PENN STATE OPENS B1G PLAY AGAINST INDIANA

RV Penn State women's basketball kicks off conference competition at home inside the Bryce Jordan Center as it hosts Indiana on Saturday, Dec. 7. The Lady Lions are receiving votes in this week's WBCA Coaches Poll for the third-straight week.

LAST TIME OUT

- The Lady Lions dropped their first game of the 2024-25 season to St. John's by a 72-67 margin.
- » Prior to the loss, Penn State had won 18-straight non-conference home games and was 8-0 to start the season for the first time since 1993-94.
- » Jayla Oden posted a career best 24 points on eight-of-13 shooting from the field. Oden continued her dominance in drawing fouls, totaling eight fouls drawn. Her shooting from the charity stripe was also effective, shooting at a seven-of-eight clip from the line.
- » Gracie Merkle surpassed the 10-point scoring mark for the ninth time this season, remaining the only Lady Lion to score in double figures in all games this campaign thus far.
- » Gabby Elliot put up 12 points and seven rebounds, marking her second-straight game in double figures and fourth of the season.
- » Penn State outrebounded St. John's 33-25. The Lady Lions have outrebounded their opponents in all nine games this season.

WHAT A WIN ON SATURDAY WOULD MEAN

- » A win over Indiana on Dec. 7 would be the Lady Lions first win in eight games over the Hoosiers and first since 2018.
- » This would be Penn State's ninth win of the season.
- » A PSU win on Saturday would be the Lady Lions first conference opener win since 2013-14 when they defeated lowa on the road. It would be their first Big Ten home opener win since 2021-22 when they lost on the road to open conference play at Indiana but returned home for their B1G home opener to defeat Rutgers on Dec. 9.

NON-CON DOMINANCE IN THE BJC

- The Lady Lions produced an unblemished non-conference home court record last season, going 11-0 in the early parts of the season, all the way through the WBIT.
- The Lady Lions were on their longest non-conference home court winning streak in program history at 18-straight games before the loss this season to St. John's.
- » Penn State has not lost a non-conference home game since Nov. 30, 2022 when it lost to Virginia.

PENN STATE VS. INDIANA SERIES

- Saturday's contest will be the 54th meeting between Penn State and Indiana, dating back to 1982
- · The Lady Lions lead the all-time series 33-20.
- The Hoosiers have won the most recent seven games.
- There has been one overtime game, a 77-71 PSU win on Jan. 10, 2010 in the Bryce Jordan Center.

LADY LIONS IN THE RANKS

- » Moriah Murray sits 13th in the Big Ten in points per game (16.2) and ninth in total points (146). She sits first in the country in three pointers (37) and third in three pointers per game per game (4.11).
- » Merkle ranks 17th in the country in total points (182) and second in the conference. She also sits second in the conference in points per game (20.2). Merkle is sixth in the nation in field goals made (75) and sixth in field goal percentage (65.8). Her five double-doubles ranks her ninth in the country and second in the B1G. She also ranks seventh in offensive rebounds per game across the nation (4.7)
- » Alli Campbell is ranked fourth in the conference in assists (44).
- » Penn State is fourth in the nation in total assists (175) and sits seventh in assists per game (20.8). The team is first in the conference in total assists and ranks third in assists per game.
- The team ranks ninth in the country in shooting percentage from the field (50.1) and third in the Big Ten.
- The Lady Lions also have the 15th-best scoring offense across the country, averaging 85.1 points per contest.

NOTES AND HEADLINES

MURRAY MAGIC

- » Murray has had an electric impact on Penn State's first nine games of the season. She has totaled 146 points throughout nine games including a career high outing against Bucknell in the season opener. Murray put up 28 points using eight three-pointers, the second highest single-game three-point record in school history.
- » She has produced four 20-plus-point games and five games with six-plus three-pointers.
- » Murray is also racking up her assist totals, improving throughout the season leading to her personal best eight assists against Drexel.
- » The redshirt-sophomore also remains perfect from the free throw line, shooting 15-of-15.

