Penn State is off to a 5-1 start to the season. The Nittany Lions began the year 5-0 before dropping their first game of the season Saturday afternoon against Providence, 65-77. Saturday's game was a one-point contest with under four minutes to play, but the Friars pulled away down the stretch.

Penn State is averaging 79.2 points per game while shooting 49.0 percent from the field and 36.0 percent from 3-point range.

HOME SWEET HAPPY VALLEY

Penn State has won 12-straight non-conference homes games played inside the Bryce Jordan Center. The Nittany Lions are 16-1 in non-conference home games under the direction of third-year head coach Mike Rhoades.

DISCIPLINED

Penn State's young squad has shown tremendous discipline as the Nittany Lions rank top 10 in the country in fewest turnovers per game (7.8 - 6th) and fewest fouls per game (13.2 - 7th) through games on Nov. 22.

DEPTH ON DISPLAY

The Nittany Lions have showcased their depth through the first six games of the season, as Penn State's 35.5 bench points per game ranks second in the Big Ten and is a top-50 mark in the nation.

The Penn State bench has outscored the opponent bench by an eye-popping total of 213-69 through six games this season.

DYNAMIC ROOKIE DUO

Penn State is one of just three schools in Division I to have two freshmen both averaging 13 or more points per game through games on Nov. 22.

The Nittany Lion rookies have combined to shoot 54.1 percent (98-181) from the field through the first six games of the season.

BURSTING ONTO THE SCENE

Rookie Kayden Mingo is the third highest-scoring freshman in the Big Ten and he leads the Nittany Lions in points (14.5 ppg), rebounds (4.3 rpg) and assists (4.2 apg) through the first six games of the season. He put together a career-best 24-point performance in Penn State's win over Harvard on Nov. 19.

Mingo, the highest-ranked recruit in program history, was named an ESPN Top 50 Impact Newcomer in late October. He was ranked as the No. 34 recruit nationally per 247Sports & No. 39 recruit nationally per ESPN out of high school. He was named the 2025 New York Gatorade Player of the Year following standout senior season at Long Island Lutheran.

STEADY FREDDIE

Redshirt junior Freddie Dillione V, Penn State's only returning starter from a season ago, has been a consistent presence for the Nittany Lions thus far this season.

Dillione is averaging 14.0 points, 4.2 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game with just four total turnovers in 162 minutes of playing time.

He has scored in double figures in each of the last five games, including a career-best 22 points and nine rebounds in Penn State's most recent game against Providence Saturday.

OH MY MELIH

Istanbul, Turkey native Melih Tunca has been on fire to start the season, scoring in double figures in all six of Penn State's game while shooting 57.7 percent (30-52) from the field and 46.7 percent (7-15) from 3-point range.

Tunca ranks third on the squad in points (13.8 ppg) and second in both assists (3.7 apg) and steals (1.3 spg).

NEW-LOOK NITTANY LIONS

The new-look Nittany Lions feature 10 new players this season.

Penn State returns just 14.6 percent of points, 11.0 percent of rebounds, 12.5 percent of assists and 15.5 percent of minutes played from last season in its three returners - Freddie Dillone V, Eli Rice and Dominick Stewart.

The Nittany Lion roster is the 10th-most inexperienced roster in Division I per Bart Torvik's experience metric. The Penn State roster features one senior, two juniors, two sophomores and eight freshmen.

TALENTED YOUTH

Penn State's eight-man freshman class is comprised of both talent and experience as the group is a combination of a top-30 recruiting class and international players that come to Happy Valley for their first years of NCAA eligibility after playing professionally overseas.

Freshman guard Kayden Mingo headlines the class as Mingo came to Penn State as a consensus top-40 prospect and the highest-ranked recruit in program history. Fellow rookies Mason Blackwood, Justin Houser, Ivan Jurić and Reggie Grodin were all recruited directly out of high school and comprise Penn State's highly-ranked class.

