2011 MPSF Player of the Year

One of forty-one players listed amongst the Preseason Herman Trophy candidates, Gyasi Zardes (Hawthorne, CA/Leuzinger HS) was a three-time MPSF Men's Soccer Player of the Week this year (Aug. 29, Sept. 5 & 26) and was named to College Soccer News and TopSoccer.com Teams of the Week on Sept. 25. He posted back-to-back hat tricks against UC Riverside (Aug. 27) and San Francisco (Sept. 1), before his third hat trick against Gonzaga (Sept. 23). Zardes reset the CSUB Division I record for most points in a game with seven against UCR. His 17 goals are the second most in a season by a CSUB player. In the NCAA Statistical report released on Nov. 8, Zardes ranks fourth nationally in goals (17), fourth in goals per game (1.00), sixth in points (36), and eighth in points per game (2.12).

2011 MPSF Newcomer of the Year

Salvador Bernal (Las Vegas, NV/Clark HS) becomes the second Rebel to earn conference freshman honors after leading the team in scoring this year with six goals (tied for sixth in the MPSF) and 14 points, ranking him in a tie for 11th. His best game came against Denver on October 16 at Peter Johann Memorial Field, where he scored a pair of second half goals in a two-minute span to help the Rebels rally from a two-goal deficit and force overtime. He scored two more goals in conference play, including a score against then No. 9 New Mexico in a 2-1 loss, and the first goal in UNLV's 3-2 win at Seattle U. His six goals were double the second place scorers on the team, while he was tied for second in assists with two.

2011 MPSF Coach of the Year

The Lobos are ranked No. 1 in the nation in all three major national polls for the second consecutive week, and logged the first undefeated season in program history with a 16-0-2 record (10-0-0 in MPSF). The team's undefeated season was just the second amongst active programs ever recorded at the University of New Mexico, and the fifth in university history. New Mexico broke its previous program record of games unbeaten in a single season, extending it to 18 games, while closing out the regular season with a program-high 12-game win streak. The Oct. 30 win over SJSU gave the team 11 straight wins, breaking the previous record of 10 straight wins set in '05. The Lobos had five players named to eight national teams of the week over the season, and three players earn MPSF Player of the Week honors.
