MAKING HISTORY

>>The 2025 season marks the beginning in Conference USA. In the summer of 2024, Kennesaw State officially became the newest members of Conference USA, after spending the previous 19 years as members of the Atlantic Sun after the school's move to the Division I level for the 2005-06 season.

INITIATING TAKEOVER MODE

>>Sophmore Ava Guzowski shined in the spotlight during the 2024 season as she recorded the most single game RBI by an Owl that year with four. It was also her career high as she hammered a solo home run and sent through a bases clearing double, scoring three runs. She led the team in RBI with 24 as she sits as the one of two player that had surpassed 20 on the season.

SERIES HISTORY

>>The Owls will be creating series history against ranked opponents #20 Northwestern and #10 Texas Tech, making these matchups a blank slate for both teams. Against lowa, the series history is brief, with the Owls trailing O-1. They also trail Pittsburgh 0-1, looking to even the score this weekend.

The Owls have a more extensive history with Penn State, but the Nittany Lions hold a commanding 4-1 lead in that series. Despite the historical dominance of Penn State, the Owls will aim to replicate their 2020 victory, a testament to their ability to compete against strong programs.

>> Head coach Tripp MacKay enters his seventh season with his eyes on his 150th overall win. He earned his 100th overall win in charge of the Owls against Troy on Feb. 19, 2023 and now sits with 133 overall wins. MacKay is only the second Owl head coach to reach triple digits in wins, joining KSU Hall of Famer Scott Whitlock.

SUCCESS ON DECK

>> Facing tough opponents has been a theme for the Owls as they are scheduled to play four '24 NCAA regional teams. They also play four teams that made the 2023 NCAA Division I regionals last season, including Tuscaloosa Regional champion, Northwestern, who advanced to the Tuscaloosa Super Regional. Two out of four 23' regional opponnets are CUSA members and will b attled later in the season during conference play.

41ST ANNIVERSARY

>> 2025 marks Kennesaw State softball's 41st year of competition. Since it's first year in 1985, KSU softball has two Division II national titles, nine Division II World Series appearances, two Division I regional appearances, three ASUN regular season titles and one ASUN tournament championship.

NCAA TOP 25

>> Ava Guzowski ended the 2024 season in the NCAA top 25 among active leaders in sacrifice flies. Guzowski finished in 28 way tie with 6 sacrifice flies on the season.

SCOUTING THE COMPETITION

>> Northwestern enters the 2025 season as the reigning Big Ten Conference Regular Season Champion who finished in the Top 25 with a 35-win season and an appearance in the NCAA Austin Regional. They are currently ranked 20th in the NCAA polls.

>>lowa had three players named to the Big Ten Players to Watch List after finishing their 2024 season 18-28, lowa is returning first-team All-Big Ten

and All-Freshman nominee Jena Young.

>>Penn state is coming off of program history high from the 2024 season after reaching the NCAA tournament for the first time in 14 years. The Nittany Lions finished the season 35-20, marking it as the third consecutive 30+ win season.

>>Pittsburgh finished off the 2024 season with a 17-32 record. Softball America nominate Freshman Gwen Sparks to the freshman watch list. The Panthers will head into the 2025 season ranked 11th in the ACC.

>>Head Coach Gerry Glasco opens up his first season with Texas Tech. The Red Raiders currently sit 10th in the NCAA polls and are favored to finish second in the Big 12.

FRESH PLATE

>> The 2025 roster features 14 returning players and 10 new additions, including four key transfers and six incoming freshmen. In the circle, three pitchers return from last season with the addition of three newcomers to add depth to the pitching staff. The Owls' catching lineup is solid with three returners joined by freshman newcomer Nowicki. The infield is packed with experience, led by five returners and supported by Salt Lake Community College transfer Lexie Shaver. In the outfield, Miller and Hardeman return; while Coastal Carolina transfer Ava Brooke Strickland and Alabama State transfer Alora Bevily, along with freshman Ana Gore round out the defense.

» Now in his seventh season at Kennesaw State, Tripp MacKay was named the sixth softball head coach in program history on June 29, 2018

» 2024 season earned a 16-37 record after facing four teams that earned a top 25 national read cuach in program history on June 23, 2016.

» 2024 season earned a 16-37 record after facing four teams that earned a top 25 national ranking during the season. The Owls secured three series wins in the final year in the ASUN against Stetson, Bellarmine and the eventual conference champion, FGCU.

» 2023 included a loaded schedule facing six teams either in the top 25 or receiving votes highlighted by a win over the #11/7 Alabama Crimson Tide. It was a year for freshmen standouts with Stella Henry and Kenley Hilleary both earning Atlantic Sun accolades. Hilleary and Henry's selection to the ASUN All-Freshman team are the most for KSU in a single season since 2019. The Owls narrowly missed out on the ASUN postseason after winning two of the last three conference series.

» 2022 was a year of adversity for Kennesaw State. Battling injuries and a tough start to the season, MacKay and the Owls battled back, winning nine of their last 10 regular season contests and earned a spot in the ASUN turnament. After defeating Stateon in a winner game, KSU entered the double-plimination portion of the event.

season contests and earned a spot in the ASUN tournament. After defeating Stetson in a win-or-go-home game, KSU entered the double-elimination portion of the event. The Owls routed Jacksonville State, 14-4, tying the ASUN tournament single-game scoring record and set an ASUN tournament single-game record with five homers in the victory.

» The 2021 campaign was one to remember for the Owls as the program earned a spot in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional and secured its first-ever win in a NCAA Division I tournament game, defeating the Auburn Tigers 1-0.

