Proceeds from the sold out exhibition game between the Nittany Lions and Leopards benefit both Hope Within Ministries and the National Multiple Sclerosis Society.



- Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Mike Rhoades will return to his alma mater when the Nittany Lions square off against Lafayette. Rhoades led Lebanon Valley College to the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship as the tournament's Co-Outstanding Player. Rhoades was the USA Today Division III National Player of the Year in 1995, a two-time NABC All-American, three-time NABC All-Region and three-time Middle Atlantic Conference Player of the Year. He was the school's all-time scoring leader (2,050) until 1999, but still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey is one of five basketball jerseys retired by LVC.
- Penn State enters its second season under Rhoades in 2024-25 and the Nittany Lions return five of their top seven scorers from a season ago, headlined by reigning Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year and Preseason All-Big Ten selection Ace Baldwin Jr.
 - The Nittany Lions return 60.7% of minutes played a season ago, the secondhighest returning percentage among Big Ten teams, and 58.9% of their scoring production.

HOMECOMING

Penn State head coach Mike Rhoades brings the Nittany Lions home to his alma mater when Penn State faces Lafavette at Lebanon Valley College Friday night.

from 1991-1995 under coaches Pat Flannery (currently on Penn State's staff) and Brad McAlester (current Lebanon Valley Head Coach). Rhoades guided the Flying Points Dutchmen to the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship with a 66-59 overtime win over NYU. He was named the tournament's Co-Outstanding Player. The Minutes entire team was inducted into the school's Athletic Hall of Fame in October 2014, the 20th anniversary of the title.

The guard was the USA Today Division III National Player of the Year in 1995, twotime NABC All-American, three-time NABC All-Region and three-time Middle Atlantic Conference Player of the Year.

He was the school's all-time scoring leader (2,050) until 1999, but still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey is one of five basketball jerseys retired by LVC.

FOR A GOOD CAUSE

Friday's exhibition game is sold out and all proceeds are benefitting both Hope Within Ministries and the National Multiple Sclerosis Society.

Hope Within Ministries helps provide primary health care to the uninsured lowincome residents of Lancaster, Dauphin and Lebanon counties.

The National Multiple Sclerosis Society is dedicated to supporting individuals affected by multiple sclerosis and funding research to find a cure for the disease.

TEST RUN

Friday's exhibition game won't count towards official records or statistics, but marks the second-straight season that the Nittany Lions will partake in an open charity exhibition game.

Penn State defeated Robert Morris in a road exhibition game a season ago, taking down the Colonials by a score of 68-58.

WHAT'S RETURNING

The Nittany Lions bring back five of their top seven scorers from a season ago in reigning Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year Ace Baldwin Jr., honorable mention All-Big Ten pick Nick Kern Jr., honorable mention All-Rhoades played at Lebanon Valley College Big Ten pick Zach Hicks, Puff Johnson and D'Marco Dunn.

NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES

The Nittany Lions added four highlytouted transfers and a five-man freshman class that ranked 29th in the country (per 247Sports) over the offseason to comprise the 2024-25 roster.

SCOUTING LAFAYETTE

The Leopards enter their second season under head coach Mike McGarvev and are coming off a 2023-24 campaign that saw Lafayette finish 11-21 overall and 10-8 in Patriot League play. Lafayette earned the No. 3 seed in the 2024 Patriot League Tournament.

Lafayette returns five of its top seven scorers from a season ago, led by Devin Hines (9.8 ppg in 2023-24) and Justin Vander Baan (9.3 ppg & 5.3 rpg in 2023-24).

AGAINST THE LEOPARDS

While Friday's exhibition game won't count towards either team's official record, the Nittany Lions and Leopards will meet for the first time since 2022.

Penn State owns a 13-4 advantage in the alltime series that dates back to 1916.

The Nittany Lions won the most recent meeting against the Leopards as Penn State picked up a 70-57 victory on Nov. 25, 2022 inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH

MIKE RHOADES

Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Men's Basketball Head Coach Mike Rhoades enters his second season as the leader of the Nittany Lions in 2024-25. Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Dr. Patrick Kraft announced the hiring of Rhoades as the 15th head coach in program history on March 29, 2023. In 20 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rhoades, a Mahanoy City, Pennsylvania native, has produced a 389-206 record, a winning percentage of .654, seven NCAA Tournament appearances and nine national postseason appearances.

Rhoades laid a strong foundation during his first season at Penn State in 2023-24. Rhoades led the Nittany Lions to a 16-17 overall record and 9-11 mark in conference play, marking the second-most Big Ten wins by a firstyear head coach in program history. The Nittany Lions defeated a pair of top-15 ranked teams in #12 Illinois and #11 Wisconsin, with the win over the 11th-ranked Badgers marking the highest-ranked win under a first-year head coach in program history.

