... totaled a 230 in the Pinehurst Challenge to finish in the top 50, tying for 48th.

2010-11: After 16 rounds her freshman year, Lavin saw a decrease in playing time as a sophomore, competing in three rounds...competed in the Nittany Lion Invitational, carding a career-best round of 73...finished in a tie for 41st place at the Nittany Lion Invitational.

2009-10: Ransone emerged early as a freshman...she played in all 28 rounds...had a team-best 78.1 average...tied a team season-low round with a 71 at the Nittany Lion Invitational...also carded two rounds of 72, once at the Lady Puerto Rico and once at the Big Ten Championships...became the first Nittany Lion since Evelyn Paik in 2006 to win an individual title at the Nittany Lion Invitational with a three-round score of 218...her score of 218 in the Nittany Lion Invitational became the second-best 54-hole score in team history behind Sara Doell's 215 in 1999...led the team with the best score in four of the 10 tournaments.

2011-12: Ceresko competed in three tournaments before an injury sidelined her for the remainder of the 2011-12 season ... had an average of 75.1 after three tournaments ... had a career-best score of 72 at the Nittany Lion Invitational ... had a team-best sixth place finish at the Cardinal Cup.

2010-11: Ceresko had a tremendous freshman campaign, accumulating the second-best average on the team of players who participated in more than 20 rounds with a 78.3...had best round of 73 at the Starmount Fall Classic...one of three players to finish in the top five in a tournament with tie for fifth place at the Starmount Fall Classic...had a final score of 147 at the Starmount Fall Classic, good for a tie for the 10th-best two-round score in school history...one of six players on the team to have notched 20 or more rounds. Vosters competed in 27 rounds this season ... led the team with a 76.6 average with players who competed in 20 or more rounds ... recorded a career-best score of 72 in both the Nittany Lion Invitational and the Pinehurst Challenge ... had two top 10 finishes, tying for eighth in both the Nittany Lion Invitational and the Hoosier Fall Invitational ... was second on the team at the Big Ten Championship.

2010-11: Vosters competed in 21 rounds this season, one of six golfers on the team to do so...had the fourth-best average on the team with players who participated in 20 or more rounds with a 78.9 average...recorded her career-best score of 73 at the Nittany Lion Invitational...had one top-10 finish as she tied for eighth place at the C&F Bank Intercollegiate...had the best finish on the team at the Big Ten Championships with a four-round score of 305 and a tie for 23rd place...the 305 tied for the fourth-best four-round score in Penn State history. Junior/Amateur Career: The Bethany Beach, Del., native comes to Penn State with a long list of junior golf accolades...finished first in numerous tours, including wins in the PGA Junior Callaway Series and the International Junior Golf Tour...notched two career wins in the Pinehurst 'Winternational' Junior Series...recorded a combined 16 top-10 finishes in those tournaments, along with American Junior Golf Association events and Future Collegian World Tour Events...took home the first place crown at the 2009 Delaware Junior Girls' Championship and finished as the runner up in the 2009 Delaware Women's Amateur, shooting a 69 in the final round, setting a new course record...represented Delaware at the 2009 USGA National Team Championship, finishing in 27th place out of a field of 118.

Archambault was one of two players to compete in 29 rounds last season and ranked fourth on the team with a 78.4 average ... had a career-best score of 71 at the Pinehurst Challenge ... had four top 15 finishes, including a second place finish in the Western Tri-Match, a 13th place finish in the Big Ten Championships, and two 15th place finishes at both the Nittany Lion Invitational and the Hoosier Fall Invitational. Summer 2012: Archambault captured the amateur championship at the Nivo Women's Provincial Match Play Championship.

Junior/Amateur Career: A native of St-Jean-sur-Richelieu, Que., Archambault brings a long list of junior golf accolades...comes to Penn State as the No. 1 ranked golfer in Quebec and the No. 16 ranked golfer nationally...picked up three victories in the summer of 2010, coming at the East Coast Junior Championship, the Provincial Junior Championship and the Provincial Junior Match Play Championship.
