LEADING OFF

- Penn State welcomes Purdue for a three-game Big Ten series.
- The Nittany Lions are looking to bounce back after falling against Delaware on Tuesday night.
- Last weekend, Penn State took the series opener against USC, 3-1.
- PSU improved to 8-1 in weekend/series openers this year.
- On Friday, Ryan DeSanto tossed seven innings, allowing one run and striking out seven, while Paxton Kling launched his 12th homer of the year.
- On Sunday, Ryan Weingartner blasted PSU's sixth grand slam of the season.
- With 59 home runs and 81 steals this season, PSU is the only D1 team this season with 59+ homers and 64+ steals this year.
- PSU, Dayton, Florida and Georgia are the only teams in D1 with five or more players with 5+ homers and 5+ steals this year.
- Penn State's 81 steals are nine more than any other Big Ten team this season.
- Ryan Weingartner's 23 steals in 2025 are sixth most in a season at PSU.
- He ranks 19th in the nation in total steals and 25th in steals per game (0.66).
- PSU is one of 13 D1 teams with seven players owning 5+ homers this season and also has eight players owning 4+ steals.
- Penn State is 20th in the nation in total homers (58).

PSU'S STRONG START

- With a 21-10 start, Penn State got off to its best 31-game start since going 23-8 to begin the 2000 season.
- Penn State started Big Ten play with series victories in each of its first two series for the first time since 2014.
- With its sweep over Minnesota, the Nittany Lions have won two Big Ten road series (at Northwestern, at Minnesota) in a season for the first time since 2012 (at lowa, at Minnesota, at Michigan State)
- PSU also has earned two road series sweeps (at Longwood, at Minnesota) in a season for the first time since 2000 (at Norfolk State, at lowa).
- The Nittany Lions have tallied 10+ runs in 18 games this season, tied for eighth in the country, and eight times in Big Ten games. PSU has 18 games of 10+ runs in a season for just the fifth time in program history (2000).
- With its win in game one against Indiana on March 7, the Nittany Lions had a nine-game win streak for the first time since 2000.

USC SERIES RECAP

- Penn State collected a 3-1 win over USC on Friday in the series opener, but fell 6-3 on Saturday and 11-6 on Sunday.
- PSU improved to 8-1 in weekend/series openers this season.
- On Friday, Ryan DeSanto fired seven innings and allowed one run, while striking out seven. He retired 14-straight between the third and seventh innings.
- DeSanto has allowed one or less run in three of his six starts against Big Ten opponents.
- **Dimond Loosli** picked up the win with two shutout innings.
- Paxton Kling launched a game-tying homer in the seventh and added a sac fly.
- In the series, Kling added a triple on Saturday, while Ryan Weingartner blasted a grand slam on Sunday.

NITTANY LIONS AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS IN HOMERS, STEALS

- Through 35 games, Penn State has slugged 59 home runs, on pace to break its team season record of 91 in 2000.
- The Nittany Lions rank 16th in the country, averaging 1.69 homers per game.
- $\bullet \;\;$ Penn State also ranks 20th in the nation in total home runs.
- Paxton Kling leads the Nittany Lions with 12 homers, while sitting 40th in the country in total homers (6th in Big Ten) and 47th in home runs per game (0.34;5th).
- Kling is among nine Nittany Lions with at least one home run this season and is one of eight with 4+ homers.
- Bryce Molinaro owns nine homers, Jesse Jaconski and Ryan Weingartner have eight, Jack Porter and Nate Voss have six, while Joe Jaconski has five homers. Cole Wagner has four.
- Molinaro has three multi-homer games this season, tied for fourth in D1
- With 59 home runs and 81 steals this season, PSU is the only D1 team with 58+ homers and 64+ steals this season.
- PSU is one of 13 D1 teams (Arkansas, Austin Peay, Dayton, Florida State, Georgia, Georgia State, High Point, Kansas, Nevada, Ole Miss, Southeastern Louisiana, Tennessee) with seven players owning 5+ homers.
- PSU, Dayton, Florida and Georgia are the only teams in the country with five or more players with 5+ homers and 5+ steals.
- Penn State has launched six grand slams, including two by Kling, one by Jesse Jaconski, one by Molinaro, one by Voss and one by Weingartner.
- $\,$ PSU is tied-fifth in the country with six grand slams this year.
- The Nittany Lions are also 24th in the country in stolen bases per game (2.31), pacing the Big Ten, and 29th in total steals (81).

