PENN STATE TRAVELS TO DISNEY

RV Penn State women's basketball takes on Georgia in the second game of the State Farm WBCA Showcase on Saturday afternoon. The Lady Lions look to seal their second win of the two-game tournament and seek their first win against the Bulldogs in program history.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Lady Lions showed grit in the first game of the WBCA State Farm Showcase. They pulled out a 74-59 win over Marshall on Thursday night.
- » Penn State earned its sixth consecutive victory to open the 2024-25 campaign 6-0. This marks the second time in three seasons the team is off to an unblemished start through six games and only the seventh time in program history with two coming under the helm of head coach Carolyn Kieger.
- » Redshirt-sophomore Gracie Merkle produced her third double-double of the season and 22nd of her career using 28 points and 11 rebounds. She is the only Lady Lion to score in double-figures in all six games.
- » Graduate student Alli Campbell posted a 12-point outing, her first time scoring double-digit points this season. She also added five rebounds, three assists, one steal and one block.
- » Grace Hall reached 10 points for the second time this season using five-of-nine shooting from the field. She also collected four boards.
- The Lady Lions outscored the Herd 42-20 in the paint, producing a 41.2 shooting percentage from the field. They also held Marshall to just 28.1% shooting from the field and 18.8% from beyond the arc.
- » Penn State forced 22 turnovers and converted 14 points off that defense.

NON-CON DOMINANCE IN THE BJC

- » The Lady Lions produced an unblemished non-conference home court record last season, going 10-0 in the early parts of the season, all the way through the WBIT.
- PSU extended its streak to 16 with a win against Bucknell on Monday, Nov. 4 in the season opener, a second win against Canisius on Nov. 7, a comeback victory over Duquesne on Nov. 10, a dominant 101-45 win over Niagara and a 100-55 victory against Monmouth on Sunday, Nov. 17.
- The streak of 16-straight home court non-conference wins, dating back to Dec. 21, 2022, is tied for the longest stretch in program history.
- Penn State has not lost a home game since Dec.
 18, 2022 when it lost to Drexel.

PENN STATE VS. GEORGIA SERIES

- Penn State has only faced Georgia two times in program history, both games were in the 90s. The Lady Lions and Bulldogs completed a home-andaway series in 1996 in Happy Valley and 1997 in Athens.
- · Georgia owns both wins.
- The first meeting between the two teams in University Park, Pa. was the first-ever women's basketball game played in the newly constructed Bryce Jordan Center, the current home to both Penn State basketball programs. Prior to the game in January of 1996, the Lady Lions played all of their games in Rec Hall.

LADY LIONS IN THE RANKS

- » Moriah Murray ranks eighth in the Big Ten in points per game (18.0) and third in total points (108). She sits 15th in the nation in total points, first in three pointers per game (4.7) and is tied for first in total three pointers (28). The Pennsylvania native is first in the B1G in total threes and first in threes per game. Murray is also one of 18 players to remain perfect from the free throw line this season.
- » Merkle ranks 5th in the country in total points (126) and first in the conference. She also sits fourth in the conference in points per game (21.0). Merkle is also third in the nation in field goals made (52) and field goal percentage (65.8). Her three double-doubles ranks her fourth in the country and first in the B1G.
- Alli Campbell is ranked 21st in the country in assists (28).
- » Penn State is second the nation in total assists (139) and sits 11th in assists per game (21.5). The

- team is second in the conference in total assists and ranks fourth in assists per game.
- The Blue & White produced one of their most effective back-to-back shooting outings against Niagara and Monmouth, leaving the team ranked 15th in the country in shooting percentage from the field (50.8) and third in the Big Ten.
- » The Lady Lions also have the 10th-best scoring offense across the country, averaging 91.0 points per contest.

