> The Redhawks are looking to snap a 4-game losing streak to the Lopes.

> Seattle U is 3-9 all-time vs GCU in Phoenix. Two of those wins came in a series win at Brazell Field in 2023.

> The Redhawks are 7-4 at home this season, but 2-8 on the road. > As a team, the Redhawks rank top 4 in all extra base hit categories in the WAC.

> Sam Kane is tied for the conference lead in home runs (7). His next long ball will move him into a tie with Trevor Antonson (2020-24) for 4th all-time in career home runs in program history.

> Seven different Redhawks have recorded a win on the mound this season. Kenny Ishikawa and Isaac Hallam both have two to lead the team.

> Kenny Ishikawa's .581 SLG% this season ranks second in program history for a single season.
> Tyler Peterson leads the team in AVG this season at .329. He hit .183 last season.



The Seattle U Athletics Hall of Famer also captured the Triple Crown, which is awarded to the pitcher who leads their league in wins (18), strikeouts (228), and ERA (2.39). He is the first Seattle U baseball alumni to earn a major award in Major League Baseball. Skubal pitched for the Redhawks between 2015-18.





12 Former Players Selected MLB Amateur Draft

2025 marks the 16th season as skipper of the Seattle U baseball program for Donny Harrel. He is the longest tenured head coach in the program's 56-year history.

During that time, Harrel has seen several former players move to the next level. Since the program's return in 2010, 20 Redhawks have signed professional contracts including 12 Major League Baseball Amateur Draft picks. Three different Redhawks appeared in MLB during the 2021 season: Tarik Skubal, Eric Yardley, and Janson Junk. In 2024, Tarik Skubal was named the American League Cy Young winner with the Detroit Tigers.

As the skipper for Seattle U, Harrel has compiled a record of 317-447-2 and has guided the program to six appearances in the Western Athletic Conference (WAC) tournament. In 2016 the Redhawks captured their first conference championship, being crowned regular season champions behind a 21-6 conference mark. Harrel was named the WAC Coach of the Year following the 2016 season.

Before coaching at Seattle U, Harrel was an assistant baseball coach at the University of Washington for four years. At Washington, Harrel was not only responsible for assisting in on-field coaching, but he also was responsible for the Huskies' schedule and assisted with travel issues, budgeting, and helping student-athletes through the admissions process. He also oversaw the team's academic performance and was named Academic Coach of the Quarter in Winter 2007 when the team broke a 14-year record for highest cumulative grade point average.

Prior to to Seattle, Harrel was an assistant coach at Oregon State during the 2003-04 season. His head coaching experience comes from seven seasons at Lane Community College in Eugene, Ore., where he compiled a 220-90 record and led the team to the NWAACC championship in 1999. Named NWAACC Southern Division Coach of the Year four times, he also led fundraising efforts to build a field, improve other facilities, buy equipment, and increase scholarship opportunities.

Donny and his wife Cam have two children, daughter Brooklyn and son Easton, and a dog, Wrigley.
