- Penn State's strong guard duo of Kayden Mingo (15.2 ppg) and Freddie Dillone V (13.6 ppg) are both averaging double-digit points.

- Penn State would pick up its first Big Ten win of the season.
- The Nittany Lions would earn their third-straight win over Wisconsin.
- Penn State would improve to 518-185 all-time inside of Rec Hall.

RETURN TO REC

Penn State returns to its roots Thursday night as the Nittany Lions host Wisconsin in the Return to Rec game. Rec Hall, which is the current home of Penn State's men's and women's volleyball and men's and women's gymnastics, women's basketball and wrestling teams, was the longtime home of the Nittany Lion men's basketball team until a 1996 move to the Bryce Jordan Center.

Men's basketball returns to Rec Hall for the third-straight year. Since moving into the Bryce Jordan Center during the 1996 season, Penn State has played at Rec Hall on five occasions – Dec. 14, 2013 vs. Princeton (L, 79-81 OT), Dec. 10, 2015 vs. Canisius (W, 81-67), Dec. 12, 2015 vs. Louisiana Monroe (W, 54-50), Feb. 21, 2024 vs. #12 Illinois (W, 90-89) and Jan. 30, 2025 vs. Ohio State (L, 64-83).

BACK TO THE ROOTS

Rec Hall gained a reputation as one of the toughest places to play in the nation when it served as the home of the Nittany Lions from 1929-96. That reputation was built on boisterous crowds who packed the arena to the rafters and a student section that was right on top of the floor. Rec Hall had a final listed capacity of 6,846 for basketball, but more than 8,000 fans jammed into the iconic building for a basketball game six times in the building's history, including a record 8,600 fans for a contest vs. Virginia on Dec. 5, 1973.

The Nittany Lions defeated Wisconsin, 79-50, in their final Rec Hall game on Jan. 7, 1996, before moving to their current home in the 15,261-seat Bryce Jordan Center the following game on Jan. 11, 1996.

The Nittany Lions compiled a stellar 514-183 (.737) record in Rec Hall from 1929-96, including a 45-game win streak from 1951-55. That era saw the Nittany Lions reach the program's only NCAA Final Four in 1954 behind All-American Jesse Arnelle and coach Elmer Gross. Arnelle is among a long list of Penn State greats to have made their mark on the Rec Hall floor, including names like John Amaechi, Freddie Barnes, John Barr, Ron Brown, Monroe Brown, Carver Clinton, Dan Earl, Mark Dumars, Gene Harris, Deron Hayes, Tom Hovasse, Mike Lang, Pete Lisicky and Bob Weiss.

Penn State was led by nine different head coaches during the Rec Hall era, including longtime NBA coaches Dick Harter (1979-83) and John Bach (1969-78), the Lions' all-time wins leader John Egli (1955-68), Helm's Foundation Hall of Fame inductee John Lawther (1937-49) and Bruce Parkhill (1984-95).

RIGHT INTO THE FIRE

The Nittany Lions, the youngest team in the Big Ten, have faced the conference's fire power right away in the early part of the BIG season. Penn State's first seven Big Ten opponents (Indiana, Michigan State, Illinois, Michigan, UCLA and Maryland) are a combined 33-16 (.673) thus far in conference play, while Penn State's remaining 10 opponents are a combined 30-40 (.429) so far in Big Ten action (through games on Jan. 19).

Four of Penn State's first five Big Ten games were against top-20 ranked opponents, with three being against top-10 teams, all of which were decided by single-digit margins and an average of 5.5 points:

Dec. 13 - #9 Michigan State (L, 72-76)
Jan. 3 - #20 Illinois (L, 65-73)
Jan. 6 - #2 Michigan (L, 72-74)
Jan. 10 - at #5 Purdue (L, 85-93)

NEW-LOOK NITTANY LIONS

The Nittany Lion roster is the 10th-most inexperienced roster in Division I per Bart Torvik's experience metric. The Penn State roster features one senior, two juniors, two sophomores and eight freshmen.

The new-look Nittany Lions feature 10 new players this season. Penn State returns just 14.6 percent of points, 11.0 percent of rebounds, 12.5 percent of assists and 15.5 percent of minutes played from last season.

DISCIPLINED

Penn State's young squad has shown tremendous discipline as the Nittany Lions rank ninth in the country in fewest turnovers per game (9.2). Penn State's young team also ranks top 40 in the country in fewest fouls per game (15.5).

