QUICK HITS

- Penn State softball travels to college softball's field of dreams this week, Thursday through Sunday, March 13 through 16, as the Blue & White prepare to open their 34th season of Big Ten Conference competition aT B1G Softball x Devon Park from the home of the Women's College World Series. The Nittany Lions will challenge defending B1G regular season champion Northwestern, as well as Minnesota in four combined games over the weekend.
- The Nittany Lions begin conference play with two games against Northwestern on Thursday and Friday, with both matchups slated for 7:30 p.m. (ET). Minnesota will battle the Blue & White on Saturday and Sunday, with contests slated for 5:30 p.m. and 1:30 p.m. (ET), respectively.
- PSU is fresh off one of its most dominant offensive weekends in program history, as the Nittany Lions rattled off four home-opening wins over Canisius, Fairfield and Lafayette highlighted by a 23-0, five-inning win over the Stags that featured the third-most runs in a single game in PSU history.
- In recognition of her dominant start to the 2025 season, in addition to an eye-popping weekend in the batter's box at Penn State's home tournament, sophomore designated player Brooke Klosowicz was named the Big Ten Conference's Player of the Week on Monday, March 10. Klosowicz, a native of Johnsburg, Illinois, became just the fourth Nittany Lion to win the award since head coach Clarisa Crowell took over in 2021, as well as the first Nittany Lion to win any major B1G accolade in 2025.

B1G SOFTBALL X DEVON PARK

- The Big Ten Conference will open one of its most anticipated softball seasons at the home of the Women's College World Series, as the league partnered with USA Softball and Devon Park to host eight B1G softball programs for 16 combined conference games in a two-week span. Penn State joins defending Big Ten regular-season champion
- Northwestern, as well as Minnesota and Michigan State in Oklahoma City on the opening weekend, Thursday through Sunday, March 13 through 16. Devon Park will welcome reigning conference tournament champion Michigan, as well as Maryland, Purdue and Wisconsin for the second weekend of work spanning Thursday through Sunday, March 20 through 23.

INTRODUCING THE WILDCATS & GOLDEN GOPHERS

- Fresh off a 2024 Big Ten Conference regular season championship title, head coach Kate Drohan and the Northwestern Wildcats enter the 2025 league campaign after a 9-9 overall start against some of the nation's stiffest competition. The Wildcats have battled five common opponents with PSU, highlighted by a 4-1 win over Duke during the NFCA Leadoff Classic. NU is 3-2 in their last five games with wins over Louisville and Longwood.
- On an individual basis, the Northwestern batting order features a pair of hitters batting above .300 in freshman Kaylie Avvisato (.382) and senior Grace Nieto (.340). In the pitcher's circle, Northwestern is led by a pair of 35-plus inning tossers in graduate Lauren Boyd and sophomore Riley Grudzielanek, who own 3.00 and 4.12 ERAs, respectively.
 - Head Coach Piper Ritter and the Minnesota Golden Gopher's arrive in Oklahoma City after publishing an 11-13 start through their first 24 fixtures of the 2025 campaign, most recently dropping a tough 2-0 midweek test in a neutral site game against McNeese in Beaumont, Texas. Minnesota is 2-3 in their last five games, with both wins coming against South Alabama at the LSU Round Robin last week.
- Four Golden Gophers are hitting at-or-above .300 at the plate so far this season, with seniors Margaret Tobias (.362) and Nani Valencia (.360) headlining the order. Taylor Krapf returns for her senior year in the Twin Cities, hitting .300 while leading the squad in homers with nine. Junior ace Sydney Schwartz leads the pitching staff with 70.1 innings and a 2.69 earned run average.

STORY OF THE SERIES: NORTHWESTERN & MINNESOTA Penn State prepares for its 70th and 71st all-time meetings with

the Northwestern Wildcats this weekend in Oklahoma City, with NU currently maintaining a 54-15 lead in a series that dates to PSU's first Big Ten Conference season in 1992. The Nittany Lions will seek their first win over Northwestern since mustering a two-game series sweep of the Wildcats on May 13, 2011, in Happy Valley. The most recent series between the two teams came in Evanston in 2023, with the Nittany Lions dropping a trio of games. NU had a handle on the first two contests, but PSU battled to take a one-run lead into the bottom of the seventh in the series finale before falling, 5-2. Penn State and Minnesota will challenge one another for the 71st and 72nd times in an all-time series that dates to 1989. The Golden Gophers maintain a 49-21 advantage over the Nittany Lions, but both teams have worked to an even record in the last four meetings at 2-2. The most recent series between the two programs came in Minneapolis during the 2023 campaign, a 2-1 series victory for Minnesota on their home field. Minnesota took the first game by a 2-0 margin, and after a single day hiatus due to a snowstorm in the area, PSU managed to split the Sunday doubleheader, dropping the first game, 3-1, before then-senior pitcher Bailey Parshall tossed a complete-game shutout to lead PSU to a 2-0 win in the finale.

