The Harry Groves Spiked Shoe Invitational

The annual Harry Groves Spiked Shoe Invitational event is named after long-time Nittany Lion men's track and field and cross-country coach: Harry Groves. Groves spent nearly forty years at the helm of the men's program, beginning in 1968 until retiring at the conclusion of the 2006 track and field season. Groves is a 2001 USTCA Hall of Fame inductee, was named national Coach of the Year on five occasions and is a 26-time Regional Coach of the Year honoree. The Invitational is hosted each fall and features high school and collegiate races.

Entry Form

Teams must submit entry form to Director of Operations, Jenna Gearing, by <u>Friday. August 23rd</u> to be eligible for competition. Entry forms can be emailed (jig5364@psu.edu).

** We will accept up to 25 teams per gender. You will be notified via email of your entry status following receipt of the entry form. **

Entry Procedure

All entries need to be done online through Direct Athletics - <u>www.directathletics.com</u>. You may change your entry until the deadline. Please delete any runners that you are certain will not be competing in the meet before the entry deadline. If you are not sure, leave them in the meet.

If you are not on Direct Athletics "Invited Teams" list, please contact Jenna Gearing at jig5364@psu.edu, to discuss potential entry.

Entry Deadline

Tuesday, Sept. 10th, 2024 @ 11:59 p.m.; Entries will open on DirectAthletics by Tuesday, August 1st @ 12:01 AM.

Entry Limit

Teams may run up to <u>15 runners</u> per gender in the varsity race. There will be NO JV race.

Entry Fee

Single Gender: \$250 per team (\$500 for combined gender programs)

Non-Scoring Teams (Less than five athletes): \$25 per individual

Entry Fee Deadline: All Entries fees will be paid online via DirectAthletics! ** NO ENTRY FEES will be accepted at the meet. ** Please note: The Direct Athletics processing charge is not included in the entry fee.

Pre-Meet and Race Day Information

Practice Day (Thursday, September 12th):

The course will be open for inspection from <u>4:30-6:00 p.m</u>.

- Note: On-site parking for teams must follow the same guidelines on both the Practice Day and Meet Day. Please reference the parking attachment emailed for additional information.
- The course will still be open to golfers during practice time, so please be mindful of this window.
- If you plan on doing strides of any kind, please use the finish line stretch.
