OPENING TIPS

- The Nittany Lions tip off Big Ten play with a trip to Assembly Hall to face Indiana Tuesday night.
- Penn State is off to an 8-1 start to the season for the second-straight year. It's the first time the Nittany Lions have started 8-1 or better in back-to-back seasons since 1994-95 and 1995-96.
- Guard Kayden Mingo is the only freshman in the country averaging 15+ ppg, 4+ apg, 4+ rpg and 2+ spg.
- Mingo (15.0 ppg) leads five Nittany Lions averaging double-figure points. Freddie Dillione V (13.2 ppg), Melih Tunca (12.8 ppg), Josh Reed (10.6 ppg) and Ivan Jurić (10.6 ppg) follow.

IF PENN STATE BEATS INDIANA

- Penn State's 9-1 start to the season would be its best since the 2014-15 team started 12-1.
- The Nittany Lions would earn a road win in Bloomington for just the fifth time in program history.
- Penn State would win its Big Ten opener for the second-straight year.

BIG TIME

Big Ten play begins Tuesday night for the Nittany Lions as Penn State travels to take on Indiana at Assembly Hall.

Penn State is 8-25 all-time in Big Ten Conference openers. The Nittany Lions took down #8 Purdue, 81-70, in last season's conference opener in Happy Valley.

The Nittany Lions open Big Ten play on the road for the 12th time in the last 17 years. The last time the Nittany Lions won their conference opener on the road was Dec. 2, 2017, when Penn State traveled to Iowa and earned a 77-73 win.

Penn State is off to an 8-1 start to the season for the second-straight year, marking the first time since 1994-95 & 1995-96 that the Nittany Lions have started back-to-back seasons 8-1 or better.

The Nittany Lions began the year 5-0 before dropping their first game of the season on Nov. 22 against Providence, 65-77. Penn State has since bounced back with its three highest-scoring games of the season, putting up back-to-back 90-plus point efforts in wins over Sacred Heart (90-59) and Boston University (96-87) and following with an 87-76 victory over Campbell.

DISCIPLINED

Penn State's young squad has shown tremendous discipline as the Nittany Lions lead the country in fewest turnovers per game (8.2). The Nittany Lions committed just three turnovers on Nov. 25 vs. Boston University, the fewest turnovers Penn State has surrendered in a game since Dec. 22, 2022.

Penn State's young team also ranks sixth in the country in fewest fouls per game (13.4).

HEATING UP

Since suffering its first loss of the season on Nov. 22, the Penn State offense has heated up over the last three games. The Nittany Lions scored 90-plus in back-to-back games vs. Boston University and Sacred Heart, marking the first time that Penn State scored 90-plus in back-to-back games since opening the 2024-25 season with three-straight 90-plus point efforts.

DEPTH ON DISPLAY

The Nittany Lions have showcased their depth through the first nine games of the season, as Penn State's 33.0 bench points per game ranks second in the Big Ten and is a top-50 mark in the nation.

The Penn State bench has outscored the opponent bench by an eye-popping total of 297-144 through nine games this season.

ONE OF ONE

Rookie guard Kayden Mingo is the ONLY freshman in the country averaging 15+ points (15.0 ppg), 4+ assists (4.2 apg), 4+ rebounds (4.0 rpg) and 2+ steals (2.1 spg) per game through games on Dec. 6.

DYNAMIC ROOKIE DUO

Penn State is one of just four schools in Division I to have two freshmen both averaging 12.5 or more points per game through games on Dec. 6.

The Nittany Lion rookies have combined to shoot 55.7 percent (147-264) from the field through the first nine games of the season.

BURSTING ONTO THE SCENE

Rookie Kayden Mingo is the highest scoring freshman in the Big Ten and he leads the Nittany Lions in points (15.0 ppg), assists (4.2 apg) and steals (2.1 spg) while ranking third in rebounds (4.0 rpg) through the first nine games of the season. He has scored in double figures in eight of nine games, including two 20-plus point efforts. He collected a single-game program record-tying eight steals against Sacred Heart on Nov. 29. His 4.22 assist-to-turnover ratio is a top-15 mark in the country.