HOMEEEEEE... HOME ON THE RANGE

- Penn State opened its 2025 home slate at Nittany Lion Softball Park & Beard Field in style last weekend, with the Blue & White rattling off a quartet of home-opening victories highlighted by a trio of runrule results at the Penn State Softball Invitational. Penn State hit a combined .534 average and outscored their opponents by a 57-11 margin while hitting a combined 15 home runs over the weekend. The highlight of the weekend came on Friday night, March 7, against the Fairfield Stags, as PSU recorded a 23-0 victory that marked the third-most runs scored in a single game in program history
 - Penn State opened the weekend with a 12-4 win over Canisius Friday, mustering 12 runs or more in back-to-back games for the first time since logging 13 and 15 runs, respectively, against the conference rival Indiana Hoosiers on April 8 and 9, 2016.
- Friday's doubleheader performance against the Golden Griffins and Stage saw PSU combine to hit 10 home runs in a single day, booking five apiece in each half of the twin-bill. The last time the Blue & White had at least five homers in a single game before Friday's efforts came on April 3, 2019, with PSU registering a half dozen in a 13-run showing against the Saint Francis Red Flash.

2025 BIG TEN SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT

SCHEDULING SHENANIGANS

The Nittany Lions are in the midst of one of the most challenging schedules the program has ever faced in 2025, with PSU completing 23 games through a 50-game slate that includes 15 games against 10 opponents that reached the 2024 NCAA Division I Softball Tournament. PSU has battled or will test three Super Regional teams from last year's tournament in addition to a pair of Women's College World Series teams in Duke and Oklahoma State. The Nittany Lion schedule features opponents from all four power conferences in addition to a trio of defending 2024 conference champions in ACC champion Duke, Big East victor Villanova and NEC titlist Saint Francis. In the most recent NFCA/GoRout Coaches Poll, released on March 4, the Nittany Lions saw eight opponents that were either ranked or receiving votes, including LSU (#44), Texas Tech (#14), Oklahoma State (#15), Duke (#16), Virginia Tech (#17), Mississippi State (#19) Washington (RV) and Ohio State (RV). Nine Penn State opponents were ranked in the NFCA Coaches Poll preseason rankings, released before the first games of the season back in January.

KLOSOWICZ COOKIN'

Sophomore Brooke Klosowicz is already off to a breakout start to her second collegiate season, pacing the Nittany Lion roster in a variety of offensive statistics including batting average (.522), OPS (1.594), hits (35), RBI (22), total bases (69), OBP (.564) and slugging (1.030). Klosowicz, a native of Johnsburg, Illinois, already boasts the longest hitting streak for the Nittany Lions in 2025, logging at least one base hit in a 13-game stretch beginning with Nicholls on February 21 and continuing through Penn State's upcoming weekend at Devon Park. She also maintains the longest active reached-base streak on the roster after reaching safely in 22-straight games, beginning with PSU's second game of the season against Duke and continuing into this weekend's action in Oklahoma City. Klosowicz's 22-game reached-base streak stands tied for the fourth-longest in Division I. Penn State's star designated player ranks prominently in both the Big Ten Conference and Division I in a variety of traditional and advanced statistics, notably standing tied for the national lead in total doubles with a dozen alongside Oklahoma's Ella Parker and Arizona's Kaiah Altmeyer. Klosowicz stands alone atop the Big Ten leaderboard with her 12 doubles and is third nationally in doubles per game with 0.52, simultaneously boasting the eighth-best slugging percentage in all of college softball with a 1.030 mark in the statistic. Klosowicz is third in the Big Ten and ninth in Division I in terms of batting average, hitting at a .522 clip while registering 35 hits, the fifth-most in the B1G and 24th in the nation. Additionally, she stands in fourth place among all collegiate hitters in terms of weighted on-base average (.700) and weighted runs created-plus (286), further underscoring her essential role as the driving force behind PSU's offensive success in the 2025 season. Klosowicz became the 17th recipient of the Big Ten Player of the Week award in Penn State history on Monday, March 10, becoming just the fourth Nittany Lion to earn that recognition since 2015. Klosowicz joins a trio of former Nittany Lions in 2022 recipient Ally Kurland, 2023 recipient Lexie Black and 2024 honoree Kaitlyn Morrison as the PSU student-athletes to earn B1G Player of the Week status under the direction of head coach Clarisa Crowell.