STASHING STEALS

The Nittany Lions lead in the Big Ten with 7.5 steals per game. Penn State has led the conference in steals per game in each of Mike Rhoades' two full seasons at the helm.

Individually, Kayden Mingo leads the conference and ranks 20th nationally with 2.4 steals per game.

ONE OF ONE

Rookie guard Kayden Mingo is the ONLY freshman in the country averaging 15+ points (15.2 ppg), 4+ assists (4.5 apg), 3.5+ rebounds (3.9 rpg) and 2+ steals (2.4 spg) per game through games on Jan. 19.

MINGO MAKING HIS MARK

Rookie Kayden Mingo is the third-highest scoring freshman in the Big Ten. He leads the Nittany Lions in points (15.2 ppg), assists (4.5 apg) and steals (2.4 spg), while ranking second on the team in rebounds (3.9 rpg).

He has scored in double figures in 13 of 15 games, including two 20-plus point efforts. Mingo leads the Big Ten and ranks 20th nationally with 2.4 steals per game and he collected a single-game program record-tying eight steals against Sacred Heart on Nov. 29.

Mingo, the highest-ranked recruit in program history, was named an ESPN Top 50 Impact Newcomer in late October. He was ranked as the No. 34 recruit nationally per 247Sports & No. 39 recruit nationally per ESPN out of high school. He was named the 2025 New York Gatorade Player of the Year following standout senior season at Long Island Lutheran.

STEADY FREDDIE

Redshirt junior Freddie Dillione V, Penn State's only returning starter from a season ago, has been an improved and consistent presence for the Nittany Lions this season.

He has scored in double figures in 13 games this season, including a career-best 25-point performance at #5 Purdue on Jan. 10:

JUMP FOR JOSH

Senior Josh Reed was relied upon as a key defensive player in his three seasons at Cincinnati, averaging just 2.8 points per game through 97 career games with the Bearcats, but has made a big offensive jump since transferring to Penn State for the 2025-26 season.

Reed is averaging 8.9 points, 3.8 rebounds and 1.1 steals per game through 18 games this season. He has scored in double figures in eight games this season after coming to Penn State with just seven career double-digit scoring games through his three seasons at Cincinnati.

Reed notched his first-career double-double against #2 Michigan on Jan. 6, finishing with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

SHOTS UP

Redshirt sophomore Eli Rice leads the Nittany Lions with a 44.8 3FG% (30-67). The Gallatin, Tenn. native has turned it up a notch since the return from the holiday break:

STRONG START FOR THE BIG FELLA

Freshman Ivan Jurić leads the team with a 56.0 (56-100) field goal percentage while averaging 9.1 points and a team-best 4.2 rebounds per game. Jurić owns seven double-digit scoring efforts and put together a career-best 20-point performance against #2 Michigan on Jan. 6.

THE OPPOSITION

SCOUTING WISCONSIN

- The Badgers are 13-5 on the season and 5-2 in conference play.
- Wisconsin rides a four-game win streak into Happy Valley and is coming off a 96-87 home win over Rutgers Saturday.
- Wisconsin's two conference losses have come against top-10 teams Purdue and Nebraska, while the Badgers have beaten Rutgers, UCLA, Michigan and Minnesota.
- The Badgers lead the Big Ten in 3-point attempts (30.9 per game) and make 10.6 threes per contest, a mark that is top 25 in the nation.
- Nick Boyd leads the Badgers with 19.9 points per game, while John Blackwell follows closely with 18.6 points per contest. Nolan Winter is averaging 14.3 points and a team-best 8.7 rebounds per game.

AGAINST THE BADGERS

- Penn State and Wisconsin meet for the only time this season Thursday night inside Rec Hall.
- The Nittany Lions have won the last two matchups with the Badgers, both of which came against top-15 ranked Wisconsin teams.
- Penn State closed the 2024-25 season with an 86-75 road win at #12 Wisconsin on March 8, 2025. The Nittany Lions shot 56 percent from the field to earn Penn State's first road win at Wisconsin in over 30 years. The win over #12 Wisconsin marked Penn State's highest-ranked road win since Feb. 1, 2009 and was Penn State's first-ever win inside Wisconsin's Kohl Center.