Mingo, the highest-ranked recruit in program history, was named an ESPN Top 50 Impact Newcomer in late October. He was ranked as the No. 34 recruit nationally per 247Sports & No. 39 recruit nationally per ESPN out of high school. He was named the 2025 New York Gatorade Player of the Year following standout senior season at Long Island Lutheran.

STEADY FREDDIE

Redshirt junior Freddie Dillone V, Penn State's only returning starter from a season ago, has been a consistent presence for the Nittany Lions thus far this season.

Dillone is averaging 13.2 points, 3.7 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game with just nine total turnovers in 231 minutes of playing time. His 13.2 points per game ranks second on the team.

He has scored in double figures in seven games this season, including a career-best 22 points and nine rebounds against Providence on Nov. 22.

OH MY MELIH

Istanbul, Turkey native Melih Tunca has been on fire to start the season, scoring in double figures in eight of nine games while shooting 54.2 percent (39-72) from the field and 45.0 percent (9-20) from 3-point range.

Tunca ranks third on the squad in points (12.8 ppg) and second in assists (3.8 apg).

JUMP FOR JOSH

Senior Josh Reed was relied upon as a key defensive player in his three seasons at Cincinnati, averaging just 2.8 points per game through 97 career games with the Bearcats, but has made a massive offensive jump since transferring to Penn State for the 2025-26 season.

Reed is averaging 10.6 points, 4.2 rebounds and 1.4 steals per game through nine games this season while shooting 51.6 percent from the field. He has scored in double figures in five games this season after coming to Penn State with just seven career double-digit scoring games through his three seasons at Cincinnati.

BIG START FOR THE BIG FELLA

Freshman Ivan Jurić leads the team with a stellar 71.4 (35-49) field goal percentage while averaging 10.6 points and a team-best 4.3 rebounds per game. Jurić owns five double-digit scoring efforts and is coming off a career-best 16-point performance against Campbell last Tuesday.

NEW-LOOK NITTANY LIONS

The new-look Nittany Lions feature 10 new players this season.

Penn State returns just 14.6 percent of points, 11.0 percent of rebounds, 12.5 percent of assists and 15.5 percent of minutes played from last season in its three returners - Freddie Dillone V, Eli Rice and Dominick Stewart.

The Nittany Lion roster is the 10th-most inexperienced roster in Division I per Bart Torvik's experience metric. The Penn State roster features one senior, two juniors, two sophomores and eight freshmen.

THE OPPOSITION

SCOUTING INDIANA

- Indiana is 7-2 on the season and 0-1 in Big Ten play. The Hoosiers started the season 7-0, but have since dropped their last two games, a 64-73 road loss at Minnesota on Dec. 3 and a 78-87 neutral site loss to #6 Louisville on Saturday.
- The Hoosiers are in their first season under head coach Darian DeVries, who came to Indiana after a one-year stint as the leader of West Virginia.
- Indiana is 6-0 in home games this season.
- Tucker DeVries leads five Hoosiers in double figures with a team-best 17.8 points per game. Lamar Wilkerson (16.0 ppg), Tayton Conerway (11.8 ppg), Reed Bailey (10.3 ppg) and Sam Alexis (10.0 ppg) follow.

AGAINST THE HOOSIERS

- Penn State and Indiana meet for the only time this regular season Tuesday night in Bloomington.
- The Hoosiers have won the last three meetings after Penn State won the previous four matchups. Indiana swept last year's regular-season series, earning a 77-71 win at The Palestra in January before taking an 83-78 victory at Assembly Hall in February.
- Penn State is 4-24 all-time when playing in Bloomington, with the most recent win coming on Feb. 3, 2024 during Mike Rhoades' first season at the helm.

YEAR THREE

The Nittany Lions enter their third season under Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Mike Rhoades in 2025-26. Rhoades has laid a strong foundation during his first two seasons and welcomes back key returnees, a top-30 recruiting class and experienced international players for the 2025-26 season.

Rhoades orchestrated the highest-scoring offense in Penn State history in 2024-25 as the Nittany Lions set a single-season program record with 79.1 points per game during his second season at the helm. He and his staff engineered the identification and development of Penn State's first-ever first-round NBA Draft pick in Yanic Konan Niederhauser, who was selected with the 30th overall pick of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers.

