#### ABOUT THE SERIES VS COLLEGE OF IDAHO

Seattle U and College of Idaho have one previous meeting in program history, a 76-64 win for the Yotes on Dec. 20, 1982 in Idaho.

#### THE BAYLOR CONNECTION

While Seattle U and College of Idaho have minimal history playing against each other, the two pro-

grams do have one big connection – Elgin Baylor. Baylor began his collegiate career at College of Idaho, playing one season for the Coyotes in 1954-55. He averaged 32.8 points and 18.9 rebounds, leading the Coyotes to a Northwest Conference title and runner-up finish in the District 5 championships. Baylor went on to start at Seattle U for two seasons, leading the 1958 Seattle U team to the NCAA title game. He earned Most Outstanding Player honors even though Kentucky won that championship contest. He scored 60 points on Jan. 30, 1958, against Portland, one of II school records he still holds. He was drafted No. I overall by the Minneapolis Lakers in 1958 and began a professional career that included II All-Star Game appearances and a spot on the NBA's 50th anniversary team. Baylor is a member of both schools' athletic Hall of Fames.

#### QUICK HITS

- Seattle U moved to 4-4 on the season with an 89-40 win over Northwest on Dec. 13.
- The game was the Redhawks' home opener, the latest home opener date since 1988-89 when Seattle U played its first IO games on the road and did not host a home game until Jan. 6, 1989.
- The 89 points scored against Northwest are a season high and the 40 points allowed are a season low.
- The 40 points allowed by Northwest is the least allowed by a Redhawks squad since Dec. 17, 2015 when they earned a 98-36 win over Northwest Indian College.
- Riley Grigsby had a team-high 27 points in the win over the Eagles, marking the fourth time this season he has led the Redhawks in scoring.
- Darrion Trammell added 15 points and six assists while Jared Pearre came off the bench to chip in a season-high I2 points on 5-of-6 shooting.
- Seattle U shot a season-high 57.6% from the field and season-high 80% from the free-throw line, but struggled from deep, going just 5-of-21 (23.8%).

#### REDHAWK RUNDOWN

- Seattle U opened the season with three consecutive wins for the first time since the 2008-09 season.
- The Redhawks picked up wins over WCC member Portland, NAIA William Jessup and Mountain West member Air Force in that stretch.
- Seattle U's 4I points at UW on Dec. 9 was the fewest points scored since a 59-44 loss at UTRGV on Feb. 14, 2019. It also marks the fewest points scored in a game during Jim Hayford's tenure.
- Emeka Udenyi was the lone double-digit scorer for the Redhawks at UW on Dec. 9, finishing with I2 points on 6-of-7 shooting. He leads the team shooting 69.7 percent from the field.
- Sophomore Darrion Trammell had a career-high 32 points in the loss at Long Beach State on Dec. 6. The game also marked his first start of the year.
- Riley Grigsby poured in six three pointers on his way to 24 points at Long Beach State on Dec. 6. The six threes were a career-high and the most threes made in a game since Matej Kavas drained six on Dec. 23, 2017 against Nicholls State.
- · Nate Robinson made his first appearance of the season on Dec. 3 at UCLA after missing the first four games due to a toe injury. The junior guard had two points, one rebound and one block in nine minutes of
- Junior Rip Economou drained four threes on Nov. 29 against Air Force on Nov. 29, notching a career-high
- The Redhawks won their season opener for a second straight year, this time with an 84-72 victory over Portland on Nov. 25.
- The win over Portland was the fourth straight for Seattle U. The teams have met during each of the past four years and are set to meet again later this season.
- Riley Grigsby poured in a career-high 28 points in the season debut versus Portland. His performance over the first three games earned him WAC Player of the Week honors.
- Freshman Kobe Williamson had an impressive collegiate debut with 10 points and nine boards against Portland. He is the first freshman to start a season opener since Morgan Means did so in 2016-17. Means finished with five points, three rebounds and three assists in that outing.