Rhoades engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 as the Nittany Lions averaged 75.1 points per game in his debut season. Penn State's 75.2 points per game in regular-season Big Ten play was the second-highest in Penn State's 32 seasons in the Big Ten, behind only the 2000-01 Nittany Lions team's 75.4 points per Big Ten game. Defensively, Penn State led the Big Ten in steals per game (8.3), turnover margin (+3.6) and threepoint percentage defense (30.3%) in 2023-24. Rhoades developed and mentored the 2024 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year in Ace Baldwin Jr. and four All-Big Ten selections in Baldwin Jr., Qudus Wahab, Nick Kern Jr. and 7ach Hicks.

Rhoades came to Penn State following a six-year stint as the head coach at VCU in which he guided the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances, a 129-60 overall record and 72-32 Atlantic 10 Conference record. He is the fourth-winningest coach in VCU history. Rhoades developed a pair of Atlantic 10 Players of the Year and 13 all-conference selections throughout his six years in Richmond. On the recruiting trail, Rhoades signed the Atlantic 10's top-ranked recruiting class in three of his last four years at VCU. In his time as an assistant and head coach at VCU, he was responsible for signing eight of the top nine all-time Ram recruits per 247Sports.

The Rams won both the Atlantic 10 regular-season and tournament championships during the 2022-23 season, making their third NCAA Tournament appearance under Rhoades and finishing 27-8 overall. The Rams' 27 wins were the most under Rhoades and the most for VCU since the 2012-13 season. Rhoades mentored VCU junior point guard Ace Baldwin Jr. to Atlantic 10 Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year honors in the 2022-23 season.

In just his second season in 2018-19, Rhoades led the Rams back to the NCAA Tournament, as well as their first Atlantic 10 Conference outright regularseason championship. VCU's 25 total wins, including 16 conference victories, tied program regular-season marks. For his efforts, he was named Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year and was a finalist for the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. Rhoades led the Rams back to the NCAA Tournament in 2020-21 following a 19-7 campaign in which the Black and Gold reached the A-10 Championship Game.

Under Rhoades tutelage, VCU saw players selected in back-to-back NBA Drafts, when Nah'Shon "Bones" Hyland was selected 26th overall by the Denver Nuggets in 2021, and Vince Williams Jr. was picked 47th overall by the Memphis Grizzlies in 2022. Justin Tillman also spent time with the Atlanta Hawks active roster during the 2021-22 season. Additionally, former VCU players Larry Sanders, Troy Daniels, Briante Weber and Treveon Graham, who each played for Rhoades during his days as an assistant coach at VCU from 2009-14, all spent time in the NBA. Mo Alie-Cox played basketball for Rhoades at VCU and has gone on to be a tight end for the NFL's Indianapolis Colts.

Prior to his six years in the head chair at VCU. Rhoades engineered a stunning turnaround at Rice as head coach of the Owls from 2014-17. Rhoades led Rice to its first 20-win campaign since 2003-04 and the program's first postseason appearance since 2011-12. Rice's 23-12 mark in 2016-17 was an 11-win improvement over the 2015-16 season and the 23 wins were the second-most in Owls' history. The Owls were a combined 12-49 in the two seasons prior to his arrival.

Rhoades spent 2009-14 as an assistant coach and associate head coach at VCU prior to taking the head coaching job at Rice, VCU reached the NCAA Tournament four times and appeared in the postseason all five years of that stretch. The Rams were 137-46 during that period and won the 2012 CAA Championship. He was integral in recruiting and developing the players that would lead the Rams to a historic Final Four appearance in 2010-11. In 2012, after VCU toppled Wichita State in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament, Rhoades was named one of the top 10 assistant coaches under 40 in the country by ESPN.com.

Prior to his VCU tenure, Rhoades enjoyed a wildly successful run at Division III Randolph-Macon in Ashland, Virginia. In 10 seasons as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, Rhoades compiled a 197-76 record (.722 win percentage) and led RMC to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including trips to the Sweet 16 in 2002 and 2003. Rhoades' teams won six Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) championships and earned national No. 1 rankings in two seasons. He was named ODAC Coach of the Year in three-straight seasons from 2001-O3, coached three ODAC Players of the Year, five ODAC Freshmen of the Year, as well as 17 All-ODAC selections. He began his coaching career at age 23 as an assistant at Randolph-Macon in 1996 under long-time head coach Hal Nunnally.

Rhoades played collegiately under coaches Pat Flannery and Brad McAlester at Lebanon Valley College in his home state of Pennsylvania. Rhoades guided the Flying Dutchmen to the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship with a 66-59 overtime win over NYU. He was named the tournament's Co-Outstanding Player. The guard was the USA Today Division III National Player of the Year in 1995, two-time NABC All-American, threetime NABC All-Region and three-time Middle Atlantic Conference Player of the Year. He was the school's alltime scoring leader (2.050) until 1999, but still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey is one of five basketball jerseys retired by LVC.
