OPENING TIPS

- Penn State puts its 4-0 record on the line when the Nittany Lions host Horizon League preseason favorite Purdue Fort Wayne in an on-campus game of the Sunshine Slam Wednesday night.
- The Nittany Lions lead the country in steals per game (15.3) and turnover margin (10.8), rank fourth in scoring margin (+35.8) and eighth in points per game (97.3).
- Five Nittany Lions are averaging double-digit points, led by Zach Hicks' 15.5 points per game.

IF PENN STATE BEATS PURDUE FORT WAYNE

- Penn State would start the season 5-0 for the first time since the 2019-20 campaign.
- The Nittany Lions would move to 2-0 all-time vs. Purdue Fort Wayne.

DOMINATION

The Nittany Lions have played 160 minutes of basketball this season and trailed for just 20 seconds. Penn State trailed St. Francis (Pa.) from 2:17 to 1:57 in the first half.

Penn State is outscoring its opponents by an average of 35.8 points per game, a mark that ranks fourth in all of Division I. All four of Penn State's wins have come by 22 or more points.

HIGH OCTANE

Penn State is averaging 97.3 points per game through the first four games of the season, a mark that ranks eighth in the country.

The Nittany Lions have scored 85-plus points in all four of their games this season, marking the first time since 2019 that Penn State has scored 80+ in four consecutive games. Should Penn State score 80+ Wednesday night vs. Purdue Fort Wayne, it would be the first time in program history that the Nittany Lions have scored 80+ in five-straight games.

Penn State scored 100+ points in back-to-back games for the first time in program history as the Nittany Lions opened the season with a 108-66 win over Binghamton and followed it with a 103-54 victory over UMBC. They were Penn State's first 100-plus point games since 2017 when the Nittany Lions scored 102 in triple overtime at Indiana and the 108-point effort vs. Binghamton was Penn State's first 100-plus point performance in a regulation game since 2009. It marked the first time Penn State has had two 100-plus point games in the same season since the 1954-55 season.

TURNING DEFENSE INTO OFFENSE

Penn State leads the nation in both steals per game (15.3) and turnover margin (+10.8) through games on Nov. 18.

The Nittany Lions have owned a 105-33 advantage in points scored off turnovers, a 65-29 edge in second-chance points and 82-27 advantage in fast-break points through the first four games of the season.

BALANCED ATTACK

Nine of the 13 players that have dressed in Penn State's first four games of the season have scored in double figures in the Nittany Lions' balanced offensive attack.

Five different players are averaging double-digit points through the first four games of the season.

ONE OF ONE

Graduate student Ace Baldwin Jr. is the ONLY active Division I player with 1,000+ career points (1,354), 600+ career assists (646) and 250+ career steals (282).

Baldwin Jr. is Division I's active career leader in steals (282) and his 646 career assists are second amongst active Division I players.

ZACH ATTACK

Senior Zach Hicks is Penn State's leading scorer through the first four games of the season and has put up impressive numbers with his 15.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 2.3 assists, 2.0 steals and 1.5 blocks per game. Hicks is shooting 56.4 percent from the field and 48.3 percent from deep thus far this season and has drained a team-leading 14 triples.

Hicks earned honorable mention All-Big Ten honors a season ago after leading the Nittany Lions with 67 made 3-pointers and ranking second on the team in rebounds (130) and free throw percentage (81.3%). He averaged 12.2 points per game while shooting 41.3 percent (33-80) from 3-point range over the final 12 games of the season.

BRING 'EM BACK

The Nittany Lions bring back five of their top seven scorers from a season ago in reigning Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year Ace Baldwin Jr., honorable mention All-Big Ten pick Nick Kern Jr., honorable mention All-Big Ten pick Zach Hicks, Puff Johnson and D'Marco Dunn.

GOT AN ACE UP OUR SLEEVE

Ace Baldwin Jr. earned a spot on the Naismith Trophy Men's College Player of the Year Watch List this preseason, in addition landing on the Bob Cousy Point Guard of the Year Top 20 Preseason Watch List and being named a Preseason All-Big Ten selection.

The point guard is coming off a senior season in which he was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year, a Naismith National Defensive Player of the Year Semifinalist, a Lefty Driesell Defensive Player of the Year Finalist, an NABC Second Team All-District 7 selection, a third-team All-Big Ten (coaches & media) pick and a Big Ten All-Defensive Team honoree. Baldwin Jr. was one of just four Big Ten players since 1992-93 (31 years) and the first since 2011-12 to finish a season averaging 14.0+ points per game, 6.0+ assists per game and 2.0+ steals per game as season ago.

He is averaging 14.3 points, 7.0 assists, 2.8 steals and 2.0 rebounds per game through the first four games this season.

BIG FELLA BURSTING ONTO THE SCENE

Yanic Konan Niederhauser, Penn State's mobile and versatile seven-foot forward, has burst onto the scene in his first four games in the Blue & White.

