THIS WEEK'S MATCHUP

• This weekend marks the 54th and 55th meetings all-time between Penn State and Wisconsin as the Badgers are the most common opponent for the Nittany Lions in the first 12 years of the program.

• Penn State holds the 27-23-3 advantage including a 15-9-1 mark at Pegula Ice Arena, however, Wisconsin swept the season series last year taking 11 of 12 possible conference points while outscoring the Nittany Lions 19-6 for the year. Penn State had won the season series each of the prior two years heading into the 2023-24 season winning six of the previous eight contests following a heartbreaking overtime loss in the 2021 Big Ten semifinals. Those six wins came in succession from December 2021 through February 2023, but the Badgers enter the series this weekend riding a five-game winning streak against the Nittany Lions.

• Friday night's game will serve as Throwback Night as Penn State will unveil a retro alternate uniform honoring the past history of ice hockey on campus in University Park and celebrating the different eras of Hockey Valley.

• Saturday night's contest will feature the annual Teddy Bear Toss, sponsored by Topline Heating & Air, during the first intermission. Fans are encouraged to bring new or gently used stuffed animals and toss them on the ice to be donated to THON and other children's charities.

• Senior Danny Dzhaniev leads Penn State with eight points on three goals and five assists in 12 career games against the Badgers while Ben Schoen returns to feast as he was averaging a point per game against Wisconsin with three goals and three assists in six games before being sidelined with his injury. Schoen has missed the last six games against the Badgers.

• This weekend pits two of the winningest coaches of all-time against each other as Guy Gadowsky sits 12th among active coaches and 35th all-time with 386 wins while Wisconsin's Mike Hastings ranks 14th among active coaches and 45th all-time with 327 victories. Hastings is the active leader in win percentage as he leads his team to victory 70.5 percent of the time, a mark good for the fourth best winning percentage all-time. Gadowsky is just one win shy of tying longtime Michigan State and Michigan Tech Bench Boss, Amo Bessone for 34th all-time and is just four wins shy of former Minnesota head man Doug Woog (390) for 33rd.

• Penn State (21 years, 9 months) is the 3rd-youngest team in the Big Ten and 12th nationally while Wisconsin (22 years, 1 month) is the oldest team in the conference ranking 24th in the nation.

NOT TOO BAD, A?

• During the bye week, Penn State head coach Guy Gadowsky announced an addition to the leadership group as senior Danny Dzhaniev was presented with a letter on his sweater as he will serve as an alternate captain for the remainder of the season joining fellow alternates Jimmy Dowd Jr. and Carson Dyck along with captain Simon Mack.

POSITIVE ON THE PK

• Penn State leads the Big Ten and ranks third in the nation on the penalty kill this season killing off 96.9 percent (31-for-32) of opponent powerplay opportunities including a 28-for-28 streak to open the year prior to a Jimmy Snuggerud net front tip a few weeks ago.

• The Nittany Lions have also scored three shorthanded goals to tie for the Big Ten lead and rank second in the country behind UConn's four. Penn State is a +2 on the PK this season, one of just two teams in the country positive while skating a man down, BC is +1 with one shorthanded goal and a perfect 100 percent penalty kill.

• PSU had just one shorty last season and two in 2022-23. The program record for shorthanded tallies is 12 achieved in 2015-16.

CAPTAIN CONSISTENCY

• Senior captain Simon Mack has been one of the most consistent players for Guy Gadowsky during his tenure in Hockey Valley and this year he currently leads all Nittany Lion blueliners with five points, a mark good for third on the team, with one goal and four assists.

• Mack's nine career goals ties for ninth all-time for Penn State defensemen while his 31 assists and 40 points are each just two shy of cracking into the top-10 all-time for Penn State blueliners.

• Along with his defensive partner, freshman Cade Christenson, the duo is plus-9 on the season with Christenson leading the team at plus-5 and Mack tied for second with Aiden Fink at plus-4. Fink's plus-4 rating is the best mark among Penn State forwards.

MEET US AT THE DOT

• Penn State ranks second in the Big Ten and 11th nationally winning 55.1 percent of its faceoffs for the year behind only Wisconsin in the conference as the Badgers rank ninth in the nation winning 55.3 percent of its draws.