POST MASTER

- » Redshirt-sophomore center Gracie Merkle continues to guide the Lady Lions using her height and strength under the rim.
- » She leads the team in scoring, averaging 20.2 points and rebounding, averaging 9.1 through nine contests.
- » She is the only Lady Lion to post double figure scoring in all nine of Penn State's games so far including five double-doubles, a 21 point and 13 rebound performance against Bucknell, a 20-point, 12 board outing against Monmouth, a season high 28 points and 11 rebounds versus Marshall and a 12 point-11 rebound game against Georgia.
- » Merkle put up career numbers in PSU's overtime win against Drexel, scoring a personal best 31 points and grabbing 11 rebounds. This marked her fourth consecutive double-double.

2023-24 SEASON IN REVIEW

- Penn State produced its best overall record in a decade with its 22-13 season.
- » The Lady Lions advanced to the Final Four of the Inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament, marking their first postseason appearance since 2017-18.
- Penn State was one of four one-seeds in the tournament after just missing a spot in the NCAA Tournament.
- » The Lady Lions finished ranked sixth in the Big Ten.
- » Penn State consistently ranked in the top-10 in three major statistical categories throughout the 2023-24 campaign. PSU produced one of the highest level offenses in the country with steady recognition in field goal percentage, three-point percentage and scoring offense.
- » The Lady Lions had for 100-plus-point performances, 13 90-plus point games and 21 80-plus point performances.
- » Penn State shattered its single game three-point record on two different occasions last season. Once against Central Connecticut on Dec. 20 with 15 three-pointers and then again when it hosted Maryland on Jan. 28 with 16.

2023-24 B1G POSTSEASON AWARDS

- » Ashley Owusu was named to All-Big Ten second team by coaches and honorable mention by media.
- » Makenna Marisa was named second team All-Big Ten by media and honorable mention by coaches.
- » Leilani Kapinus was named to the All-Big Ten defensive team by coaches and media and was an All-Big Ten honorable mention by the media.
- » Tay Valladay is an honorable mention by the media and Penn State's Sportsmanship Award recipient.
- » Shay Ciezki was an honorable mention by media.

POSTSEASON PLAY

- The Lady Lions earned a number one seed in the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament in 2024.
- » This was Penn State's first postseason appearance since 2017-18 when the team lost in the first round of the WNIT to Radford.
- » The WBIT appearance is head coach Kieger's first postseason appearance in Happy Valley.
- » The Lady Lions advanced to the Final Four of the WBIT, losing to Villanova in the semifinals.
- » As the highest seed in the tournament, PSU earned hosting rights through the first three rounds of competition.
- » Penn State first hosted George Mason, a game that went to overtime but eventually ended with a 84-80 Penn State victory.
- » Next, the Blue & White hosted Belmont on March 25, which resulted in a 74-66 PSU win.
- » The final host site game before traveling to Hinkle Fieldhouse for the Final Four, was a quarterfinal match up against SEC opponent Mississippi State. The Lady Lions put forth a dominant performance with a 92-87 win to advance to the semifinals.

TRANSER TALK

- » Head Coach Kieger picked up four transfers in the portal this off season.
- » Gracie Merkle came to Happy Valley after spending two years at Bellarmine where she lead the country in field goal percentage her freshman season. She suffered an injury during her sophomore campaign and returns to the court with the Lady Lions this fall. Merkle is a 6'6 center, the tallest athlete in Lady Lions history.
- » Gabby Elliott brings two years of Big Ten experience and four total years of collegiate basketball experience to the Lady Lions. She played her most recent two seasons at Michigan State and spent her first two seasons at Clemson where she was an all-conference performer her freshmen year. Elliott has battled injuries on and off since her sophomore season.
- Tamera Johnson is a graduate transfer from Louisianna Lafayette. She spent all four years in Louisiana as a forward. Johnson averaged double figure scoring in her two most recent seasons, including a career best 11.3 clip her senior campaign. She ranked 15th in blocks (18), 18th in

- rebounding (6.1) and 22nd in steals (41) in the Sun Belt Conference this past season, while producing the second highest scoring average on her team among the starting five..
- Vitoria Santana is a Brazil native who played her first two seasons at Eastern Arizona. She was a dominant performer, averaging 15.9 points, 8.1 rebounds and 3.8 assists per game in her last year at EAU. Santana recorded 30, double-digit scoring efforts including two, 30-plus-point outings. She compiled four ACCAC Player of the Week nods throughout her time in Arizona and earned Defensive Player of the Year, All-ACCAC DI first team and All-Region DI first team in her most recent campaign.

