OPENING NOTES

- Penn State welcomes No. 4 Kentucky for its 2025 home opener at Rec Hall on Friday. The match will air live on FOX with Michelle McMahon on play-by-play and Emily Ehman on color commentary.
- The Nittany Lions are 46-3 all-time in home openers. They are 3-0 under head coach Katie Schumacher-Cawley with wins over UConn (3-0), Western Kentucky (3-1), and Louisville (3-0).
- Penn State will play a nationally-ranked opponent in its home opener for the third-straight season, but just the sixth time in program history. The Nittany Lions lost to No. 12 UC Santa Barbara in 1986 and posted wins over No. 4 Texas in 2007, No. 9, Stanford in 2012, No. 22 Western Kentucky in 2023, and No. 4 Louisville in 2024.
- The Nittany Lions have won 13 straight home openers, with the last loss coming to Oregon in 2011.

FIVE STRAIGHT RANKED OPPONENTS

- •Penn State will play its fifth-consecutive nationally-ranked opponent to open the season, adding No. 4 Kentucky to a list that includes No. 12 Creighton, No. 14 Kansas, No. 13 Arizona State, and No. 24 TCU.
- It is the first time the Nittany Lions open a season with five ranked opponents since 2007 when they played No. 4 Texas, No. 4 Texas again, No. 18 Cal Poly, No. 1 Nebraska, and No. 24 St. John's. That team started 4-1 and went on to win the national title.

SERIES HISTORY - KENTUCKY

- Penn State and Kentucky will play for the ninth time in program history. The Nittany Lions lead the all-time series 7-1.
- The teams played for the first time in 12 years last season. The Nittany Lions pulled off a 3-2 reverse sweep on the road. Izzy Starck recorded a double-double with 47 assists and 17 digs. Gillian Grimes tallied 14 digs, Ava Falduto had 12 digs and three aces, and Maggie Mendelson contributed eight blocks and six kills.
- Penn State and Kentucky will meet at Rec Hall for just the third time. The Nittany Lions won the previous two matchups in 1984 and 1986.

SCOUTING KENTUCKY

- Kentucky is ranked fourth in the nation and is 1-1 overall following a 3-0 win over Lipscomb and a 3-2 loss to No. 1 Nebraska in which it led 2-0.
- •The Wildcats are the two-time defending champions in the SEC. They were picked first in the 2025 SEC Preseason Coaches Poll. Four Wildcats redshirt sophomore middle blocker Brooke Bultema, junior outside hitter Brooklyn DeLeye, senior outside hitter Eva Hudson, and junior libero Molly Tuozzo were selected to the Preseason All-SEC Team.
- Brooklyn DeLeye was an AVCA Player of the Year finalist and a first-team All-American last season. Hudson was a second-team All-American last season at Purdue.

PENN STATE VS. SEC

- Penn State is 63-21 all-time against current members of the SEC.
- The Nittany Lions have played 14 of the 16 teams in the conference and have a winning record against 13 of those teams.
- Penn State is unbeaten against eight of the teams in the SEC, going a combined 19-0 against Alabama, Arkansas, Auburn, Mississippi State, Missouri, Oklahoma, South Carolina, and Texas A&M.

PENN STATE ADDS TWO GATORADE PLAYER OF THE YEAR RECIPIENTS

- With the additions of junior transfer **Kennedy Martin** and sophomore transfer **Emmi Sellman**, Penn State adds two high school Gatorade Player of the Year players to its all-time roster. Martin received the honor in South Carolina in 2022. Sellman earned the award in Maryland in both 2022 and 2023.
- Fifty Penn State players have been named Gatorade Player of the Year in 21 different states.
- Izzy Starck was the Gatorade Player of the Year in Colorado in 2022 and in Florida in 2023.

JUREVICIUS FAMILIAR NAME AT PENN STATE

- Redshirt Sophomore **Caroline Jurevicius** and freshman defensive specialist **Ava Jurevicius** are the daughters of former Penn State football great Joe Jurevicius, a wide receiver from 1994-97. He finished his career with 1894 yards and 15 touchdowns on 94 catches during an era the Nittany Lions went 41-8 in a four-year span.
- Joe Jurevicius went on to an 11-year NFL career, which included a Super Bowl win with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers in 2003. He had four catches for 78 yards in the win.

PRO DADS

- The Jurevicius sisters aren't the only current Penn State women's volleyball player with a dad that played in one of the USA's big four pro sports.
- Patrick Ewing, the father of freshman **Alexis Ewing**, played 17 seasons in the NBA and was an 11-time All-Star. He played 15 seasons for the New York Knicks, one for the Seattle SuperSonics, and one for the Orlando Magic,
- Ruvell Martin, the father of junior **Kennedy Martin**, played seven seasons as a wide receiver in the NFL. He played three seasons for the Green Bay Packers, one for the St. Louis Rams, one for the Seattle Seahawks, and two for the Buffalo Bills.
- Demetris Nichols, the father of middle blocker **Gabrielle Nichols**, played two seasons in the NBA, suiting up for the Cleveland Cavaliers, Chicago Bulls, and New York Knicks. He was a second-round draft pick by the Portland Trail Blazers in the 2007 NBA Draft.

3 COACHES, 50 SEASONS

- Head Coach **Katie Schumacher-Cawley** is just the third head coach and the first woman head coach in the history of Penn State women's volleyball.
- Tom Tait was the first head coach in program history and held the position from 1976-78. Russ Rose was the second, coaching for 43 seasons from 1979-2021.
- Schumacher-Cawley who played for Rose, was a two-time All-American and helped Penn State win its first national title in 1999.
- Schumacher-Cawley is in her 13th season as a head coach. She spent eight seasons at UIC and one year at Penn before returning to Happy Valley as an assistant coach in 2018. She took over as head coach in January of 2022.
