• Fordham enters the game with a 3-3 record after a 73-71 loss to Drexel on Friday night in the Rose Hill Gym while Penn State is 5-0 on the year after a 102-89 win over Purdue Fort Wayne on Wednesday (both games were campus site games of the 2024 Sunshine Slam).

• Monday night's game will be the fifth meeting between the Rams and the Nittany Lions on the hardwood, the first since 2014 when Fordham head coach Keith Uργο served as an assistant for the Nittany Lions.

• Penn State leads the all-time series, 3-1, and have taken the past two matchups.

• Jackie Johnson III has scored 114 points over his first six games, the second most by a player in his first six games for Fordham.

• Grad student forward Abdou Tsimbila was named to the Atlantic 10 Preseason All-Defensive Team for the second straight year.

• Tsimbila is fourth all-time at Fordham with 168 career blocks.

• The Rams continue the 2024 Sunshine Slam in Dayton Beach, Fla., by facing either Clemson or San Francisco on Tuesday, November 26.

THE PENN STATE SERIES

- Monday night's game will be the fifth meeting between the Rams and the Nittany Lions on the hardwood, the first since 2014 when Fordham head coach Keith Urgo served as an assistant for the Nittany Lions.
- Penn State leads the all-time series, 3-1, and have taken the past two matchups.
- The last time Fordham played a Big 10 school was the Penn State game in 2014.

Keith Urgo wasted no time turning heads in his first year at the helm of the Fordham Basketball program in 2022-23. Elevated from the position of associate head coach in April of 2022, Urgo promptly led the Rams to their finest season in more than three decades on his way to Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honors.

The 2022-23 Rams finished with a record of 25-8, tied for the second highest win total in program history behind only the legendary 26-3 Rams of 1970-71. Urgo's first campaign was the most successful in the school's three-decade Atlantic 10 tenure, winning 12 conference matchups and finishing with a .667 winning percentage. Their 12-6 league mark placed the Rams in a three-way tie for second place in the final A-10 standings and secured the no. 3 seed in the Atlantic 10 Championship, another program high-water mark for Fordham. The Rams took down La Salle in the conference quarterfinals in front of 9,000 fans at Barclays Center to earn their second-ever berth in the Atlantic 10 semifinals.

In addition to becoming the second Fordham head man to ever be named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year (Nick Macarchuk- 1999), Urgo also won the Joe B. Hall Award, presented annually by CollegeInsider.com to the top first-time head coach in the nation.

Urgo also saw three of his players honored by the conference at season's end. Darius Quisenberry earned Second Team All-Conference accolades, Khalid Moore garnered a spot on the All-Conference Third Team and Kyle Rose played his way onto the Atlantic 10 All-Defensive Team. It marked just the second time in program history and the first since 2006 that multiple Fordham players were honored with spots on All-Atlantic 10 Teams.

The following spring, Rose earned his second consecutive nod to the Atlantic 10 All-Defensive Team.

The NABC District 4 Coach of the Year, Urgo was also named a finalist for the Jim Phelan Award, which recognizes the nation's top

Just as impressive as his on-court achievements, Urgo led the charge to change the culture around Fordham Basketball on campus. By January, Rose Hill was filled to the rafters, anchored by a raucous student section that Urgo affectionately dubbed "The Shirtless Herd." After the crowd helped will Fordham to a pair of impressive victories over George Washington and Saint Louis in late January, Urgo took to calling the 98-year-old gym "Rose Thrill" and the name stuck. The Rams won their final six home games at went 18-2 overall in the Bronx, good enough for the highest home win total in the nation.

Urgo, who was recognized as one of the nation's top assistant coaches in 2019-2020 while at Penn State, came to Fordham in 2021 as the team's associate head coach under Kyle Neptune.

In his first year at Fordham, Urgo helped the Rams to an amazing turnaround as Fordham recorded a 16-16 overall record, a 14-win improvement from 2020-2021. The Rams won a second round Atlantic 10 Tournament game and reached the quarterfinals for the first time since 2007 and opened Atlantic 10 regular season play 2-0 for the first time since joining the conference in 1995. The Rams finished the season ranked 41st nationally in adjusted defensive efficiency according to KenPom, the highest such rating in program history.

Urgo brought a plethora of experience to Rose Hill, including ten seasons at Penn State University.