Tibor Mirtič and Melih Tunca join the freshmen group for their first seasons of NCAA eligibility after playing professionally overseas in their respective home countries of Slovenia and Turkey. Mirtič played the 2024-25 season for Krka Novo Mesto in Slovenia's top professional league, while Tunca was with Turk Telekom in the Turkish Basketball Super League, the top professional league in Turkey. Both players also own years of FIBA Euro Championship experience.

BACK IN BLUE & WHITE

Freddie Dillone V is Penn State's only returning starter from the 2024-25 campaign. Dillone V started 28 of 31 games a season ago, averaging 9.4 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.7 assists per game in an average of 24.6 minutes per contest.

Dominick Stewart returns for his sophomore season following a highly-productive offseason. Stewart is expected to play a larger role this year following a freshman campaign that saw him appear in 24 games.

Eli Rice enters his second season in the Blue & White fully healthy following a redshirt year due to a season-long injury. Rice played his freshman year at Nebraska before coming to Penn State ahead of the 2024-25 season.

EXPERIENCED TRANSFERS

Josh Reed and Saša Ciani transferred in to Penn State during the spring and bring valuable college basketball experience to the roster.

Reed saw action in 97 games through first three collegiate seasons at Cincinnati as one of the Bearcats' top defenders and key role players.

Ciani played his first two collegiate seasons at UIC (2024-25) and Xavier (2023-24), seeing action in 58 games while making 26 starts. He is coming off a 2024-25 season at UIC in which he averaged 9.9 points and a team-best 7.6 rebounds per game while shooting 53.3 percent from the field. Ciani played professionally in his native country of Slovenia prior to his NCAA career.

THE OPPOSITION

SCOUTING BOSTON UNIVERSITY

- The Terriers are 3-3 on the young season and coming off a thrilling 75-74 win over Harvard Saturday afternoon at Mohegan Sun Arena. Freshman Chance Gladden drove to the hoop for the game-winning bucket with four seconds remaining to help the Terriers claim their second one-point win of the season.
- BU also owns victories at Northeastern (76-75 OT) and against Brown (90-77) this season, while the Terriers' three losses have come against Northwestern (52-76), Merrimack (79-91) and Columbia (49-54).
- Ben Defty leads the Terriers with 13.8 points and 6.7 rebounds per game.
- Three other BU players are averaging double-digit points in Michael McNair (13.0 ppg), Chance Gladden (12.3 ppg) and Sam Hughes (11.0 ppg).

AGAINST THE TERRIERS

- Penn State and Boston University meet for the fourth time in program history Tuesday and for the first time since 1984.
- The two teams played a home-and-home series in 1983 and 1984, with BU winning both contests.
- Penn State won the first-ever meeting between the two squads, 84-67, in 1956.

YEAR THREE

The Nittany Lions enter their third season under Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Mike Rhoades in 2025-26. Rhoades has laid a strong foundation during his first two seasons and welcomes back key returnees, a top-30 recruiting class and experienced international players for the 2025-26 season.

Rhoades orchestrated the highest-scoring offense in Penn State history in 2024-25 as the Nittany Lions set a single-season program record with 79.1 points per game during his second season at the helm. He and his staff engineered the identification and development of Penn State's first-ever first-round NBA Draft pick in Yanic Konan Niederhauser, who was selected with the 30th overall pick of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers.

HIGH OCTANE

Penn State's offense has thrilled under head coach Mike Rhoades as the Nittany Lions have averaged 77.1 points per game through Rhoades' two completed seasons in Happy Valley. Rhoades orchestrated the highest-scoring offense in Penn State history in 2024-25 as the Nittany Lions set a single-season program record with 79.1 points per game during his second season at the helm. He engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 as the Nittany Lions averaged 75.1 points per game in his debut season (2023-24).

CAPTAINS

Penn State has named four team captains ahead of the 2025-26 season. The four captains were elected by both the players and the staff:

- Junior forward Saša Ciani
- Freshman guard Kayden Mingo
- Senior forward Josh Reed
- Redshirt sophomore guard Eli Rice

FIRST-ROUND DRAFT PICK

Mike Rhoades and his staff were responsible for identifying, recruiting and developing Penn State's first-ever first-round NBA Draft pick in Yanic Konan Niederhauser as the big man was selected with the 30th overall pick of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers in June 2025. Konan Niederhauser led the Big Ten with 2.3 blocks per game during his one season in the Blue & White in 2024-25 and saw a +7.8 points per game and +3.1 rebounds per game increase from his collegiate career averages prior to his time at Penn State.