Freshman left fielder Natalie Lieto has burst onto the scene in her rookie season as a dynamic threat in both the batter's box and left field. Hailing from Monroe, Connecticut, Lieto stands second on the team in batting average with a .333 mark and has contributed the fourth-longest hitting streak on the Nittany Lion roster with five, an active streak she will carry into this weekend's action in Oklahoma City. The right-handed hitter has legged out 11 extra-base knocks this season to date, including four doubles, a triple and six home runs to amass 48 total bases and a .774 slugging percentage that brings her OPS to the second-highest mark on the roster at 1.217. Her dynamic start to the season also extends to the defensive end, where she boasts a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage including a myriad of highlight-reel catches in left field.

As a prospect in high school, Lieto was a dominant force behind Masuk High School's four-peat of state championship runs in CIAC competition over the last four years. She was named an All-State selection on multiple occasions in Connecticut and picked up laurels as a PGF All-American during her travel ball career.

GORDON'S GREATNESSWith her most recent stretch of performances at the Hokie Invite and

Penn State Softball Invitational, senior utility Maddie Gordon cracked her way into the top 10 all-time at Penn State for home runs in a career. Gordon has mashed 22 homers during her time at PSU, the eighthmost in the team's record book, needing one more to tie for seventh. The Shenandoah, Virginia, native has been on an absolute tear on the offensive end in the 2025 campaign, hitting to the tune of a .311 average paired with an eye-popping 1.140 OPS in the Nittany Lions' first 23 games. Gordon has cranked all six of her home runs in the 2025 campaign in the last three weeks heading into B1G Softball x Devon Park, adding a trio of doubles and a triple for 10 extra-base knocks in that span. Gordon owns the second-longest hitting streak and reached-base streak on the roster this season, booking seven and 11-game stretches in each respective category. Gordon garnered a wide array of preseason accolades in January, securing the No. 7 utility/DP ranking from D1Softball, adding honors as the No. 16 player in the B1G and No. 99 player nationally according to D1. Softball America rated Gordon as the No. 92 player in the nation, with the Nittany Lion additionally logging B1G Player to Watch status.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

Penn State welcomed a trio of transfer prospects to Happy Valley in the 2024-25 offseason, including Pittsburgh infielder Jordan George, FGCU infielder Meagan Ricks and Saint Francis infielder Kaylie Walters.

The incoming Nittany Lion transfer class features a pair of First Team All-Conference honorees from their prior institutions, with Ricks picking up a First Team All-Atlantic Sun distinction during her time with FGCU, while Walters landed a First Team All-NEC accolade in her only season with the Red Flash. Both Nittany Lion All-Conference transfer players have cemented routine starting roles through the early portion of the 2025 season.

In addition to the program's trio of incoming transfers, Penn State hauled in a three-member freshman class for the 2025 season that features some of the nation's premier individual prospects. The incoming Nittany Lion freshman class garnered the No. 24 national ranking and is comprised of pitcher Abigail Britton, catcher Macy Chamberlin and rounded out by outfielder Natalie Lieto.

THE ROAR FROM 2024

Penn State softball booked one of its strongest seasons in program history in the 2024 campaign, with the Nittany Lions amassing the third-winningest season in program history with a 35-20 effort and pairing that with the program's first NCAA Tournament Regional appearance since hosting a Regional in 2011. The Blue & White mustered a victory in the 2024 NCAA Tournament, downing the UAlbany Great Danes in a 9-3 contest from Davis Diamond in Bryan-College Station, Texas. The win marked PSU's first national postseason victory since besting the Fordham Rams in extra innings during the 2011 University Park Regional.

Penn State has booked 30-win seasons in each of the last three years, marking the first stretch of three consecutive 30-win campaigns in Happy Valley since notching five such seasons from 1999 to 2003. Penn State will seek consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since back-to-back berths in 2005 and 2006.

The Nittany Lions additionally mustered a 12-11 record in Big Ten Conference competition in 2024, tying for the fourth-most B1G wins in program history. Penn State has finished .500 or better in conference play in each of the last three years, accomplishing that feat for the first time since joining the Big Ten in 1992.

UP NEXT

Penn State softball continues its 2025 Big Ten Conference slate and prepares for its first true road series of the season, as the Nittany Lions head to Bloomington, Indiana, and Andy Mohr Field to battle the Indiana Hoosiers. Action runs Friday through Sunday, March 21 through 23, with one game per day slated for 6 p.m. (ET), 2 p.m. (ET) and 1 p.m. (ET), respectively. All three games will stream live to a worldwide audience of authenticated subscribers via B1G+ and the B1G+ app on connected devices.

