Home matches played at Jeffrey Field

- No. 12 Penn State women's soccer kicks off its 31st varsity season as a member of the Big Ten Conference on Thursday, September 12, as the Nittany Lions welcome the Michigan Wolverines to Jeffrey Field for a 7:30 p.m. (ET) kickoff. The match will stream live to a worldwide audience of authenticated subscribers via B1G+ and the B1G+ app.
- In the team's most recent outing, the Blue & White closed out their three-match road trip against opponents that were ranked or receiving votes in the United Soccer Coaches poll, battling to a scoreless draw against the No. 23 Georgetown Hoyas in the nation's capital. Penn State narrowly edged out the Hoyas in total shot attempts by a 13-12 tally, but Georgetown booked a slim 3-2 win in shots on goal.
- PSU extended its unbeaten streak to five consecutive matches and went unbeaten against ranked or receiving votes opponents over a three-match road span for the first time since the 2021 team did so at No. 13 West Virginia, No. 18 UCF and No. 3 Virginia from September 2 through 9 of that year.
- Penn State gears up for its 31st Big Ten opener this week in Happy Valley, with the Nittany Lions seeking victories in consecutive conference opening matchups for the first time since PSU won back-toback league openers in the 2017 and 2018 campaigns. The Blue & White are an impressive 22-5-3 overall in their conference opening tests dating to the program's inaugural season in 1994.
 - The Nittany Lions were tabbed as the No. 2 team in the Big Ten Conference in a preseason poll of the league's coaches, with newcomer UCLA taking the top spot in the conference back in August. Through Penn State's first seven matches of the year, the Blue & White amassed a 5-1-1 overall record with an impressive 3-1-1 tally against opponents that were either ranked or receiving votes on the day of the match, building one of the strongest non-conference ledgers in the nation. In the latest United Soccer Coaches poll, released on Tuesday,
 - September 10, the Penn State women's soccer team moved to the No. 12 position nationally. The Nittany Lions maintain the second-highest ranking in the Big Ten Conference and are one of six B1G programs that are either ranked or receiving votes, including Michigan State (#5), Iowa (#17), Ohio State (#20), UCLA (#22) and USC (RV).

WATCHING THE WOLVERINES

- Head Coach Jennifer Klein continues her ninth campaign as a head coach and seventh at the helm in Ann Arbor. The Wolverines are off to a 1-5-1 start in the 2024 campaign and are fresh off their first win of the campaign over a nationally ranked opponent in then-No. 24 Alabama, downing the Crimson Tide by a 1-0 tally at home. Michigan called on Elle Ervin to provide her first collegiate goal in what eventually became the match-winner against Alabama.
- On the pitch, Michigan is paced by B1G Player to Watch and junior midfielder Jenna Lang, who leads the squad with a trio of goals for six points on the year. Six different student-athletes are tied for the team lead in assists with three, while graduate goalkeeper Stephanie Sparkowski leads the way with 21 saves this year.

STORY OF THE SERIES

- Penn State and Michigan get set for their 42nd all-time meeting in a series that dates back to PSU's inaugural varsity season in 1994. The Nittany Lions boast a dominant 26-7-8 lead in the series, with the Blue & White last bringing home a victory in 2022.
 - PSU is unbeaten through the last two matchups against the Wolverines, with the Nittany Lions booking a 3-0 win in 2022 followed by a 1-1 draw last year. Despite Penn State's dominant lead in the all-time series, the Wolverines have moved closer to the Blue & White through the last seven contests, playing to an even 3-3-1 record in those opportunities.
- In the most recent matchup between the two programs on September 28 of last year, the Nittany Lions and Wolverines played to a 1-1 draw highlighted by an early score from thensenior+ forward Payton Linnehan. Michigan evened the match on a right-footed effort from Wolverine midfielder Jenna Lang to force the draw that ended PSU's nine-match win streak in 2023.

B1G THINGS COMING

Penn State enters its 31st season as a participating women's soccer Big Ten Conference member institution this week with Thursday's test against Michigan. The Nittany Lions are the most dominant program in B1G history by every statistical measure, hauling in a league-best nine B1G Tournament titles in addition to 20 B1G regular season crowns, more than all other schools combined. The Blue & White are 22-5-3 overall through their first 30 B1G regular season openers, in addition to boasting a 27-2-1 record on Jeffrey Field in the team's first Big Ten match of the year. PSU is seeking consecutive B1G-opening wins for the first time since 2017-18, and looks to extend a two-match winning streak in Big Ten home openers dating to the 2022 season.