- The Rams trailed by seven with 1:22 remaining before a Will Richardson three made it a four-point game, 73-69, with just over a minute remaining.
- Medor forced a Drexel turnover on the inbounds play and the Rams turned that into a pair of Medor free throws with 48 seconds left to make it a 73-71 game.
- Medor then rebounded a Drexel miss with 13.9 seconds remaining and the Rams called a time out as they crossed midcourt with ten seconds on the clock.
- Fordham inbounded the ball to Johnson who drove to the baseline and got off an off-balanced shot that rebounded off the rim as the final clock sounded.

JOHNSON OFF TO HOT START

- Senior guard **Jackie Johnson III** is off to one of the best starts for a Fordham player in his first six games as a Ram.
- Johnson has scored 114 points over his first six games, the second most scored by a player in his first six games for Fordham.
- Jon Severe netted 139 points in his first six games in 2013.
- Other players to get off to good starts over first six games include Eric Paschall (113), Darius Quisenberry (101), and Bevon Robin (97).

JOHNSON GOES FOR 20

- Senior guard **Jackie Johnson III** has scored 20 points in three of his first six games with the Rams.
- Johnson did not record a 20-point game in his two years at UNVL.
- He did have three such games as a freshman at Duquesne in 2021-22, including a career-high 30 points against George Washington.

JOHNSON AT THE SUNSHINE SLAM



- Senior guard **Jackie Johnson III** is playing in the Sunshine Slam for the second straight season.
- Last year Johnson played in the tournament with UNLV as the Runnin' Rebs fell to Florida State and Richmond.
- Johnson averaged 11.5 ppg in the two games played in Dayton Beach, shooting 8-for-13 from the field and 5-for-7 from behind the arc.
- His best game came against Richmond where he netted 17 points, shooting 5-for-8 from the field and 5-for-7 from three.

FORDHAM FIRST IN THREE-POINTERS

Did you know???? Fordham was the first team in the NCAA to use the three-point shot? The first time a three-point shot was used experimentally in a game was on February 7, 1945 when Columbia defeated Fordham, 73-58. The three-point line was set at 21 feet from the basket and Columbia scored 11 “long goals” to Fordham’s nine. Also, free throwers had an option to take their shots from the regular 15-foot distance for one point or from 21 feet for two points. Eight “long fouls” were made during the game.

The game also featured a 12-foot wide free throw lane, a move that would be adopted by the NCAA eleven years later.

- Tripp scored 12 points in his season premier against Georgian Court and followed that with ten versus Drexel.
- He is averaging 11.0 ppg on the year, shooting .615 (8-13) from the field and 2-for-3 from behind the arc.

DOUBLING UP

- Freshman center **Jaden Smith** notched his first career double-double in just his third game with the Rams.
- He scored 14 points and added 13 rebounds in Fordham’s win over Georgian Court on November 19.
- Smith is the first Fordham freshman to record a double-double since Joel Soriano did it in 2020 in his 25th college game.
- Eric Paschall was the fastest freshman to notch a double-double, doing it in his first game with 31 points and ten rebounds vs. NY Tech in 2014.

TSIMBILA NAMED TO A-10 PRESEASON ALL-DEFENSIVE TEAM

- Fordham grad student forward **Abdou Tsimbila** was named to the 2024-25 Atlantic 10 Preseason All-Defensive team.
- This marks Tsimbila’s second consecutive A-10 Preseason All-Defensive Team honor, as he also earned the distinction last October.
- In 2023-24, Tsimbila ranked second in the A-10 and 18th in the nation in blocked shots with 2.3 per game.
- He recorded six or more blocks in a game on three separate occasions, including a career-best nine rejections against NJIT on Dec. 6.
- His 72 blocks on the campaign tied Dud Tongal (1978-79) for the fifth highest single-season total in program history.
- Entering the season, his fourth at Rose Hill, Tsimbila ranks sixth on the Fordham career blocks list with 157 and is just three rejections away from entering the top five.
- In addition to his shot-altering prowess, Tsimbila is also one of the league’s top rebounders, leading the team and ranking 10th in the A-10 with 6.3 boards per game.
- He tallied four double-doubles on the season while averaging a career-best 7.5 points per outing.

- The Rams also return the team’s leading rebounder and shot blocker in **Abdou Tsimbila**, who ranked second in the A-10 and 18th in the nation last year with 2.3 rejections per contest.

