- · Maine is playing in the program's 20th NCAA Tournament while Penn State is skating in its fourth.
- Penn State, who is serving as the host institution for the Allentown Regional, earned an at-large bid for this season's tournament while Maine earned Hockey East's automatic bid with the program's sixth-ever conference tournament title.

A WIN ON FRIDAY WOULD. . .

- Move Maine to 25-7-6 on the year.

SERIES HISTORY vs PENN STATE

- This marks the first-ever meeting between Maine and Penn State ... the teams were scheduled to play a series during the 2021-22 season but the two-game set at Pegula Ice Arena was canceled due to COVID-19 protocols.
- The Black Bears are 37-46-4 all-time against current Big Ten schools, including a mark of 11-11 in the NCAA Tournament.
- The last time the University of Maine and Penn State met in any sport was in baseball in February 2022.

MAINE IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- Maine is playing in its 20th NCAA Tournament ... the program has appeared in 11 Frozen Fours ... the Black Bears have won two national titles, doing it in 1993 and 1999.
- The Black Bears are 30-21 all-time in the tournament, including a mark of 14-8 in the regional round.
- Maine has not won an NCAA Tournament game since March 24, 2007 when it topped UMass, 3-1, in the regional final to advance to the Frozen Four ... the Black Bears are 0-3 since then.
- Maine appeared in its first national title game in 1993, topping Lake Superior State, 5-4, for the program's first title ... the Black Bears are 2-3 in the championship game.
- · Maine is the only team in the 2025 NCAA Tournament whose losses on the season all came at the hands of another NCAA Tournament team.

THAT SWEET SIXTH CROWN

- Maine won the program's sixth Hockey East Tournament title with a 5-2 win over UConn on March 21.
- It was Maine's first crown since 2004 and the first Hockey East tournament title for a non-Massachusetts sauad since that 2004 team.
- Albin Boija was named the tournament MVP and was joined on the All-Tournament team by Luke An-

- Maine earned a double overtime 4-3 win over Northeastern in the Thursday night semifinal.
- The Black Bears advanced to the semifinal round in back-to-back seasons (this year and last year) for the first time since 2004-05 and 2005-06 ... the Black Bears took down UMass Lowell in the March 15 quarterfinal round at home, 7-1.
- Maine's six titles are third most all-time behind BC (12) and BU (10).

IT'S WORTH NOTING

- Maine is the only team in the 2025 NCAA Tournament whose losses on the season all came at the hands of another NCAA Tournament team.
- Since the start of 2002-03 season, Albin Boija is only the second Hockey East goaltender and just the 13th nationally to post a goals against average of 1.76 or below in their first 36 games played in a season.
- Maine's scoring margin currently sits at +1.4 ... the Black Bears have not ifnished a season with a scoring margin of +1.0 or above since 2005-06 (+1.14).
- Since the turn of the new year, Maine has played 20 games with 18 of those games coming against ranked or receiving-votes opponents, going 12-4-4 over that stretch.
- · Maine's seven losses in the regular season marked the fewest regular season losses for the program since going 26-7-3 during the 2003-04 regular season.
- Maine is the first Hockey East program since 2012-13 to finish in the top three of the regular season standings while having fewer than three draft picks on the roster (doing it last year and this year).
- With a 7-21-28 scoring line, Frank Djurasevic has the first 25-point season by a Maine blue liner since Ben Hutton had 29 points in 2013-14 ... he is one of two Hockey East players and only 10 players nationally to have at least 45 blocked shots and at least 25 points.
- Harrison Scott's 56.6 winning percentage is sixth in the country among players with at least 400 wins.

- Since at least the 2010-11 season, Maine is the only Hockey East program to finish in the top two of the regular season standings while having fewer than two draft picks on the roster.
- Since 2012-13, Maine is the first Hockey East program to finish in the top three of the regular season standings while having fewer than three draft picks on the roster.
- Since 2015-16, Maine is the first Hockey East program to finish in the top four with fewer than three draft picks (doing it in 2023-24 and 2024-25).

THE BRICK WALL FROM SUNDSVALL

- · Albin Boija is currently tied fourth in the country with a 1.76 goals against average while his .930 save percentage is tied for ninth nationally but is the second best mark among goaltenders with at least 35 games played.
- He is also fifth overall in wins with a 23-7-6 record and is tied third in shutouts with four.
- Boija is one of four finalists for the Richter Award.
- Since the start of 2002-03 season, Boija is only the second Hockey East goaltender and just the 13th nationally to post a goals against average of 1.76 or below in their first 36 games played in a season.
- With a 20-save performance against Northeastern on Jan. 31, 2025, Boija earned his 25th career win in his 41st career game to become the fastest Maine goaltender to 25 wins since Ben Bishop (2005-07) did it in 35 games.
- And then, with a 25-save game against Vermont on March 1, Boija earned his 30th win in his 49th career game to become the fastest Maine goalie to the 30win mark since Bishop did it in 44 games.
- Since at least 2002-03, Boija's 1.77 goals against in Hockey East games the best mark by a league goaltender who played at least 23 conference games.