# GRIGSBY NAMED WAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Riley Grigsby was named TicketSmarter WAC Player of the Week for Nov. 23-29. This marks Grigsby's first career Player of the Week honor. The junior guard/forward from San Jose, Calif., averaged 18.3 points per game to lead the Redhawks to their first 3-0 start since the 2008-09 season. He opened the season with a career-high 28 points in an 84-72 win at Portland, adding six rebounds, four assists and two blocks against the Pilots. Against William Jessup, he had I4 points to go along with four rebounds, two assists and two steals. Continuing the road trip from Portland to Las Vegas, Grigsby scored I3 points with three assists and a block in a 63-45 win over Air Force.



#### WINNING WAYS

While the Redhawks' squad features II new faces, they are not all new to each other including a trio of junior college transfers from City College of San Francisco. Nate Robinson, Darrion Trammell and Emeka Udenyi spent the 2019-20 season as teammates for the Rams, who went a perfect 30-0 while averaging more than IOO ppg.

#### PRESEASON HONORS

Junior forward Riley Grigsby earned the first league recognition of his career, being named to the Coaches Preseason All-WAC Second Team. The San Jose, Calif., native is the Redhawks' lone returning starter and is coming off of a sophomore campaign that saw him average 9.7 points and 5.5 rebounds per game. Grigsby led Seattle U in scoring twice and collected three double-doubles, including career highs of 23 points and 12 rebounds in a win over Grand Canyon on Feb. 20.

#### WAC PRESEASON POLLS

The Redhawks were selected to finished fifth in the Western Athletic Conference in both the WAC 2020-21 Preseason Coaches Poll and Media Poll.

The WAC Digital Network is available on both desktop and mobile/tablet devices, as well as for over-the-top (OTT) platforms, including Roku, Amazon Fire TV, Android TV and Apple TV.

RADIO: All Seattle U men's basketball games will once again be available on KTTH 770 AM in the Seattle area, and online at mynorthwest.com.

Reigning WAC champion NM State was selected to repeat the feat in 2020-21, earning eight of nine first-place votes in the Coaches' Poll. Coaches could not vote for their own team or players. The Aggies were also the first-place pick by the media. Grand Canyon was picked second in both polls, followed by UTRGV in third and California Baptist in fourth.

#### **OVERTIME**

- Seattle U is 5-3 in overtime games under Head Coach Jim Hayford. The Redhawks went I-2 in extra time during the 2019-20 season, including an 88-87 loss at California Baptist on Feb. 29, 2020, which ultimately ended up being the final game of the shortened season.
- Seattle U also played triple overtime affair at Kansas City on Jan. 2, 2020, the longest game the Redhawks had played since a triple overtime defeat to Chicago State on Feb. 27, 2014.

#### AGAINST THE RANKS

A meeting with the nationally-ranked Washington on Dec. 17, 2019 was just the third game against a ranked opponent during Seattle U's modern-day DI era. Seattle U's last meeting with a ranked opponent came on Dec. 21, 2011, when it hosted No. 24 Virginia at KeyArena. The Cavaliers won, 83-77. The Redhawks' only other ranked match-up came on Mar. 3, 2009 against then No. 13 Washington. The Huskies would claim an 87-60 victory at Alaska Airlines Arena.

#### HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

The Redhawks surpassed the IOO-point mark for the fifth time under Head Coach Jim Hayford with their II5-8I win over Pacific University on Nov. I2, 2019. They achieved the feat twice during his first season (I2I vs. Puget Sound on Nov. I2, 2017; IO2 vs. Detroit Mercy on Nov. I8, 2017) and twice in 2018-I9 (IO7 vs. Northwest University on Nov. 28, 2018; IO2 vs. Prairie View A&M on Dec. 20, 2018).

