PENN STATE RETURNS TO BJC TO HOST IOWA

Penn State kicks off the new year returning to Happy Valley to host no. 23 Iowa on New Years Day. The Lady Lions look to bounce back from their loss on the road to Minnesota while securing their first conference win of the season.

LAST TIME OUT

- » Penn State lost a tough road contest at Minnesota following a long, 13-day break in action. The Golden Gophers jumped out to an early lead that the Lady Lions could not overcome. The final score was 90-54 in favor of the Minnesota.
- » Gabby Elliott was the lone PSU player to reach double figure scoring, totaling 19 points, nine of which came from beyond the arc.
- » Gracie Merkle, Penn State's leading scorer, was held from scoring in the contest but she managed four rebounds and three blocks on the defensive end.
- » The Lady Lions' bench contributed 19 points.

LAST TIME AGAINST IOWA

- » Penn State and Iowa faced twice in the 2023-24 campaign. The first was a high-scoring match up in Carver Hawkeye Arena on Feb. 8. Iowa came away with the 111-93 victory.
- » Four Lady Lions posted double-digit scoring outings, Ashley Owusu leading the way with 18, Makenna Marisa and Leilani Kapinus with 12 apiece and Alli Campbell with 10 points. Kapinus also contributed 10 rebounds to round out the double-double.
- » The Lady Lions led at the end of the first quarter after the team's traded the lead seven times. Iowa recaptured the advantage in the second quarter and the Lady Lions could not come back.
- » Iowa dominated the second meeting in the quarterfinals of the Big Ten Tournament, securing a 95-62 win.
- » Kapinus and Owusu led the team on offense with 19 and 18 points respectively.

WHAT A WIN ON SATURDAY WOULD MEAN

- » A win over Iowa on Wednesday would be the Lady Lions' first Big Ten win of the season.
- » A victory on Wednesday would be PSU's first win over Iowa since Jan. 3, 2017. The Hawkeyes have won the last 10 meetings.
- » Penn State would recapture the series lead with a win over Iowa, a series currently tied at 29-29.

LADY LIONS IN THE RANKS

- » Merkle ranks 34th in the country in total points (244) and fourth in the conference. She also sits fifth in the B1G in points per game (18.8). Merkle is 17th in the nation in field goals made (101) and sixth in field goal percentage (66.4). Her seven double-doubles ranks her 10th in the country and third in the Big Ten.
- » Moriah Murray sits 19th in the Big Ten in points per game (14.0) and 19th in total points (182). She is seventh in the country in three pointers (44) and seventh in three pointers per game per game (3.38).
- » Alli Campbell is ranked fifth in the conference in assists (60).
- » Penn State is 18th in the nation in total assists (244) and sits 15th in assists per game (18.8). The team is third in the conference in total assists and ranks second in assists per game.
- » The team ranks 19th in the country in shooting percentage from the field (48.2) and third in the Big Ten.

NON-CON DOMINANCE IN THE BJC

- » The Lady Lions produced an unblemished non-conference home court record last season, going 11-0 in the early parts of the season, all the way through the WBIT.
- » The Lady Lions were on their longest non-conference home court winning streak in program history at 18-straight games before the loss this season to St. John's.
- » Penn State has not lost a non-conference home game since Nov. 30, 2022 when it lost to Virginia.

NOTES AND HEADLINES

MURRAY MAGIC

- » Murray has had an electric impact on Penn State's first 13 games of the season. She has totaled 182 points throughout this season including a career high outing against Bucknell in the season opener. Murray put up 28 points using eight three-pointers, the second highest single-game three-point record in school history.
- » She has produced four 20-plus-point games and five games with six-plus three-pointers.
- » The redshirt-sophomore from Pennsylvania remained the nation's three-point leader since week two of the season, marking five-straight weeks this week up until the team's most recent break in action.
- » Murray is also racking up her assist totals, improving throughout the season leading to her personal best eight assists against Drexel.
- » The redshirt-sophomore also remains perfect from the free throw line, shooting 18-of-18.