HIGH OCTANE

Penn State's offense has thrilled under head coach Mike Rhoades as the Nittany Lions have averaged 77.1 points per game through Rhoades' two completed seasons in Happy Valley. Rhoades orchestrated the highest-scoring offense in Penn State history in 2024-25 as the Nittany Lions set a single-season program record with 79.1 points per game during his second season at the helm. He engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 as the Nittany Lions averaged 75.1 points per game in his debut season (2023-24).

CAPTAINS

Penn State has named four team captains ahead of the 2025-26 season. The four captains were elected by both the players and the staff:

- Junior forward Saša Ciani
- Freshman guard Kayden Mingo
- Senior forward Josh Reed
- Redshirt sophomore guard Eli Rice

FIRST-ROUND DRAFT PICK

Mike Rhoades and his staff were responsible for identifying, recruiting and developing Penn State's first-ever first-round NBA Draft pick in Yanic Konan Niederhauser as the big man was selected with the 30th overall pick of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers in June 2025. Konan Niederhauser led the Big Ten with 2.3 blocks per game during his one season in the Blue & White in 2024-25 and saw a +7.8 points per game and +3.1 rebounds per game increase from his collegiate career averages prior to his time at Penn State.

Konan Niederhauser was the first Nittany Lion to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft in Penn State history. He was the highest-drafted Nittany Lion in the modern era of the draft and the 16th overall NBA Draft pick from Penn State. Current Denver Nugget Jalen Pickett (2nd round, pick 32, Denver) was the previous highest pick from Penn State in modern Draft history. Konan Niederhauser became the third Penn State player drafted in the last three years, joining Jalen Pickett (2023 to Denver) and Seth Lundy (2023 to Atlanta).

OUR STATE

Penn State's schedule is set up to take the Nittany Lions all over the state of Pennsylvania. Penn State traveled to Xfinity Mobile Arena in Philadelphia, the home of the 76ers, on Nov. 15 to face in-state foe La Salle. The Nittany Lions will meet Pittsburgh in a non-conference battle inside the GIANT Center in Hershey on Dec. 21. Penn State also makes its return to the historic Palestra in Philadelphia on Jan. 3 when Penn State hosts Illinois in a Big Ten battle inside the Cathedral of College Basketball.

PETER AND ANN TOMBROS ENDOWED HEAD COACH MIKE RHOADES

Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Men's Basketball Head Coach Mike Rhoades enters his third season as the leader of the Nittany Lions in 2025-26. Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Dr. Patrick Kraft announced the hiring of Rhoades as the 15th head coach in program history on March 29, 2023. In 21 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rhoades, a Mahanoy City, Pennsylvania native, has produced a 405-221 record, a winning percentage of .647, seven NCAA Tournament appearances and nine national postseason appearances.

Rhoades orchestrated the highest-scoring offense in Penn State history in 2024-25 as the Nittany Lions set a single-season program record with 79.1 points per game during his second season at the helm. Penn State earned two wins over top-15 ranked teams in 2024-25, including a Big Ten-opening win over #8 Purdue which marked Penn State's first win over a team ranked in the top 10 of the AP Poll since Dec. 2019. The Nittany Lions earned their first road win at Wisconsin in over 30 years and took down the 12th-ranked Badgers for Penn State's highest-ranked road win since 2009 in the regular-season finale. Rhoades earned his 400th career head coaching win on Dec. 29, 2024 with a victory over Penn.

Rhoades and his staff were responsible for identifying, recruiting and developing Penn State's first-ever first-round NBA Draft pick in Yanic Konan Niederhauser as the big man was selected with the 30th overall pick of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers in June 2025. Konan Niederhauser led the Big Ten with 2.3 blocks per game during his one season in the Blue & White in 2024-25 and saw a +7.8 points per game and +31 rebounds per game increase from his collegiate career averages prior to his time at Penn State.

The 2024-25 Nittany Lions started the season 6-0 for the first time in 25 years and started the season 8-1 for the first time in 10 years under Rhoades' tutelage. Penn State scored 100+ points in three games in the same season for just the second time in program history and finished the season ranking second in the Big Ten in steals and third in turnovers forced per game. Rhoades guided point guard Ace Baldwin Jr. to his second-straight Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honor, as Baldwin Jr. became the first-ever Penn State player to earn the award in back-to-back years.