» MacKay led the team to a 10-5 ASUN record and a berth in the 2021 ASUN Championship game. The Owls also notched key in-state victories with one against Georgia State and two against the Yellow Jackets from Georgia Tech.

» Melanie Bennett finished second in the ASUN in total strikeouts and was named the ASUN Freshman of the Year. Senior Lexi Solorzano was one of the three unanimous selections to the ASUN All-Conference first team. Brea Dickey and Taylor Cates were also named to the ASUN All-Conference first team, while Christen Florence was named to the ASUN

» He led KSU to a historic start before the 2020 season was shortened by the NCAA due to COVID-19. The Owls raced out to a 21-4 record before ASUN Conference play, highlighted by wins at a Top-25 Auburn squad, Iowa State, Penn State, and a 13-1 home record.

» The Owls dominated at the plate and in the circle. The team's .350 average ranked seventh nationally. The Owls were sixth in the country with 47 doubles, and eighth with 12 triples. KSU carried a .419 on-base percentage that was 14th best in the country, and ranked 18th with an average of 6.64 runs per-game.

» In 2019, his first year at KSU, he led the Owls to a 26-29 overall record while finishing fifth in the ASUN with a 10-11 league record.

» A powerhouse at the plate, the Owls finished the 2019 season ranked in the ASUN's top-3 for slugging percentage (2nd), on-base percentage (2nd), doubles (2nd), home runs (T-1st). RBIs (3rd) and runs scored (3rd).

» Under MacKay, the Owls had two second team All-ASUN honorees in Kira Czyrklis and Maddie Roth and two all-freshman team selections in Christen Florence and Katie Greep. The Owls succeeded in the classroom as well with Roth and Jessie Mullen earning ASUN All-Academic accolades while Brea Dickey was named a Google Cloud Academic All-America Third Team selection, the second such honor in program history.

» Before joining KSU, MacKay spent two seasons as an assistant coach at the University of Texas, helping the Longhorns to a 66-52 (.559) record and two NCAA postseason appearances while playing in the Big 12.

» Charged with overseeing all aspects of the Texas offense, MacKay mentored freshman second baseman Janae Jefferson to second team NFCA All-America and NFCA All-Central Region honors in 2018. Jefferson was also a top 10 finalist for the Schutt Sports/NFCA National Freshman of the Year Award.

» During his two seasons in Austin, six of MacKay's players garnered NFCA All-Central Region honors, including three (Jefferson, Paige von Sprecklen [P/UT] and Kaitlyn

MacKay spent the 2015-16 year as the Director of Player Development for Scrap Yard Sports in Houston, Texas, while also working with the former National Pro Fastpitch expansion team, the Scrap Yard Dawgs. During his time with the organization, he was in charge of overseeing player and coach development as well as development camps and clinics while serving as the team's co-head coach.

» Prior to his time with Scrap Yard Sports, MacKay served eight seasons as part of Patty Gasso's coaching staff at the University of Oklahoma, where as an assistant, he was

responsible for working primarily with OU's outfielders and offense.

» During a stint stretching from 2007-2015, he helped guide the Sooners to a 389-97 overall record, eight consecutive NCAA postseason appearances, including four Women's College World Series berths (national runner-up in 2012), five Big 12 Conference regular-season titles, two Big 12 Conference Tournament Championship crowns and the 2013 NCAA Division I National Championship. For his efforts, he shared 2013 NFCA National Coaching Staff of the Year honors and four straight NFCA Regional Coaching Staff of the Year (2012,

» Helping craft offensive teams that consistently ranked among the nation's elite during each season of his tenure, the 2013 Sooner offense proved especially potent on the way to winning the national title, leading the country in runs scored per contest (7.8) and slugging percentage (.582), while also rating in the NCAA Division I top 10 in batting average (.333), home runs per game (1.54) and doubles per game (1.57). The powerful lineup also established the NCAA single-season record for walks with 348 and set Big 12 season marks

for runs scored (476), RBIs (444), slugging and on-base percentage.

» Among the numerous individual offensive standouts MacKay helped tutor at Oklahoma were Lauren Chamberlain, who completed her playing days as the NCAA's career HR leader (95 HR's), two-time USA Softball National Collegiate Player of the Year Keilani Ricketts and multi-time All-American Shelby Pendley (finished sixth on the NCAA career HR list

with 84). Overall during his time at OU, the Sooners earned a total of 19 NFCA All-America, 39 NFCA All-Region and 52 All-Big 12 Conference honors.

Last year was another stellar from the circle as Hampton led the Owls a 3.51 team ERA, registering four pitcher to ERA's under 4.00. She help revamp the ability of fifth year senior Lindsey Kyte who produced a career year in her final stanza.

2023 proved to be another strong one for the pitching staff racking up a 4.54 team ERA. Between Hilleary and Bennett, they averaged a 3.62 ERA with 266 total strikeouts. She helped lift Hilleary to an All ASUN Freshman Team spot.

In her first season at Kennesaw State in 2022, the Owls went 23-28, including 12-12 in conference play. KSU set a program record for wins to end the regular season, with seven including nine of the last 10. The Owls defeated Stetson in the ASUN tournament play-in game and earned a fourth-place finish in the conference after a 14-4 win over Jacksonville State.

On the field in 2022, third baseman Taylor Cates had one of the most prolific seasons in KSU softball history. She set KSU Division I program records for home runs (19), slugging percentage (.847) and total bases (133). Cates also earned ASUN All-Conference First Team and All-Academic honors in addition to CoSIDA Academic All-American Third Team and NFCA All-Region Second Team.

She graduated from East Paulding High School in Dallas, Ga. before playing collegiate softball at Abraham Baldwin in Tifton, Ga. and then began pitching instruction throughout the Metro Atlanta area for the past several years.