Konan Niederhauser is averaging 11.3 points and a team-best 6.5 rebounds per game while shooting 62.5 percent (15-24) from the field through the first four games of the season.

The Switzerland native transferred to Penn State ahead of the 2024-25 season following two years at Northern Illinois.

FUTURE LOOKS BRIGHT

Head Coach Mike Rhoades has inked the highest-ranked recruiting class in program history and the 19th-ranked class in the country as three highly-touted prospects signed to join the Nittany Lions during the November early signing period.

Penn State's three-member class ranks 19th in the nation per 247 Sports. The three-member class is comprised of Mason Blackwood (Rochester, N.Y.), Justin Houser (Camp Hill, Pa.) and Kayden Mingo (Farmingdale, N.Y.). The three new Nittany Lions join the program as the Class of 2029 and bring accomplished athletic and academic pedigrees to Penn State.

THE OPPOSITION

SCOUTING PURDUE FORT WAYNE

- The Mastodons are 3-1 on the young season.
- Purdue Fort Wayne's wins have come over Bluffton (99-47), Bethune-Cookman (91-69) and Southern Indiana (93-74). The Mastodons' lone loss was a 68-75 road defeat at UCF.
- Rasheed Bello leads Purdue Fort Wayne with 18.5 points per game, while Jalen Jackson follows closely with 17.0 points per contest. Eric Mulder is averaging 10.8 points and a team-best 8.5 rebounds per game.
- Purdue Fort Wayne was picked to finish atop the Horizon League this season and is coming off a 23-13 campaign in 2023-24 that saw the Mastodons finish as the runner-up in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.

AGAINST THE MASTODONS

- Penn State and Purdue Fort Wayne meet for just the second time in program history Wednesday night.
- The only other meeting came on Dec. 28, 2005, a 74-59 Penn State win inside the Bryce Jordan Center.

ON THE RIGHT RHOADES

Head Coach Mike Rhoades enters his second season at the helm of the Nittany Lions in 2024-25. Here's a look at what he and his staff accomplished during their first season in Happy Valley:

Two wins over top-15 ranked teams in #12 Illinois and #11 Wisconsin.

Win over #11 Wisconsin was the highest-ranked win under a first-year head coach in program history.

Nine Big Ten wins were the second-most by a first-year head coach in program history.

Engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 (75.1 ppg).

Penn State led the Big Ten in steals per game (8.3), turnover margin (+3.6) and three-point percentage defense (30.3%).

THE 2024-25 SLATE

Penn State is set to host seven non-conference home games and 10 Big Ten matchups, including a Sunday, Jan. 5, tilt with Indiana inside the historic Palestra in Philadelphia, and a Thursday, Jan. 30, Return to Rec game against Ohio State inside Rec Hall on Penn State's campus. The 2024-25 schedule features seven Friday, Saturday or Sunday home games inside the Bryce Jordan Center, three of which come in conference play.

The Nittany Lions visited CFG Bank Arena in Baltimore to face Virginia Tech on Nov. 15 in the Hall of Fame Series Baltimore, and will take a trip to Wells Fargo Center in Philadelphia, the home of the NBA's 76ers, on Dec. 21 to meet Drexel. Penn State will head to Florida during Thanksgiving week for the two-game Sunshine Slam in Daytona Beach where the Nittany Lions will match up with Fordham before facing either Clemson or San Francisco.

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH

MIKE RHOADES

Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Men's Basketball Head Coach Mike Rhoades enters his second season as the leader of the Nittany Lions in 2024-25. Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Dr. Patrick Kraft announced the hiring of Rhoades as the 15th head coach in program history on March 29, 2023. In 20 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rhoades, a Mahanoy City, Pennsylvania native, has produced a 389-206 record, a winning percentage of .654, seven NCAA Tournament appearances and nine national postseason appearances.

Rhoades laid a strong foundation during his first season at Penn State in 2023-24. Rhoades led the Nittany Lions to a 16-17 overall record and 9-11 mark in conference play, marking the second-most Big Ten wins by a first-year head coach in program history. The Nittany Lions defeated a pair of top-15 ranked teams in #12 Illinois and #11 Wisconsin, with the win over the 11th-ranked Badgers marking the highest-ranked win under a first-year head coach in program history.

Rhoades engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 as the Nittany Lions averaged 75.1 points per game in his debut season. Penn State's 75.2 points per game in regular-season Big Ten play was the second-highest in Penn State's 32 seasons in the Big Ten, behind only the 2000-01 Nittany Lions team's 75.4 points per Big Ten game. Defensively, Penn State led the Big Ten in steals per game (8.3), turnover margin (+3.6) and three-point percentage defense (30.3%) in 2023-24. Rhoades developed and mentored the 2024 Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year in Ace Baldwin Jr. and four All-Big Ten selections in Baldwin Jr., Qudus Wahab, Nick Kern Jr. and Zach Hicks.