POST MASTER

- » Redshirt-sophomore center Gracie Merkle continues to guide the Lady Lions using her height and strength under the rim.
- » She leads the team in scoring, averaging 18.8 points and rebounding, averaging 9.2 through 13 contests, nearly averaging a double-double each game.
- » She is the only Lady Lion to post double figure scoring in 12 of Penn State's 13 games so far including seven double-doubles, a 21 point and 13 rebound performance against Bucknell, a 20-point, 12 board outing against Monmouth, a season high 28 points and 11 rebounds versus Marshall and a 12 point-11 rebound game against Georgia. Most recently, she produced a 24 point and 18 board performance at Providence and a 22 point, 12 rebound excursion at Kansas.
- » Merkle put up career numbers in PSU's overtime win against Drexel, scoring a personal PSU best 31 points and grabbing 11 rebounds. This marked her fourth consecutive double-double.

2023-24 SEASON IN REVIEW

- » Penn State produced its best overall record in a decade with its 22-13 season.
- » The Lady Lions advanced to the Final Four of the Inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament, marking their first postseason appearance since 2017-18.
- » Penn State was one of four one-seeds in the tournament after just missing a spot in the NCAA Tournament.
- » The Lady Lions finished ranked sixth in the Big Ten.
- » Penn State consistently ranked in the top-10 in three major statistical categories throughout the 2023-24 campaign. PSU produced one of the highest level offenses in the country with steady recognition in field goal percentage, three-point

percentage and scoring offense.

- » The Lady Lions had for 100-plus-point performances, 13 90-plus point games and 21 80-plus point performances.
- » Penn State shattered its single game three-point record on two different occasions last season. Once against Central Connecticut on Dec. 20 with 15 three-pointers and then again when it hosted Maryland on Jan. 28 with 16.

2023-24 BIG POSTSEASON AWARDS

- » Ashley Owusu was named to All-Big Ten second team by coaches and honorable mention by media.
- » Makenna Marisa was named second team All-Big Ten by media and honorable mention by coaches.
- » Leilani Kapinus was named to the All-Big Ten defensive team by coaches and media and was an All-Big Ten honorable mention by the media.
- » Tay Valladay is an honorable mention by the media and Penn State's Sportsmanship Award recipient.
- » Shay Ciezki was an honorable mention by media.

POSTSEASON PLAY

- » The Lady Lions earned a number one seed in the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament in 2024.
- » This was Penn State's first postseason appearance since 2017-18 when the team lost in the first round of the WNIT to Radford.
- » The WBIT appearance is head coach Kieger's first postseason appearance in Happy Valley.
- » The Lady Lions advanced to the Final Four of the WBIT, losing to Villanova in the semifinals.
- » As the highest seed in the tournament, PSU earned hosting rights through the first three rounds of competition.
- » Penn State first hosted George Mason, a game that went to overtime but eventually ended with a 84-80 Penn State victory.
- » Next, the Blue & White hosted Belmont on March 25, which resulted in a 74-66 PSU win.
- » The final host site game before traveling to Hinkle Fieldhouse for the Final Four, was a quarterfinal match up against SEC opponent Mississippi State. The Lady Lions put forth a dominant performance with a 92-87 win to advance to the semifinals.

TRANSER TALK

- » Head Coach Kieger picked up four transfers in the portal this off season.
- » Gracie Merkle came to Happy Valley after spending two years at Bellarmine where she lead the country in field goal percentage her freshman season. She suffered an injury during her sophomore campaign and returns to the court with the Lady Lions this fall. Merkle is a 6'6 center, the tallest athlete in Lady Lions history.
- » Gabby Elliott brings two years of Big Ten experience and four total years of collegiate basketball experience to the Lady Lions. She played her most recent two seasons at Michigan

State and spent her first two seasons at Clemson where she was an all-conference performer her freshmen year. Elliott has battled injuries on and off since her sophomore season.

- » Tamera Johnson is a graduate transfer from Louisiana Lafayette. She spent all four years in Louisiana as a forward. Johnson averaged double figure scoring in her two most recent seasons, including a career best 11.3 clip her senior campaign. She ranked 15th in blocks (18), 18th in rebounding (6.1) and 22nd in steals (41) in the Sun Belt Conference this past season, while producing the second highest scoring average on her team among the starting five..
- » Vitoria Santana is a Brazil native who played her first two seasons at Eastern Arizona. She was a dominant performer, averaging 15.9 points, 8.1 rebounds and 3.8 assists per game in her last year at EAU. Santana recorded 30, double-digit scoring efforts including two, 30-plus-point outings. She compiled four ACCAC Player of the Week nods throughout her time in Arizona and earned Defensive Player of the Year, All-ACCAC DI first team and All-Region DI first team in her most recent campaign.

