KICKIN' IT

No. 3 Penn State women's soccer seeks a return to the win column this Sunday, August 25, as the Nittany Lions play host to the Division II in-state opponent West Chester Golden Rams with a 1 p.m. (ET) kick from Jeffrey Field. The match will stream live to a worldwide audience of authenticated subscribers via B1G+ and the B1G+ app.

The Nittany Lions return to action on a quick turnaround following the program's first defeat of the campaign, with third-ranked PSU dropping a 2-1 decision at the hands of No. 21 Virginia last Thursday night, August 22, at Jeffrey Field. The Blue & White took a one-goal lead into the halftime intermission, but Virginia rattled off a pair of scores midway through the second half to overcome the Nittany Lion advantage. Despite the final scoreline, Penn State looked effective and efficient on both ends of the pitch. The Nittany Lions were prolific on the attacking end, dominating the final shot margin by a striking 20-9 overall tally. PSU also managed to surpass the Cavaliers in shot on goal attempts, winning the statistic by a 7-6 final line. Virginia was opportunistic with their chances, securing both of their goals in the 54th minute onward, while simultaneously racking up a 6-3 differential in corner kicks.

Penn State University welcomed incoming freshman students and their families back to campus on Thursday, with the Nittany Lion women's soccer match against Virginia serving as the backdrop for the program's annual March to the Match event. PSU's March to the Match provided an electric atmosphere, with 1,603 fans filling into the stands highlighted by a jam-packed Park Avenue Army student section.

At halftime of Thursday night's contest against the Cavaliers, the Blue & White honored Nittany Lion women's soccer alumna, two-time FIFA Women's World Cup champion and current Penn State Board of Trustees member Ali Krieger, welcoming the 2006 B1G Defender of the Year back to her home pitch.

In the most recent United Soccer Coaches poll, released on Tuesday, August 20, Penn State improved to the No. 3 position in the nation following their dominant opening-night result in a top 10 clash. Penn State is the highest ranked team in the Big Ten Conference, leading a group of seven teams that are either ranked or receiving votes in the poll.

GRAPPLING WITH THE GOLDEN RAMS

- Under the guidance of veteran head coach Betty Ann Kempf-Townsley, the West Chester Golden Rams head to Jeffrey Field for their final preseason tune-up before the start of the 2024 NCAA Division II regular season. WCU returns to work this season following a trip to the NCAA Tournament Round of 16, where the Golden Rams fell on penalties to eventual quarterfinalist Gannon.
- West Chester went 16-3-4 overall last year, mirroring the record set by their Division I opponents from Happy Valley last season. WCU has recently been one of the most dominant programs in women's soccer at the Division II level, advancing to the national championship match in the 2022 NCAA Tournament.
- The Golden Rams return a litany of impressive student-athletes from their recent NCAA Tournament successes, highlighted by forward Faith Matter, who finished with 35 points on 12 goals and 11 assists last year. In goal, everyday starter Grace Keen returns to WCU following a 101-save campaign that featured 13 wins.

STORY OF THE SERIES

- Penn State and West Chester get set for the second all-time meeting in program history this weekend in Happy Valley, with the Nittany Lions taking the only prior contest at home a season ago. Against teams from Pennsylvania, PSU prepares for its 47th all-time fixture, owning a 43-2-1 record against Commonwealth opponents. Penn State's only two losses came against Villanova in 1995 and 1997, with one draw against Bucknell in 2009.
- In the only prior regular season meeting, Penn State utilized a dominant offensive outing and total team effort to book the program's first victory of the 2023 season, downing West Chester by an 8-0 tally. The Blue & White set single-match records for both shots and corner kick attempts in the contest while matching the largest margin of victory in a match in program annals.

