QUICK HITS

- The Penn State women's tennis team makes its first trip to the West Coast for Big Ten action this weekend with matchups against No. 12 USC and No. 8 UCLA.
- The Nittany Lions will face the Trojans at 3 p.m. at David X. Marks Tennis Stadium on Saturday before ending the trip against the Bruins on Sunday at 3 p.m. at the Los Angeles Tennis Center.
- The Blue & White sit at No. 47 in the latest ITA rankings. The tandem of Olivia Dorner and Maelie Monfils are ranked as the No. 75 doubles team in the country. The duo is 4-1 during the spring.

LAST TIME OUT

- Penn State split matches against Michigan State and Michigan this past weekend. The Nittany Lions defeated the Spartans, 4-2, before falling to the Wolverines by a 4-0 margin.
- Olivia Dorner won the 100th match of her Penn State career in the triumph against Michigan State. She defeated Nina Plihal, 6-4, 6-0, on court four.
- Brianna Baldi and Maria Daciana Ciubotaru went 2-0 as a doubles tandem, including their first ranked victory as a pair over Michigan's No. 68 Piper Charney and Emily Sartz-Lunde.
- Ciubotaru clinched the dual win over Michigan State with a 6-1, 6-1 victory against Oriana Parkins-Godwin on court five.
- Patricia Grigoras earned two wins in the victory over the Spartans. In doubles, she paired with Maiko Uchijima to clinch the doubles point on court two. The duo picked up a 6-2 win. The sophomore secured a singles victory on court three over Matilde Morais, 6-3, 6-3.

MATCHUP PREVIEW

ACROSS THE NET

USC

- USC enters the weekend as the No. 12 team in the country with a 9-4, 2-0 Big Ten record. The Trojans are coming off a road sweep over Minnesota and Wisconsin.
- Southern California has one top 25 win as the team defeated No. 11 Stanford, now unranked, at the end of January. All four of USC's losses have been against current top 25 opponents: No. 6 Pepperdine, No. 8 UCLA, No. 15 California and No. 21 Virginia.
- The Trojans have two ranked doubles pairs in No. 15 Daniela Borrueal and Lily Fairclough and No. 32 Jana Hossam Salah and Fairclough.
- USC has three ranked singles competitors: No. 38 Hossam Salah, No. 39 Emma Charney and No. 98 Eugenia Zozaya Menendez.

UCLA

- UCLA is the No. 8 team in the country according to ITA. The Bruins will take a 7-3, 1-1 Big Ten record into the weekend.
- UCLA split its weekend against Wisconsin and Minnesota.
- The Bruins have three wins over current top 25 teams in nonconference play: No. 6 Pepperdine, No. 12 USC and No. 20 UCF. The other two losses have been to ranked opponents as well as they dropped contests to No. 7 LSU and No. 15 California.
- No. 31 Olivia Center and Kate Fakh is the only ranked doubles pair.
- UCLA has three ranked singles players: No. 40 Anne-Christine Lutkemeyer, No. 54 Mayu Crossley and No. 108 Bianca Fernandez.

SERIES HISTORY

USC

- Saturday will be the second meeting between Penn State and USC and the first in Los Angeles.
- The Nittany Lions earned a historic victory over the Trojans in Happy Valley a season ago, 4-3. The win over No. 14 USC was the highest-ranked win in at least 20 years for the Blue & White.
- In the triumph, PSU took the doubles point before singles wins from Dorner, Grigoras and Ciubotaru. Dorner earned a ranked win over No. 46 Grace Piper in the victory while Ciubotaru clinched the contest.

UCLA

- Penn State and UCLA met for the first time last season.
- The Bruins picked up a 4-0 victory at Sarni Tennis Center.

NOTES AND STORYLINES

Liv Hits the Century Mark

- With a court four singles win in Penn State's 4-2 win against Michigan State on March 6, senior Olivia Dorner reached 100 career victories as a Nittany Lion.
- She has 53 doubles and 47 singles triumphs to her name.

