THE DRAW

Penn State chases a sixth consecutive conference win when the team travels to Johns Hopkins on Wednesday evening. Six conference wins would mark the most ever for PSU.

The Nittany Lions are one of the hottest teams in the conference right now, coming off the heels of a fifth-straight conference win, this time doubling up No. 22 Souther California

Senior Ellie Hollin raked in the preseason recognitions. She was named a consensus preseason first-team All-American and earned a spot on the Tewaaraton watch list.

Hollin also was named a Big Ten Player to Watch. She joined sophomores Sydney Manning and Kelly MacKinney on the list.

Goaltender Sydney Manning is back in 2025 after being named the 2024 Big Ten Freshman of the Year.

Kelly MacKinney is third in the Big Ten in assists (33) and third in assists per game (2.36) after the first 14 outings of the season.

NOTES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT

A 10-2 second half powered Penn State to its second top 25 win of the season, downing No. 22 Southern California, 16-8 on Sunday afternoon at Panzer Stadium. The senior day win moves Penn State to 7-7 (5-2 Big Ten), while USC falls to 9-6 (2-5 Big Ten).

Sophomore Kelly MacKinney led both teams with five points on a goal and four assists. Junior Erika Ho led all scorers with four goals in the contest. Ho matched her career-high draw controls for a third time this season, winning 14 pulls for the Nittany Lions in addition to scooping three ground balls. Even though it was senior day, the freshmen had some of the biggest impacts on the final score. First-year Brooke Long secured her first-career hat trick, while rookie Ellie Wisch put up three points on a pair of scores and an assist. Junior Maddie Greco tallied her first career points with a goal and assist, both of which were crucial in the Blue and Whites momentum swing in the first half. Senior Lauren Saltz and junior Emma Kelly rounded out the multi-point scorers on Sunday afternoon. Saltz put up a goal and an assist in addition to three draw controls, two ground balls, and a caused turnover. Kelly buried two shots, won two draws, and vacuumed up two ground balls.

Defensively, goalkeepers Ashley Bowan and Sydney Manning split time, combining for a .556 save percentage, making 10 saves collectively. Manning as an individual made saves at a 75 percent clip, the second highest mark of her career.

NITTANY LIONS VS. JOHNS HOPKINS

In a series dating back to 2002, Penn State owns a 17-10 advantage in the all-time series against the Blue Jays. Despite the all-time series leading toward the Nittany Lions, the Jays have won five of the last six meetings. PSU's lone win in the stretch was a 16-13 win at home last season.

Penn State have taken down the Blue Jays in eight of the 11 games at Homewood Field. Still, the Blue and White will be chasing the first win in hostile territory since 2019.

SCOUTING THE BLUE JAYS

Johns Hopkins comes into the week ranked eighth in the IWLCA Coaches Poll, boasting a 10-4 overall record and 4-2 conference mark. The Blue Jays are coming off a shocking 13-2 loss to Michigan on Sunday after missing the presence of their number one attacker, Ashley Mackin.

Mackin, who leads the Blue Jays in goals, points, and free position goals despite only appearing in 12 games, has recorded at least four points in nine games this season, and at least four of those points came from goals in each appearance. In the potential absence of Mackin, Hopkins will look to Ava Angello to spark the offense. The junior is the Jays number two scorer, posting 48 goals and 14 assists in 14 games.

WEEKLY RECOGNITION

After a second top 25 win, this time toppling No. 22 Southern California, 16-8, Penn State moved into third in the Big Ten Conference and pushed its win streak to five, the longest in the Big Ten. For their efforts in the win, senior Lauren Saltz and freshman Brooke Long earned weekly conference honors.





NOTES AND HEADLINES

Saltz, the Big Ten Midfielder of the Week, posted a goal and an assist on senior day in the upset win. She also scooped two ground balls, caused a turnover, and won three draw controls.

Long, the Big Ten Freshman of the Week, put up her first-career hat trick on just four shots in the win. Long also caused two turnovers and scooped two ground balls as a strong two-way midfielder.

The win over USC earned Penn State a spot back into the Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association Coaches Poll. The Nittany Lions entered the week at 25.

In addition to the rookies, Penn State added transfers Lily Strohecker (Navy), and Delaney Radin (Florida).

(W)HO'S NEXT UP

Junior Erika Ho posted four goals in Penn State's upset win over No. 22 Southern California, helping the Nittany Lions earn a fifth-straight conference victory and break into the Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association (IWLCA) poll for the first time since week two of the 2025 season.

On three separate occasions this season, Ho has won 14 draw controls (vs. Drexel, at Oregon, vs. USC). The mark matches the second most by a Nittany Lion since at least the 2012 season. She now owns three of the top eight spots in the PSU record books since in at least the last 13 seasons. She sits at 98 draw controls on the season. 32 more wins would match the single season PSU record (130, set by Madison Carter in 2017).

UP NEXT

Women's lacrosse next awaits its matchup in the first round of the Big Ten Tournament. A win over Johns Hopkins could lock up the third seed for Penn State, marking the third consecutive season that PSU claims a top-three seed.