NITTANY LION SOFTBALL PARK & BEARD FIELD

A facility years in the making, stateof-the-art and second to none that is what Nittany Lion Softball Park and Beard Field provides to the Penn State athletic community. With numerous donations and the Penn State Board of Trustees' approval, construction of the \$10.2 million complex was completed in time for the 2011 season. The facility houses the Nittany Lion softball team and allows the program to compete with the best in the country.

complex features 1,084 permanent seats with fantastic sight lines, accessible seating, concession stands, permanent bathrooms and merchandise areas for fans. On the softball side of things, the field with irrigation, dugouts, batting cages and tunnels, bullpens, scoreboard and a state-of-the-art lighting system make Nittany Lion Softball Park a collegiate softball gem.

The complex consolidates the team's resources into one area with new training rooms, media center, video room, study space, locker rooms and coaches' offices all housed at the softball park. A new press area behind home plate was constructed, which further enhanced the amenities of the stadium.

Key benefactors of the project allowed Nittany Lion Softball Park to take shape and get off the ground. The playing field was named Beard Field in recognition of a generous donation from Lee and William Beard in October 2009. The Penn State locker room was named the Fran Vanden Locker Room, recognizing a gift from George and Frances Vanden. Another major donation came from the James M. and Margaret V. Stine Foundation to name both the Softball Office Complex and Media Center in honor of the Stine Family. Art and Paige Nagle also contributed to the project and one of the assistant coaches' offices dons their names.

Penn State's first game in its new home was March 26, 2011, a thrilling 8-5 victory over Wisconsin. Plenty of firsts were delivered that afternoon and none more memorable than Lisa Akamine's inside-the-park home run as Penn State overcame a three-run deficit to win the inaugural game. For the season, Penn State boasted an 11-8-1 record on Beard Field in its first campaign. It was the first winning season at home since 2007 for the Nittany Lions, which coincided with PSU's last trip to the NCAA Tournament before 2011.

stadium paid dividends immediately for the Nittany Lion program as Penn State hosted the 2011 NCAA University Park Regional.

The event marked the first time PSU hosted NCAA Softball in 28 years as Oregon, Fordham and Albany competed with Penn State for the right to go to the NCAA Super Regionals. In the three-day event, nearly 1,900 fans streamed through the turnstiles. Oregon would eventually advance, but not before an exciting 16-inning midnight thriller between Penn State and Fordham. The Nittany Lions prevailed, 5-2, in the second-longest game in PSU history.

As if the NCAA event wasn't exciting enough. Penn State then hosted the PIAA Softball Championships. Four games in one day on a sparkling afternoon in mid-June had nearly 3,000 fans attend. The first game of the day featured local powerhouse Philipsburg-Osceola and Brandywine Heights with a standing room-only crowd of 1,800 spectators. The PIAA is still a committed partner of Penn State Athletics, as Nittany Lion Softball Park and Happy Valley Hospitality earned rave reviews. Penn State's University Park campus has played host to the PIAA Championships in every season since Beard Field opened in 2011.

Nittany Lion Softball Park is located on the corner of Park Avenue and University Drive, facing the Bryce Jordan Center, Mount Nittany and Beaver Stadium to the southeast, providing spectacular views and a gorgeous setting for all who attend softball games.

"Bill and I are both very pleased to be a small part of this very impressive facility. For us, the decision to give to this facility, to this program, was easy because one of our big passions is certainly the students of this university, but in particular the softball program. Our passion to help the softball program is because we've watched this program grow. Then-Penn State University Vice President for Athletics Sandy Barbour named Clarisa Crowell as the eighth head coach of the Nittany Lion softball program on August 3, 2020. Crowell enters her fifth season at the helm of the Blue & White in the 2025 campaign.

Crowell's most recent season in Happy Valley was one of the most successful on record at PSU, as the Nittany Lions rolled to a 35-20 overall record and 12-11 mark in Big Ten play while making the program's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2011 at the 2024 Bryan-College Station Regional. The Blue & White recorded the third-most overall victories in school history and the fourth-most B1G wins in a single year, finishing at or above .500 in conference play for the third-straight season. PSU booked three consecutive 30-win seasons for the first time since rattling off five straight from 1999 to 2003, while recording three straight B1G campaigns at or above .500 for the first time in school history.