- Over his first two years at Fordham head coach **Keith Uργο** has amassed 38 wins.
- The 38 wins are the most for a Fordham head coach in his first two seasons since Johnny Bach won 40 games his first two seasons (1950-62).

BLOCK PARTY

- Grad student forward **Abdou Tsimbila**, who was named to the Atlantic 10 Preseason All-Defensive Team, has become a force at blocking shots.
- Last year Tsimbila blocked 72 shots in 32 games (2.3/game), second in the Atlantic 10.
- Tsimbila blocked a career-high nine shots vs. NJIT on Dec. 6, the fourth most blocks by a player in Division I this year.
- He has 168 career blocks at Fordham, fourth on the Rams' career list.

RAMS WIN TWO EXHIBITIONS

- The 2024-25 Rams played a pair of exhibition contest this year, defeating Holy Cross, 67-64, and UMBC, 86-72.
- **Abdou Tsimbila**, **Jahmere Tripp**, and **Josh Rivera** did not play in the Holy Cross game.
- Senior guard **Jackie Johnson III** paced the Rams, averaging 21.5 ppg, shooting (8-17) from behind the arc while junior forward **Romad Dean** averaged 7.5 rpg.
- The games helped raise funds for Able Athletics, a local charity that empowers children with disabilities through athletic participation.

- Junior forward **Romad Dean** and freshman guard **Kingston Price** have some unique workout partners.
- Dean spent the summer of 2003 in Dallas, working out with fellow Bahamian Buddy Hield (Hield was playing for the national team last summer).
- Dean stayed with Hield and worked out with the Philadelphia 76er guard daily.
- Price has an NBA workout partner in All-Star Victor Oladipo, who missed the 2023-24 season with an injury.
- Price's father, Kingston, was an AAU coach for Oladipo, with whom the family maintains a close relationship.

WINNING A-10 GAMES

- The win over Rhode Island in 2022-23 on February 25 brought Fordham to eleven Atlantic 10 wins on the year, surpassing the record for A-10 wins in a season of ten set by the 2006-2007 squad.

won five straight Atlantic 10 games since 2007.

- The Rams have never won six straight A-10 games.
- The win on January 25, 2023 at St. Bonaventure was the first time Fordham won three straight Atlantic 10 games, all on the road.
- The last time a Fordham team won three straight conference, all on the road, was 1992 when the Rams played in the Patriot League.
- The 12-6 A-10 mark in 2022-23 was the best for the Rams since joining the conference in 1995.
- Over the past two years the Rams are 18-17 in Atlantic 10 regular season games.
- Over the previous four years Fordham won just 19 A-10 contests.

WINNING AT HOME

- Over the past three years, Fordham has compiled a 26-14 record in the Rose Hill Gym.
- The 2022-2023 Fordham Rams won 18 of their 20 home games, having an eleven-game winning streak stopped by a loss to Davidson on December 28.
- The 18 wins is school record for most home wins in a season (former mark was 14 by the 2015-2016 team).
- The Rams started the home season 11-0, the best home start for the Rams since 1990.
- The 1990 squad won all 12 of its home games, eleven of those vs. Div. I opponents.
- The 1968 team won all eleven home games vs. Div. I opponents.

OVERSEAS RAMS

- Fordham has numerous former Rams playing professionally overseas.
- Two of last year's graduates are playing professionally, led by guard **Kyle Rose**, who recently signed with the Mexico City Capitanes of the NBA G League.
- Rose's backcourt mate from 2023-24 **Antrell Charlton** signed on with SKSE Salgotarjani, which competes in Hungary's second division.
- Other recent Rams who are playing overseas include **Darius Quisenberry** suiting up in Finland, **Khalid Moore** playing in France, and **Rostik Novitskyi** playing in Latvia.
- The list also includes **Chuba Ohams** (Spain), **Javonte Hawkins** (Russia), **Bryant Dunston** (Lithuania), **Erten Gazi** (Turkey), **Christian Sengfelder** (Germany), **David Pekarek** (Czech Republic), **Will Tavares** (France), **Chris Gaston** (Puerto Rico), **Josh Colon-Navarro** (Puerto Rico), and **Brandon Frazier** (Spain).