• A pair of freshmen lead the way for the Nittany Lions as Keaton Peters ranks second in the Big Ten among true centermen winning 61.1 percent (58-for-95) of his draws while Charlie Cerrato sits fourth in the Big Ten at 60.6 percent (57-for-94).

• Wisconsin's Owen Lindmark leads the conference at 67.6 percent (96-for-142).

SCOUTING WISCONSIN



• The Badgers had their winningest season in recent memory in 2023-24 going 26-12-2 and reaching the NCAA Tournament before bowing out to Quinnipiac in the first round. So far this season, Wisconsin is just 2-8-0 with a 1-5-0 conference record.

• The Badgers are without three of its top-5 leading scorers from last season including each of the top two in Cruz Lucius and David Silye while leading goal scorer Carson Bantle also graduated. Bantle had 14 goals a season ago while Lucius had 13 and a team-best 34 points. Silye led the team with 23 assists and was second with 32 points.

• Simon Tassy is the leading returning point getter for the Badgers as he ranked third on the team with 12 goals and 28 points a season ago, however, through the first 10 games of 2024-25, Tassy has just one goal and three points as just eight different Badgers have found the back of the net through 10 games.

• Quinn Finley leads those eight players with seven goals, three on the powerplay, to rank tied for the conference lead while ranking third nationally. His team-leading 10 points are tied for seventh in the Big Ten entering the weekend. Finley scored in both games last weekend for Wisconsin and had a three-game goal scoring stretch during the middle of October. Finley finished his freshman campaign last season with 10 goals and six assists for 16 points.

• The Badgers are also without the services of the 2024 Mike Richter Award winner, Kyle McClellan, between the pipes as returning sophomore William Gramme and RIT transfer Tommy Scarfone have split time evenly so far this season starting five games apiece. Gramme started each game last weekend against Minnesota after Scarfone played both games against Notre Dame the week before. The prior three series saw the two split time with Scarfone starting the opener and Gramme playing the finale.

• Both Gramme and Scarfone have similar numbers through 10 games this season each collecting one win with Gramme having a slightly better .886 save percentage to Scarfone's .885, but the latter boasts a stronger goals-against average of 2.59 compared to Gramme's 3.17.

• Specialty teams have been among their struggles this season as the Badgers rank last in the Big Ten and 50th out of 64 teams nationally on the penalty kill at 74.1 percent (20-for-27) while the powerplay has fared slightly better converting seven times on 37 chances (18.9 percent) to rank third in the conference, but only middle of the pack nationally. The Badgers had a string of four-straight games with a man-advantage tally snapped last Saturday against Minnesota.

DOMINANT D-FENCE

• Penn State has started the year strong on the defensive side of the puck allowing just 13 goals over the first seven games to rank third in the Big Ten and 14th nationally averaging 1.86 goals against per game.

• The Nittany Lions have yet to allow more than three goals in a game this season and have allowed fewer than three in four contests through the first month of the year.

• Penn State is also leading the Big Ten and tied for eighth in the nation allowing just 24.4 shots per game including just 12 two weeks ago against a Minnesota Gopher team who led the nation at the time averaging just under 40 shots per game and currently ranks second in the Big Ten and third nationally averaging 35.7 shots per game.

• The 12 shots in a game ties a Penn State record for fewest shots allowed set against AIC on October 20, 2023 and it marks the fewest shots ever allowed by the Nittany Lions in a Big Ten game.

ARSI'S ON IT

• Junior goaltender Arsenii Sergeev has played every minute for PSU so far in his first season in Hockey Valley and is currently sixth in the Big Ten and tied for 16th in the nation with a 1.71 goals-against average, however, he ranks tied for second in the conference and seventh in the nation among goaltenders with at least seven games played.

• Sergeev's .929 save percentage places him sixth in the Big Ten and 21st nationally while ranking third in the B1G and 10th in the nation among goalies with seven or more games played.

• Sergeev is the only Big Ten goaltender to play every minute of every game, aside from times where the net was empty, for his team through the first month and a half of the season.

NON-CONFERENCE DOMINATION

• Penn State concluded the 2023-24 non-conference slate with an 8-2-0 record.

• Penn State has now registered at least eight non-conference victories eight times and have a 75.2 percent all-time winning percentage in regular-season non-conference games since the Big Ten's inception prior to the 2013-14 season.