PSU's return to the NCAA Tournament saw the Blue & White record a 1-2 record in Texas A&M's regional, dropping an opening-round decision to Texas State before defeating UAlbany in the first elimination game of the bracket. Penn State's 9-3 win over the Great Danes featured multiple home runs, including a go-ahead grand slam from senior Liana Jones to ensure the NCAA Tournament victory. The Nittany Lions recorded their first NCAA Tournament win since 2011 in the process. Under Crowell's direction, PSU's 60th varsity team brought the all-time Nittany Lion record in the NCAA Division I Softball Tournament to 13-22, winning at least one game in a national postseason tournament for just the eighth time in program history.

Crowell also directed one of the most decorated seasons in Nittany Lion history, with multiple student-athletes picking up All-Big Ten and NFCA All-Region recognition highlighted by the 2024 Big Ten Freshman of the Year, Bridget Nemeth. A native of Glendora, California, Nemeth cemented herself as one of the most successful first-year athletes in Nittany, Lion softball history under Crowell's tutelage, becoming the first Freshman All-American in school history according to both D1Softball and Softball America. The righthanded pitcher delivered the first individual award from the B1G league office in program history, becoming the first individual award winner at Penn State since Nan Sichler earned the Atlantic 10 Most Valuable Player and Pitcher awards in 1988. Additionally, Nemeth's breakout season was duly recognized on the Penn State campus in 2024, with the freshman earning Penn State's Female Athlete of the Year award, the second softball student-athlete to land that honor in three seasons.

A trio of Nittany Lion athletes earned NFCA All-Great Lakes Region accolades in the postseason, with Nemeth garnering a First Team nod while Maddie Gordon appeared on the Second Team and Gaby Garcia rounded out the Third Team. Nemeth additionally landed unanimous First Team All-B1G accolades and All-Freshman honors while Garcia, Gordon and Kaitlyn Morrison secured spots on the league's Second Team. Penn State's decorated student-athletes led the way in one of the most productive two-way campaigns in school history, with the Nittany Lion offense hitting the most doubles and home runs in a single season while accumulating the most total bases in a year in program history. PSU pitching accounted for the third-most overall victories in the circle in a single season in program history, with four student-athletes contributing to that impressive statistic.

In the classroom, Crowell's squad posted yet another year with a 1,000 NCAA Academic Progress Rate, signifying the program's success at developing student-athletes on and off the field. Thirteen different Nittany Lions picked up Academic All-Big Ten distinction, while five more Penn Staters garnered B1G Distinguished Scholar status in the 2024 postseason. Senior Amanda Mack rounded out the postseason Big Ten accolades, picking up the Big Ten Sportsmanship

award in recognition of her outstanding leadership on and off the field. Finally, a quintet of Nittany Lions landed College Sports Communicators Academic All-District laurels for the second year in a row, with Garcia, Gordon, Jones, Morrison and Emily Maddock landing that distinction.

In 2023, Crowell led the Blue & White to their second consecutive 30-win season, the first instance of back-to-back 30-win campaigns at PSU since the 2005 and 2006 teams accomplished that feat. Penn State published a 31-16 overall record at season's end and mustered an 11-11 record in Big Ten Conference play, ensuring that the Nittany Lions would finish at or above .500 in the league in consecutive seasons, also for the first time since 2005-06.

Under Crowell's direction, the Nittany Lions saw continued success on the Big Ten's biggest stage in 2023, winning a conference tournament game in consecutive seasons for the first time since the 2016 and 2017 squads did so. PSU also recorded consecutive postseason appearances for the first time in five seasons, reaching back-to-back Big Ten Tournaments for the first time since the Nittany Lions appeared in five straight from 2013 to 2017.

As the program's pitching coach, Crowell directed the most effective pitching staff in the Big Ten Conference that season. The Nittany Lions finished as the conference's leader in overall earned run average, rounding out the year with a 2.18 mark. The Blue & White also recorded the third-best strikeout-to-walk ratio in the league and 15th-best nationally, striking out 3.59 batters for every walk surrendered. Crowell's pitching direction also culminated in multiple program records being shattered by fifth-year left-hander Bailey Parshall, who set PSU records in career strikeouts (783) and shutouts (21).

In the classroom, PSU published a perfect Academic Progress Rate of 1,000 and saw 18 Nittany Lion student-athletes land Academic All-Big Ten honors. Penn State also mustered 12 Easton/NFCA Scholar Athletes, seven Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honors and five College Sports Communicators (CSC) Academic All-District accolades, reflecting Crowell's commitment to comprehensive excellence on and off the field.