#### 400 CAREER VICTORIES AND COUNTING FOR HAYFORD

Head Coach Jim Hayford earned his 400th career victory on Nov. I2, 2019 as the Redhawks defeated Pacific University, I15-81. The win was also Hayford's 40th at the helm of the Redhawks, achieved in just over two seasons. "Players win games," said Hayford postgame. "I've had a lot of great players and a lot of great assistant coaches. A lot of credit goes to my family. I've been doing this 2I years and it's a stressful job, so I guess I've got some stick-to-it-ness and I got a few things right." His road to 400 included I2 seasons of 20 wins or more and II national postseason tournaments, including six (2003, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011) at NCAA Division III Whitworth, three at EWU (2015, 2016, 2017) and two at Seattle U (2018, 2019). Hayford is in his 22nd season as a head coach and now has 416 career victories.

#### YEAR THREE UNDER HEAD COACH JIM HAYFORD

Against the abrupt and heartbreaking ending to the 2019-20 season, Head Coach Jim Hayford closed out his third season at the helm of the Redhawk program with a year filled with memorable moments and achievements. All told,

the Redhawks would go I4-I5 overall, 7-7 in Western Athletic Conference play and earn the third seed in the WAC Tournament – tying the program's highest seed – before the impact of unforeseen circumstances forced the cancellation of their final two regular-season games, the WAC Tournament and any potential postseason play.

Primed to begin the year on a high note, Hayford would tip off the personal achievements on No. 12, 2019 with the 400th win of his 20-year career. The Redhawks would finish the season with a pair of 1,000-point scorers on the court as senior Morgan Means hit the mark on Nov. 26, 2019 and redshirt junior Terrell Brown added his name to the list on Feb. 20, 2020, becoming just the third and fourth players to reach 1,000 points in the program's modern-day DI era. As a team, the Redhawks added themselves to the program's record book as their 209 three pointers ranks seventh for a single season and their collective free-throw percentage of 77.5 (506-653) ranks second best all-time, trailing only the 1944-45 team that went 145-172 from the line for an 84.3 average. The team free-throw shooting also ranked among the best in the nation as their 77.5 percentage was 12th, free-throws made ranked 29th and free-throws attempted ranked 79th. The Redhawks also finished second among all 350 Division I programs in fewest turnovers, and eighth in fewest turnovers per game (10.2).

In WAC play, Seattle U earned a trio of home-and-home sweeps, downing Chicago State, CSU Bakersfield and Utah Valley - the final in thrilling overtime fashion as Means banked home a runner from the left block with 1.5 seconds remaining for an 87-85 win in Orem. The victory in Bakersfield was also a first as WAC opponents and last achieved the 2010-II season. The Redhawks also earned a thrilling 95-89 win over Grand Canyon on Feb. 20, 2020, marking the second straight year of clinching a key win over the Lopes.

#### **HOME COURT ADVANTAGE**

Seattle U has compiled a 243-153 (.613) record in the Redhawk Center, including a I5-game winning streak that began Nov. 5, 2008 with a perfect I0-0 mark during the 2008-09 season. In 2017-18, the Redhawks went 9-1, in 2018-19, the Redhawks went I2-6 and in 2019-20 they were 9-3.



# FUTURE REDHAWK

Brody Nunn, a 6-2 guard hailing from Melbourne, Australia, will continue his playing career at Seattle U beginning in 2021.

"Brody is an outstanding shooter and very skilled guard," said Head Coach Jim Hayford said. "He is great in the classroom and will be a great leader on our campus."

Nunn attends Haileybury College in Melbourne, where he averaged 18.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 2.0 steals and 4.0 assists per game during his junior season in 2019. He has also been a member of the U20 Victorian state team. Nunn averaged I2.0 points, 3.0 assists and 2.0 rebounds per game during the 2020 National Junior Championships. He shot 63 percent from the 3-point line during the U20 nationals, setting an all-time tournament record. His total makes ranked fourth during tournament play. Nunn competed for the Sandringham Sabers UI8 team in the Southern Basketball Association, winning the 2018 U18 Victoria championship. During that 2018 season, he led the entire National Classic Tournament in made three-pointers with 27 while shooting at a 47 percent clip.