- Penn State has nine more steals than any other Big Ten team this season and is approaching its team record of 91 steals in 2000
- PSU has eight players owning 4+ steals.
- Weingartner leads the Big Ten in total steals (23), sitting 19th in the country, and steals per game (0.66), holding 25th.
- Weingartner's 23 steals are sixth in a season at PSU.
- Wagner has 11 steals and Kling has 10.
- Penn State has three players with 10+ steals in a season for the first time since 2015 (Greg Guers, 14; Jim Haley, 11; Taylor Skerpon, 11).

HAGENMAN MAKES MLB DEBUT

- Former Nittany Lion Justin Hagenman made his Major League baseball debut for the New York Mets on Wednesday, April 16.
- After entering the game in the second inning, against the Minnesota Twins, Hagenmen went 3.1 innings. He was charged with one run on three hits, while striking out four.
- Hagenman notched two strikeouts in the first inning, including a punch out against the first batter he faced, the Twins' Ryan leffers
- He is the 24th Penn State player to appear in a MLB game and the first since Nate Bump in 2005.
- After being selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 23rd round of the 2018 MLB Draft, Hagenman's professional baseball journey includes stops with the Ogden Raptors (2018), Great Lakes Loons (2018-19), Tulsa Drillers (2021-22), Oklahoma City Dodgers (2022-23), Worchester Red Sox (2023-24) and Syracuse Mets (2025).
- Hagenman was traded from the Dodgers to the Boston Red Sox in July 2023 and signed with the Mets in November 2024.
- In his minor league career, Hagenman is 32-16 with 22 saves and a 3.95 ERA in 203 appearances (27 starts) and 433 strikeouts in 419.1 innings.
- He was a three-year starter at Penn State from 2016-18, posting a 4.64 ERA, 10 wins and 190 strikeouts. He is fourth all-time at PSU with 42 career starts.

SWEEP IN MINNESOTA

- Penn State picked up a Big Ten road sweep over Minnesota.
- The Nittany Lions earned a 10-4 win on Friday, a 5-2 victory on Saturday and a 15-10 win on Sunday.
- Bryce Molinaro and Nate Voss each had two homers, while Voss drove in six runs.
- Jesse Jaconski collected six hits, including two doubles and one homer, while Cole Wagner tallied six hits with a triple and a homer and five RBI.
- On Friday, Ryan DeSanto fired six strong innings, allowing one run and striking out four.
- Wagner contributed a two-run triple and two-run homer, while Jaconski added three hits, including a solo homer.
- On Saturday, Mason Horwat tossed a career-high 6.1 innings, giving up two runs and recording four strikeouts.
- Voss had a solo homer in the fourth and a go-ahead three-run double in the ninth.

CATCHERS NOTES


- The Nittany Lions boast three catchers with plenty of college baseball experience and strong defensive numbers.
- Senior Matt Maloney has made 59 starts in 64 appearances in his first two seasons at Penn State.
- In his collegiate career, Maloney has played in 155 games with 131 starts. He has a .288 average with 139 hits, 27 doubles, one triple, six homers, 80 RBI, 83 runs and 10 steals. He also has 42 walks and 25 hit-by-pitches.
- · He has a .425 slugging percentage at PSU.
- He has recorded 37 multi-hit games and 17 multi-RBI games in his collegiate career.
- In 2025, Maloney has 15 hits, with four doubles and a homer, 13 RBI and 11 runs.
- He had three-multi hit games in Virginia with two hits vs. Richmond, three vs. VCU and three vs. William & Mary, while scoring four runs and driving in four.
- Maloney drove in two runs with a double and scored twice at Georgetown.
- He had three hits, including a double, in the Northwestern series.
- On defense, Maloney has notched 24 assists and caught nine runners stealing at PSU.
- Junior Nate Voss joins the Nittany Lions after playing the 2024 season at lowa Western C.C. and the 2023 season at Michigan.
- He has started 16 games at catcher and two as DH in 2025.
- This season, he has two doubles, one triple, six homers and 20 RBI.