YEAR THREE

The Nittany Lions enter their third season under Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Head Coach Mike Rhoades in 2025-26. Rhoades has laid a strong foundation during his first two seasons and welcomes back key returnees, a top-30 recruiting class and experienced international players for the 2025-26 season.

Rhoades orchestrated the highest-scoring offense in Penn State history in 2024-25 as the Nittany Lions set a single-season program record with 79.1 points per game during his second season at the helm. He and his staff engineered the identification and development of Penn State's first-ever first-round NBA Draft pick in Yanic Konan Niederhauser, who was selected with the 30th overall pick of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers.

HIGH OCTANE

Penn State's offense has thrilled under head coach Mike Rhoades as the Nittany Lions have averaged 77.1 points per game through Rhoades' two completed seasons in Happy Valley. Rhoades orchestrated the highest-scoring offense in Penn State history in 2024-25 as the Nittany Lions set a single-season program record with 79.1 points per game during his second season at the helm. He engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 as the Nittany Lions averaged 75.1 points per game in his debut season (2023-24).

FIRST-ROUND DRAFT PICK

Mike Rhoades and his staff were responsible for identifying, recruiting and developing Penn State's first-ever first-round NBA Draft pick in Yanic Konan Niederhauser as the big man was selected with the 30th overall pick of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers in June 2025. Konan Niederhauser led the Big Ten with 2.3 blocks per game during his one season in the Blue & White in 2024-25 and saw a +7.8 points per game and +3.1 rebounds per game increase from his collegiate career averages prior to his time at Penn State.

Konan Niederhauser was the first Nittany Lion to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft in Penn State history. He was the highest-drafted Nittany Lion in the modern era of the draft and the 16th overall NBA Draft pick from Penn State. Current Denver Nugget Jalen Pickett (2nd round, pick 32, Denver) was the previous highest pick from Penn State in modern Draft history. Konan Niederhauser became the third Penn State player drafted in the last three years, joining Jalen Pickett (2023 to Denver) and Seth Lundy (2023 to Atlanta).

Peter and Ann Tombros Endowed Men's Basketball Head Coach Mike Rhoades enters his third season as the leader of the Nittany Lions in 2025-26. Penn State Vice President for Intercollegiate Athletics Dr. Patrick Kraft announced the hiring of Rhoades as the 15th head coach in program history on March 29, 2023. In 21 seasons as a collegiate head coach, Rhoades, a Mahanoy City, Pennsylvania native, has produced a 405-221 record, a winning percentage of .647, seven NCAA Tournament appearances and nine national postseason appearances.

Rhoades orchestrated the highest-scoring offense in Penn State history in 2024-25 as the Nittany Lions set a single-season program record with 79.1 points per game during his second season at the helm. Penn State earned two wins over top-15 ranked teams in 2024-25, including a Big Ten-opening win over #8 Purdue which marked Penn State's first win over a team ranked in the top 10 of the AP Poll since Dec. 2019. The Nittany Lions earned their first road win at Wisconsin in over 30 years and took down the 12th-ranked Badgers for Penn State's highest-ranked road win since 2009 in the regular-season finale. Rhoades earned his 400th career head coaching win on Dec. 29, 2024 with a victory over Penn.

Rhoades and his staff were responsible for identifying, recruiting and developing Penn State's first-ever first-round NBA Draft pick in Yanic Konan Niederhauser as the big man was selected with the 30th overall pick of the 2025 NBA Draft by the Los Angeles Clippers in June 2025. Konan Niederhauser led the Big Ten with 2.3 blocks per game during his one season in the Blue & White in 2024-25 and saw a +7.8 points per game and +31 rebounds per game increase from his collegiate career averages prior to his time at Penn State.

The 2024-25 Nittany Lions started the season 6-0 for the first time in 25 years and started the season 8-1 for the first time in 10 years under Rhoades' tutelage. Penn State scored 100+ points in three games in the same season for just the second time in program history and finished the season ranking second in the Big Ten in steals and third in turnovers forced per game. Rhoades guided point guard Ace Baldwin Jr. to his second-straight Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year honor, as Baldwin Jr. became the first-ever Penn State player to earn the award in back-to-back years.

Rhoades signed the highest-ranked recruiting class and highest-ranked recruit in program history in Kayden Mingo during the November 2024 signing period. Mingo, a consensus top-40 recruit nationally, headlines the Class of 2029 that ranks in the top 30 nationally.