BALLIN' LIKE BEANY

- Through her first seven matches of the 2024 campaign, redshirt senior forward Kaitlyn MacBean has broken out as a star on the national stage. She ranks prominently in the Big Ten and NCAA Division I in multiple statistical categories, highlighted by the thirdmost total goals in the nation with eight scores thus far.
- The Excelsior, Minnesota, native ranks inside the top 20 nationally in match-winning goals (2nd, 3), total goals (3rd, 8), total points (8th, 16) goals per match (9th, 1.14), shots per match (15th, 4.43) and points per match (16th, 2.29) while leading the B1G in total goals alongside Minnesota's Khyah Harper.
 - MacBean registered goals in eight consecutive matches beginning in the second round of the 2023 NCAA Tournament against Santa Clara and concluding with PSU's fifth match of 2024 against Saint Louis on the road. MacBean's eight-match scoring streak was the third-longest in Nittany Lion history, with her run trailing a 17-match and 13-match streak from PSU legend Tiffany Weimer.

JORDAN 11'S

- Senior midfielder Jordan Fusco stands as one of the strongest individual distributors in women's college soccer from the attacking midfield slot, with the Olmsted Township, Ohio, native recording at least one assist in four of Penn State's first seven matches.
- Fusco ranks prominently in the Big Ten Conference in multiple passing categories, pacing the league while ranking 11th nationally in total assists with five while ranking third in the conference and 24th nationally in assists per match with 0.71. Fusco stands as the 15th-best overall scorer in the Big Ten with seven total points in the 2024 campaign, with her quintet of assists joining a matchwinning goal in the PSU season opener.
- Following the opening week of action in the 2024 regular season, Fusco picked up TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week recognition following her three-point outing against then-No. 8 Texas Tech on Jeffrey Field.

KULPA'S KILLIN' IT

- Through the first seven matches of the 2024 season, freshman forward Aubrey Kulpa has established herself as one of the premier rookie scoring options in the nation, joining veteran teammate Kaitlyn MacBean as a target on the Nittany Lion front line.
- The Cromwell, Connecticut, native has found the back of the net on three separate occasions since opening night against Texas Tech, additionally adding her first collegiate assist in the 3-1 Nittany Lion win over border rival West Virginia.
- In the Big Ten Conference individual rankings, Kulpa stands in 11th place with a trio of total goals through this point in her rookie year.

 During her youth career with Oakwood SC in her native Connecticut,
 - Kulpa was a 2022 Youth All-American, was named the MVP of the GA U17 National Championship and led her team to a GA National title in 2022.

BORGIE BALL

Junior midfielder Olivia Borgen tallied her first goal of the 2024 campaign, as well as her seventh collegiate score on Thursday, September 5, at Princeton, finding the back of the net in her only shot and shot on goal of the night in 19 minutes of work.

Borgen contributed the first six goals and first three assists of her collegiate career as a fixture in the starting XI for all 23 matches a year ago. She amassed 1,410 minutes of action as a premier member of the Nittany Lion attacking midfield, adding individual distinction as an honorable mention TopDrawerSoccer National Team of the Week honoree following a brace at Northwestern on October 17.

Borgen joined a pair of teammates in MacBean and Schiemann as B1G Players to Watch in the 2024 season, looking to expand on her dominant sophomore outing in the 2023 Elite Eight campaign.

BLUE & WHITE... RED WHITE & BLUE

Redshirt sophomore goalkeeper Mackenzie Gress earned a spot on the United States U-20 Women's Youth National Team roster for the 2024 FIFA U-20 Women's World Cup in Colombia. The Nittany Lion keeper began her journey with the team on Sunday, August 18, and will return following the conclusion of the FIFA U-20 World Cup. Entering the weekend, Gress and Team USA are gearing up for their Round of 16 match against Mexico Wednesday night. Freshman midfielder Katie Scott has been a crucial contributor to the U-17 U.S. WYNT, joining Nittany Lion alumna and U-17 WYNT Head Coach Katie Schoepfer's squad over the spring and summer. Scott boasts prior experience in the U.S. Women's Youth National Team organization, appearing on the U15 and U16 USYNT rosters.