• The Nittany Lions are an eye-popping 49-7-1 in regular-season non-conference games since the start of the 2018-19 season including a 22-3-0 mark over the past two-plus seasons.

• Penn State remains home for the second of three-straight home series as the No. 5 Michigan Wolverines visit Hockey Valley next Friday and Saturday.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

• Senior Simon Mack was named the 11th captain in Penn State Hockey history with classmates Carson Dyck and Danny Dzhaniev along with graduate student Jimmy Dowd Jr. serving as alternate captains this season.

• Mack is the fourth Penn State blue-liner to serve as team captain and this marks the fourth-straight season a defensive player has been voted captain (Paul DeNaples 2022 and 2023, Christian Berger 2024).

• Mack along with Dyck, Dzhaniev and Dowd Jr. are each wearing a letter for the first time in their Nittany Lion careers marking back-to-back seasons Penn State has had an entirely new leadership group.

HUMANITARIAN EFFORTS

• Senior Dylan Lugris was named the 2024 Hockey Humanitarian Award winner becoming just the second Nittany Lion to be recognized with a major national award joining PJ Musico, the 2015 Derek Hines Unsung Hero Award recipient.

• Lugris came up with the idea for the Penn State Sled Hockey Classic two years ago. His mission is to grow the game of hockey while bringing awareness and knowledge to the sport of sled hockey and to provide the State College Coyotes the means necessary for organizational growth.

• Since the initial Penn State Sled Hockey Classic two years ago, following the second-annual event back in February, the Coyotes have more than doubled in roster size and are proud members of the Northeast Sled Hockey League competing in multiple games and tournaments per month thanks in large part to the near \$50,000 Dylan and his Penn State teammates have raised for the Coyotes organization.

• Guy Gadowsky is now the only NCAA Division I coach to have coached multiple Hockey Humanitarian winners as Lugris joins former Princeton goaltender Eric Leroux, the 2006 Hockey Humanitarian Award winner.

THE BIG GADOWSKY

• In his 13th season behind the Nittany Lion bench, head coach Guy Gadowsky has 213 victories at Penn State. Under his guidance PSU has posted five 20+ win seasons and reached the NCAA Tournament on three occasions with a pair of Big Ten Championships mixed in.

• With 386 total wins in his 24-year coaching career, Gadowsky ranks 35th among Division I coaches all-time and 12th among active NCAA Division I coaches.

HOCKEY VALLEY HAT-TRICKS

• Last November, Penn State registered a pair of hat-tricks in back-to-back games for the first time ever as Fink scored a trio of goals at Michigan on Saturday, November 18 and Jacques Bouquot tipped the hat in the very next game against Lindenwood just six days later.

• Ryan Kirwan added the third hat-trick of the season in a 7-6 victory over Army to start the New Year. The Nittany Lions now have 13 hat-tricks in program history and the 2023-24 campaign marked the first time in program history with three hat-tricks in the same season.

• Fink's hat-trick was just the second on the road in program history and first in a Big Ten road game. It was also just the fourth ever in conference play and first since Evan Barratt nearly five years ago to the day back on November 17, 2018.

DIMINUTIVE DANNY

• Standing just 5 foot 5 inches tall, junior Danny Dzhaniyev has the distinction as shortest player in college hockey for the third consecutive season. Dzhaniyev, who wears No. 13, is a full 15 inches shorter than the last player to don No. 13 for the Blue & White, Nikita Pavlychev, who at 6 foot 8 inches tall spent many years as the tallest player in college hockey.

PACKING THE PEG

• Penn State once again played in front of the highest capacity crowds in the nation in 2023-24 with a 110.7 percent capacity. Pegula Ice Arena has been sold out for 177 of its 194 games hosted all-time, excluding the 2020-21 season when fans were prohibited from attending games due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

• Penn State had a streak of 104-consecutive regular-season sell-outs from March 14, 2014 through November 22, 2019.

• More than 6,000 fans have filed into the arena on 136 occasions including 17 games in 2023-24 and both so far this season.

• The Nittany Lions averaged 6,314 fans per home game last season, the seventh highest attendance in the nation, including a Pegula Ice Arena record of 6,578 on January 27 against Ohio State. It marked the second-straight season that Penn State has set an attendance record during its annual Wear White game.

• Penn State also saw the second and third largest crowds in building history during a 4-2 victory over No. 14 Michigan drawing 6,571 fans and an overtime loss against Wisconsin attracting 6,569 fans.