Maiko Mania

- Maiko Uchijima's 135 wins across singles and doubles are the most career wins on the team. She joined the Nittany Lions last season after two years at Temple, where she picked up 72 of those victories.
- Uchijima has collected two Big Ten Player of the Week honors with Penn State.

Sophomore Sensations

- Patricia Grigoras returned to Penn State after being tabbed to the Big Ten All-Freshman Team in 2025. She's off to a 7-4 (2-1 Big Ten) start in singles this spring. She earned a ranked win against Ohio State's No. 114 Sophia Cisse-Ignatiev.
- Maria Daciana Ciubotaru was named a Big Ten Player to Watch entering 2026. She has already secured victories on four different courts this season and has clinched four matches for PSU, including No. 25 Yale and Michigan State.

Doubles Dubs

- Penn State is 10-0 this season when taking the doubles point, including the most recent win over Michigan State.
- At the top spot, No. 75 Olivia Dorner and Maelie Monfils boast a 4-1 dual record in 2026 with ranked wins over the No. 11 and No. 75 doubles tandems.

Welcome to Happy Valley

- Assistant Coach Colby Meeks joined the staff with coaching experience at Liberty, Rice and New Mexico.
- Additionally, Penn State welcomed three newcomers to the program for the 2025-26 season in Maelie Monfils, Brianna Baldi and Ansley Cox.
- Baldi, a sophomore, and Monfils, a junior, joined the team after starting their collegiate careers at Wake Forest and Florida State, respectively.
- Cox, a four-star recruit out of Alabama, is the only freshman on the roster.

The Best in the Northeast

- The Nittany Lions earned the top spot in the postseason ITA Northeast Regional rankings a season ago.
- On the individual side, Olivia Dorner (No. 6), Patricia Grigoras (No. 8) and Maiko Uchijima (No. 15) earned regional singles rankings. In doubles, Dorner and Uchijima (No. 2) and Grigoras and Jordina Cegarra (No. 8) earned recognition.
- Penn State swept the ITA Northeast Region Coach and Assistant Coach of the Year awards in 2025. Head Coach Alexandra McIntyre and Assistant Coach Mike Mucci, now head coach of Portland State women's tennis, secured the honors.

On the Rise

- The 2025 spring season saw the Nittany Lions capture 14 victories, the most since the 2012-13 season.
- Penn State picked up its highest-ranked win in at least 20 years when the Nittany Lions took down No. 14 USC at home.

2025 FALL REVIEW

Debbie Southern Fall Classic

- Brianna Baldi won her flight in singles with a 3-0 record in her first action in the Blue & White, earning Big Ten Player of the Week. She took down Wake Forest's Heidi Bulger in the final.
- Baldi paired with Patricia Grigoras for two doubles wins as well.
- Fellow newcomer Maelie Monfils was another winner in Greenville, South Carolina with two singles wins.

ITA All-Americans

- Grigoras won two matches in prequalifying singles, defeating UCLA's Bianca Fernandez and Florida State's MaryBoyce Deatherage.
- The doubles pair of Olivia Dorner and Monfils took down Kansas' No. 85 Meg McCarty and Sandugash Kenzhibayeva while Jordina Cegarra and Maiko Uchijima picked up a win over Tulane's Leigh Van Zyl and Campbell Ricci.

Martha Thorn Invitational

- Freshman Ansley Cox took home the first two wins of her young career, defeating Liberty's Aranai Martinez in singles while pairing with Cegarra for a doubles victory.
- Maria Ciubotaru and Uchijima earned two singles wins apiece.

ITA Northeast Regional

- The Nittany Lions shined with three singles competitors and three doubles team reaching the quarterfinals, including two top three finishes.
- Uchijima earned Big Ten Player of the Week with her performance at the event. Paired with Dorner, the tandem played in the doubles championship for the second year in a row. The Tokyo, Japan native took home third place in singles with a ranked win over Columbia's No. 108 Gayathri Krishnan, 6-2, 6-4.
- Baldi advanced to the quarterfinals in singles with three wins where she did not drop a set. She reached the doubles quarterfinal with Ciubotaru who advanced to the top 16 on the singles side.
- Grigoras put together a strong showing en route to the singles quarterfinals while advancing to the top 16 of doubles alongside Cegarra.
- Cox and Monfils found themselves in the doubles quarterfinals after two dominant wins.