Of the 123 goals Maine has scored this season, **39** of them have come in the first two minutes or last two minutes of the period for 32% of Maine's total goals.

Since Ben Barr's arrival ahead of the 2021-22 season, Maine's scoring margin has steadily increased every year. Maine has not finished with a scoring margin of +1.0 or above since the 2005-06 season (+1.14).

MAINE WELCOMES MAKAR

- In 37 games as a Black Bear, Taylor Makar has recorded career-highs in points (30), goals (18), assists (12), game-winning goals (6), short-handed goals (2) and shots on goal (100).
- · His six game-winning goals are second in Hockey East and tied sixth in the nation.
- · Makar record his first career hat trick against Vermont on Feb. 28.
- The senior now has five multi-goal games and nine multi-point outings this year.
- In the season-opening win over AIC on Oct. 5, Makar scored the game-winner and had a career-high three points on two goals and one assist.
- · Against Quinnipiac, Makar scored his first career short-handed goal.
- Makar has also set career-best point streaks (6) and goal streaks (5) this season.

THE OFFENSIVE DEFENSEMEN

- With Frank Djurasevic and Brandon Holt, Maine is one of just two Hockey East teams to have two defensemen with at least 20 points each.
- Djurasevic has a career-high 28 points on seven goals and a team-leading 21 assists ... the sophomore is second or tied second among all Hockey East blue liners in points, goals and assists.
- Djurasevic's 28 points mark the first 25-point season by a Maine blue liner since Ben Hutton had 29 points during the 2013-14 season.
- Djurasevic is one of two Hockey East players and only 10 players nationally to have at least 45 blocked shots and at least 25 points.
- · Holt has a career-high 20 points from four goals and a career-best 16 assists ... he also has a career-high 44 blocked shots this season.
- · Holt was named the Hockey East Defender of the Month for October and was runner up for Best Defensive Defenseman ... Djurasevic was named the Defender of the Month for November.

THE JOSH NADEAU SHOW

- With one goal and three assists in the third period against UNH on Feb. 15, 2025, Josh Nadeau registered the first four-point period by a Hockey East player in over two years.
- The sophomore is currently third on the team with 29 points on 10 goals and 19 assists.
- Nadeau's 74 points in his first 73 games mark the most by a Maine player in their first 73 games at Maine since Gustav Nyquist had 88 points (2008-10).
- His eight game-winning goals since the start of the 2023-24 season are also the third most among Hockey East players and 15th most in the country.



- Nadeau has 22 career multi-point games, including two career four-point ooutings.
- As a rookie, Nadeau led Maine in power-play goals (8) and tied for the team lead in assists (27) while sitting second in points (45).

THE GREAT SCOTT

- Harrison Scott has a career-high 18 goals and a career-high 17 assists for a team-leading and career-best 35 points.
- At the face-off dot, Scott's 56.6 winning percentage is sixth in the country among players with at least 400 wins.
- His 801 face-off wins since the start of the 2023-24 season are the most by a Hockey East player and eighth in the nation.
- Since Scott's arrival for the 2023-24 season, Maine has gone 23-4-1 when he scores a goal and 35-7-4 when he has a point.
- Earlier this year, he became the first Black Bear since the start of the 2005-06 season to score 30 goals in his first 60 games at Maine ... he is just the eighth Hockey East player since the start of the 2005-06 season score 30 goals in their first 60 career games in the league.
- So far this year, he has seven multi-point games, four multi-goals games and two four-point games.
- In his first season at Maine, Scott recorded then career-highs in points (27), goals (15), assists (12), game-winning goals (4) and was second in Hockey East with a career-high 396 face-off wins.

THE POLLS

- When Maine was ranked in both polls back on Oct. 23, 2023, it marked the first time back in the national rankings since March 2020.
- Currently ranked #4, Maine has now been ranked for 46 consecutive weeks for the longest stretch since a 57-week period from January 2005 to March 2007.
- Maine has also been ranked in the top 10 for 22 straight weeks.