HISTORICALLY SPEAKING

- Fordham University's home court, the Rose Hill Gymnasium which was named as one of the four "Cathedrals of College Basketball" by ESPN The Magazine, is the oldest gym still being used by an NCAA Division I basketball team. The 3,200-seat gym opened on January 16, 1925 for a game between Fordham and Boston College. The Rams took the opener 46-16 in a game refereed by one of the University's most prominent alumni, "The Fordham Flash", Baseball Hall of

Famer Frankie Frisch.

- The Gym was one of the largest on-campus facilities at the time it was built, earning the nickname "The Prairie" because of its large floor space. The original configuration had no end zone stands and a seating capacity of 2,100 but several standing room crowds of 6,000 were reported in the late 1920s. Since its opening in 1925, the gym has seen numerous renovations, adding new seating, scoreboards and public address systems.
- The arena has been in continuous use by Fordham's basketball teams since its opening with the exception of the World War II years, when it was used for a barracks.
- The Rose Hill Gym has been the site of many legendary college and high school basketball games including Kareem Abdul Jabbar's final high school game and the 1988 Tolentine-Archbishop Molloy Catholic High School Athletic Association (CHSAA) Championship game, billed by the New York Newsday as the "Best High School Game of the 80's".
- The Rose Hill Gym has been named as one of the Top Ten arenas by USA Today and was featured in the 2011-12 ESPN The Magazine College Basketball issue as one of four Cathedrals of College Basketball.

WHAT'S NEXT?

- The Rams will play either Clemson or San Francisco in the 2024 Sunshine Slam, on Tuesday, November 26, at either 1:30 p.m. or 4:00 p.m. at the Ocean Center in Daytona Beach.
- It would be the second meeting between the Rams and the Tigers, the first coming in 1987, a 90-85 Clemson win at the Hawaii Pacific Classic.
- The Rams are 50-112 against schools currently in the ACC.
- The last time the Rams played an ACC school was a game against Miami in 2021 at Barclays Center.
- It would be the second meeting between the Rams and the Dons, the first coming in 1968, a 77-64 win for the Rams at Lobo Classic.
- The Rams are 3-6 against schools currently in the West Coast Conference.
- The last time the Rams played a WCC school was a 2010 game against Santa Clara as part of the Cable Car Classic.

THE ROSE HILL GYM TURNS 100!



The oldest NCAA Division I continually used gym is about to turn 100. When Bishop John J. Collins, S.J., who served as president of Fordham University from 1904-1906, blessed the cornerstone of what would become the Rose Hill Gymnasium on November 4, 1923 then university president, Rev. E.P. Tivnan, S.J., said “We have set a cornerstone today – may we not call it a milestone.” This year we will call it a milestone as the beloved building celebrates its 100th anniversary.




When the cornerstone was laid, the plans of architect Emile G. Perrot, who also designed buildings at fellow Jesuit institutions Georgetown University and Saint Joseph’s University, were put into action. A year and a half later, on January 16, 1925, the Rose Hill Gym officially opened with a basketball game between Fordham and Boston College in a game officiated by Major League Baseball Hall of Famer Frankie Frisch, aka The Fordham Flash.

This year we celebrate the historic Rose Hill Gym with a special 100th anniversary logo and special events throughout the 2024-2025 season to honor the cherished facility. The Rose Hill Gym was one of the largest on-campus facilities at the time it was built, earning the nickname “The Prairie” because of its large floor space. The original configuration had no end zone stands and a seating capacity of 2,100 but several standing room crowds of 6,000 were reported in the late 1920s. It was just one of two regulation sized basketball courts in New York City when it opened.

The Rose Hill Gym has been used continuously as an athletic facility since 1925, with the exception of the 1943-1944 academic year when the building was used as a U.S. Army barracks.

Over the years the Rose Hill Gym has served many different purposes, including sporting events, concerts, television and movie sets, fashion shows, inaugurations, and even as a church, since the gym hosts the annual Graduation Mass each May. The venue has been the site of many legendary college and high school basketball games including Kareem Abdul Jabbar’s final high school game, and the 1988 Tolentine-Archbishop Molloy Catholic High School Athletic Association (CHSAA) Championship game, which featured three high school All-Americans and was billed by the New York Newsday as the “Best High School Game of the 80’s”.

Many honors have been bestowed on the historic building, including being named as one of the four “Cathedrals of College Basketball” by ESPN The Magazine and as one of the Top Ten arenas by USA Today.