Mike Gambino was hired on July 3, 2023 as the 15th head coach in Penn State baseball program history. Gambino took over the Penn State Baseball program after 13 years at the helm of his alma mater Boston College.

In 2024, Penn State went 29-24 overall and 12-12 in Big Ten play. The 29 wins are Penn State's most under a first-year head coach.

Penn State posted its first winning record in the regular season since 2016 (28-27) and maintained a .500 or better mark from the entire season for the first time since 2011 (32-22). The Blue and White notched its best record in Big Ten play since going 12-12 in 2016.

The Nittany Lions finished with a Top-100 RPI for the first time since 2007.

Penn State reached the Big Ten Tournament Championship Game for the first time since 2000 and won three-straight games to open the Big Ten Tournament for the first time in program history. Gambino was the first Big Ten baseball coach to lead his team to a Big Ten Championship Game in year one since Minnesota's John Anderson in 1982.

The Nittany Lions' tremendous Big Ten Tournament run, as the eighth seed, included wins over Illinois (8-4) and Michigan (9-5 and 7-6) before falling to No. 2 seed Nebraska, 2-1, in the championship game.

In the regular season, Penn State earned Big Ten sweeps over Maryland and Northwestern, a series win over Rutgers and victories against Michigan, Indiana, Michigan State and Minnesota. PSU was 6-2 in Big Ten series openers.

Non-conference play included series wins over Stanford, Davidson, Harvard and UMass Lowell, while also earning two wins over Army and one over Monmouth on opening weekend and a win over Georgetown. Midweek wins included Pitt and FDU.

Penn State had three of its five largest home crowds in 2024. The Nittany Lions set a program record with 5,025 fans against Kent State (4/16). PSU also had 4,902 fans against FDU (4/9) and 3,505 against Pitt (3/26). Penn State finished second in the Big Ten in average attendance (1,615).

Adam Cecere (first team), J.T. Marr (first team) and Travis Luensmann (second team) were tabbed American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) All-Region East Team. Penn State had three ABCA All-Region selections for the first time since 1973. The three selections were tied with Maryland for most in the Big Ten.

Cecere (second team) and Marr (second team), Bryce Molinaro (third team) and Mason Horwat (freshman team) earned All-Big Ten honors.

As a team, Penn State finished among the Top Five in the Big Ten in batting average (.306; 2nd), slugging percentage (.491; 2nd), sac flies (32; 2nd), double plays (46; 3rd), double plays per game (0.87; 3rd), doubles per game (2.08; 4th), home runs per game (1.34; 5th) and runs per game (7.6; 5th).

The Nittany Lions had seven players with 52+ hits and eight with 40+ hits, seven players with 37+ RBI, five with a .409+ on-base percentage and eight with a .425+ slugging percentage.

Penn State, Illinois and Indiana were the only Big Ten teams with seven players owning 37+ RBI and PSU was one of two Big Ten teams with seven players owning 52+ hits.

The Nittany Lions launched 71 homers, its most since hitting 91 in 1998. PSU's 46 homers in Big Ten games were tied for most in the conference with Illinois

Cecere (17), Grant Norris (14) and Molinaro (11) became Penn State's first trio with 11+ homers in a season since 1999 (Shawn Fagan, 13; Dan Beers, 13; Chris Netwall, 12).

Marr posted incredible numbers, batting .416 with 92 hits (17 doubles, six homers), 54 RBI and 50 runs. His batting average never dipped below .408 in the entire 2024 season. Marr's 92 hits are tied-second in a season at Penn State, while he ranks seventh in total bases (127), eighth in at-bats (221), doubles (17) and RBI (54).

Marr ranked second in the Big Ten in hits per game (1.74; 2nd nationally), batting average (.416; 5th), hits per game (92; 22nd), eighth in on-base percentage (.464) and 11th in OPS (1.039).