Konan Niederhauser was the first Nittany Lion to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft in Penn State history. He was the highest-drafted Nittany Lion in the modern era of the draft and the 16th overall NBA Draft pick from Penn State. Current Denver Nugget Jalen Pickett (2nd round, pick 32, Denver) was the previous highest pick from Penn State in modern Draft history. Konan Niederhauser became the third Penn State player drafted in the last three years, joining Jalen Pickett (2023 to Denver) and Seth Lundy (2023 to Atlanta).

OUR STATE

Penn State's schedule is set up to take the Nittany Lions all over the state of Pennsylvania. Penn State will travel to Xfinity Mobile Arena in Philadelphia, the home of the 76ers, on Nov. 15 to face in-state foe La Salle. The Nittany Lions will meet Pittsburgh in a non-conference battle inside the GIANT Center in Hershey on Dec. 21. Penn State also makes its return to the historic Palestra in Philadelphia on Jan. 3 when Penn State hosts Illinois in a Big Ten battle inside the Cathedral of College Basketball.

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH MIKE RHOADES

Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Men's Basketball Head Coach Mike Rhoades enters his third season as the leader of the Nittany Lions in 2025-26. Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Dr. Patrick Kraft announced the hiring of Rhoades as the 15th head coach in program history on March 29, 2023. In 21 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rhoades, a Mahanoy City, Pennsylvania native, has produced a 405-221 record, a winning percentage of .647, seven NCAA Tournament appearances and nine national postseason appearances.

Rhoades orchestrated the highest-scoring offense in Penn State history in 2024-25 as the Nittany Lions set a single-season program record with 79.1 points per game during his second season at the helm. Penn State earned two wins over top-15 ranked teams in 2024-25, including a Big Ten-opening win over #8 Purdue which marked Penn State's first win over a team ranked in the top 10 of the AP Poll since Dec. 2019. The Nittany Lions earned their first road win at Wisconsin in over 30 years and took down the 12th-ranked Badgers for Penn State's highest-ranked road win since 2009 in the regular-season finale. Rhoades earned his 400th career head coaching win on Dec. 29, 2024 with a victory over Penn.

Rhoades and his staff were responsible for identifying, recruiting and developing Penn State's first-ever first-round NBA Draft pick in Yanic Konan Niederhauser as the big man was selected with the 30th overall pick of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers in June 2025. Konan Niederhauser led the Big Ten with 2.3 blocks per game during his one season in the Blue & White in 2024-25 and saw a +7.8 points per game and +31 rebounds per game increase from his collegiate career averages prior to his time at Penn State.

The 2024-25 Nittany Lions started the season 6-0 for the first time in 25 years and started the season 8-1 for the first time in 10 years under Rhoades' tutelage. Penn State scored 100+ points in three games in the same season for just the second time in program history and finished the season ranking second in the Big Ten in steals and third in turnovers forced per game. Rhoades guided point guard Ace Baldwin Jr. to his second-straight Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honor, as Baldwin Jr. became the first-ever Penn State player to earn the award in back-to-back years.

Rhoades signed the highest-ranked recruiting class and highest-ranked recruit in program history in Kayden Mingo during the November 2024 signing period. Mingo, a consensus top-40 recruit nationally, headlines the Class of 2029 that ranks in the top 30 nationally.

Rhoades laid a strong foundation during his first season at Penn State in 2023-24. Rhoades led the Nittany Lions to a 16-17 overall record and 9-11 mark in conference play, marking the second-most Big Ten wins by a first-year head coach in program history. The Nittany Lions defeated a pair of top-15 ranked teams in #12 Illinois and #11 Wisconsin, with the win over the 11th-ranked Badgers marking the highest-ranked win under a first-year head coach in program history.