POWER TO THE PORTAL

Penn State head coach Erica Dambach announced the addition of three transfer student-athletes to the team's 2024 roster in January. The Nittany Lions welcomed Ginger Fontenot, Jordan Fusco and Kayleigh Herr to the program with all three immediately eligible. A two-time All-Ivy League selection while at Penn, Fontenot appeared and started in all 44 of her matches played in Philadelphia, earning First Team accolades in 2023 and Second Team honors in 2022. During her impressive career in Knoxville, Fusco totaled 38 points split between 14 total goals in addition to 10 assists, making 61 appearances and 53 starts in three years with the Lady Vols. Herr appeared in 12 matches for the Tar Heels, making eight starts in the process while playing all 90 minutes on four occasions. Sidelined by injury at varying points in both of her collegiate seasons to date, Herr stood out in her limited opportunities.

RECRUITING ROUNDUP

The 2024 Penn State women's soccer signing class picked up the No. 5 final national ranking according to TopDrawerSoccer, highlighted by four student-athletes ranked inside the TDS top 100. The Blue & White added four defenders, three forwards, a midfielder and a goalkeeper in the 2024 recruiting window and welcomed six student-athletes that garnered national rankings from TopDrawerSoccer overall. Top-ranked goalkeeper and 20th-ranked overall prospect Kealey Titmuss headlines the group, with U17 U.S. Youth National Team midfielder Katie Scott and 27th-overall player and forward Addison Hess adding depth and a wealth of experience across the pitch. Bella Ayscue picked up the No. 98 ranking nationally as a defender out of the NC Courage Academy system, joining new teammate Kayleigh Herr. PSU additionally added Lilly Burger, Jolie Farmer, Kieryn Jeter, Aubrey Kulpa and Natalie Magnotta to complete the nine-member class.

THE B1G LEAGUES

Penn State was selected as the preseason No. 2 team in the Big Ten Conference in a poll of the league's coaches released Tuesday, August 13. UCLA stands as the preseason favorite to take home the conference's regular season crown, with second-place PSU having accomplished that feat 20 times previously. The league's 2023 regular season co-champions in Michigan State and Nebraska sit third and fourth, respectively, while newcomer USC, as well as Wisconsin, Rutgers and lowa round out the top half of the conference's preseason poll. Ohio State, Indiana, Michigan, Northwestern, Washington, Minnesota, Illinois, Purdue, Maryland and Oregon close out the 18-team poll. Junior midfielder Olivia Borgen, redshirt senior forward Kaitlyn MacBean and senior defender Mieke Schiemann also picked up individual distinction as Big Ten Players to Watch in the conference office's release with Schiemann and MacBean serving as returning All-Big Ten performers from the 2022 and 2023 seasons, respectively.

SCHEDULE? TUFF.

- The Nittany Lions' 2024 schedule features 19 total opponents, with 13 teams reaching the 2023 NCAA Division I Women's Soccer Tournament a year ago. Four of Penn State's challengers in the 2024 campaign reached the Sweet 16, with one foe in Nebraska advancing to the National Quarterfinals last season.
- Penn State will battle five teams in conference competition who are currently ranked or receiving votes in the United Soccer Coaches Poll released on Tuesday, September 10. PSU faces off against Michigan State (#5), Iowa (#17), Ohio State (#20), UCLA (#22) and USC (RV) over the course of the next 12 matches, with only one of those tests coming at home on Jeffrey Field.
- The Blue & White also faced off against a pair of teams they hosted at Jeffrey Field during the 2023 NCAA Tournament, with a rematch of the 2023 NCAA Sweet 16 coming on the road at Saint Louis, as well as a road test at reigning Big East champion Georgetown.

UP NEXT

No. 12 Penn State women's soccer returns for its second match in a four-match homestand this Sunday, September 15, as the Nittany Lions host the Columbia Lions in a 1 p.m. (ET) fixture from Jeffrey Field. The match will serve as Senior Day presented by the Penn State Alumni Association, with the match and post-match Senior ceremony set to stream live via B1G+ and the B1G+ app.

JEFFREY FIELD NITTANY



Jeffrey Field, the home of Nittany Lion soccer, was dedicated on Sept. 29, 1972. Located in the heart of the Penn State athletic facilities complex with a picturesque view of Mount Nittany, the stadium was named in honor of the late Bill Jeffrey, legendary head coach of the soccer program from 1926-52. Jeffrey Field has been the host site for numerous NCAA and conference contests in men's and women's soccer. Games are frequently televised from Jeffrey Field, allowing a nationwide audience to view Penn State in action. Widely regarded as one of the finest grass surfaces in the country, Jeffrey Field was honored as the 2006 Collegiate Soccer Field of the Year by the SportsTurf Managers Association.