MURRAY MAGIC

- » Murray is responsible for 108 points throughout Penn State's first six games of the campaign. She produced a career night in the season opener against Bucknell, posting 28 points using eight three pointers, the second highest single-game three-point record in program history.
- » After an eight-point outing in game two, Murray continued her scoring tear against Duquesne with 26 points in the Lady Lions comeback win on Sunday. Her 28 points on six-of-10 shooting from three-point range along with six-of-six shooting from the free throw line guided Penn State in its journey back from an 18-point early deficit.
- » She continued her hot streak with another double figure scoring outing against Niagara, posting 17 points using five threes and two free throws.
- » In her most recent outing against Monmouth, Murray put up 23 points, 21 of them coming from beyond the arc to total 47 made threes on the season.
- » In the first-of-two games at the WBCA Showcase, she managed six points, all of which came from long-range.
- » Murray averages 18.0 points, 2.3 rebounds, 1.83 steals and 1.5 assists through six games. She is also producing unblemished shooting from the charity stripe, going 14-for-14 on the season.

POST MASTER

- » Redshirt sophomore center Gracie Merkle continues to guide the Lady Lions using her height and strength under the rim.
- » Merkle leads the team in scoring, averaging 21.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 2.17 blocks per game through the first six contests of the season.
- » She is the only Lady Lion to post double figure scoring in all six of Penn State's games so far including three double-doubles, a 21 point and 13 rebound performance against Bucknell, a 20-point, 12 board outing against Monmouth and a season high 28 points and 11 rebounds versus Marshall.

2023-24 SEASON IN REVIEW

- » Penn State produced its best overall record in a decade with its 22-13 season.
- » The Lady Lions advanced to the Final Four of

- the Inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament, marking their first postseason appearance since 2017-18.
- » Penn State was one of four one-seeds in the tournament after just missing a spot in the NCAA Tournament.
- » The Lady Lions finished ranked sixth in the Big Ten.
- » Penn State consistently ranked in the top-10 in three major statistical categories throughout the 2023-24 campaign. PSU produced one of the highest level offenses in the country with steady recognition in field goal percentage, three-point percentage and scoring offense.
- » The Lady Lions had for 100-plus-point performances, 13 90-plus point games and 21 80-plus point performances.
- » Penn State shattered its single game three-point record on two different occasions last season. Once against Central Connecticut on Dec. 20 with 15 three-pointers and then again when it hosted Maryland on Jan. 28 with 16.

2023-24 B1G POSTSEASON AWARDS

- » Ashley Owusu was named to All-Big Ten second team by coaches and honorable mention by media.
- » Makenna Marisa was named second team All-Big Ten by media and honorable mention by coaches.
- » Leilani Kapinus was named to the All-Big Ten defensive team by coaches and media and was an All-Big Ten honorable mention by the media.
- » Tay Valladay is an honorable mention by the media and Penn State's Sportsmanship Award recipient.
- » Shay Ciezki was an honorable mention by media.

POSTSEASON PLAY

- The Lady Lions earned a number one seed in the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament in 2024.
- This was Penn State's first postseason appearance since 2017-18 when the team lost in the first round of the WNIT to Radford.
- » The WBIT appearance is head coach Kieger's first postseason appearance in Happy Valley.
- The Lady Lions advanced to the Final Four of the WBIT, losing to Villanova in the semifinals.
- » As the highest seed in the tournament, PSU earned hosting rights through the first three rounds of competition.
- » Penn State first hosted George Mason, a game that went to overtime but eventually ended with a 84-80 Penn State victory.
- » Next, the Blue & White hosted Belmont on March 25, which resulted in a 74-66 PSU win.
- The final host site game before traveling to Hinkle Fieldhouse for the Final Four, was a quarterfinal match up against SEC opponent Mississippi State. The Lady Lions put forth a dominant performance with a 92-87 win to advance to the semifinals.