Rhoades signed the highest-ranked recruiting class and highest-ranked recruit in program history in Kayden Mingo during the November 2024 signing period. Mingo, a consensus top-40 recruit nationally, headlines the Class of 2029 that ranks in the top 30 nationally.

Rhoades laid a strong foundation during his first season at Penn State in 2023-24. Rhoades led the Nittany Lions to a 16-17 overall record and 9-11 mark in conference play, marking the second-most Big Ten wins by a first-year head coach in program history. The Nittany Lions defeated a pair of top-15 ranked teams in #12 Illinois and #11 Wisconsin, with the win over the 11th-ranked Badgers marking the highest-ranked win under a first-year head coach in program history.

Rhoades engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 as the Nittany Lions averaged 75.1 points per game in his debut season. Penn State's 75.2 points per game in regular-season Big Ten play was the second-highest in Penn State's 32 seasons in the Big Ten, behind only the 2000-01 Nittany Lions team's 75.4 points per Big Ten game. Defensively, Penn State led the Big Ten in steals per game (8.3), turnover margin (+3.6) and three-point percentage defense (30.3%) in 2023-24.

Rhoades came to Penn State following a six-year stint as the head coach at VCU in which he guided the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances, a 129-60 overall record and 72-32 Atlantic 10 Conference record. He is the fourth-winningest coach in VCU history. Rhoades developed a pair of Atlantic 10 Players of the Year and 13 all-conference selections throughout his six years in Richmond. On the recruiting trail, Rhoades signed the Atlantic 10's top-ranked recruiting class in three of his last four years at VCU. In his time as an assistant and head coach at VCU, he was responsible for signing eight of the top nine all-time Ram recruits per 247Sports.

Under Rhoades tutelage, VCU saw players selected in back-to-back NBA Drafts, when Nah'Shon "Bones" Hyland was selected 26th overall by the Denver Nuggets in 2021, and Vince Williams Jr. was picked 47th overall by the Memphis Grizzlies in 2022. Justin Tillman also spent time with the Atlanta Hawks active roster during the 2021-22 season. Additionally, former VCU players Larry Sanders, Troy Daniels, Briante Weber and Treveon Graham, who each played for Rhoades during his days as an assistant coach at VCU from 2009-14, all spent time in the NBA. Mo Alie-Cox played basketball for Rhoades at VCU and has gone on to be a tight end for the NFL's Indianapolis Colts.

Prior to his six years in the head chair at VCU, Rhoades engineered a stunning turnaround at Rice as head coach of the Owls from 2014-17. Rhoades led Rice to its first 20-win campaign since 2003-04 and the program's first postseason appearance since 2011-12. Rice's 23-12 mark in 2016-17 was an 11-win improvement over the 2015-16 season and the 23 wins were the second-most in Owls' history. The Owls were a combined 12-49 in the two seasons prior to his arrival.

Rhoades spent 2009-14 as an assistant coach and associate head coach at VCU prior to taking the head coaching job at Rice. VCU reached the NCAA Tournament four times and appeared in the postseason all five years of that stretch. The Rams were 137-46 during that period and won the 2012 CAA Championship. He was integral in recruiting and developing the players that would lead the Rams to a historic Final Four appearance in 2010-11. In 2012, after VCU toppled Wichita State in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament, Rhoades was named one of the top 10 assistant coaches under 40 in the country by ESPN.com.

Prior to his VCU tenure, Rhoades enjoyed a wildly successful run at Division III Randolph-Macon in Ashland, Virginia. In 10 seasons as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, Rhoades compiled a 197-76 record (.722 win percentage) and led RMC to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including trips to the Sweet 16 in 2002 and 2003. Rhoades' teams won six Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) championships and earned national No. 1 rankings in two seasons.

Rhoades played collegiately under coaches Pat Flannery and Brad McAlester at Lebanon Valley College in his home state of Pennsylvania. Rhoades guided the Flying Dutchmen to the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship with a 66-59 overtime win over NYU. He was named the tournament's Co-Outstanding Player. The guard was the USA Today Division III National Player of the Year in 1995, two-time NABC All-American, three-time NABC All-Region and three-time Middle Atlantic Conference Player of the Year. He was the school's all-time scoring leader (2,050) until 1999, but still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey is one of five basketball jerseys retired by LVC.