BALLIN' LIKE BEANY

- MacBean maintains the longest active goal-scoring streak on the roster with five straight, contributing goals in each of Penn State's final three NCAA tournament matches last season as well as the first two contests of the 2024 campaign against Texas Tech last week, and Virginia last Thursday night.
- The promising attacking player needs goals in just two more matches to move into third place all-time at PSU for consecutive matches with a goal, a feat last achieved by Maya Hayes over a seven-match period during the 2011 campaign.
- MacBean, a native of Excelsior, Minnesota, stands as the only 2023 All-Big Ten honoree returning to the Penn State roster for the program's 31st varsity season. The veteran attacker was the highest-scoring player for PSU in its run to the Elite Eight last year, dropping 26 points on 10 goals and six assists.
- The redshirt senior forward has appeared in 44 matches and started 22 in her career with 2,334 career minutes played at PSU.

JORDAN 11'S

- Senior midfielder Jordan Fusco picked up national accolades following the first week of the season, appearing on the TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week in the organization's release Tuesday, August 20.
- A native of Olmsted Township, Ohio, Fusco arrived in Happy Valley last spring and made an instant impact for the Nittany Lions in her Penn State debut against Texas Tech. Fusco was the highest-scoring individual player in the win, with the newcomer logging both a goal and an assist in the match. Fusco opened the scoring in the 2024 season with a 17-yard left-footed banger in the seventh minute, later contributing an assist on a corner kick in the 17th.
- One of the headline women's soccer transfers in the 2024 cycle, Fusco arrived in Happy Valley following a dominant trio of seasons at Tennessee. During her impressive career in Knoxville, Fusco totaled 38 points split between 14 total goals in addition to 10 assists, making 61 appearances and 53 starts in three years with the Lady Vols.

BORGIE BALL

- Borgen, a native of Hanson, Massachusetts, returns to work in Happy Valley following a breakout 2023 campaign by every statistical measure. Borgen contributed the first six goals and first three assists of her collegiate career as a fixture in the starting XI for all 23 matches a year ago.
- Borgen amassed 1,410 minutes of action as a premier member of the Nittany Lion attacking midfield, with her masterpiece performance coming with a shorthanded brace against Northwestern that earned her Honorable Mention National Team of the Week accolades from TopDrawerSoccer on October 17.
- Borgen joined a pair of teammates in MacBean and Schiemann as B1G Players to Watch in the 2024 season, looking to expand on her dominant sophomore outing in the 2023 Elite Eight campaign.

MIEKE MAGIC

- One of the most experienced center backs in women's college soccer, the Berlin, Germany, native Schiemann returns for her senior year in the Blue & White following an all-around dominant 2023 effort.
- A former All-Big Ten honoree from the 2022 season, Schiemann is no stranger to the spotlight, turning in a junior season that featured her highest offensive production since arriving in Central Pennsylvania while simultaneously serving as the anchor for one of the nation's premium defensive squads. Schiemann appeared and started all 23 matches a season ago, scoring five goals primarily as a set-piece target while chipping in an assist to finish with 11 points on the campaign.
- Schiemann is consistently rated as one of the top players in the nation according to TopDrawerSoccer, appearing as a midseason top-100 player in last year's release from the organization. She has been honored on two occasions as a National Team of the Week member while racking up a pair of B1G Defensive Player of the Week laurels.

POWER TO THE PORTAL

- Penn State women's soccer head coach Erica Dambach announced the addition of three transfer student-athletes to the team's 2024 roster in January. The Nittany Lions welcomed Ginger Fontenot, Jordan Fusco and Kayleigh Herr to the program with all three immediately eligible to compete at PSU this fall.
- A two-time All-Ivy League selection while at Penn, Fontenot appeared and started in all 44 of her matches played in Philadelphia, earning First Team accolades in 2023 and Second Team honors in 2022.
- During her impressive career in Knoxville, Fusco totaled 38 points split between 14 total goals in addition to 10 assists, making 61 appearances and 53 starts in three years with the Lady Vols.
- Herr appeared in 12 matches for the Tar Heels, making eight starts in the process while playing all 90 minutes on four occasions. Sideline by injury at varying points in both of her collegiate seasons to date, Herr stood out in her limited opportunities.