• Along with the top three attended games in program history, six of the top-10 attended games all-time came last season.

• The 6,314 average and 110.7 capacity percentage are both single-season records at Pegula Ice Arena.

• Penn State celebrated its 1,000,000th fan at Pegula Ice Arena on January 20, 2023 against Notre Dame.

• Penn State saw a single-season record 133,422 fans come through the gates during the 2018-19 season.

WELCOME HOME

• Penn State opened the 5,704-seat Pegula Ice Arena with a 4-1 win against Army Oct. 11, 2013.

• The arena was brought to fruition through an initial \$88 million donation—the largest in University history—in September 2010 from Penn State alumnus Terry Pegula and his wife, Kim. The Pegulas added to that figure to bring their total donation to \$102, supplying \$90 million for the facility.

• The \$90 million facility broke ground in early February 2012 and was turned over to Penn State in September 2013.

THIS IS BIG TEN HOCKEY

• The Big Ten is in its 12th season entering 2024-25. In league action, each Big Ten team will play 24 league games, including 12 home contests.

• The Big Ten is comprised of seven total universities with the University of Notre Dame becoming an official affiliate member at the start of the 2017-18 season.

• Big Ten teams are awarded three points for a regulation victory, two points for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout win and one point for a 3-on-3 overtime or shootout loss.

• The 2018-19 season was the first season the Big Ten instituted a 3-on-3 overtime period joining the NCHC and WCHA. Continuing in 2022-23, regulation games that end in a tie will go straight to a 3-on-3 overtime where the winner is awarded the extra conference point.

• Big Ten schools have won a combined 23 national championships, more than any other league.

• The Big Ten Hockey Conference is the only Power 4 conference to sponsor men's hockey.

MEET COACH GADOWSKY

Guy Gadowsky guides the Nittany Lions in his 25th collegiate season at the helm of an NCAA Division I program and his 13th at Penn State in 2024-25. Gadowsky's 382 victories entering the 2024-25 season rank 35th all-time and are 12th among active coaches.

AT PENN STATE

This past season, the Nittany Lions won the first four games of the season for the second-straight year as Gadowsky led Penn State to a 15-win campaign including a trio of victories over top-15 opponents, No. 12 Michigan, No. 7 Minnesota and No. 14 Michigan. Penn State also secured its first-ever season sweep of Ohio State following its first-ever sweep in Columbus, only the third such instance in which the Nittany Lions have won all four games in a season against a conference foe and first

since the 2016-17 season. The Nittany Lions also secured their largest comeback in program history to start the New Year with five-unanswered goals in a 7-6 victory over Army West Point after trailing 6-2 midway through the game.

Gadowsky earned his 200th career victory as the Nittany Lion Bench Boss, also the 200th for the program, during a 5-3 victory against No. 12 Michigan at Yost Ice Arena on November 18, 2023, the first Penn State victory in Ann Arbor in four years.

Gadowsky saw freshman Aiden Fink land on the B1G All-Freshman team as the only unanimous selection becoming the first Penn State representative in eight seasons. Fink was also an All-Big Ten honorable mention and a Hobey Baker nominee as he led the team with 34 points, the third most by a Nittany Lion freshman all-time while his 19 assists and 15 goals were good for second and fifth, respectively.

Gadowsky also saw junior Dylan Lugin earn the 2024 Hockey Humanitarian Award as college hockey's finest citizen. Lugin became the second HHA recipient to be coached by Gadowsky as he is now the only coach to roster multiple Humanitarian winners. Lugin is also now just the second Nittany Lion to receive a national award joining PJ Musico, the 2015 Derek Hines Unsung Hero Award winner.

In the classroom Penn State bolstered the highest grade point average for a men's team in Happy Valley during the fall semester with a 3.50 GPA and the Nittany Lions had a Big Ten best nine distinguished scholars recognized in the spring.

The Nittany Lions once again led the country in attendance capacity at 110.7 percent while achieving their three highest attended games in program history.

In 2022-23, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to their third NCAA Tournament appearance over the past six that have been played (The 2020 postseason was can-

celed due to the COVID-19 pandemic with Penn State sitting No. 7 in the PairWise). Penn State advanced to the Allentown Regional Final following an 8-0 victory over Michigan Tech, the largest shutout in NCAA Tournament history. The Nittany Lions finished the year 22-16-1 registering the second-most wins in a single-season in program history and it was also the fifth 20+-win season over the past eight years for Penn State under Gadowsky.