In recognition of her exemplary record in the classroom and on the diamond, senior first baseman Lexie Black secured two of the highest honors bestowed by the Big Ten Conference in 2023. Black, a native of Omaha, Nebraska, landed the Big Ten Postgraduate Scholarship in preparation for her continuing education in veterinary medicine at the University of Nebraska, Additionally, Black garnered the Big Ten Medal of Honor, bestowed upon one male and female graduating student-athlete from each B1G member institution.

Penn State finished the 2022 campaign with a 25-win improvement from the previous season, marking the largest single-season turnaround for a team in NCAA Division I. The Nittany Lions also reached the 30-win mark and finished above 500 in Big Ten Conference play for the first time since 2016. Penn State completed the campaign with 32 wins, which at the time marked the most wins for PSU in a season since 2008. As a result of the program's meteoric rise to prominence, Crowell was honored as the 2022 ECAC Coach of the Year.

On the defensive side, the Blue and White registered 12 shutouts on the year, the most by any Nittany Lion squad since the 2008 team accomplished that feat. At the dish, the Nittany Lions' 75 doubles ranked tied for second in program history, while their 43 home runs and 207 RBI ranked third in program history.

Parshall led the way on an individual basis, earning NFCA All-America Third Team honors to go along with NFCA First-Team All-Region and First-Team All-Big Ten accolades. Parshall was selected as the Female Penn State Athlete of the

Year for the 2021-22 academic year as a result. Parshall became just the fifth NFCA All-American in program history and the first Penn State pitcher to earn All-American recognition since Ashley Esparza did so in 2005. Parshall was dominant in the circle in 2022, posting a 22-9 individual record with a 1.68 ERA and nine shutouts in 212.1 innings pitched.

In addition to Parshall's nationally acclaimed statistical season, junior catcher Cassie Lindmark collected NFCA All-Region Third Team and All-Big Ten Second Team laurels. Lindmark provided and immediate offensive pop for the Nittany Lion lineup, hitting .400 in the leadoff spot in addition to building a striking .508 on-base percentage. She became just the sixth Nittany Lion to hit .400 in a season and ranked tied for sixth on the program's single-season batting average leaderboard.

The Nittany Lions maintained consistent success in the classroom, tying a then-program record by placing 16 student-athletes on the Academic All-Big Ten team for the second consecutive year. Six student-athletes were designated as Big Ten Distinguished Scholars. Fourteen student-athletes made the Dean's list during spring semester and the squad compiled a 3.45 GPA, posting the highest cumulative GPA for the program in at least a decade. Under Crowell's leadership, Claire Swedberg was selected as the 2022 Big Ten Postgraduate Award winner, a recipient of the Fulbright grant and was also selected to be the Grand Marshal for the Penn State Health and Human Development Department.

In her first season at the helm in Happy Valley in 2021, Crowell led the Nittany Lions to a win over No. 23 Minnesota, the program's first victory over a ranked opponent since 2017. Penn State also had wins over four other Big Ten programs in a COVID-maligned conference-only calendar during the 2021 spring semester, including three-straight wins and a series victory over Rutgers. The consecutive victories against the Scarlet Knights marked the first time Penn State won three consecutive Big Ten contests since 2017.

Crowell also mentored Parshall in her ongoing success in the circle, as the then-junior pitcher recorded two double-digit strikeout games and moved into sixth all-time in the Penn State record books with 396 career strikeouts and third all-time with seven career saves. In the classroom, a program-record 16 student-athletes earned Academic All-Big Ten honors in Crowell's first season of leadership, immediately setting the tone for multiple seasons of academic excellence that followed.

Prior to her arrival at Penn State, Crowell spent eight years as head coach at Miami (Ohio). Crowell and the RedHawks made a MAC Tournament appearance every season in which a tournament was held, winning the league tournament title and making an NCAA Regional appearance in 2016.

Crowell coached 12 student-athletes to first team All-MAC honors, 10 to second-team honors, nine All-MAC Freshman Team recipients and six National Fastpitch Coaches Association (NFCA) All-Region honorees. RedHawk student-athletes also excelled in the classroom with 40 Easton/NFCA Scholar-Athletes and 32 Academic All-MAC honorees during Crowell's tenure in Oxford.

In the COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, Crowell's RedHawks were selected as the MAC preseason favorites. Junior pitcher Courtney Vierstra ranked fifth nationally and first in the conference in strikeouts with 140 over 18 appearances. Crowell's tutelage of Vierstra saw the junior star finish fifth nationally in strikeouts per seven innings with 12.5 at the season's suspension mark.