NOTES AND HEADLINES

TRANSER TALK

- » Head Coach Kieger picked up four transfers in the portal this off season.
- » Gracie Merkle came to Happy Valley after spending two years at Bellarmine where she lead the country in field goal percentage her freshman season. She suffered an injury during her sophomore campaign and returns to the court with the Lady Lions this fall. Merkle is a 6'6 center, the tallest athlete in Lady Lions history.
- » Gabby Elliott brings two years of Big Ten experience and four total years of collegiate basketball experience to the Lady Lions. She played her most recent two seasons at Michigan State and spent her first two seasons at Clemson where she was an all-conference performer her freshmen year. Elliott has battled injuries on and off since her sophomore season.
- Tamera Johnson is a graduate transfer from Louisianna Lafayette. She spent all four years in Louisiana as a forward. Johnson averaged double figure scoring in her two most recent seasons, including a career best 11.3 clip her senior campaign. She ranked 15th in blocks (18), 18th in rebounding (6.1) and 22nd in steals (41) in the Sun Belt Conference this past season, while producing the second highest scoring average on her team among the starting five...
- Vitoria Santana is a Brazil native who played her first two seasons at Eastern Arizona. She was a dominant performer, averaging 15.9 points, 8.1 rebounds and 3.8 assists per game in her last year at EAU. Santana recorded 30, double-digit scoring efforts including two, 30-plus-point outings. She compiled four ACCAC Player of the Week nods throughout her time in Arizona and earned Defensive Player of the Year, All-ACCAC DI first team and All-Region DI first team in her most recent campaign.

2024-25 FRESH FACE FRESHMEN

- The Lady Lions introduce five freshmen to their roster for the 2024-25 season.
- » Jill Jekot enrolled at Penn State in January of 2024. The Pennsylvania native was a two-time Mid Penn All-Conference first team selection,

- two-time first team All-State member. Jekot earned several awards throughout her high school career including Mid Penn Commonwealth Player of the Year, Hempfield Tip-Off Tournament MVP and United Ban Myrtle Beach Classic All-Tournament honors
- » Cam Rust was a highly touted recruit and consensus top-100 player across multiple ratings agencies. Rust was a four-star ranking out of high school according to Prospects Nation and a 90 Grade according to ESPN.
- Talayah Walker joins the Lady Lions from Odenton, Md. Walker averaged 17.8 points and 4.1 rebounds throughout her high school career including a 19.0 ppg in her senior season and 20.8 ppg her junior campaign. She was a three-time WCAC first team selection.
- » Shaelyn Steele is a freshman guard out of Russell, Ky. Steele was the top-ranked recruit out of Kentucky in 2024. The freshman averaged 19.5 points and 6.7 rebounds per game throughout her high school career including a 21.1 clip her senior campaign.
- » Ari Williams is the final freshmen of the class, coming to the Lady Lions from Chicago, Ill. A powerful presence on the wing, Williams helped lead her team to a City Championship and runner-up finish in consecutive years. She helped the team to an unblemished record in 2020-21.

FAMILY TIES

- » Jill Jekot isn't the first Jekot family member to pass through Happy Valley. Her older sister Kelly Jekot was a Lady Lion from 2020-22 for her graduate seasons.
- Kelly Jekot was PSU's leading scorer and rebounder before a season-ending injury in 2020. She came back for her fifth season of eligibility and played in 28 games, starting in 21 of them. She averaged 3.8 points and 2.3 rebounds per game in her final season. She was a two-time member of the Academic-All Big Ten Team, 2020-21 Academic All-District honoree and earned Penn State's Big Ten Sportsmanship award in 2021 and 2022.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Georgia

- The Bulldogs 3-2 to start the 2024-25 campaign. They opened with three straight wins against North Carolina Central, Houston and Furman before dropping two consecutive games to Georgia State and Georgia Tech.
- Most recently in its first game at the State Farm WBCA Showcase, Georgia defeated Tulsa by a 60-44 margin. De'Mauri Flournoy led the team in scoring with 19 points and Asia Avinger also produced a 13-point outing.
- Last season, the Bulldogs went 12-18 overall and 3-13 in the SEC. They lost to Kentucky in the SEC Tournament to end their season.
- Four Georgia players average double-digit scoring: Woolfolk (18.0), Turner (13.0), Flournoy (12.7) and Avinger (11.8).
- Javyn Nicholson led the team in scoring last year, averaging 8.7 points per game.