Cecere paced the Big Ten in slugging percentage (.676) and OPS (1.140), while holding second in walks per game (0.89; 49th nationally), third in home runs (17), home runs per game (0.32) and walks (47), fourth in onbase percentage (.474) and sixth in sac flies (5).

Cecere's 47 walks are tied for a PSU season record and his 17 homers are tied-second in a season at Penn State. He also ranks sixth in a season in slugging percentage (.676), seventh in hit-by-pitches (10), eighth in total bases (125) and ninth in RBI (53).

Joe Jaconski ranked fifth in the Big Ten in walks (43) and Norris ranked ninth in homers (14). Norris' 14 homers are sixth in a season at PSU, while Jaconski's 43 walks are fourth.

On the mound, Luensmann ranked fifth in the Big Ten in hits allowed per nine innings (6.67; 34th nationally) and sixth in wins (7), while Jaden Henline sat second in walks per nine innings (1.99) and Anthony Steele was third in appearances (26).

In 13 seasons leading the Eagles, Gambino ranks second in program history in wins (291) while guiding Boston College to a pair of NCAA Regional appearances in 2016 and 2023 and an NCAA Super Regional appearance in 2016. He had five seasons of 25 or more wins and eight seasons with 10 or more ACC wins. BC also appeared in the ACC Championship Tournament four times under Gambino's tutelage, including berths in three of four years for the first time since Boston College joined the ACC in 2006.

Gambino has a long history of developing Major League Baseball talent with 34 draft picks in his 13 years at BC. He had three first round picks and eight picks in the first five rounds of the MLB Draft in his BC tenure. Four former Boston College players appeared in MLB games in 2023: outfielder Jake Alu (Washington Nationals), outfielder Sal Frelick (Milwaukee Brewers), pitcher Michael King (New York Yankees) and pitcher Emmet Sheehan (Los Angeles Dodgers). Five of Gambino's former BC players have reached the major leagues.

He coached five All-American selections and five Freshman All-Americans at Boston College. Gambino guided 16 All-ACC selections, including 2021 ACC Player of the Year Sal Frelick.

In his time at Boston College, Gambino put together five recruiting classes ranked among the nation's Top 60 by Perfect Game.

In 2023, Gambino guided the Eagles to a 37-20 overall record and 16-14 mark in ACC play. The 37 overall wins tie the program record set by the 2005 squad and the 16 ACC victories are also a highwater mark for the program topping the 14 victories by the 2010 team. Boston College logged 12 ranked wins, including a thrilling 7-6 victory over No. 2 Tennessee in 10 innings, on the way to playing in the Tuscaloosa Regional and reaching the regional final. The Eagles were ranked for 12 weeks in the DIBaseball Poll, reaching as high as ninth. Three of Gambino's players earned All-ACC accolades, including Chris Flynn claiming second-team All-ACC as a starting pitcher.

Gambino also spent two years as a regional scout for the Detroit Tigers and was an assistant coach at Boston College from 2003-05.

Gambino played for the Eagles from 1997-2000, starting 166 games in the middle infield. He posted a career batting average of .313 with 22 doubles, eight home runs, 87 RBIs and 117 runs. His 78 hits in 2000 were a program record that stood until 2011. Gambino's 52 runs his final year are in the top 10 in BC history.

The Garrison, New York native was a first-team All-Big East, All-New England and All-Northeast region honoree following his senior campaign. He also earned second-team All-New England and Big East Academic Team accolades during his playing career.

Gambino played two seasons in the Boston Red Sox minor league system. He spent the 2000 season with the Augusta Green Jackets before splitting the 2001 season between Augusta and the Lowell Spinners. In 2002, the Red Sox hired Gambino as a special assistant to the Major League staff before heading back to Lowell for a coaching role with the Spinners just prior to the June draft. Following his stint in Lowell, the Red Sox sent Gambino to the MLB Scout Development Program.

Gambino received his bachelor's degree from Boston College in English and theology. He and his wife, Jill, have two children, Sonny and Callahan.