In the spring of 2019, Crowell led Miami to a 35-16 overall record and a 16-4 ledger in conference play, as the RedHawks captured their first MAC regular-season title in program history. Miami posted 10-straight wins against MAC opponents, the longest win streak in conference play in the

history of the RedHawk program. The team also ranked first in the MAC for pitching and team defense with an overall ERA of 2.55 coupled with a .972 fielding percentage. Crowell was named the 2019 MAC Coach of the Year while seven student-athletes earned All-MAC selections and two more were named NFCA All-Region honorees. Vierstra headlined the list of All-Region recipients after boasting the third-best strikeouts-per-seven innings ratio in the country (10.3).

Crowell's 2017 team excelled offensively, ranking second all-time in Miami history for runs scored (265), runs per game (5.00), RBI (235), doubles (74) and home runs (47). Crowell led Michaela Schlattman to NFCA All-Region recognition, marking the third-straight season a RedHawk player garnered regional accolades. The RedHawks went 29-24 in 2017, highlighted by a dominant 16-2 record at home.

In 2016, Crowell led Miami to a 35-23 overall record and 15-7 record in MAC competition, finishing just half a game short of the MAC regular-season title. The RedHawks made up for that with a perfect 4-0 record in the MAC Tournament to earn the program's fourth conference tournament crown and a spot in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2012. Miami went on to beat No. 23 Notre Dame, 3-2, in the opening game of the Ann Arbor Regional.

The 2016 RedHawks broke six offensive school records, including runs (302), runs per game (5.21), RBI (274), doubles (83), home runs (56) and walks (200). Miami also held a .977 fielding percentage, a school record, and the seventh-best fielding percentage in the nation. Crowell coached senior outfielder Taylor Shuey to become the first softball player in school history to be named MAC Player of the Year after breaking Miami's career RBI record with 114. Senior pitcher Amber Logemann was also named the MAC Tournament MVP after going 4-0 individually with a domineering 0.65 ERA in 32.1 innings pitched.

Crowell's third season in 2015 saw senior outfielder Tiyona Marshall garner NFCA All-Mideast Region First-Team honors after Marshall set school records in hits (86), runs scored (50) and batting average (.446).

Prior to Miami, Crowell spent six seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma State where she primarily worked with the pitchers and catchers. In 2010, both of her pitchers earned spots on the All-Big 12 and NFCA All-Midwest Region teams. In 2011, Crowell coached catcher Courtney Totte to an All-Big 12 first-team appearance and recognition as a Third Team All-American. Crowell helped lead the Cowgirls back to national prominence, as Oklahoma State returned to the Women's College World Series for the first time since 1998 in the 2011 campaign. The coaching staff also hauled in NFCA Midwest Region Coaching Staff of the Year accolades at season's end.

Crowell's previous stop at Syracuse as an assistant coach in 2006 saw the Orange land four players as NFCA All-Region designees and five players secure All-Conference honors. All-American and Big East Player of the Year Alexis Switenko led the way, while Tonye McCorkle, the Big East Co-Rookie of the Year, published a dominant season of her own. Crowell began her collegiate coaching career at Ohio University, where she served as an assistant for two

Crowell was a decorated student-athlete at Virginia Tech as a four-year letterwinner and a three-time All-Conference performer for the Hokies. In 2013, Crowell was inducted into the Virginia Tech All-Sports Hall of Fame.

Crowell graduated from Virginia Tech in 2002 with a Bachelor of Science degree in psychology. She earned a Master of Science in recreation and sports sciences from Ohio University in 2005.

Assistant Coach South Carolina '02 **Second Season** Av-Dree-Awn-Uh Buh-Get-Uh



COACH BIO

Penn State softball head coach Clarisa Crowell announced the addition of former Division III head coach and previous Big Ten assistant Adrianna Baggetta to the Nittany Lion coaching staff on Tuesday, August 15, 2023. Baggetta returns for her second season with the Blue & White ahead of the 2025 season.

In her first season of work with the Nittany Lions as the team's hitting coach in 2024. Baggetta oversaw one of the most dominant power hitting teams in Penn State program history and helped guide the Blue & White to their first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2011. Baggetta led the way in one of the most productive offensive campaigns in school history, with the Nittany Lion offense hitting the most doubles and home runs in a single season while accumulating the most total bases in a year in program history, PSU also mustered the third-most RBI, runs scored and triples in a single season in school history with Baggetta helping steer the offense.

Baggetta joined the Blue & White as an assistant after spending five seasons as the head coach at Emory University. While at the helm in Atlanta, Baggetta compiled 91 overall victories and led Emory to the championship series of the 2019 NCAA Division III Softball Tournament. Emory's landmark 2019 campaign included a University Athletic Association conference championship, while the program's national runner-up finish proved to be the most dominant single season in school history.