TOP-3 FINISH

- The Black Bears finished second or higher in the Hockey East regular season standings for the first time since finishing second during the 2005-06 season.
- Additionally, after finishing tied for third last season, this marks the first back-to-back top-3 finishes for the Black Bears since 2002-03 and 2003-04.
- Maine is the first Hockey East program since 2012–13 to finish in the top three of the regular season standings while having fewer than three draft picks on the roster, doing it last year and this year.
- In the 41 seasons of Hockey East, Maine was the eighth team to finish in the top two in the regular season standings without having a major award winner (Player, Coach, Rookie) or first team all-star.
- In 2023-24, the Black Bears were just the second team in 25 years to be picked to finish ninth or lower that went on to earn a top-3 finish (joining the 2011-12 UMass Lowell squad that was led by that season's head coach of the Year, Norm Bazin).

BALANCED ATTACK

- Maine is one of three Hockey East teams to have seven players with at least 20 points each (joining UMass and Boston University).
- The Black Bears are one of two teams in the conference to have two defenders with at least 20 points (Boston University).
- Maine has five players with at least 25 points each for the first time since 2011-12.
- For the first time since 2010-11 and 2011-12, the Black Bears have four players with at least 25 points in back-to-back seasons.
- Maine also has five players with at least 10 goals each and nine players with at least seven goals each.
- \bullet The Black Bears have 10 players with at least 15 points each, the most for the program since having nine in the 2017–18 season.
- Twenty-two different players have registered at least one point this year.

SHOTS, SHOTS, SHOTS

- Maine has outshot the opponent in 59 of 73 contests dating back to the start of 2023-24
- The Black Bears sit fourth in the country and first in Hockey East with an average of 34.9 shots on goal per game.
- Maine ranks third in the nation in overall Fenwick percentage (57.1) and is first in power-play Fenwick percentage (67.0)

CAPTAIN CLUTCH

- Captain David Breazeale has scored a career-high three goals this season with all three serving as the game-winning goal or game-tying goal against a ranked opponent.
- Against #7/8 Quinnipiac on Oct. 19, the defender scored the winner with 36 seconds remaining in overtime to secure the top-10 sweep.
- Breazeale also stuffed home the third-period game-winner against #6 Denver on Jan. 4 while his second-period strike at #8 UMass Lowell started Maine's 3-1 comeback win.
- He leads Maine with a career-high 49 blocks after leading the team with 43 a season ago.

FREEL GOOD

- Thomas Freel has recorded a career-high 11 goals and added seven assists for 18 points this season.
- \bullet Eight of his goals have come on the power-play, tied for eighth in the country.
- The alternate captain has six multi-point games on the year.
- Earlier this year, Freel became just the 12th NCAA DI men's hockey player since 2005-06 to score seven power-play goals in their first 11 games of the season and only the second Hockey East player.
- Maine is 13-1-1 all-time when he scores a goal and 27-8-4 when he has a point.

CARNEY CONNECTION

- Junior forward Aidan Carney is the second member of his family to skate for the Black Bears, joining his father Keith Carney.
- Keith Carney was a two-time All-American defenseman ... he recorded 126 points on 14 goals and 112 assists in his three seasons in Orono before going on to skate in 1,018 regular season NHL games.
- Aidan Carney skated in 19 games as a freshman, recording two goals and one assist for three points.

WHAT'S BACK FOR THE BLACK BEARS

- The Black Bears return 17 point-getters from last season's team, including three of the top five and seven of the top 10.
- Overall, Maine returns 63 percent of goals, 68 percent of assists and 66 percent of the points from a season ago.
- Maine welcomes back double-digit goal scorers Josh Nadeau (19) and Harrison Scott (15) along with four players who had at least 15 assists in Nadeau (27), Breen (30), Brandon Chabrier (16) and Thomas Freel (16).
- In between the pipes, Albin Boija is back after starting 43 percent of last year's

ODD AND ENDS ON 2023-24...

- Maine's 23 wins marked its most in a season since going 23-14-2 in 2011-12.
- Twenty of Maine's 37 games were against ranked opponents, with the Black Bears going 11-8-1 for the most ranked wins since 2003-04 (12).
- The Black Bears went 13-2-2 at Alfond Arena to hit 13 wins at home for the first time since 2013-14.
- Maine led Hockey East with 11 sellouts at Alfond Arena (and had 12 total including the annual neutral site home game in Portland).
- Alfond Arena had a 99 percent capacity for all home games.
- Maine finished second in Hockey East and 18th in the nation with a 51.9 face-off winning percentage ... Harrison Scott was second among Hockey East players and 14th in the nation with 396 face-off wins.
- Maine averaged 62.19 shots per game last season, the second most of any Hockey East school.

BEN BARR, HEAD COACH

Ben Barr enters his fourth season as the head coach of the University of Maine men's ice hockey team in the 2024-25 season. In just three seasons, Barr has steadily returned the Black Bears' hockey program to among the nation's elite.