Rhoades engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 as the Nittany Lions averaged 75.1 points per game in his debut season. Penn State's 75.2 points per game in regular-season Big Ten play was the second-highest in Penn State's 32 seasons in the Big Ten, behind only the 2000-01 Nittany Lions team's 75.4 points per Big Ten game. Defensively, Penn State led the Big Ten in steals per game (8.3), turnover margin (+3.6) and three-point percentage defense (30.3%) in 2023-24.

Rhoades came to Penn State following a six-year stint as the head coach at VCU in which he guided the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances, a 129-60 overall record and 72-32 Atlantic 10 Conference record. He is the fourth-winningest coach in VCU history. Rhoades developed a pair of Atlantic 10 Players of the Year and 13 all-conference selections throughout his six years in Richmond. On the recruiting trail, Rhoades signed the Atlantic 10's top-ranked recruiting class in three of his last four years at VCU. In his time as an assistant and head coach at VCU, he was responsible for signing eight of the top nine all-time Ram recruits per 247Sports.

Under Rhoades tutelage, VCU saw players selected in back-to-back NBA Drafts, when Nah'Shon "Bones" Hyland was selected 26th overall by the Denver Nuggets in 2021, and Vince Williams Jr. was picked 47th overall by the Memphis Grizzlies in 2022. Justin Tillman also spent time with the Atlanta Hawks active roster during the 2021-22 season. Additionally, former VCU players Larry Sanders, Troy Daniels, Briante Weber and Treveon Graham, who each played for Rhoades during his days as an assistant coach at VCU from 2009-14, all spent time in the NBA. Mo Alie-Cox played basketball for Rhoades at VCU and has gone on to be a tight end for the NFL's Indianapolis Colts.

Prior to his six years in the head chair at VCU, Rhoades engineered a stunning turnaround at Rice as head coach of the Owls from 2014-17. Rhoades led Rice to its first 20-win campaign since 2003-04 and the program's first postseason appearance since 2011-12. Rice's 23-12 mark in 2016-17 was an 11-win improvement over the 2015-16 season and the 23 wins were the second-most in Owls' history. The Owls were a combined 12-49 in the two seasons prior to his arrival.

Rhoades spent 2009-14 as an assistant coach and associate head coach at VCU prior to taking the head coaching job at Rice. VCU reached the NCAA Tournament four times and appeared in the postseason all five years of that stretch. The Rams were 137-46 during that period and won the 2012 CAA Championship. He was integral in recruiting and developing the players that would lead the Rams to a historic Final Four appearance in 2010-11. In 2012, after VCU toppled Wichita State in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament, Rhoades was named one of the top 10 assistant coaches under 40 in the country by ESPN.com.

Prior to his VCU tenure, Rhoades enjoyed a wildly successful run at Division III Randolph-Macon in Ashland, Virginia. In 10 seasons as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, Rhoades compiled a 197-76 record (.722 win percentage) and led RMC to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including trips to the Sweet 16 in 2002 and 2003. Rhoades' teams won six Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) championships and earned national No. 1 rankings in two seasons.

Rhoades played collegiately under coaches Pat Flannery and Brad McAlester at Lebanon Valley College in his home state of Pennsylvania. Rhoades guided the Flying Dutchmen to the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship with a 66-59 overtime win over NYU. He was named the tournament's Co-Outstanding Player. The guard was the USA Today Division III National Player of the Year in 1995, two-time NABC All-American, three-time NABC All-Region and three-time Middle Atlantic Conference Player of the Year. He was the school's all-time scoring leader (2,050) until 1999, but still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey is one of five basketball jerseys retired by LVC.

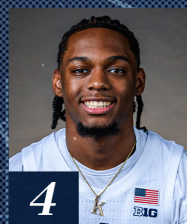

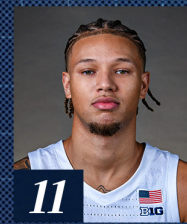

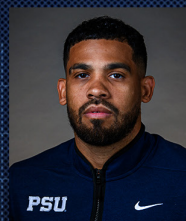