2024-25 FRESH FACE FRESHMEN

- » The Lady Lions introduce five freshmen to their roster for the 2024-25 season.
- » Jill Jekot enrolled at Penn State in January of 2024. The Pennsylvania native was a two-time Mid Penn All-Conference first team selection, three-time first team All-Sentinel honoree and two-time first team All-State member. Jekot earned several awards throughout her high school career including Mid Penn Commonwealth Player of the Year, Hempfield Tip-Off Tournament MVP and United Ban Myrtle Beach Classic All-Tournament honors.
- » Cam Rust was a highly touted recruit and consensus top-100 player across multiple ratings

agencies. Rust was a four-star ranking out of high school according to Prospects Nation and a 90 Grade according to ESPN.

- » Talayah Walker joins the Lady Lions from Odenton, Md. Walker averaged 17.8 points and 4.1 rebounds throughout her high school career including a 19.0 ppg in her senior season and 20.8 ppg her junior campaign. She was a three-time WCAC first team selection.
- » Shaelyn Steele is a freshman guard out of Russell, Ky. Steele was the top-ranked recruit out of Kentucky in 2024. The freshman averaged 19.5 points and 6.7 rebounds per game throughout her high school career including a 21.1 clip her senior campaign.
- » Ari Williams is the final freshmen of the class, coming to the Lady Lions from Chicago, Ill. A powerful presence on the wing, Williams helped lead her team to a City Championship and runner-up finish in consecutive years. She helped the team to an unblemished record in 2020-21.

FAMILY TIES

- » Jill Jekot isn't the first Jekot family member to pass through Happy Valley. Her older sister Kelly Jekot was a Lady Lion from 2020-22 for her graduate seasons.
- » Kelly Jekot was PSU's leading scorer and rebounder before a season-ending injury in 2020. She came back for her fifth season of eligibility and played in 28 games, starting in 21 of them. She averaged 3.8 points and 2.3 rebounds per game in her final season. She was a two-time member of the Academic-All Big Ten Team, 2020-21 Academic All-District honoree and earned Penn State's Big Ten Sportsmanship award in 2021 and 2022.

THE OPPOSITION

Scouting Iowa

- Iowa is 11-2 overall 1-1 Big Ten so far throughout the 2024-25 campaign despite losing its two-time National Player of the Year Caitlin Clark. After being unranked to begin the season, the Hawkeyes have climbed their way to no. 23 in the polls.
- The Hawkeyes have a split record in conference play, losing to Michigan State on the road and returning home to defeat Purdue handily in their most recent outing.
- Lucy Olsen leads the team in scoring, averaging 17.5 points per game followed by Hannah Stuelzel averaging 13.6 and Addison O'Grady averaging 13.3. Penn State faced Lucy Olsen in the WBIT Final Four last season when she played for Villanova.
- The 2024 Big Ten Tournament Champions have the 21st best field goal shooting at a 48.1 percentage. O'Grady leads the team in that category, shooting 67.3% from the field to lead the Big Ten.

Against the Hawkeyes

- The all-time series between Penn State and Iowa is tied at 29-29 with Iowa victorious in the most recent 10 games.
- The Lady Lions are 16-10 in games played at home.
- The first sellout ever in PSU women's basketball history was a contest inside Rec Hall on Feb. 6 1994 when the Lady Lions hosted no. 8 Iowa. PSU earned a 63-61 victory. This game also holds the all-time attendance record inside Rec Hall.

- » Penn State finished the season 22-13, marking its best overall record since 2013-14 (24-8).
- » After just missing a trip to the NCAA Tournament, the Lady Lions made a run to the final four of the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament, losing to Villanova in the semifinal game at Hinkle Fieldhouse in Indianapolis, Ind.
- » Penn State was consistently ranked in the top-10 in three major statistical categories throughout the season: field goal percentage, scoring offense and three-point percentage.
- » The Lady Lions earned their 1,000th program win on Jan. 14, 2024 at Rutgers.
- » Penn State earned its second largest single-season point total with 2,894 points while producing its second highest single-game point totals in program history, scoring 119 points against St. Francis. The team totaled four 100-plus point games throughout the season.