BLUE & WHITE... RED WHITE & BLUE

- Redshirt sophomore goalkeeper Mackenzie Gress earned a spot on the United States U-20 Women's Youth National Team roster for the 2024 FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup in Colombia. Gress has established herself as one of the most consistent contributors to the program's U-20 Team over the past year and a half. Gress has appeared on multiple rosters for the U.S. U-20 WYNT in recent months, participating in multiple training camps and friendly matches throughout the spring and summer, with the Nittany Lion starting her world cup journey earlier this week.
- Freshman midfielder Katie Scott also has experience with the U-17 U.S. WYNT, joining Nittany Lion alumna and U-17 WYNT Head Coach Katie Schoepfer's squad over the spring and summer. Scott boasts prior experience in the U.S. Women's Youth National Team organization, appearing on the U15 and U16 USYNT rosters. She was an instrumental contributor to Team USA's U15 CONCACAF Championship title during her season with the team and helped lead the U16 squad to the French Mondial World Cup title during her stint with the organization.
- The Fairview, Pennsylvania, native, Scott maintained the No. 26 ranking in the nation according to TopDrawerSoccer, making her one of four Penn State signees in the TDS Top 100 entering 2024.

RECRUITING ROUNDUP

- The 2024 Penn State women's soccer signing class picked up the No. 5 final national ranking according to TopDrawerSoccer, highlighted by four student-athletes ranked inside the TDS top 100.
- The Blue & White added four defenders, three forwards, a midfielder and a goalkeeper in the 2024 recruiting window and welcomed six student-athletes that garnered national rankings from TopDrawerSoccer overall. Top-ranked goalkeeper and 20th-ranked overall prospect Kealey Titmuss headlines the group, with U17 U.S. Youth National Team midfielder Katie Scott and 27th-overall player and forward Addison Hess adding depth and a wealth of experience across the pitch. Bella Ayscue picked up the No. 98 ranking nationally as a defender out of the NC Courage Academy system, joining new teammate Kayleigh Herr.
- PSU additionally added Lilly Burger, Jolie Farmer, Kieryn Jeter, Aubrey Kulpa and Natalie Magnotta to complete the nine-member class.

- Penn State was selected as the preseason No. 2 team in the Big Ten Conference in a poll of the league's coaches released Tuesday, August 13.
- UCLA stands as the preseason favorite to take home the conference's regular season crown, with second-place PSU having accomplished that feat 20 times previously. The league's 2023 regular season co-champions in Michigan State and Nebraska sit third and fourth, respectively, while newcomer USC, as well as Wisconsin, Rutgers and Iowa round out the top half of the conference's preseason poll. Ohio State, Indiana, Michigan, Northwestern, Washington, Minnesota, Illinois, Purdue, Maryland and Oregon close out the 18-team poll.
- Junior midfielder Olivia Borgen, redshirt senior forward Kaitlyn MacBean and senior defender Mieke Schiemann also picked up individual distinction as Big Ten Players to Watch in the conference office's release with Schiemann and MacBean serving as returning All-Big Ten performers from the 2022 and 2023 seasons, respectively.

SCHEDULE? TUFF.

- The Nittany Lions' 2024 schedule features 19 total opponents, with 13 teams reaching the 2023 NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Tournament a year ago. Four of Penn State's challengers in the 2024 campaign reached the Sweet 16, with one foe in Nebraska advancing to the National Quarterfinals last season.
- Penn State battles six teams who are currently ranked or receiving votes in the United Soccer Coaches Poll released on Tuesday, August 20. PSU faces off against UCLA (#6), Michigan State (#8), Ohio State (#18), Saint Louis (#23), Iowa (#24) and Georgetown (RV) over the course of the next 17 matches, with only one of those tests coming at home on Jeffrey Field.
- The Blue & White will also face off against a pair of teams they hosted at Jeffrey Field during the 2023 NCAA Tournament, with a rematch of the 2023 NCAA Sweet 16 coming on the road at Saint Louis, as well as a road test scheduled at reigning Big East champion Georgetown.