Penn State women's soccer alumnae Sam Coffey and Alyssa Naeher joined the United States Women's National Team in a Gold Medal performance at the 33rd Summer Olympiad, while alumna Laura Freigang and Team Germany picked up the Bronze Medal in the 2024 Paris Summer Olympic Games. Freigang, Coffey and Naeher became the 13th, 14th and 15th Penn State-affiliated athletes to secure Olympic Medals at the 2024 Paris Games, respectively, while Coffey and Naeher also became the only Nittany Lion Gold Medalists at the 33rd Olympiad. Penn State's trio of Olympic Medalists stands as a program record for a single Olympic Games, with a Nittany Lion landing gold for the first time since Erin McLeod and Team Canada picked up the sport's highest honor at the 2020 Tokyo Games.

The leadership of Penn State women's soccer head coach Erica Dambach continues to produce incredible success season after season. While trophies, academic awards and international achievements line the walls as evidence of a championship program, her impact on Nittany Lion student-athletes stands as the truest testament to her teams' culture of excellence. Dambach is in the midst of her 18th season at the helm in University Park during the 2024 campaign, Penn State's 31st varsity season.

The numbers that document PSU's success are staggering. A two-time National Coach of the Year and five-time Big Ten Coach of the Year, Dambach has led her teams to 17 consecutive NCAA Tournaments, 11 Big Ten regular season titles, five Big Ten Tournament titles and the 2015 NCAA National Championship. In 22 years as a head coach and 18 seasons leading the Nittany Lions, Dambach has accumulated 319 career wins with a .709 winning percentage, one of the most dominant marks in all of college athletics.

In the 2023 campaign, Dambach collected her 300th career head coaching victory with a 2-1 result on the road against the West Virginia Mountaineers. Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics, Dr. Patrick Kraft, as well as Deputy AD for Administration and External Operations Brandi Stuart presented the Dambach family with a game ball commemorating the accomplishment prior to Penn State's next home match against TCU on August 27, 2023, a 1-0 Nittany Lion win.

Dambach earned her Bachelor of Science degree with a concentration in biology from William & Mary in 1997. The Huntingdon Valley, Pennsylvania, native holds a United Soccer Coaches Advanced National Degree and a USSF "A" Coaching License.

The former Erica Walsh married Jason Dambach in January 2016, and they currently reside in State College, Pennsylvania. Erica and Jason have two daughters, Addie and Kylie.

One of the nation's premier recruiting coordinators and goalkeeping coaches. Tim Wassell returns to Happy Valley for his 15th season ahead of the 2024 campaign. Head Coach Erica Dambach named Wassell to the Nittany Lion coaching staff on June 2, 2010, and promoted him to Associate Head Coach in recognition of his stellar efforts on the pitch and recruiting trail on July 15, 2021.

Wassell has attracted nationally ranked recruiting classes to Happy Valley year after year, with six top-five classes since 2014 according to Top Drawer Soccer, including the top-ranked recruiting classes in the nation in both 2019 and 2022. Wassell's reputation as one of the sport's top recruiters, paired with the elite tactical and developmental staff in Happy Valley, routinely churns out some of the most successful professional prospects both in the NWSL and abroad.

Wassell's track record of goalkeeper development was crucial in Penn State's success in recent years, with veteran shot-stopper Katherine Asman blossoming into one of the top keepers in the nation under his watch. Asman managed to improve her win total in net each season of her collegiate career, finishing her five years as a player in Happy Valley with a career-best 0.64 goals-against average, the eighth-best GAA for a single-season in Nittany Llon women's soccer history. Asman was an All-B1G keeper under Wassell's watch and helped guide the Blue & White to at least the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament every year in which she was a regular starter. Additionally, 2022 transfer goalkeeper Morgan Messner cultivated her skills under Wassell's leadership and leveraged her Penn State experience to kick off a career in the NWSL with San Diego Wave FC in the spring of 2024.

Wassell, a native of Holidaysburg, Pennsylvania, earned his bachelor's degree in business at PSU Altoona. He also has gained NSCAA National and Goalkeeping Coaching Diplomas during his coaching career.
