# The Harry Groves Spiked Shoe Invitational:

The annual Harry Groves Spiked Shoe Invitational event is named after long-time Nittany Lion men's track and field and cross-country coach Harry Groves. Groves spent nearly forty years at the helm of the men's program, beginning in 1968 until retiring at the conclusion of the 2006 track and field season. Groves is a 2001 USTCA Hall of Fame inductee, was named national Coach of the Year on five occasions and is a 26-time Regional Coach of the Year honoree. The Invitational is hosted each fall and features high school and collegiate races.

# **Team Entry Limit:**

Entries are **LIMITED** to 15 per gender in the collegiate races.

# **Entry Deadline:**

Tuesday, September 10<sup>th</sup> @ 11:59 p.m.; Entries will be open on DirectAthletics on Tuesday, August 1<sup>st</sup> @ 12:01 AM.

# **Entry Fee:**

**Single Gender:** \$300 per team (\$600 for combined gender programs);

Non-Scoring Teams (Less than five athletes) & Unattached Athletes: \$35 per individual

Entry Fee Deadline: All Entries fees will be paid online via DirectAthletics! \*\* NO ENTRY FEES will be accepted at the meet. \*\*

# **Unattached Athletes:**

To be considered please contact **Jenna Gearing** (<u>jig5364@psu.edu</u>) via email prior to Monday, August 26<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Proof of performance (within the last year) MUST be included in the entry request. Standards are the following:

Women - 19:00 or better for 5k | Men - 16:30 or better for 5k

#### **Team Camps/Course Guidelines**

Please keep team camps AWAY from the starting line. Team camps should be on the field below the starting line (between the starting line and the parking lot) and away from all fairways and greens. Please avoid all greens and fairways in general. PLEASE inform any parents, fans, etc., of this as well. You can contact Doug Linebaugh from Best Event Rentals (814-238-3037) to purchase a tent for your team camp. Please NOTE - NO TEAM CAMPS OR WARMUPS will be permitted on fenced in rugby fields.

#### **Results**

Results can be found on PTTiming.com. They will be posted on TFRRS & GoPSUsports.com at the conclusion of the day. We are required to record all DNF's in the official race results. If you have individuals who will not be competing, please return their bibs to the packet pick-up tent before the race starts so that they aren't incorrectly marked as DNF.