Led by goaltender Liam Souliere, Penn State improved drastically on the defensive side of the puck lowering its goals-against average by nearly a half goal per game from the 2021-22 campaign. Souliere had one of the best seasons in program history between the pipes as his 2.43 goals-against average set a new Penn State single-season record while his 19 wins are the second-most all time and his .917 save percentage is the third best mark.

Penn State climbed to as high as No. 5 during the 2022-23 season and became the first team in NCAA history to defeat separate No. 1 ranked teams in back-to-back weeks when they defeated No. 1 Michigan and No. 1 Minnesota on consecutive weekends in November. The Nittany Lions finished the year with a No. 8 final ranking in both national polls to tie their highest finish all-time.

In 2021-22, Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions back to the Big Ten semifinals for the seventh-straight season and the eighth time overall in the nine-year history of the conference. Both marks tie for the most all-time.

Penn State became the first road team in league history to win a best-of-three quarterfinal series defeating No. 12 Ohio State in back-to-back games after starting in a one-game hole following an opening game loss.

Throughout the 2021-22 season, Penn State had marquee wins against No. 6

North Dakota in the first-ever meeting between the two schools. The Nittany Lions defeated the Fighting Hawks, 6-4, in front of a sold-out crowd at Bridgestone Arena in Nashville, Tennessee during the 2021 US Hockey Hall of Fame Game. The Nittany Lions also defeated No. 7 Minnesota on the road for just the sixth time in program history.

Gadowsky also saw former captain Brandon Biro '20 make his NHL debut as he suited up for the Buffalo Sabres back in February becoming the third former Nittany Lion to lace 'em up in the show.

In a season unlike any other in 2020-21, Gadowsky led Penn State back to the Big Ten semifinals for the sixth consecutive season and the seventh time overall as he became the winningest coach in the history of the tournament after securing his 11th victory in B1G tournament play.

The Bench Boss registered his 150th career victory at Penn State in his 300th game as Nittany Lion head coach on January 9, 2021 at Ohio State.

Penn State captain Alex Limoges went on to sign an AHL contract with the San Diego Gulls and in just 23 games scored 11 goals while adding 10 assists for 21 points.

Following the season Aarne Talvitie inked his entry-level, NHL contract with the New Jersey Devils while earlier in the season former Nittany Lion Peyton Jones also put pen to paper on an NHL contract giving Penn State six NHL signees in the past two seasons and 10 overall.

Near the conclusion of the 2020-21 NHL season former Penn State forward Brett Murray (2017-18) made his NHL debut with the Buffalo Sabres becoming the second Nittany Lions to skate in an NHL contest.

Gadowsky led Penn State to its first-ever Big Ten regular-season championship during the 2019-20 season with a single-season program record 12 conference victories and 41 points. The Penn State bench boss was named a finalist for the Big Ten Coach of the Year award while leading the Nittany Lions to the Big Ten Tournament semifinals for the sixth time in the seven-year history of the conference. Penn State earned a first-round bye straight to the semifinals.

Gadowsky secured his seventh career 20-win season and his fourth in the past five years at Penn State in 2019-20 becoming one of just two Big Ten programs to have four 20-win seasons over the past five years. He also had the Nittany Lions in line for their third NCAA Tournament appearance before the postseason was canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic with Penn State finishing the season No. 7 in the final PairWise rankings marking the highest finish in program history.

Gadowsky registered his 300th career victory in October against Sacred Heart.

In 2019-20 he coached Penn State's first-ever CCM/AHCA All-Americans as both Cole Hults and Nate Sucease landed on the Second-Team West while also being named First-Team All-Big Ten. Hults earned Penn State's first-ever Big Ten Player of the Year honors while also garnering Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year while Sucease took over as the program's all-time leader in goals (61) and points (140) during the 2019-20 season.

At the conclusion of the season the Nittany Lions saw four players sign NHL entry-level contracts while three others signed AHL deals.

In 2018-19, Gadowsky led Penn State to its second-highest win total in program history with 22, and became the winningest coach in Big Ten Tournament history, compiling a 10-6 record over six seasons. The Nittany Lions returned to the Big Ten Championship game for the second time in the past three seasons, but dropped a tough 3-2 decision at Notre Dame.