Baggetta also boasts nearly a decade of prior assistant coaching experience in the Big Ten Conference. Before arriving at Emory, she worked as an assistant coach, and ultimately as an associate head coach with the lowa Hawkeyes. While in lowa City, she was tasked with directing the hitters and defensive personnel while simultaneously managing the team's travel budget and recruiting operations. During her time with the Hawkeyes, lowa saw 17 student-athletes garner All-Big Ten accolades, nine earn placements on the All-Big Ten Defensive Team and six more appear as NFCA All-Region representatives.

ALEXIS GALLAGHER

Assistant Coach Saint Francis '17 **Fourth Season**



COACH BIO

Head Coach Clarisa Crowell announced the promotion of Volunteer Assistant Alexis Gallagher to become the program's third assistant coach on Thursday, July 6, 2023. She enters her second season as a full-time assistant and fourth season at Penn State overall in the 2025

Gallagher's first season of full-time experience with the Nittany Lions marked one of the most successful seasons in program history, with Penn State cranking out a 35-20 overall record and 12-11 mark in Big Ten play in addition to recording the first NCAA Tournament appearance in Happy Valley since 2011. Working closely with the PSU pitching staff, Gallagher was crucial in the development of Bridget Nemeth's B1G Freshman of the Year and Freshman All-America campaign, With Gallagher and Crowell's guidance, Nemeth garnered Penn State's Female Athlete of the Year award, the second softball pitcher to land that honor in three seasons with Gallagher on staff.

A rising star in the collegiate coaching ranks, Gallagher remained at home in Happy Valley after spending the 2022 and 2023 seasons as the Nittany Lions' volunteer assistant coach. Under her tutelage and with the support of Penn State's staff, Gallagher has helped coach 15 All-B16 postseason selections, 11 NFCA Great Lakes All-Region designees and 2022 Third Team NFCA All-American Bailey Parshall.

As a student-athlete at Saint Francis, she was named the 2014 NEC Rookie of the Year and became just the second player in SFU softball history to be named to an NFCA All-Region Team. She was also named a First Team All-NEC selection in 2014 and 2015. Gallagher was a member two NEC championship teams in her junior and senior seasons despite being unable to play both years due to ACL injuries. Gallagher was designated a three-year team captain from her sophomore seasons through her redshirt-senior campaign. Gallagher earned her Master's of Occupational Therapy in 2018 from Saint Francis University, the same impressive which issued her bachelor's degree in 2017. university which issued her bachelor's degree in 2017.

MYSHA SATARAKA

Assistant Coach UCLA '16 Third Season Mee-Shuh Sat-Uh-Rock-Uh



COACH BIO

Mysha Sataraka enters her third season as an assistant coach with the Penn State softball program in the 2025 campaign after head coach Clarisa Crowell welcomed her to the staff in July 2022.

In her second year with the program in 2024, Sataraka helped steer Penn State to its third-winningest season in program history, booking a 35-20 overall record and 12-11 ledger against Big Ten Conference competition while simultaneously helping spearhead the first NCAA Tournament campaign in Happy Valley in 13 years. Penn State's 2024 season marked the first NCAA Regional bid since 2011, with the Nittany Lions earning a spot in the Bryan-College Station Regional, dropping a pair of games to Texas State with a landmark win over UAlbany in the first elimination game of the bracket.

PSU booked three consecutive 30-win seasons for the first time since rattling off five straight from 1999 to 2003, while recording three straight BIG campaigns at or above .500 for the first time in school

The Nittany Lions recorded their first NCAA Tournament win since 201 in the process. With Sataraka playing a pivotal role, PSU's 60th varsity team brought the all-time Nittany Lion record in the NCAA Division I Softball Tournament to 13-22, winning at least one game in a national postseason tournament for just the eighth time in program history.

Her first season with the Blue & White saw the program secure a trio of All-Big Ten accolades with Emily Maddock landing a First Team selection while Lexie Black and Bailey Parshall brought home Second Team recognition. In the classroom, PSU tallied 18 Academic All-Big Tehonors, 12 Easton/NFCA Scholar Athlete recognitions and five College Sports Communicators Academic All-District accolades.

A former NFCA All-American and three-time All-Pac-12 selection as a player at UCLA, Sataraka joined Penn State from Loyola Marymount where she was an assistant coach for two seasons. Prior to coaching, Sataraka was a standout athlete at UCLA, where she led the Bruins to the College World Series in 2015 and 2016. Her senior season, Sataraka went .380 at the plate, while posting 15 home runs and 59 RBIs, which earned her NFCA All-America second team honors.