Rhoades laid a strong foundation during his first season at Penn State in 2023-24. Rhoades led the Nittany Lions to a 16-17 overall record and 9-11 mark in conference play, marking the second-most Big Ten wins by a first-year head coach in program history. The Nittany Lions defeated a pair of top-15 ranked teams in #12 Illinois and #11 Wisconsin, with the win over the 11th-ranked Badgers marking the highest-ranked win under a first-year head coach in program history.

Rhoades engineered the highest-scoring offense under a first-year head coach at Penn State since 1954-55 as the Nittany Lions averaged 75.1 points per game in his debut season. Penn State's 75.2 points per game in regular-season Big Ten play was the second-highest in Penn State's 32 seasons in the Big Ten, behind only the 2000-01 Nittany Lions team's 75.4 points per Big Ten game. Defensively, Penn State led the Big Ten in steals per game (8.3), turnover margin (+3.6) and three-point percentage defense (30.3%) in 2023-24.

Rhoades came to Penn State following a six-year stint as the head coach at VCU in which he guided the Rams to three NCAA Tournament appearances, a 129-60 overall record and 72-32 Atlantic 10 Conference record. He is the fourth-winningest coach in VCU history. Rhoades developed a pair of Atlantic 10 Players of the Year and 13 all-conference selections throughout his six years in Richmond. On the recruiting trail, Rhoades signed the Atlantic 10's top-ranked recruiting class in three of his last four years at VCU. In his time as an assistant and head coach at VCU, he was responsible for signing eight of the top nine all-time Ram recruits per 247Sports.

Under Rhoades tutelage, VCU saw players selected in back-to-back NBA Drafts, when Nah'Shon "Bones" Hyland was selected 26th overall by the Denver Nuggets in 2021, and Vince Williams Jr. was picked 47th overall by the Memphis Grizzlies in 2022. Justin Tillman also spent time with the Atlanta Hawks active roster during the 2021-22 season. Additionally, former VCU players Larry Sanders, Troy Daniels, Briante Weber and Treveon Graham, who each played for Rhoades during his days as an assistant coach at VCU from 2009-14, all spent time in the NBA. Mo Alie-Cox played basketball for Rhoades at VCU and has gone on to be a tight end for the NFL's Indianapolis Colts.

Prior to his six years in the head chair at VCU, Rhoades engineered a stunning turnaround at Rice as head coach of the Owls from 2014-17. Rhoades led Rice to its first 20-win campaign since 2003-04 and the program's first postseason appearance since 2011-12. Rice's 23-12 mark in 2016-17 was an 11-win improvement over the 2015-16 season and the 23 wins were the second-most in Owls' history. The Owls were a combined 12-49 in the two seasons prior to his arrival.

Rhoades spent 2009-14 as an assistant coach and associate head coach at VCU prior to taking the head coaching job at Rice. VCU reached the NCAA Tournament four times and appeared in the postseason all five years of that stretch. The Rams were 137-46 during that period and won the 2012 CAA Championship. He was integral in recruiting and developing the players that would lead the Rams to a historic Final Four appearance in 2010-11. In 2012, after VCU toppled Wichita State in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament, Rhoades was named one of the top 10 assistant coaches under 40 in the country by ESPN.com.

Prior to his VCU tenure, Rhoades enjoyed a wildly successful run at Division III Randolph-Macon in Ashland, Virginia. In 10 seasons as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, Rhoades compiled a 197-76 record (.722 win percentage) and led RMC to four NCAA Tournament appearances, including trips to the Sweet 16 in 2002 and 2003. Rhoades' teams won six Old Dominion Athletic Conference (ODAC) championships and earned national No. 1 rankings in two seasons.

Rhoades played collegiately under coaches Pat Flannery and Brad McAlester at Lebanon Valley College in his home state of Pennsylvania. Rhoades guided the Flying Dutchmen to the 1994 NCAA Division III National Championship with a 66-59 overtime win over NYU. He was named the tournament's Co-Outstanding Player. The guard was the USA Today Division III National Player of the Year in 1995, two-time NABC All-American, three-time NABC All-Region and three-time Middle Atlantic Conference Player of the Year. He was the school's all-time scoring leader (2,050) until 1999, but still holds Lebanon Valley records in free-throw percentage (.845), assists (668) and steals (212). His No. 5 jersey is one of five basketball jerseys retired by LVC.