- No. 3 Penn State women's soccer remains in Happy Valley for the final contest of its four-match home stand, as the Nittany Lions play host to the border-rival West Virginia Mountaineers on Thursday, August 29. Action from Jeffrey Field kicks off at 7:30 p.m. (ET), with streaming available to a worldwide audience of authenticated subscribers via B1G+ and the B1G+ app.

THE HOME OF THE NITTANY LIONS



Jeffrey Field, the home of Nittany Lion soccer, was dedicated on Sept. 29, 1972. Located in the heart of the Penn State athletic facilities complex with a picturesque view of Mount Nittany, the stadium was named in honor of the late Bill Jeffrey, legendary head coach of the soccer program from 1926-52. Jeffrey Field has been the host site for numerous NCAA and conference contests in men's and women's soccer. Games are frequently televised from Jeffrey Field, allowing a nationwide audience to view Penn State in action. Widely regarded as one of the finest grass surfaces in the country, Jeffrey Field was honored as the 2006 Collegiate Soccer Field of the Year by the SportsTurf Managers Association.

Penn State women's soccer alumnae Sam Coffey and Alyssa Naehar joined the United States Women's National Team in a Gold Medal performance at the 33rd Summer Olympiad, while alumna Laura Freigang and Team Germany picked up the Bronze Medal in the 2024 Paris Summer Olympic Games. Freigang, Coffey and Naehar became the 13th, 14th and 15th Penn State-affiliated athletes to secure Olympic Medals at the 2024 Paris Games, respectively, while Coffey and Naehar also became the only Nittany Lion Gold Medalists at the 33rd Olympiad. Penn State's trio of Olympic Medalists stands as a program record for a single Olympic Games, with a Nittany Lion landing gold for the first time since Erin McLeod and Team Canada picked up the sport's highest honor at the 2020 Tokyo Games.

The leadership of Penn State women's soccer Head coach Erica Dambach continues to produce incredible success season after season. While trophies, academic awards and international achievements line the walls as evidence of a championship program, her impact on Nittany Lion student-athletes stands as the truest testament to her teams' culture of excellence. Dambach is in the midst of her 18th season at the helm in University Park during the 2024 campaign, Penn State's 31st varsity season.

The numbers that document PSU's success are staggering. A two-time National Coach of the Year and five-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Dambach has led her teams to 17 consecutive NCAA Tournaments, 11 Big Ten regular season titles, five Big Ten Tournament titles and the 2015 NCAA National Championship. In 21 years as a head coach and 17 seasons leading the Nittany Lions, Dambach has accumulated 315 career wins with a .707 winning percentage, one of the most dominant marks in all of college athletics.

In the 2023 campaign, Dambach collected her 300th career head coaching victory with a 2-1 result on the road against the West Virginia Mountaineers. Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics, Dr. Patrick Kraft, as well as Deputy AD for Administration and External Operations Brandi Stuart presented the Dambach family with a game ball commemorating the accomplishment prior to Penn State's next home match against TCU on August 27, 2023, a 1-0 Nittany Lion win.

Dambach earned her Bachelor of Science degree with a concentration in biology from William & Mary in 1997. The Huntingdon Valley, Pennsylvania, native holds a United Soccer Coaches Advanced National Degree and a USSF "A" Coaching License.

The former Erica Walsh married Jason Dambach in January 2016, and they currently reside in State College, Pennsylvania. Erica and Jason have two daughters, Addie and Kylie.

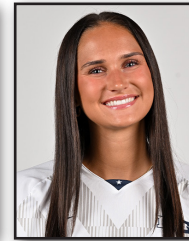