Penn State secured its most Big Ten wins in program history with 11 while its 35 points were also the most in a single season. The Nittany Lions once again led the nation in goals per game with a new single-season record of 4.54 while also setting single-season records for goals (177), assists (301) and points (478), each of which were also tops in the nation.

Gadowsky saw sophomore Alex Limoges become the first Nittany Lion ever to lead the nation in points as he set a single-season program record with 50 while his 23 goals were also a new program standard and ranked tied for second in the nation.

Sophomore Evan Barratt became just the fourth player in program history and third in the last three seasons to earn first-team All-Big Ten honors. Barratt, along with teammate Aarne Talvitie, also became the first Nittany Lions ever to represent their countries at the IIHF World Junior Championship. Talvitie captained Finland to the gold medal while Barratt helped Team USA take home the silver.

Despite the win total and records the Nittany Lions fell one spot short of the NCAA Tournament, finishing the season at No. 16 in the PairWise rankings.

Gadowsky led his Nittany Lions to their second-straight NCAA Tournament in 2017-18. Penn State was able to take the short drive down to Allentown, Pennsylvania, as it served as host for the Midwest Regional. The Nittany Lions' season was cut short at the hands of the Denver Pioneers, 5-1, in the NCAA Midwest Regional semifinal.

Earlier in the 2017-18 season, Gadowsky secured his 100th career victory at Penn State, also the 100th victory for the program, a 5-1 win over Minnesota on February 23, 2018. That victory was the start of the Nittany Lions first-ever sweep of the Golden Gophers, which secured home ice

for Penn State in the Big Ten Tournament quarterfinals. Penn State went on to sweep Minnesota in two games, clinching the series and its fourth B1G Semifinal appearance in five years.

Junior Andrew Sturtz became just the second member of the 100-point club at Penn State in 2017-18 and the all-time leading goal scorer in program history. Sturtz graduated early and signed an NHL deal with the Ottawa Senators.

Gadowsky also coached Trevor Hamilton to a Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year award, the first major conference honor awarded to a Nittany Lion. To that point, Hamilton joined Casey Bailey and Vince Pedrie as the only first-team All-Conference members in program history.

In 2016-17, Gadowsky led Penn State to its most successful season ever, compiling a record of 25-12-2. Penn State won the 2017 Big Ten Tournament and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament appearance, falling one game shy of the Frozen Four. The Nittany Lions defeated Union 10-3, tying the record for most goals in a team's tournament debut, before bowing out to eventual national champion Denver, 6-3, in the Midwest Regional final.

Penn State opened the 2016-17 season 13-1-1 using a program-best 11-game winning streak. The Nittany Lions also earned their first-ever uscho.com No. 1 national ranking on Jan. 17, 2017, with a 16-2-1 record. Penn State finished the season as the highest-scoring team in the country, averaging 4.10 goals per game.

The 2016-17 Nittany Lions also set numerous single-season team records on offense, including most goals (160), assists (265), points (425), shots (1,719), goals/gm (4.10) and shots/gm (44.1) to go along with the program-best 25 victories.

Penn State had its first 20-win season under Gadowsky in 2015-16, finishing third in

the Big Ten with a 21-13-4-1 overall record.

Penn State rose as high as 14th in the uscho.com National Poll in the 2015-16 campaign. On February 6, the Nittany Lions earned their first-ever victory at Minnesota's Mariucci Arena as they defeated the Gophers 5-3.

PSU secured a 5-2 triumph over Wisconsin in the Big Ten quarterfinals before a loss to eventual champion Michigan in the semifinals.

Of Gadowsky's 24 players on the 2015-16 roster, eight signed professional contracts in the off-season ranging from the ECHL, AHL, NHL and Europe.

His 2014-15 Nittany Lions exceeded expectations all season, with a winning record in overall action (18-15-4) and Big Ten play (10-9-1-0), while earning the program's first national ranking. Despite being picked sixth in the preseason, Gadowsky's team was in the hunt for a Big Ten title until the final weekend of the season.

Under Gadowsky's tutelage, junior Casey Bailey led the Big Ten in scoring and parlayed his outstanding season into a two-year contract with the Toronto Maple Leafs. Bailey was an All-Big Ten first-team honoree, while six other Nittany Lions earned honorable-mention recognition from the league coaches.