Current Redhawk freshman Kobe Williamson was Nunn's teammate at Haileybury, the Victorian state team and the Sandringham Sabers.

Jim Hayford enters his fourth season as the head coach of Seattle University men's basketball in 2020-21. He was named the Redhawks' head coach on Wednesday, Mar. 28, 2017. In his first season at Seattle U, he led the Redhawks to their most successful season in the school's modern-day Division I era and has complied a 52-44 record at SU. Hayford is 412-219 in 21 total seasons as a head coach.

Along with improved records over Hayford's tenure, the Redhawks have also seen a rise of their rankings, including a 199 average over the last three seasons (according to KenPom), a marked improve-

ment over a 268 average over the previous three seasons (2015-17).

Against the abrupt and heartbreaking ending to the 2019-20 season, Hayford closed out his third season at the helm of the Redhawk program with a year filled with memorable moments and achievements. All told, the Redhawks would go 14-15 overall, 7-7 in Western Athletic Conference play and earn the third seed in the WAC Tournament – tying the program's highest seed – before the impact of unforeseen circumstances forced the cancellation of their final two regular-season games, the WAC Tournament and any potential postseason play.

Primed to begin the year on a high note, Hayford would tip off the personal achievements on No. 12, 2019 with the 400th win of his 20-year career. The Redhawks would finish the season with a pair of 1,000-point scorers on the court as senior Morgan Means hit the mark on Mov. 26, 2019 and redshirt junior Terrell Brown added his name to the list on Feb. 20, 2020, becoming just the third and fourth players to reach 1,000 points in the program's modern-day DI era. As a team, the Redhawks added themselves to the program's record book as their 209 three pointers ranks seventh for a single season and their collective free-throw percentage of 77.5 (506-653) ranks second best all-time, trailing only the 1944-45 team that went 145-172 from the line for an 84.3 average. The team free-throw shooting also ranked among the best in the nation as their 77.5 percentage was 12th, free-throws made ranked 29th and free-throws attempted ranked 79th. The Redhawks also finished second among all 350 Division I programs in fewest turnovers, and eighth in fewest turnovers per game (10.2).

In WAC play, Seattle U earned a trio of home-and-home sweeps, downing Chicago State, CSU Bakersfield and Utah Valley - the final in thrilling overtime fashion as Means banked home a runner from the left block with 1.5 seconds remaining for an 87-85 win in Orem. The victory in Bakersfield was also a first as WAC opponents and last achieved the 2010-II season. The Redhawks also earned a thrilling 95-89 win over Grand Canyon on Feb. 20, 2020, marking the second straight year of clinching a key win over the Lopes.

# HEAD COACH JIM HAYFORD



Hayford's Redhawks went 18-15 overall in 2018-19, marking the first back-to-back seasons with 18 wins or more since 2007-08 and 2008-09. The squad jumped out to a 12-3 record to start the season, including wins over Pac-12 members Washington State and Cal, marking the best start to a year in more than 50 years. The Redhawks would battle injury and illness as conference play got underway, but rebounded to win five of their final six regular-season contests. Terrell Brown (All-WAC Second Team, WAC All-Newcomer Team) and Myles Carter (WAC All-Defensive Team, NBCA All-District Second Team) both entered the Seattle U all-time record book during the season. Brown's 150 assists ranks eighth all-time and Carter's 60 blocks ranks second. The team's 238 three-pointers ranks third all-time while their 118 blocks are second.

Inheriting a program that went I3-I7 in 20I6-I7, Hayford led the 20I7-I8 Redhawks to finish 20-I4 overall, I6-3 on their home court and 8-6 in Western Athletic Conference play. The win total marked a program high since returning to Division I in 2008-09, and marked the first 20-win DI season since I963-64 when Seattle U finished 22-6. The I6 home victories was also a modern-day DI record, while the eight WAC wins was the most since joining the league in 20I2-I3. The fourth-place finish ties the best finish during the Redhawks six years competing in the WAC. The season culminated in Hayford's I0th national postseason appearance as a head coach as the Redhawks earned a berth in the Collegiate Basketball Invitational (CBI).