During the 2023-24 season, Barr guided Maine to a 23-12-2 record and spots in both the Hockey East Tournament championship weekend and the NCAA Tournament for the first time since the 2011-12 season. The Black Bears earned a national ranking for the first time in over three years and the team went on to sustain that success by earning a ranking for 21 consecutive weeks for the first time in nearly 20 years. The team also made a return to the national top 10 for the first time since 2012 and earned a spot in the top five for the first time since 2010.

Off the ice, the 2023-24 team recorded the program's highest fall grade point average ever last year with a 3.71. In each of Barr's first two seasons, at least 22 student-athletes earned a spot on the Hockey East All-Academic Team. Maine led Hockey East with six Hockey East All-Academic All-Star Team members in 2021-22, and tied for the most members in the 2022-23 season with four. Additionally, there have been 27 AHCA Academic All-American nods.

In Barr's first season behind the bench, Maine went 7-22-4. He won his first career game on Nov. 12, 2021 with a 6-5 victory against Merrimack at Alfond Arena. In Barr's second season in 2022-23, the Black Bears improved to 15-16-5 overall.

Barr arrived at UMaine with 15 years of assistant coaching experience in Division-I programs and a tradition of success at each of his stints at five different institutions. Most recently, Barr spent five years at UMass as associate head coach and recruiting coordinator where he helped guide the Minutemen to a 94-75-10 record, including a 72-26-6 mark over his last three seasons. His time at UMass included a Hockey East regular season and tournament title, three NCAA appearances, back-to-back NCAA title game appearances, and the 2021 National Championship.

Barr began his coaching career at his alma mater, Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, where he spent the 2004-05 and 2007-08 seasons as a volunteer assistant coach. Barr joined Union College in September of 2008 as a full-time assistant. In his three seasons at Union, Barr played a key role in developing Union into a national champion. In his final year on staff, the Dutchman captured their first-ever ECAC Regular Season Championship and earned their first trip to the NCAA Tournament in school history. At the time, working under head coach Nate Leaman, Barr and the Union staff were named the 2011 Spencer Penrose NCAA Staff of the Year.

After three years at Union, Barr was hired as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Providence College. In his first year on staff, the Friars reached the Hockey East semifinals for the first time in 11 years. In his final year on staff, Providence advanced to the NCAA quarterfinal round in its first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2001. Following his departure, with players both recruited and developed by Barr, the Friars went on to win the 2015 NCAA National Championship.

In June of 2014, Barr accepted a role as the associate head coach at Western Michigan University where he would stay for two seasons. At Western Michigan, Barr again served as recruiting coordinator and assisted head coach Andy Murray in developing a championship culture. The team transformed into a top-10 program and reached the NCAA Tournament the year after Barr's departure.

The Faribault, Minn. native began his role at UMass in April of 2016 where he went on to serve five seasons as the associate head coach and recruiting coordinator. In his first season at UMass, the team finished the year at 5-29-2. Just two seasons later, the program registered a 31-10 overall mark, a Hockey East regular season championship, and finished as the NCAA runners-up. Two years later, the Minutemen achieved greatness as they were crowned the Hockey East and NCAA Champions.

In his five seasons behind the bench at UMass, Barr led the charge in his recruiting coordinator role in recruiting the top producing freshman class in all of NCAA hockey in 2017-18. Under the leadership of Greg Carvel, Barr earned his second Spencer Penrose National Coaching Staff of the Year award. Barr played a key role in bringing several firsts to UMass as the Minutemen earned their first Hockey East regular season title in school history in 2019, their first Hockey East Tournament title in 2021, and the school's first-ever National Championship in April of 2021.

Barr attended Shattuck-St. Mary's Prep School in Faribault, Minn. where he served as Captain of the Shattuck-St. Mary's Midget hockey team in 1999. A Williams Cup recipient, Barr was named Shattuck-St. Mary's Best All-Around Athlete in 2000. Prior to his playing career at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute, Barr competed as a member of the 1999 USA National Championship team.

Barr earned a four-year athletic scholarship at RPI where he went on to achieve four letters for the men's ice hockey team from 2000-04. He served as the team's captain during the 2003-04 season, leading the program to a 22 win season. Barr earned the Rensselaer Coach's award in 2003 and 2004 and was named the team's Most Valuable Player for the 2002-03 campaign. Barr graduated from RPI in May of 2004 with a Bachelor of Science in Management and Technology with a Marketing concentration.

Barr and his wife, Tara, are the proud parents of a son, Brooks, and twins, Isla and Griffin.