The 2014-15 season also saw Gadowsky reach the 200-win plateau in historic fashion when his Lions knocked off No. 4 UMass Lowell, 4-1 on Nov. 15, 2014. The program's rise from its first year in the Big Ten to its sophomore campaign saw gains of 10 wins overall and seven wins in conference play.

Penn State earned wins over every Big Ten team in 2014-15 including a season sweep of perennial power Wisconsin and a first win over Big Ten champion Minnesota on THON Night.

During the 2013-14 campaign, the bench boss guided the Nittany Lions in its first season of Big Ten Conference play. Penn State faced seven NCAA tournament teams and three Frozen Four participants, and capped its season with a 2-1 double-overtime victory against Michigan in the Big Ten quarterfinals.

Gadowsky led the Nittany Lions to double-digit wins (13-14-0) during their inaugural NCAA Division I season in 2012-13, with several marquee victories, including wins against three future Big Ten opponents (Michigan State, Ohio State, Wisconsin). Penn State also topped Vermont at Wells Fargo Arena in front of the largest crowd to watch a college hockey game in an NHL barn (19,529).

Gadowsky steered Penn State's final season in the ACHA in 2011-12, while recruiting for the future. That team went 29-5-0.

AT PRINCETON

Before arriving in Happy Valley, Gadowsky served as Princeton's bench boss for seven seasons. In his first five years as head coach, the Tigers improved their win total in each season. In 2008-09, Princeton captured a program-record 22 victories and earned its second-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Gadowsky took a program that had a won a combined eight games in the two seasons prior to his arrival and guided it to both the ECAC Hockey Tournament and Ivy League crowns in 2007-08. The team earned its first NCAA Tournament berth since 1998, and Gadowsky garnered ECAC Hockey Coach of the Year honors and was a finalist for the Spencer Penrose Award, presented to Division I hockey's top coach. He was also named Inside College Hockey National Coach of the Year.

More than 20 Tiger players went on to sign professional contracts, with Kevin Westgarth playing for the Stanley Cup champion Los Angeles Kings in 2011-12. Gadowsky also coached two ECAC and Ivy League Players of the Year as Lee Jubinville (2008) and Zane Kalembe (2009) each won the award in their junior seasons.

HEAD COACH GUY GADOWSKY



AT ALASKA

Gadowsky spent five seasons as head coach of Alaska (1999-2004), where he took a team that had not won more than 14 games in any of the previous five seasons since joining the then-Central Collegiate Hockey Association. After two rebuilding seasons, the 2002 CCHA Coach of the Year led the Nanooks, ranked 11th nationally at the end of the season, to their only 20-win campaign since joining the conference. He followed that up with 15 wins in 2002-03 and 16 victories his last season.

Alaska twice hosted the first round of the CCHA playoffs in a three-year span, a feat never accomplished prior to Gadowsky's arrival. During his tenure with the Nanooks, his teams set school records for team grade-point average, wins and game attendance.

BEFORE COLLEGE COACHING

Before joining the collegiate ranks, Gadowsky spent three seasons (1996-99) as head coach and director of hockey operations for the Fresno Falcons of the West Coast Hockey League. He led the squad to the playoffs in each season and left the team as the winningest coach in franchise history. In his first season, Gadowsky posted a 38-win campaign and garnered WCHL Coach of the Year accolades.

PLAYING CAREER

The Edmonton, Alberta, native played collegiately at Colorado College from 1985-89, serving as team captain as a senior, while also earning the team's Rodman Award, given for outstanding leadership and sportsmanship. A three-time WCHA All-Academic team member, he collected 46 points in 134 career games.

Upon graduation, Gadowsky embarked on a seven-year professional career that included stops with the ECHL's Richmond Renegades, the IHL's San Diego Gulls and the AHL's St. John's Maple Leafs and Prince Edward Island Senators. Gadowsky saved his best season for last as he totaled 52 goals and 29 assists for the Fresno Falcons in 1995-96. He earned league MVP and first-team all-star recognition.

Gadowsky also competed with the Canadian National Team and played professionally in Austria, the Netherlands and Sweden during the 1993-94 season.

PERSONAL LIFE

Gadowsky and his wife, Melissa, have two sons, Mac and Magnus, and a daughter, Mia.