Hayford's up-tempo style of play saw the Redhawks set numerous modern-day DI program records including total points (2,589), field goals (881), field goal percentage (44.6), three-point field goals (312), free-throw percentage (73.8), rebounds (1,298) and blocks (123). Three Redhawks earned postseason honors from the WAC, including junior center Aaron Menzies (Second Team All-WAC, All-Defensive Team), sophomore guard Matej Kavas (Second Team All-WAC) and graduate guard Jordan Hill (All-Newcomer Team). Menzies would set an all-time program record with 79 blocks and a modern-day DI record with 302 rebounds.

Hayford has 20 total seasons as a head coach, amassing an overall record of 398-204 (.670). Prior to Seattle U, he had stints at EWU, Whitworth (NCAA DIII) and Sioux Falls (NAIA). He has coached in IO national postseason tournaments, including six (2003, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011) at NCAA Division III Whitworth, three at EWU (2015, 2016, 2017) and one at Seattle U (2018).

In 2016-17, Hayford completed his sixth season as the head coach at EWU, leading the Eagles to a 22-12 overall record and a 13-5 mark in Big Sky Conference play. In six seasons with Hayford at the helm, the Eagles went to the NCAA Tournament (2015), the CBI Tournament (2016, 2017), earned a Big Sky regular season cochampionship (2015) and won the Big Sky Tournament title (2015). Under Hayford, the Eagles had one Big Sky Conference Player of the Year (Jacob Wiles, 2017), two Big Sky Freshmen of the Year, 12 All-Big Sky selections, seven National Association of Basketball (NABC) All-District selections, two Associated Press honorable mention All-Americans and one NBA Draft pick (Tyler Harvey, 2015).

The building process at EWU hit its stride in 2014-15 when Hayford led the Eagles to a 26-9 mark, including a 14-4 Big Sky record. EWU went on to win the Big Sky Conference Tournament and earn a bid to the NCAA Tournament – the first postseason appearance for the program since 2003-04. The team featured Tyler Harvey, who

was the nation's leader in scoring (23.1 ppg) and three-pointers made per game (4.0), and went on to be the program's third all-time NBA Draft pick. For his efforts, Hayford was named Big Sky Co-Coach of the Year.

Before taking over at Eastern Washington in March of 20II, Hayford spent IO seasons building Whitworth University in Spokane, Wash., into a NCAA Division III powerhouse. In his tenure at the helm of the Pirates, Hayford had a record of 217-57 and a winning percentage of .792. He was the Northwest Conference Coach of the Year five times, and twice was honored by the NABC as the West Region Coach of the Year.

Taking over a program that went 25-24 in the two seasons prior (1999-01), Hay-ford coached the Pirates to eight 20-win seasons, six appearances in the NCAA Division III Tournament (including the last five seasons in a row), five Northwest Conference titles, three NCAA DIII Sweet I6 appearances (2008, 2010, 2011) and one Elite Eight appearance (2011). At the time he left Whitworth, his career winning percentage ranked among the top IO among all active NCAA Division III coaches.

Prior to Whitworth, Hayford was head coach at the University of Sioux Falls (S.D.), where he compiled a 37-27 record in two seasons. During his inaugural season (1999-2000), he led the Cougars to their first conference playoff appearance in five years. Hayford's Cougars finished the 2000-0I season at 22-I2, setting a school record for wins in a season. Prior to Hayford's arrival, USF was 9-I7 in 1998-99.

Hayford served as the top assistant coach at Azusa Pacific University (Calif.) from 1990-99, including eight seasons under Bill Odell. APU won seven consecutive Golden State Athletic Conference titles during that time and advanced to the NAIA Division I Final Four in each of his final two seasons there.

Hayford earned his bachelor's degree in social science from Azusa Pacific in 1989. He earned a master's degree in education from Claremont Graduate School in 1991. Hayford and his wife, Robin, have two adult children, daughter, Jayme, and son, Joseph.