ITA East Sectional

- In round of 32 singles play, Baldi bested Virginia Tech's Ozlem Uslu.
- Dorner and Uchijima took a doubles win over UConn's Chloe Lomans and Madison McLeod in consolation doubles.

- Alexandra McIntyre enters her seventh season in 2025-26 leading the Penn State women's tennis program. She was named the program's 11th head coach on July 1, 2019 after spending the 2018-19 season as an assistant coach with the Nittany Lions.
- Prior to Penn State, McIntyre served as a volunteer assistant coach at North Carolina during the 2017-18 season. The Tar Heels won the ITA National Indoor Championship, the 2018 ACC Tournament and held the nation's No. 1 ranking for 10 consecutive weeks. North Carolina finished the 2017-18 season with five All-Americans.
- In 2025, Penn State collected 14 wins, its most since 2013. PSU went 10-2 at home. The Nittany Lions earned five Big Ten wins, including victories over Indiana, Purdue, Rutgers, No. 14 USC and Minnesota. Penn State's win over No. 14 USC was its highest-ranked win in at least 20 years.
- The Nittany Lions were ranked in the ITA Poll for the final 11 weeks of the season, rising as high as No. 33 on March 11. Olivia Dorner was tabbed second-team All-Big Ten, while Patricia Grigoras was named to the Big Ten All-Freshman team.
- In the Fall, Dorner and Maiko Uchijima won the doubles title at the ITA Northeast Regional, becoming the first Nittany Lions to compete at NCAA Individual Championships since 2012. The pair rose as high as No. 46 in the ITA Doubles Poll and finished the season with a 22-9 record, including 12-7 in dual matches with three wins over ranked opponents.
- Dorner earned eight singles wins at No. 1, including a victory over USC's No. 46 Grace Piper. Grigoras went 19-9 in singles as a freshman, including a 13-7 mark in dual matches. Uchijima tallied 13 singles wins and 26 doubles wins in 2024-25.
- In 2024, the Nittany Lions tallied six wins, including four in Big Ten play. Sofiya Chekhlystova earned All-Big Ten honors for the third time in her career. She finished the season ranked No. 4 in the ITA Northeast Region. Dorner and Karly Friedland ranked as high as No. 69 in the ITA Doubles Poll, while finishing the year as the No. 9 doubles pair in the ITA Northeast Region.
- In 2023, Penn State earned 12 wins, including four in Big Ten action. Chekhlystova picked up All-Big Ten honors, collecting 22 singles wins and 14 doubles wins, ranking as high as No. 42 in the ITA Singles Poll. Dorner earned 17 singles wins as a freshman, including 15 wins in dual matches.
- During the 2022 campaign, the Nittany Lions posted 11 wins and five wins in Big Ten conference play. Penn State ranked as high as No. 61 in the ITA national rankings. Chekhlystova earned All-Big Ten honors, going 11-4 in singles action.
- In her second year as head of the program in 2021, Anghelescu coached the Nittany Lions to a 9-7 record in conference play during the spring season, the first winning record in conference action since 2015. McIntyre coached senior Gabby O'Gorman to a unanimous selection to All-Big Ten honors in 2021.
- The 2020 spring was shortened due to the COVID-19 Pandemic cancelling Big Ten play. Despite the pandemic, in her first year as head coach, McIntyre led the Nittany Lions to five wins in 10 matches.
- As an assistant coach, McIntyre helped lead the Nittany Lions to 11 wins during the 2019 spring season, the team's most dual-match victories since 2015. The Nittany Lions reached a team ranking of No. 49, their first top-50 ranking since the 2016 season.