2024-25 FRESH FACE FRESHMEN

- » The Lady Lions introduce five freshmen to their roster for the 2024-25 season.
- » Jill Jekot enrolled at Penn State in January of 2024. The Pennsylvania native was a two-time Mid Penn All-Conference first team selection, three-time first team All-Sentinel honoree and two-time first team All-State member. Jekot earned several awards throughout her high school career including Mid Penn Commonwealth Player of the Year, Hempfield Tip-Off Tournament MVP and United Ban Myrtle Beach Classic All-Tournament honors.
- » Cam Rust was a highly touted recruit and consensus top-100 player across multiple ratings agencies. Rust was a four-star ranking out of high school according to Prospects Nation and a 90 Grade according to ESPN.
- » Talayah Walker joins the Lady Lions from Odenton, Md. Walker averaged 17.8 points and 4.1 rebounds

- throughout her high school career including a 19.0 ppg in her senior season and 20.8 ppg her junior campaign. She was a three-time WCAC first team selection.
- » Shaelyn Steele is a freshman guard out of Russell, Ky. Steele was the top-ranked recruit out of Kentucky in 2024. The freshman averaged 19.5 points and 6.7 rebounds per game throughout her high school career including a 21.1 clip her senior campaign.
- » Ari Williams is the final freshmen of the class, coming to the Lady Lions from Chicago, Ill. A powerful presence on the wing, Williams helped lead her team to a City Championship and runner-up finish in consecutive years. She helped the team to an unblemished record in 2020-21.

FAMILY TIES

- Jill Jekot isn't the first Jekot family member to pass through Happy Valley. Her older sister Kelly Jekot was a Lady Lion from 2020-22 for her graduate seasons.
- » Kelly Jekot was PSU's leading scorer and rebounder before a season-ending injury in 2020. She came back for her fifth season of eligibility and played in 28 games, starting in 21 of them. She averaged 3.8 points and 2.3 rebounds per game in her final season. She was a two-time member of the Academic-All Big Ten Team, 2020-21 Academic All-District honoree and earned Penn State's Big Ten Sportsmanship award in 2021 and 2022.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Indiana

- Indiana holds a 6-3 record to begin the 2024-25 campaign. After winning their season opener against Brown, the Hoosiers suffered a home court overtime loss to Harvard in the following game. Indiana then dropped another game to Butler on the road before returning home and defeating no. 24/23 Stanford. The Hoosiers played at the Battle 4 Atlantis Tournament where they walked away winning two of the three games against Columbia and no. 18/17 Baylor. They were defeated by no. 16/15 North Carolina in the final game of the competition. Most recently, Indiana returned home to host Maine and Southern Indiana.
- Indiana was picked to finish fifth in the Big Ten Preseason Poll after finishing third in the conference last season.
- Junior guard Yarden Garzon was one of 20 athletes selected to the watchlist for the 2025 Cheryl Miller Award. This is her second consecutive season on the preseason list after being a Top-10 Finalist last year.
- Garzon leads the team in scoring, averaging 13.8 points per game. Shay Ciezki, Lily Meister and Chloe Moore-McNeil also average double figure points.
- · Ciezki played two seasons in Happy Valley before transferring to Indiana.
- Last season, the Hoosiers advanced to the Sweet 16 for the third time in four years after defeating Fairfield and Oklahoma in the first and second rounds. They lost to eventual National Champions South Carolina in the round of 16.
- Indiana suffered a loss to Michigan in the quarterfinals of the 2024 Big Ten Tournament after receiving a first-round-bye.