Rhoades came to Penn State following a six-year stint as the head coach at VCU in which he guided the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances, a 129-60 overall record and 72-32 Atlantic 10 Conference record. He is the fourth-winningest coach in VCU history. Rhoades developed a pair of Atlantic 10 Players of the Year and 13 all-conference selections throughout his six years in Richmond. On the recruiting trail, Rhoades signed the Atlantic 10's top-ranked recruiting class in three of his last four years at VCU. In his time as an assistant and head coach at VCU, he was responsible for signing eight of the top nine all-time Ram recruits per 247Sports.

The Rams won both the Atlantic 10 regular-season and tournament championships during the 2022-23 season, making their third NCAA Tournament appearance under Rhoades and finishing 27-8 overall. The Rams' 27 wins were the most under Rhoades and the most for VCU since the 2012-13 season. Rhoades mentored VCU junior point guard Ace Baldwin Jr. to Atlantic 10 Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year honors in the 2022-23 season.

In just his second season in 2018-19, Rhoades led the Rams back to the NCAA Tournament, as well as their first Atlantic 10 Conference outright regular-season championship. VCU's 25 total wins, including 16 conference victories, tied program regular-season marks. For his efforts, he was named Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year and was a finalist for the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year award. Rhoades led the Rams back to the NCAA Tournament in 2020-21 following a 19-7 campaign in which the Black and Gold reached the A-10 Championship Game.

Under Rhoades tutelage, VCU saw players selected in back-to-back NBA Drafts, when Nah'Shon "Bones" Hyland was selected 26th overall by the Denver Nuggets in 2021, and Vince Williams Jr. was picked 47th overall by the Memphis Grizzlies in 2022. Justin Tillman also spent time with the Atlanta Hawks active roster during the 2021-22 season. Additionally, former VCU players Larry Sanders, Troy Daniels, Briante Weber and Treveon Graham, who each played for Rhoades during his days as an assistant coach at VCU from 2009-14, all spent time in the NBA. Mo Alie-Cox played basketball for Rhoades at VCU and has gone on to be a tight end for the NFL's Indianapolis Colts.

Prior to his six years in the head chair at VCU, Rhoades engineered a stunning turnaround at Rice as head coach of the Owls from 2014-17. Rhoades led Rice to its first 20-win campaign since 2003-04 and the program's first postseason appearance since 2011-12. Rice's 23-12 mark in 2016-17 was an 11-win improvement over the 2015-16 season and the 23 wins were the second-most in Owls' history. The Owls were a combined 12-49 in the two seasons prior to his arrival.

Rhoades spent 2009-14 as an assistant coach and associate head coach at VCU prior to taking the head coaching job at Rice. VCU reached the NCAA Tournament four times and appeared in the postseason all five years of that stretch. The Rams were 137-46 during that period and won the 2012 CAA Championship. He was integral in recruiting and developing the players that would lead the Rams to a historic Final Four appearance in 2010-11. In 2012, after VCU toppled Wichita State in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament, Rhoades was named one of the top 10 assistant coaches under 40 in the country by ESPN.com.

Prior to his VCU tenure, Rhoades enjoyed a wildly successful run at Division III Randolph-Macon in Ashland, Virginia. In 10 seasons as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, Rhoades compiled a 197-76 record (.722 win percentage) and led RMC to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including trips to the Sweet 16 in 2002 and 2003. Rhoades' teams won six Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) championships and earned national No. 1 rankings in two seasons. He was named ODAC Coach of the Year in three-straight seasons from 2001-03, coached three ODAC Players of the Year, five ODAC Freshmen of the Year, as well as 17 All-ODAC selections. He began his coaching career at age 23 as an assistant at Randolph-Macon in 1996 under long-time head coach Hal Nunnally.

Rhoades played collegiately under coaches Pat Flannery and Brad McAlester at Lebanon Valley College in his home state of Pennsylvania. Rhoades guided the Flying Dutchmen to the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship with a 66-59 overtime win over NYU. He was named the tournament's Co-Outstanding Player. The guard was the USA Today Division III National Player of the Year in 1995, two-time NABC All-American, three-time NABC All-Region and three-time Middle Atlantic Conference Player of the Year. He was the school's all-time scoring leader (2,050) until 1999, but still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey is one of five basketball jerseys retired by LVC.

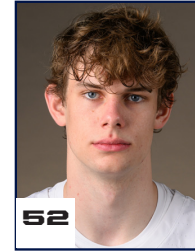

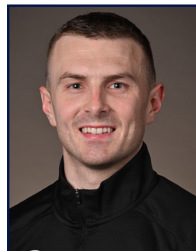

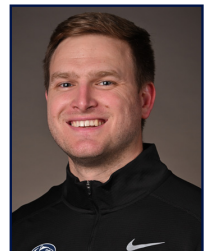
